• **THE SERIES.** BYU and the Naval Academy are playing for just the third time. The last contest took place more than 30 years ago, with the Cougars earning a 31-10 victory in Annapolis in 1989. Ty Detmer threw for 353 yards and two touchdowns. Detmer's 353 yards was the second game amidst a streak of 24 consecutive regular season games where he threw for 300+ yards — still an NCAA record.

• **SERIES OPENERS.** Kalani Sitake is 3-1 in season openers and BYU is 15-5 over the past 20 seasons in game one. This just the fifth time in 20 years that BYU has not opened the year against a Power 5 opponent.

• **LA'IE BOYS.** In one of many connections between the two head coaches, both Kalani Sitake and Ken Niumatalolo grew up on the streets of the North Shore in La'ie, Hawai'i. Though 10 years apart, the two shared many of the same experiences at family gatherings and friendships on the Island together.

• **MORE CONNECTIONS.** In addition to their upbringing in Hawai'i, Niumatalolo (Samoan) and Sitake (Tongan) are the only two head coaches at the FBS level of Polynesian descent. The two are also members of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints and served missions to Ventura, California (Niumatalolo) and Oakland, California (Sitake). Niumatalolo's son, Va'a, played linebacker at BYU for Sitake and is currently on his father's football staff at Navy. Alongside all of the Niumatalolo-Sitake connections, Navy slot backs coach Joe DuPaix spent two seasons as the running backs coach and recruiting coordinator at BYU in 2011-12. DuPaix helped bring in the Cougars' all-time leading rusher, Jamaal Williams, during his stint and coached Williams in his freshman season. DuPaix's father, Roger DuPaix, played offensive line for the Cougars from 1960-62 before going on to a graduate assistant position at BYU. Roger DuPaix had a successful coaching career in Utah, including 26 years as the head coach at Skyline High School where the field is named in his honor. Current BYU linebacker Pepe Tanuvasa transferred from the Naval Academy after playing in 13 games for the Midshipmen in 2018.

• **COMING BACK FOR MORE.** Two of BYU's most valuable players decided to return for the senior seasons with tight end Matt Bushman and defensive lineman Khayiris Tonga. Bushman, a three-time Mackey Award watch list honoree was ranked the No. 5 tight end by Lindys Sports. Tonga, an Outland Trophy and Nagurski Trophy watch list honoree, is a force at the line of scrimmage.

• **OFFENSIVE LINE.** The Cougars return two of the top offensive linemen in the country with left tackle Brady Christensen and center James Empey. Both were listed in Pro Football Focus' top returning linemen for the 2020 season and are up for the Rimington and Outland Trophies. The duo has started 26 games apiece on the O-line, and the offensive line as a unit returns 115 combined starts.

TRICK PLAY, FG LIFT NO. 21 NAVY OVER KANSAS STATE 20-17, TO WIN THE LIBERTY BOWL

MEMPHIS, Tenn. (AP) Bijan Nichols kicked a 23-yard field goal with two seconds remaining and No. 21 Navy capitalized on a fourth-down gamble in the final minute to beat Kansas State 20-17 in the Liberty Bowl on Tuesday.

A Navy team with the nation's top-ranked rushing attack set up the winning score by completing a halfback option pass with less than 30 seconds left. The Midshipmen snapped the ball on fourth-and-3 from the Kansas State 46. Quarterback Malcolm Perry pitched to C.J. Williams, and he threw downfield to a wide-open Chance Warren for a 41-yard gain.

Perry, who rushed for 213 yards, spiked the ball with 5 seconds left to set up Nichols' field goal. Nichols had missed a 38-yarder earlier in the fourth quarter.

The victory enabled Navy (11-2) to tie a program record for wins and ensured the Midshipmen will finish a season in the AP Top 25 for just the third time in the last 56 years. Navy finished 18th in 2015 - when it also won 11 games - and was 24th in 2004.

Navy went 3-10 last year and matched the second-biggest season-to-season improvement in win-loss record of any team in Football Bowl Subdivision history. Hawaii owns the record by going 9-4 in 1999 after finishing 0-12 in 1998.

The Mids made that dramatic turnaround thanks largely to Perry, who capped a brilliant senior season with 28 carries and a touchdown pass.

Perry ran for 2,017 yards this season to set a Football Bowl Subdivision record for yards rushing by quarterback. The record had been owned by Jordan Lynch, who ran for 1,920 yards for Northern Illinois in 2013.

Navy dominated much of the game but wasted a couple of opportunities to put it away. The Mids led 17-10 late in the third quarter when a holding penalty on Billy Honaker wiped out a 31-yard run by Perry that would have given them first-and-goal at the 2. Navy ended up punting.

Nichols then sent a 38-yard field goal attempt wide left with 8:26 left in the game. At that point, Navy was outgaining Kansas State 351-83 but only led 17-10.

Kansas State finally got its offense going at that point, as Skylar Thompson connected with Wykeen Gill on a 15-yard completion and a 42-yard pass on back-to-back plays. Those long gains set up Thompson's 1-yard sneak that tied the game with 5:14 left.

That set up Navy's dramatic winning drive.

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR TEN

As the only football team playing in the western part of the United States, the BYU football team looks to make its mark during an unprecedented 2020 football season. Entering its 10th year as an independent, BYU has pressed forward with its 2020 football season despite many conferences and teams canceling their season due to the COVID-19 pandemic. As one of only four independent teams moving forward, the Cougars currently have eight teams on the schedule from the American Athletic Conference, Sun Belt Conference, Conference USA and FCS's Big South Conference and with one game against a fellow independent team. The season features six home games against Troy, UTSA, Texas State, Western Kentucky and North Alabama with road matchups against Navy and Army.



BOWLING OPPONENTS

Both Navy and Western Kentucky played in bowl games following the 2019 season. After going 11-2 in, Navy participated in the 2019 Liberty Bowl coming away with a last-minute win taking down Kansas State 20-17. Western Kentucky also participated in the 2019 bowl, traveling to the First Responder Bowl taking the win against Western Michigan 23-20.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's winning percentage at LaVell Edwards Stadium is ranked No. 14 among teams playing in their current stadium.

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates more than 400 missions around the world in over 150 nations speaking more than 160 languages. More than 67,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours — seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples) — teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

About 65 percent of the current team has served a mission. Members of the team have served in 28 different countries and six of the seven continents around the globe. More than 30 members of the team (previous signees or on roster) are currently serving in the mission field.

POLYNESIAN PIPELINE

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recruiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. About 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now, several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff.

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA. His staff includes Polynesians Ilaisa Tuiaki, Fesi Sitake Harvey Unga, Nu'u Tafisi, Jack Damuni, Jasen Ah You and Vince Feula.

2019 BYU SEASON REVIEW

BYU achieved the highs of victories over storied programs and nationally ranked teams in 2019 while also experiencing the lows of tough losses during a 7-6 campaign that culminated at the SoFi Hawai'i Bowl.

For only the second time in program history, BYU played eight opponents that achieved eight or more victories, including four teams with 10 or more wins, something a Cougar team had only done on two previous occasions. Wins over nationally ranked USC and Boise State and a road triumph at Tennessee helped BYU tie for No. 7 nationally for the most wins over teams with winning records.

BYU utilized valuable contributions from key senior leaders while relying on the talents of many of its younger players to navigate a strong schedule that featured four ranked teams and 10 of 12 FBS opponents that would earn bowl eligibility.

Highlighted by victories over No. 14 Boise State and No. 24 USC, the Cougars achieved five regular-season victories over teams with a winning record in 2019. Only national champion LSU, Ohio State, Georgia, Clemson, Boise State and Oregon had more victories over winning teams.

The Cougars started the season as the only program to play three ranked teams and four Power 5 opponents in their first four games. Three BYU opponents finished the season ranked in the College Football Playoff final rankings—No. 11 Utah, No. 19 Boise State and No. 22 USC. BYU earned a 2-1 record in those games with its wins over the Broncos and Trojans.

After a 30-12 loss to No. 14 Utah in the opener, BYU claimed dramatic overtime wins the next two weeks against two historic college football programs. A 29-26 double-overtime triumph at Tennessee came against the SEC East Division's third-place team that finished at 8-5 overall as the Gator Bowl Champions. More than 92,000 fans welcomed the Cougars to Rocky Top and witnessed the late-game heroics that propelled BYU to the memorable victory.

BYU's successful first-ever visit to historic Neyland Stadium was followed the next week with another big win in LaVell Edwards Stadium over USC. Sealed with a diving interception by senior defensive back Dayan Ghanwoloku, the Cougars delivered a strong overall performance to earn a 30-27 overtime win that inspired Cougar fans to rush the field in celebration. BYU's victory over USC marked the first win in program history against the storied Pac-12 program from Los Angeles.

Following the strong start, the Cougars endured a three-game losing streak that started at home against No. 21 Washington (45-19) before road setbacks at Toledo (28-21) and South Florida (27-23). While freshman backup quarterback Jaren Hall performed well in Wilson's absence, he couldn't stay on the field for a complete game after being injured first at USF and later at Utah State. Third-stringer Baylor Romney also proved ready when his number was called. The freshman led BYU to home wins as the starter over undefeated Boise State and eventual 8-5 FBC Mortgage Cure Bowl Champion Liberty, while also delivering a strong second-half performance in place of the injured Hall at rival Utah State to reclaim the Old Wagon Wheel after a two-year hiatus.

BYU's impressive win over Boise State ruined the Broncos' otherwise perfect regular season on their way to the Mountain West title at 12-1 and marked the first time in BYU history the Cougars have defeated a 12-win team. The victory also stopped BYU's three-game skid and starting a five-game winning streak.

Following wins over the Broncos (28-25), Aggies (42-14) and Flames (31-24), Wilson returned to action to lead BYU to a 42-10 home victory over Idaho State and a 56-24 road win at UMass. The string of wins ended in a 13-3 defeat at San Diego State in the regular-season finale against an Aztec team that would go on to dominate the New Mexico Bowl to finish the year 10-3 overall.

Seven wins in the regular season earned the Cougars their 14th bowl invitation in the last 15 years. The Christmas Eve date with hometown favorite Hawai'i in the SoFi Hawai'i Bowl ended up rated No. 4 in CBS and USA Today's bowl game rankings but the Cougars came up on the wrong end of a wild 38-34 affair. Both teams combined for 1,000 yards of total offense but a late Rainbow Warrior warrior touchdown with just over a minute to go gave Hawai'i the final advantage. Hawai'i was the fourth team BYU faced in 2019 that achieved 10 or more victories on the season.

BYU has had no less than seven different receivers in every game this season, and at least eight in 11 of 13 contests. Thirteen of the 19 players return in 2020.

The BYU offensive line is the most experienced unit on the team, returning a combined 115 starts, including everyone from 2019 that started a game. Brady Christensen and James Empey have started the most games, with 26 starts each, followed by Keanu Saleapaga (19), Tristen Hoge (18), Chandon Herring (12), Blake Freeland (7), Clark Barrington (4) and Kieffer Longson (3).

200+

BYU passed for 200+ yards in every game in 2019. Including the final two games of 2018, the Cougars have gone for 200+ in 15 straight games. The last time BYU had 200+ in more consecutive games was a string of 19, spanning the 2007-08 seasons. 2008 was the last year BYU threw for at least 200 in every game.

500x3

Matt Bushman had more than 500 receiving yards for the third consecutive season, only the third tight end in BYU history to do so. Consensus All-Americans Dennis Pitta and Gordon Hudson are the only other tight ends, while Bushman became just the 12th overall player to do it at BYU. Only former receiver Cody Hoffman and versatile back Matt Bellini have had four seasons of 500 yards or more.

THE BYU OFFENSE

- **QUARTERBACK STARTS.** With redshirt freshman quarterback Jaren Hall starting at USF in 2019 due to Zach Wilson's injury, it marked the sixth consecutive year the Cougars have started at least two different players at quarterback through a single season. When Baylor Romney started vs. Boise State it marked the second time in three years that at least three different players have started a game at quarterback. The 2013 season was the last time BYU started the same player under center for an entire season (Taysom Hill). Since 2009, BYU has had at least two different starting quarterbacks in all but two seasons (2009 and 2013).
- **FRESHMAN START.** With Hall getting the call at USF and Romney vs. Boise State, it made it six times since 2010 BYU has started a freshman signal caller. (2010 Jake Heaps, 2012 Taysom Hill, 2015 Tanner Mangum, 2017 Joe Critchlow and 2018 Zach Wilson).
- **COACHING EXPERIENCE.** The BYU offensive staff has more than 90 years of coaching experience. Jeff Grimes has the most with more than 25 years. Tight ends coach Steve Clark has been coaching since 1994 and passing game coordinator Aaron Roderick has 21 years in the profession. Roderick, Clark and wide receivers coach Fesi Sitake have all been offensive coordinators at the college level.

KALANI SITAKE**HEAD COACH****YEARS AT BYU**

5th year at BYU

YEARS OVERALL

5th year as head coach, 20 years in coaching

Kalani Sitake (pronounced kah-lah-nee see-tah-kay) enters his fourth season overseeing the BYU football program in 2020.

A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake is the 14th head coach in BYU history and just the fourth since 1972, when Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards took over the program. Sitake is the first former player under Edwards to be named head coach at BYU.

Named BYU's head coach on December 19, 2015, Sitake returned to his alma mater with 15 years of coaching experience, including seven seasons a defensive coordinator and four years as an assistant head coach. He came to BYU from Oregon State, where he served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator in 2015 under head coach Gary Andersen. Sitake spent the prior 10 seasons at the University of Utah under head coach Kyle Whittingham. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012. He coached 12 all-conference honorees at Utah, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014).

During his career, Sitake has helped mentor 23 NFL Draft picks, including BYU linebackers Sione Takitaki and Fred Warner and running back Jamaal Williams. Takitaki was a third-round pick of the Cleveland Browns in this year's draft and Warner was one of the league's top rookies after being taken in the third round in 2018 by the San Francisco 49ers. Williams, who was selected in the fourth round by the Green Bay Packers in the 2017 NFL Draft, finished his BYU career as the school's all-time leading rusher after averaging the nation's fifth-best per-game totals at 137.5 yards per outing for Sitake's Cougars in 2016.

Sitake has coached in 11 bowl games during his career and has been on the winning side in nine of those 11 contests, including a 2-1 mark as a head coach. BYU is coming off an appearance in the 2019 Hawai'i Bowl vs. the Rainbow Warriors.

Sitake began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002 under Gary Crowton. Sitake then joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.

He began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards. A team captain as a senior, Sitake's last game as a player was also the last game coached by the legendary Edwards, who was a great mentor for Sitake.

Born in Nuku'alofa, Tonga, and raised in Laie, Hawai'i and Provo, Utah, Sitake is the nation's first FBS head football coach of Tongan descent. He graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. Sitake and his wife Timberly have three children, Skye, Sadie and Kelaokalani (KK).

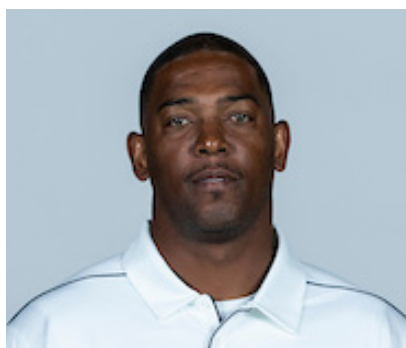
