## BYU STORYLINES

- Junior guard Elijah Bryant posted 22 points against Niagara for his third 20-point game of the season. Bryant hit a career-best 13 of 14 from the free-throw line. In the last three games, the Gwinnett, Georgia, native has hit a combined 30 of 33 from the line.
- TJ Haws and Zac Seljaas are riding streaks of consecutive games with a 3-point field goal, both dating back to their freshman seasons. Haws has hit a 3 in 20-straight games, tied for the ninth-longest streak in BYU history. Seljaas had drained a trey in 14-straight games.
- BYU and Alabama are playing at LIU-Brooklyn Friday as part of the Barclays Center Classic. The Cougars last played in Brooklyn in 2012 in the Coaches vs. Cancer Classic against Florida State and Notre Dame.

- 2** The number of preseason All-WCC honorees for BYU in TJ Haws and Yoeli Childs. Last season, Haws and Childs were both All-WCC Freshman Team honorees and Haws was named to the All-WCC First Team. Since joining the WCC in 2011, the Cougars have had two players on the All-WCC First Team each year.
- 3** The number of 20-point games for Elijah Bryant so far this season. He opened the year with 27 vs. Mississippi Valley State and followed with 22 at Princeton in game two. After getting banged up vs. UT Arlington, Bryant came off the bench vs. Niagara and scored 22 points.
- 6** The number of career double-doubles for sophomore forward Yoeli Childs. He had five as a freshman and opened the 2017-18 season with 13 points and 10 rebounds vs. Mississippi Valley State.
- 12** The number of 3-point field goals made by BYU in the season opener vs. Mississippi State, tied for the most by a Cougar team in a season opener. BYU also made 12 in the 2003-04 season opener vs. Southern Utah.

**THE BASKETBALL HALL OF FAME: HOOPHALL AWARDS**

BYU sophomore guard TJ Haws is a preseason candidate for the 2018 Jeff West Shooting Guard of the Year Award, presented by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Haws earned first-team All-WCC honors in 2016-17 while averaging 13.8 points, 2.9 rebounds, 3.2 assists and 1.0 steal. The Alpine, Utah, native also hit a team-high 76 3-pointers, second all-time among BYU freshmen.

**LAST TIME OUT – BIG SECOND HALF PROPELS BYU TO 95-88 WIN OVER NIAGARA**

PROVO, Utah – Elijah Bryant, Yoeli Childs and TJ Haws combined for 61 points in BYU basketball's 95-88 win over Niagara Tuesday night at the Marriott Center.

"I think that was a competitive game and we learned a lot about ourselves," BYU head coach Dave Rose said. "We had to overcome some personal issues. It was a good learning experience and a good win."

On the game, Bryant tallied 22 points and seven rebounds and Childs added 21 points and five boards. Haws contributed 18 points, six rebounds and six assists. Luke Worthington also scored in double-digits with 11 points.

A dunk by Childs put the Cougars (3-1) on the board first, starting a 6-0 run to give BYU an early lead. After four scoreless minutes, Niagara (1-3) finished a layup and then went 5-6 from the field to take a 12-11 advantage with 13:06 to play in the first half.

Dalton Nixon scored his first bucket of the night and Zac

Seljaas hit his first 3-pointer with just under eight minutes to go in the first half to tie the game at 20-all. Nixon continued by converting on a three-point play to give the Cougars a 23-22 advantage.

The game was tied at 29-all with 2:04 left in the first half when Childs stole the ball and charged to the basket, scoring a layup for a two-point BYU lead, but a pair of free-throws by the Purple Eagles tied the game once again at 31-all.

After multiple possession exchanges in the final minute of the half, Niagara took a 34-31 lead at halftime with a three-point conversion in the last two seconds. Childs led with eight points after 20 minutes of play. In the first half, the Cougars shot 46.4 percent compared to the Purple Eagles 43.3 percent.

Worthington recorded the first bucket of the second half, but Niagara answered with a 9-2 run.

TJ Haws made five consecutive points to start a 10-4

run by the Cougars, giving BYU a 51-47 advantage. A 3-pointer by the Purple Eagles cut the lead back to one point. Free throws by Bryant and Haws and a three-point play by Childs gave BYU a 57-50 lead with 11:37 remaining.

A pair of threes by Bryant and a Worthington jumper gave the Cougars a 75-65 advantage. Childs grabbed a steal for a dunk with two minutes remaining to give the Cougars an 85-74 lead.

BYU ended the game shooting 9 of 12 from the line to secure the 95-88 victory.

**NOTES AND STORYLINES**

**Super Sophomores**

BYU's 2017-18 roster includes three players who etched their names in the BYU record book during the freshman seasons. Yoeli Childs and TJ Haws were freshmen in 2016-17 while Zac Seljaas was a rookie in 2015-16. All three are back this season, looking to build on their record-setting freshman campaigns. Childs finished his freshman year first all-time among BYU freshmen in rebounds and second in rebounds per game, blocks, blocks per game and field goal percentage.

Haws concluded his first year second all-time among BYU freshmen in 3-point field goals, fourth in points scored, fifth in assists, tied for first in games started and third in double figure scoring games. Seljaas finished the 2015-16 season first all-time among BYU freshmen in 3-point field goal percentage, second in 3-point field goals, second in 3-point field goals per game, second in games with 3-plus 3-point field goals and tied for second most games with 5-plus 3-pointers.

**All-Haws Team**

TJ Haws earned first-team All-WCC honors as a freshman in 2016-17, becoming the third Haws in BYU history to earn all-league honors. His father Marty Haws earned first-team All-WAC honors as a senior in 1989-90 and his brother Tyler was a four-time all-league honoree. As a freshman in 2009-10, Tyler was named to the All-Mountain West Conference Third Team. Following a two-year mission for the LDS Church, Tyler earned first-team honors as a sophomore, junior and senior. In addition to joining his father and brother as an all-conference performer, TJ became the second Cougar in program history – the other being Danny Ainge – to earn first-team all-league honors as a freshman.

**Dave Rose**

BYU head coach Dave Rose has led the Cougars to one of the most successful eras in program history since taking over in 2005. His career record of 307-112 ranks him second in BYU history in total victories and first in winning percentage (.733). Rose has been named conference coach of the year three times, led the Cougars to four conference titles, eight NCAA tournament appearances, four NIT appearances, eight 25-win seasons and 12 20-win seasons.

**BYU and the Postseason**

Under Dave Rose, BYU has reached the postseason in 12-straight seasons, a school record. The previous record was six-straight seasons (1989-90 to 1994-95). During that time the Cougars have earned eight bids to the NCAA tournament and four to the NIT. The Cougars' eight NCAA tournament bids in the last 12 years are more than 200-plus NCAA Division I schools have since beginning their programs.
