QUICK HITS

ROAD WARRIORS. BYU (9-15, 5-4) returns to Miller Park Thursday-Saturday for just the second home series of the year, having played 35 of its previous 40 games on the road over the past two seasons. So far in 2021, the Cougars are 2-2 at home and 7-13 on the road, having played games at Texas State (4), No. 10 Texas (4), No. 23 Oregon State (3), Utah (2), Dixie State (1), LMU (3) and Santa Clara (3).

WEEK IN REVIEW. BYU is coming off a series at Santa Clara that saw the Cougars lose games one (0-5) and two (3-11), before bouncing back to win game three of the series 3-1 on Saturday.

Portland (14-13, 6-3) heads to Provo having defeated No. 19 Oregon 6-4 in Eugene on Tuesday. The Pilots also took two of three games from Saint Mary's over the weekend (4-3, 2-14, 3-0) in Moraga, California.

HOME SWEET HOME. Over the last three seasons (2019-2021), BYU is 22-5 (.815) at home.

BYU VS PORTLAND. BYU and Portland have met 41 times in baseball, with the Cougars holding a 28-13 advantage. Due to the 2020 pandemic, the WCC foes last met during the 2019 regular season in Provo on April 21-23. BYU swept the series 3-0 with scores of 11-1, 3-1, 10-1 and would later go on to finish the season 36-17 and win the WCC regular-season title with a 18-9 record.

PORTLAND HISTORY. University of Portland is a private Catholic university in Oregon. It was founded in 1901 and is affiliated with the Congregation of Holy Cross, which also founded its sister institution the University of Notre Dame. The university enrolls approximately 4,200 students.

MORE QUICK HITS

PITCHING MATCHUP. Game one at Miller Park on Thursday features BYU right-handed pitcher Easton Walker (1-2, 1.78 ERA) versus Pilot right-hander Brett Gillis (1-3, 6.00 ERA). Walker has appeared in seven games and has given up just seven earned runs, while recording 32 strikeouts over 35.1 innings. Gillis has also appeared in seven games with 12 earned runs and 27 strikeouts in 18 innings of work.

SCOUTING THE PILOTS. Portland is currently 8-7 on the road in 2021 having played at UC Davis (1-2), Gonzaga (1-2) Washington (0-1), Pacific (3-0) and Oregon (1-1) and Saint Mary's (2-1).

PORTLAND ON OFFENSE. Sam Brown leads Portland in hitting (.337) and on base percentage (.416). He is second in runs scored (17) and slugging percentage (.547). Chad Stevens leads the team in RBIs (19), runs (18), hits (35) and total bases (58). Stevens' 11 doubles is tops in the WCC.

PILOT PITCHING. Bradley McVay, who is scheduled to start Saturday, is the Pilots' leader in ERA at 2.12 with 34.0 innings pitched and 38 strikeouts. His 2.25 ERA in WCC games is the sixth best in league play. Peter Allegro is second on the Pilots with an ERA of 2.81 over 25.2 innings of work. He is 2-2 on the year with 35 strikeouts. Christian Peters, who is scheduled to start Friday, has an ERA of 3.05 over 44.1 innings and is 4-3 on the year.

BYU OFFENSIVE LEADERS. Centerfielder Mitch McIntyre leads the Cougars in several statistical categories, including batting average (.308), hits (28), doubles (7), triples (2) and on base percentage (.427). The senior from Stansbury Park, Utah, is also third in slugging percentage (.429) and walks (16).

Andrew Pintar is leading the Cougars in runs (20), walks (21) and total bases (4). The sophomore second baseman from Spanish Fork, Utah, is second on the team in hits (24), doubles (5), RBI (12) slugging (.435) and on base percentage (.395).

BYU's game-two starter Jack Sterner has started six games for the Cougars. Over the course of 24.2 innings, the right hander sophomore from Laguna Niguel, California, is 0-1 on the season with a 4.01 ERA and 23 strikeouts. The Cougars' game three starter will be determined later.

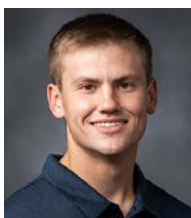

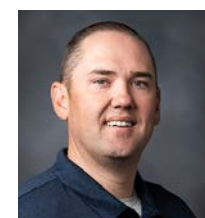
