#### OPENING TIPS

- Utah State's 10-1 start to the season is its best since the 2012-13 team began the year with a 14-1 record.
- Utah State trails BYU 92-143 in what is the longest series in USU men's basketball history. The Aggies have lost seven straight to the Cougars and are 0-3 all-time in neutral-site contests.
- Utah State is 4-6 all-time at Vivint Smart Home Arena with victories over Southern Utah (76-63) during the 1994-95 season, Wyoming (73-72) during the 1996-97 season, San Diego State (64-61) during the 1997-98 season and Weber State (76-67) in last year's Beehive Classic.
- Utah State is 1-1 all-time in the Beehive Classic, losing to Utah, 77-67, during the 2017-18 season, before beating Weber State, 76-67, during the 2018-19 season.
- As of Dec. 10, Utah State is among the top-10 in the nation in nine different statistics. The Aggies lead the nation in total rebounds (488), rank second in rebound margin (+12.7) and free throws made (200), third in free throws attempted (260) and scoring margin (+20.9), fourth in defensive rebounds per game (31.55) and total rebounds per game (44.36), fifth in total assists (181), sixth in won-lost percentage (.909) and 10th in assist-turnover ratio (1.45). USU is also among the top-25 in the country in free throw percentage, shooting 76.9 percent from the line to rank No. 25 in the land.
- Utah State is the only team in the Mountain West with five players scoring in double figures. Furthermore, the Aggies are also the only team in the Mountain West with two players coming off the bench that average double figures.
- Utah State senior guard **Sam Merrill**, currently with 1,745 career points, is inching closer to moving up in the career scoring mark in USU history. Merrill is four points behind **Tai Wesley** (2008-11) for No. 8, and 29 points behind **Kendall Youngblood** (1989-92) for No. 7 on the all-time scoring list.
- Merrill** needs four more assists to tie **Tony Brown** (396) for No. 3 on the all-time assists list, two steals away from tying **Wesley** for No. 9 on the all-time steals list and two field goals away from breaking into the top-10 in career field goals.
- Merrill** did not appear in Utah State's last contest against Saint Katherine, snapping a streak of 102 consecutive games played and 97 consecutive starts.
- Sophomore forward **Justin Bean**, a former walk-on, leads the Mountain West in rebounding with 12.0 boards per contest and is one of two players in the conference averaging a double-double (Carlton Bragg, UNM), turning in 14.7 points per game.
- Bean** is second in the nation in offensive rebounds per game (4.64), fourth in the nation in total rebounds per game (12.0) and 20th in the nation in defensive rebounds per game (7.36).
- Bean's** 12.0 rebounds per game is the most by an Aggie since Marvin Roberts pulled down a school-record 13.9 rebounds per contest during the 1969-70 season.
- Over the last four games, **Bean** has recorded more offensive rebounds by himself than all four of the entire teams combined (24-23).
- Bean** has recorded a double-double in each of the last six games and is tied for first in the nation with eight double-doubles on the year.
- Bean's** streak of consecutive double-doubles is the longest since **Greg Grant** recorded 10 straight during the 1984-85 season.
- Bean** is the first Aggie to average a double-double in a season since Mike Santos averaged 18.2 points and 11.3 rebounds per game during the 1976-77 season.
- USU head coach **Craig Smith** is 3-2 all-time against teams from the Beehive State, including a 3-1 record at USU.

## SAINT KATHERINE NOTABLES

• Senior guard **Diogo Brito** made his first start since the 2017-18 season, finishing with 15 points, seven rebounds, a game-high three steals and adding one assist.

• The win over the Firebirds marked the third wire-to-wire victory for Utah State this season.

• Sophomore guard **Brock Miller** finished the contest with a game-high 22 points, matching the total points scored by the entire USK starting backcourt.

• Redshirt freshman center **Trevin Dorius** and sophomore forward **Justin Bean** combined for 25 rebounds, three shy of matching the Firebirds' total of 28 rebounds for the entire game.

## FREE FREE THROWS

Utah State ranks second in the nation with 200 free throws made, while opponents have only attempted a total of 156 free throws against the Aggies this season.

## START TO THE SEASON

Utah State opened the 2019-20 season with a seven-game winning streak, its best start since the 1961-62 season, when the Aggies began the year 8-0. The start was also the fourth best in school history.

## GLASS EATERS

• Utah State has outrebounded all but one opponent this season and has a rebounding advantage of 10.5 boards per contest to rank No. 8 in the nation.

• Utah State ranks fourth in the nation with 31.55 defensive rebounds per game, totaling 347 defensive rebounds this season. The total is one less than opponents have pulled down in total rebounds this season (348).

## BENCH SCORING

Utah State's bench has outscored the opponent's reserves in every game this season, totaling 310 points to the opposition's 151.

## SECOND CHANCE POINTS

Utah State's dominance on the glass is evident in its second chance points as the Aggies have totaled 155 second-chance points to the opposition's 50.

## DEFENSE BECOMING OFFENSE

Utah State has made its defense part of its best offense as the Aggies have totaled more points off turnovers than their opponents in all but three games this season. On the year, USU has totaled 181 points off opponent miscues this season, compared to 115 points scored off of Aggie turnovers.

## HOME SWEET HOME

• Utah State is playing its 50th year inside the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum in 2019-20.

• Utah State has now won 13-straight home games, including eight consecutive MW home victories and 14-straight non-conference home games. The streak is the longest since USU won 32-straight home games from the 2009-11 seasons.

## COME BACK KIDS

Utah State overcame a 19-point deficit with 16:32 to play in the second half against LSU to post an 80-78 victory over the Tigers in their opening game of the Jersey Mike's Jamaica Classic. The comeback was the biggest since USU overcame an 18-point halftime deficit against Weber State on Nov. 14, 2014, to post a 72-61 win over the Wildcats.

## AROUND THE WORLD

Utah State is tied for third in the nation with the most internationals on its roster, with student-athletes calling five different countries outside of the United States home (Australia, Suriname, Canada, Portugal, Poland).

## USU IS A UNANIMOUS FAVORITE

Utah State was named a unanimous favorite by the Mountain West media to capture the 2019-20 conference title. It is the first time in MW history that a team has been a unanimous selection.

## AGGIES HAVE THE HEIGHT

• Utah State is the tallest team in the nation, on average, with an average height of 79.6 inches. The Aggies rank ahead of Seton Hall (79.21), Oklahoma (79.07), Oregon State (78.93) and Mississippi State (78.75).

• Utah State is tied for the tallest freshman class in the nation as **Sean Bairstow**, **Liam McChesney** and **Trevin Dorius** have an average height of 6-feet-10-inches, tying Illinois.

• Utah State is tied for first in the nation for the most 7-footers on its roster with three, tying Hawai'i.

• Junior center **Kuba Karwowski** is the tallest player in Utah State history, standing at 7-foot-2. Karwowski is tied with three others in the NCAA as the fifth-tallest player in the nation.

## PORTUGAL(OGAN)

Utah State's 2019-20 roster features a duo from Portugal in senior guard **Diogo Brito** and sophomore center **Neemias Queta**. The Aggies make up two-thirds of the players from Portugal on NCAA Division I rosters as there are only three in the nation - Hugo Ferreira (Cleveland State).

## WHERE THE POINTS COME FROM

Utah State has scored 893 points this season. The following is where the points are coming from:

## RUN AWAY VICTORIES

• Utah State is 23-1 in games that have been decided by 16 or more points under head coach **Craig Smith**.

• Utah State posted victories of 40 or more points in back-to-back games over Weber State and Denver, marking the first time since the 1944-45 season and just the fourth time in school history the Aggies have posted back-to-back 40-point wins.

• Utah State posted a 55-point victory over Weber State on Nov. 8, with an 89-34 win against the Wildcats. The 55-point margin is tied for the largest in school history against a Division I opponent, matching a 115-60 win over CS Fullerton on Dec. 23, 1972.

• **Smith** was named the Mountain West Coach of the Year and the USBWA District VIII Coach of the Year, along with being named a finalist for the Jim Phelan Coach of the Year.

• Utah State got off to its best start under a first-year head coach in school history in 2018-19 as **Smith** led the Aggies to a 10-3 record over their opening 13 games, surpassing the previous best start of 9-4 under **Ladell Andersen** during the 1961-62 season.

• **Smith** has the best record in school history over the first 46 games as a Utah State head coach with a 38-8 mark.

## ABOUT KLAY STALL

• **Stall** missed all of the 2018-19 season after suffering a knee injury in the off-season.

• **Stall** played in four minutes against Weber State on Nov. 8, logging two points and one rebound. It was his first action on the court since the 2017-18 season.

## ABOUT SEAN BAIRSTOW

• **Bairstow** has family ties to both Utah State and the Mountain West as his sister, Stephanie, was a member of the USU women's basketball team from 2013-14, and his brother, Cam, was an all-conference performer at New Mexico from 2011-14.

• **Bairstow** won the slam dunk competition at the annual Aggie Madness event to begin the 2019-20 season.

## ABOUT ROCHE GROOTFAAM

• **Grootfaam** spent the 2018-19 season as a redshirt as he was coming back from a knee injury sustained at the College of Southern Idaho.

• **Grootfaam** played in four minutes against Weber State on Nov. 8, logging one rebound. It was his first action on the court since the 2017-18 season and his NCAA Division I debut.

## ABOUT SAM MERRILL

• Last year, **Merrill** was the only player in the nation to shoot at least 46 percent from the field, 37 percent behind the 3-point line and 90 percent at the charity stripe last season. **Merrill** is one of just six players to do it in the past 22 years.

• **Merrill** was named the 2019-20 MW Preseason Player of the Year after being named 2019 Mountain West Player of the Year and MW Tournament MVP. **Merrill** finished the year with 731 points, the fifth-most in a single season in Utah State history, while his average of 20.9 points per game ranked second in the MW. **Merrill** was also the top distributor for the Aggies, totaling a team-best 147 assists and averaging 4.2 per contest to rank fifth in the MW.

## ABOUT ALPHONSO ANDERSON

• **Anderson** is one of three players in the Utah State roster to record 20-point games, logging 21 points against North Carolina A&T and a career-high 24 points against LSU.

• **Anderson** was named to the Jamaica Classic all-tournament team after averaging 21.5 points, 5.0 rebounds and 1.0 steals per game against LSU and North Texas.

• **Anderson** has appeared in the starting lineup in two games, averaging 3.5 points and 2.5 rebounds per game. However, **Anderson** has been a force when coming off of the bench, averaging 14.4 points and 5.8 rebounds per game.

## ABOUT ABEL PORTER

• **Porter** recorded his first career double-double with 10 points and 10 assists against Weber State on Nov. 8.

• Over the final 17 games that **Porter** was inserted into the starting lineup in 2018-19, the team averaged more assists (17.7 to 16.5), fewer turnovers (11.9 to 13.6), shot better from behind the 3-point line (.374 to .335), averaged more points per game (78.7 to 78.6) and won 15 of its final 17 games of the season.

# UTAH STATE MEN'S BASKETBALL

• Over the final 17 games that **Abel Porter** was inserted into the starting lineup in 2018-19, each of the five other returning Aggies saw their scoring averages jump, including **Sam Merrill** (23.0 from 18.9), **Neemias Queta** (13.1 from 10.6), **Diogo Brito** (9.8 from 6.6), **Brock Miller** (8.4 from 7.9) and **Justin Bean** (4.9 from 2.8). Porter, himself, also jumped up from 2.9 points per game over the first 18 games of the season to 8.1 points per game over the final 17 games of the season.

## ABOUT BROCK MILLER

• **Miller** is one of four Aggies that have recorded a 20-point game this season, scoring a career-high 27 points against Denver.

• **Miller** made a career-high seven 3-point field goals against Denver, tied for the most by any player in the MW this season.

• **Miller** leads the Aggies with 79 3-point field goals attempts this year, making up 69.9 percent of his field goal attempts this season.

## ABOUT NEEMIAS QUETA

• **Queta** helped Portugal to the 2019 FIBA U20 Division B European Championship, finishing second in the tournament in blocks per game (2.0) and field goal percentage (.673), third in rebounds per game (11.0), 16th in points per game (14.3) and graded out as the most efficient player in the entire tournament.

• **Queta** rewrote the single-season block record at Utah State with his 84 blocks in 2018-19, shattering the previous single-season record of 59. Queta also recorded a MW freshman-record six blocks against Fresno State on Jan. 9. Queta finished the year ranked No. 14 in the nation with 2.4 blocks per game and his 84 blocks were more than 82 teams in the nation in 2018-19.

• **Queta** recorded a block in all but one game in 2018-19, making the 29-game stretch to begin the year the longest in school history.

• **Queta** made his season debut against Fresno State on Dec. 7, scoring six points and logging one block and one rebound in 10 minutes of action.

• **Queta**, the reigning MW Freshman and Defensive Player of the Year, was one of just two true freshmen over the past 17 seasons that finished the year with 400-plus points, 80-plus blocks and 50-plus assists (Anthony Davis, 2012).

## ABOUT DIOGO BRITO

• **Brito** is one of only three players in the Mountain West returning in 2019-20 that played in more than 30 games and averaged more than 8.0 points, 4.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.0 steals per game.

• Over the last two seasons, Utah State is a perfect 21-0 when **Brito** scores in double figures.

• **Brito** has recorded multiple steals in all but one game this season and is second in the MW with 2.2 steals per game.

## ABOUT TREVIN DORIUS

• **Dorius** used a redshirt year during the 2016-17 season before departing for a mission for the LDS Church in Scottsdale, Ariz.

• **Dorius** recorded his first career start at San José State, scoring four points and pulling down two rebounds in 13 minutes of action.

## ABOUT JUSTIN BEAN

• **Bean** played the first seven games of the season with a mask to project a broken nose he suffered during the second week of October. Bean also had oral surgery following USU's 81-73 victory over Montana State on Nov. 5 to repair two teeth that were damaged during the game against the Bobcats. Bean suffered a similar injury when not wearing a mouth guard against UTSA on Nov. 18.

• **Bean** was named the Jamaica Classic Tournament MVP after averaging a double-double of 14.0 points and 13.0 rebounds per game against LSU and North Texas.

## ABOUT KUBA KARWOWSKI

• **Karowski** is second on the Utah State roster with his 12 blocks this season. Karowski's four blocks against Montana State and UTSA are tied for the most in the MW in a single game this season.

• Last season, **Karowski** finished third in the NJCAA in shooting percentage, converting 70.6 percent (108-of-153) from the floor.

## NATIONAL LEADERS

• Utah State ranks among the top-10 in the nation in rebounding margin, outrebounding opponents by 10.5 per game to rank No. 9.

• Sophomore forward **Justin Bean** leads the nation with his seven double-doubles this season, and ranks second in the nation in offensive rebounds per game (4.40), fifth in the nation in total rebounds per game (11.8) and 19th in the nation in defensive rebounds per game (7.40).

## ABOUT THE 2018-19 SEASON

• Utah State finished the 2018-19 season with an overall mark of 28-7, tying for the third-most victories in school history. The wins are the most for the Aggies since the 2010-11 season, when USU finished with a school-record 30-4 mark.

• Utah State punctuated its 2018-19 campaign with an appearance in the NCAA Tournament, losing 78-61 to Washington in Columbus, Ohio. USU entered the tournament as the No. 8 seed, the highest for the Aggies in school history. The game marked the first appearance for Utah State in the NCAA Tournament since the 2010-11 season.

• Utah State was one of only two teams in the nation a season ago with a top-30 NET ranking, a top-20 non-conference strength of schedule and 14 wins away from home (Duke).

• Utah State finished the 2018-19 season ranked No. 25 in the nation in both The Associated Press and USA Today Coaches poll, marking the first time the Aggies have been ranked since the 2010-11 season, when USU entered the NCAA Tournament ranked No. 19 in the country.

• Utah State scored a school-record 2,753 points last season, breaking the previous school record of 2,619 points set during the 1969-70 season.

• Utah State recorded a school-record 147 blocked shots last season, breaking the previous school record of 142 rejections set during the 2014-15 season.

• Utah State was the only team in the Mountain West with four players in the top-25 in the league in assists per game last year.

• Utah State was one of only two teams in the nation to finish in the top-10 in defensive field goal percentage, assists per game and rebounding margin during the 2018-19 season (Michigan State).

## DID YOU KNOW?

- BYU has won eight of the last 10 contests, including each of the last seven. Five of the last seven victories by the Cougars have come by double digits.
- In Utah State's two victories over the last 10, USU has recorded more rebounds, more free throws, shot at a higher percentage at the free throw line and has committed fewer fouls than the Cougars en route to the wins.
- Utah State has shot better from the floor in six of the last 10 games in the series.
- The shooting prowess has extended beyond the 3-point line as well, as Utah State has recorded a better shooting percentage from long range in eight of the last nine games.

### LOGAN, Utah - Mr. Double-Double was at it again Tuesday night.

Justin Bean had 12 points and 14 rebounds for his sixth-consecutive double-double to power Utah State to a 94-49 non-conference victory over Saint Katherine at the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum. The sophomore forward now has eight double-doubles on the season, which is tied for first in the nation, and his streak of six straight is the longest since Greg Grant notched 10 in a row during the 1984-85 season.

Bean wasn't the only Aggie to record a double-double on the night. Redshirt freshman center Trevin Dorius had 10 points and 11 rebounds - both career highs - to go along with two assists.

The game was never in doubt as Utah State (10-1) raced out to a 15-0 lead before the Firebirds even knew what hit them. Saint Katherine didn't help its cause early on as it misfired on its first seven shots before Jared Strate made a layup with 15:01 remaining in the first half.

Sophomore guard Brock Miller led all scorers in the game with 22 points, to go along with six rebounds. Senior guard Diogo Brito made his first start of the season for the Aggies, recording 15 points and seven rebounds, while junior forward Alphonso Anderson added 11 points and nine rebounds.

Zethan Dumpson had 13 points and Austin Armstead had 12 for the Firebirds (3-8), who used this game as an exhibition contest.

Utah State scored nearly half of its points in the paint with 42. The Aggies, who outrebounded Saint Katherine 63-28, grabbed 22 offensive boards on the night, which lead to 23 second-chance points.

All nine players that checked into the game for Utah State scored at least two points and grabbed at least two rebounds. Freshman guard Sean Bairstow led the hosts with a career-high five assists as the Aggies had 20 helpers on 35 field goals.

Utah State shot 45.5 percent from the field (35-of-77), including 38.7 percent from 3-point range (12-of-31), and 75.0 percent from the free throw line (12-of-16).

### PROVO, Utah - Utah State cut a 22-point first-half deficit to a dozen points a handful of times in the second half, but could never get closer than that in a 95-80 loss to BYU on Wednesday night at the Marriott Center.

Junior guard Sam Merrill, hounded all night by the Cougars' defense, led the Aggies with 17 points on 5-of-13 shooting from the field, but just 1-of-5 from beyond the arc.

Freshman center Neemias Queta added 16 points, eight rebounds, three steals and two blocks for Utah State, which shot 48.3 percent on the night (29-of-60), including 17.6 percent from beyond the arc (3-of-17), and 79.2 percent from the free throw line (19-of-24).

BYU's Yoeli Childs led all scorers in the game with 31 points on 11-of-18 shooting from the field. He also had seven rebounds and five steals.

The Cougars (6-4), who snapped a three-game losing streak, became the second team to shoot over 50 percent against the Aggies. BYU nearly shot 56 percent from the field (33-of-59) and hit 11 of the 24 3-pointers it took.

Behind Queta's eight boards, Utah State (7-2) outrebounded its opponent for the ninth time this season, 34-24. Senior forward Dwayne Brown Jr. pulled down six rebounds for the Aggies, who only had six assists on 29 baskets.

## HEAD COACH CRAIG SMITH

**North Dakota, 1996**  
**Second Year (189-92, Eight Seasons)**

Craig Smith was named the 19th head coach of Utah State men's basketball on March 26, 2018.

In all, Smith has 23 years of collegiate coaching experience, including eight years as a head coach, and has been to postseason play 11 times during his career, while winning four regular season and three postseason conference championships. As a head coach, Smith has been named conference Coach of the Year four times (2006, 2007, 2017, 2019) in addition to receiving the NAIA II National Coach of the Year Award in 2007, the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) District 12 Coach of the Year Award in 2017, and NABC District 17 Coach of the Year and USBWA District VIII Coach of the Year in 2019.

In his first year at the helm at Utah State, Smith led the Aggies to a 28-7 record, the most wins by a first-year head coach and the third-most wins overall in school history. USU advanced the NCAA Tournament, earning a No. 8 seed, the highest in program history, and logged school records of 2,753 points and 147 blocks.

Smith came to Utah State after spending the past four years as the head coach at the University of South Dakota, where he led the Coyotes to a 79-55 (.590) record, including a 38-26 (.594) mark in the Summit League. In his last two seasons at USD, he led the program to back-to-back postseason appearances (NIT, CBI) and a conference championship (2017), as the Coyotes produced a 48-21 (.696) record, including a 23-7 (.767) mark in league play.

During the 2017-18 season at South Dakota, Smith led the Coyotes to a 26-9 record, which is the second-most wins in school history, and its best record in their 10 years at the Division I level. USD also finished second in its conference during the 2017-18 campaign with an 11-3 mark and advanced to the championship game of the Summit League Tournament, followed by an appearance in the College Basketball Invitational, which was its second-straight postseason appearance. In all, USD did not lose back-to-back games once during the 2017-18 regular season.

Statistically, South Dakota led the Summit League and ranked 12th in the nation in scoring margin (+12.2 points per game) during the 2017-18 season, while also ranking first in the conference and 32nd nationally in field goal percentage defense (.409), and first in the conference and 36th in the nation in field goal percentage offense (.476). USD also ranked third in the Summit League and 35th in the nation in scoring offense (80.9 points per game) during the 2017-18 campaign, second in the conference and 30th in the nation in turnovers (11.1 per game), and second in the league and 20th nationally in turnover margin (+3.2 per game). The Coyotes also led the league and ranked 65th nationally in 3-point field goal percentage defense (.329) last season and were first in the conference in scoring defense (68.7 points per game), while also ranking second in the conference in both free throws made (555) and attempted (740).

Following the 2016-17 season, Smith was named the Summit League and NABC District 12 Coach of the Year as he led South Dakota to a 22-12 record, including a 12-4 mark in league play, to win its second-ever Division I conference championship. The Coyotes concluded the season by playing in the National Invitation Tournament.

During his four years as the head coach at South Dakota, Smith coached nine players who earned a total of 11 Summit League honors, including Matt Mooney, who was a two-time first-team all-league honoree and a two-time NABC All-District 12 team member.

Prior to being the head coach at South Dakota, Smith spent two seasons as an assistant at Nebraska (2013-14) and five seasons as an assistant at Colorado State (2008-12), helping the Cornhuskers to the 2014 NCAA Tournament and the Rams to the 2012 NCAA Tournament. While at CSU, Smith also helped the Rams advance to the 2010 CBI Tournament and the 2011 NIT.

Smith's other head coaching stint was at Mayville State University in North Dakota, where he compiled a 72-29 record in three seasons and three-straight NAIA II National Tournament appearances from 2005-07. The Comets were 1-25 the season before Smith's arrival and competed in the NAIA National Championship game in their third season under Smith.

After winning 17 games in his first season at Mayville State, the Comets set a school record for victories with 28 during the 2005-06 campaign, while winning the Dakota Athletic Conference (DAC) regular season and tournament championships. Mayville State advanced to the national quarterfinals before falling to the eventual national champions.

In 2007, Smith was named the NAIA II National Coach of the Year when the Comets defended their regular season and tournament titles and advanced to the National Championship game. It marked the first time any men's basketball team from North Dakota had ever played for a national title. Smith also earned DAC Coach of the Year honors in both 2006 and 2007.

Smith began his coaching career as an assistant at Mayville State during the 1996-97 season as he helped the Comets advance to the NAIA II Tournament. He then spent the 1997-98 season as a graduate assistant at Northern State in South Dakota, helping the Wolves to the Elite Eight of the NCAA Division II Tournament. He then spent three seasons as an assistant at Minot State in North Dakota, followed by three more seasons as an assistant at North Dakota State, where he began his affiliation with current Nebraska head coach Tim Miles. Following his three years as head coach at Mayville State, Smith worked under Miles at both Colorado State and Nebraska before becoming the head coach at South Dakota.

Smith is a Stephen, Minn., native and a 1996 graduate of the University of North Dakota, where he earned his bachelor's degree in secondary education. He then earned his master's degree in teaching and learning from Northern State, where he served as a graduate assistant for the 1997-98 season. The Wolves reached their first-ever Elite Eight that season.

Smith and his wife, Darcy, have three sons: Landon, Brady and Carson, along with a daughter, Lauren.

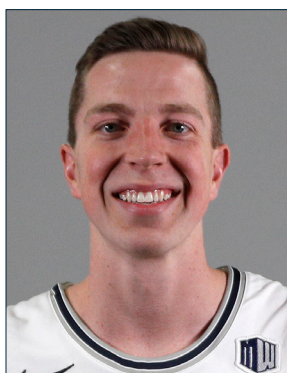
