Lions Take 1-0 WCC Record into Provo for BYU's Conference Opener

LOS ANGELES - LMU is 1-0 in the West Coast Conference for the first time since the 2013-14 season. That year, the Lions beat BYU and San Diego to open WCC action at 2-0. This year's LMU men's basketball team (7-8, 1-0 WCC) has an opportunity to beat the same two teams to hit that mark, as they take on BYU (11-4, 0-0 WCC) in Provo on Saturday night at 7 p.m. MTN (6 p.m. PST).

The Lions are coming off a come-from-behind win over University of San Diego on Thursday night, after erasing a seven-point deficit with under 12 minutes to play. LMU's keys to victory were a season-low six turnovers and 14 fouls committed to make up for an off-shooting night. All nine players to see the court for the Lions played at least 13 points and knocked down a field goal.

The Cougars have not played a conference game yet, but closed out the non-conference portion of their schedule with five consecutive wins. BYU has posted a 6-1 record at home this year, with their lone loss coming to currently undefeated San Diego State, the nation's 13th-ranked team.

BYU ranks in the top-10 nationally in a number of statistical categories, including total three point field goals (4th), total assists (6th), assist-to-turnover ratio (8th), and three point field goal percentage (8th).

The WCC leads all Division I conferences in total field goal percentage with these two teams being a large part of that stat. BYU ranks 14th nationally at 49.2 percent from the field, and LMU ranks 21st after hitting 48.4 percent of their shots. LMU's Eli Scott leads the conference individually in that category (among players with five makes per game) after shooting 56.1 percent to date this season.

The game will air on BYUTV and stream live on BYU Sports Network. Live Stats will be run through Statbroadcast. Jesse Kass can be heard on KXLU 88.9 FM and TuneIN Radio.

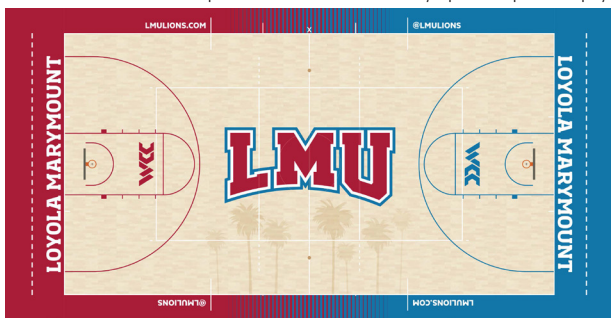

LMU'S FIRST TRIPLE-DOUBLE

On Dec. 7, 2019, Eli Scott recorded the first triple double in LMU history. Scott entered halftime with 11 assists on the 18 made LMU baskets, and was a rebound shy of hitting a first half double-double. After taking just two shots in the first half, Scott started looking for his own scoring and went 7-for-9 from the field, and 1-for-1 from long range, after intermission to finish with a game-high 21 points. Scott's 13 assists is tied for 10th in program history.

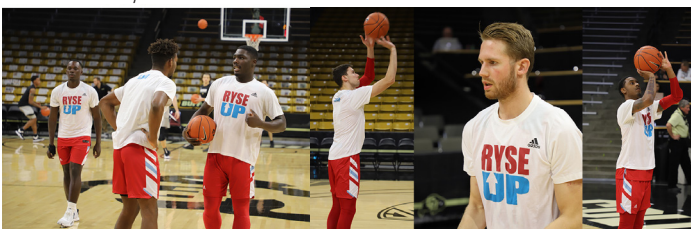

RYSE UP WARMUP SHIRTS

This is the second year that LMU will have Ryse Up shirts as part of the team's warmup apparel. Ryse Williams, a local LMU basketball commit out of Redondo Union High School, passed away a day before his high school graduation in June 2017. Williams was suffering from a rare, aggressive form of cancer that got into his lungs and liver and had reached stage 4. LMU Head Coach Mike Dunlap continues to honor his scholarship and plans to retire his #4 jersey following the 2021-22 season, in what should have been his senior year.



30TH ANNIVERSARY SEASON

The 2019-20 men's basketball season is the 30th anniversary of one of the biggest stories in the history of college basketball. The record-breaking high-scoring team of 1989-90 will not only be remembered as LMU's last time in the NCAA Tournament, but more importantly for tragic death of one of the game's all-time great players, Hank Gathers. LMU will be honoring Gathers throughout the season, highlighted by a statue in the likeness of Hank placed on campus in front of the Gersten Pavilion Ticket Office. LMU'S GSR RANKS SECOND IN CA

LMU continued to post strong GSR numbers in the latest announcement from the NCAA on Wednesday, surpassing last year's overall mark of 92 with a new mark of 94.

This year marks the seventh straight time in the 14-year history of the metric that LMU has reached or exceeded 90 percent, and the 11th straight year the campus has posted a mark of 88 percent or higher.

Of the 24 Division I schools in California, LMU's rate of 94 percent is second overall behind Stanford at 97. The West Coast Conference shows well in the GSR standings, as the Lions are one of seven member schools that are at or above 90 percent, and tied for second overall.

Mike Dunlap, a 1980 graduate of LMU, is in his sixth season at the helm of the Lions in 2019-20. He has led the Lions to a better season than the one before in each of his first three years at LMU, and made the postseason in his fifth season.

Dunlap's first season with the Lions was about setting a foundation for years to come. And his second season, he considered it "year one" with this new foundation. The Lions peaked down the stretch, winning three of their last four and finished 14-17 overall, 6-12 in the WCC, and earned a win in the WCC tournament.

They did it again in 2016-17, entering the 2017 WCC Championships winning their last three games of the regular season and four of their last five. It is the best finish to a season for the Lions since winning 10 straight in 1990-91. They improved their overall win total and WCC win total for the third straight year at 15-15 overall and 8-10 in the WCC.

The 2018-19 team made a return to postseason play for the first time since 2012, and only the third time since the NCAA Tournament run of 1989-90. The Lions picked up CBI wins over Cal Baptist and Brown, before falling in the semifinals.

Dunlap, who is 77-95 in his six seasons at LMU through Jan. 3, 2019, is coaching in his 21st season as a head coach at the collegiate level with a 416-217 record.

Prior to LMU, he was the head coach of the Charlotte Bobcats for the 2012-2013 season, becoming the first coach in NBA history to win three times as many games as the year before. Before arriving in Charlotte, he was with Steve Lavin as his top assistant at St. John's. During the 2011-12 season, he oversaw the day-to-day operations of the team and served as acting head coach in all but four games while Lavin recovered from surgery to treat prostate cancer. During the 2009-10 season he was an associate head coach on Ernie Kent's staff at Oregon, and the 2008-09 season he was associate head coach at Arizona under legendary coach Lute Olson.

Prior to his work as an assistant, he spent nine seasons as the head coach at Metro State, leading his teams to national titles in 2000 and 2002 while earning NABC Division II Coach of the Year honors in both of those seasons. Dunlap, whose teams went to the NCAA Tournament in each of his nine seasons, posted an overall record of 248-50 (.832), winning five Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference titles.

In 2006, he left Metro State to become an assistant coach with the Denver Nuggets under George Karl. In two seasons with the Nuggets, he helped the team to a 95-69 record that included a 50-win season in 2007-08, the team's first in 23 years.

Dunlap's previous head coaching experience also includes three seasons with the Adelaide 36ers in Australia's National Basketball League and five seasons at California Lutheran University. From 1994-97, he led the 36ers to a 59-33 record (.641) and three straight appearances in the NBL Final Four, including advancing to the Grand Final game in 1995.

Before going to Australia, Dunlap was head coach at Division III California Lutheran from 1989-94, where his teams posted an 80-54 record (.597) and won three straight SCIAC titles from 1992-94, advancing to the Sweet 16 in 1992 and 1994.

His college coaching experience also includes five seasons with the Lions (1980-85), one season at the University of Iowa (1985-86) and three seasons at the University of Southern California (1986-89).
