- THE SERIES. BYU and Louisiana Tech are scheduled to meet for the first time. The Bulldogs are coming off a 10-win season in 2019 and six consecutive bowl victories. Former BYU head coach Gary Crowton (2001-2004) spent three seasons as the head coach at Louisiana Tech (1996-98). Bronco Mendenhall, head coach at BYU from 2005-2015 was Crowton's defensive backs coach at LA Tech in 1997 and served as his defensive coordinator at BYU (2003-04).
- RANKED TEAM. BYU is currently ranked No. 22 in both the AP and Coaches Polls, the second-consecutive week the Cougars have been in the 2020 rankings. Louisiana Tech received two votes in the Coaches Poll.
- CONFERENCE USA. The Bulldogs are one of three Conference-USA teams BYU is scheduled to play in 2020. The Cougars are also slated to face UTSA next week and Western Kentucky later in the year.
- **POINTS.** Both the Cougars and Bulldogs are scoring at a high rate in 2020 to start the year. Through two games BYU is averaging 51.5 points per game, ranked No. 2 nationally, while Louisiana Tech checks in at 48.5 points per game, good for No. 6 in the nation.
- WEEKLY HONORS. Following the Cougars' 48-7 win, quarterback Zach Wilson was named one of the Davey O'Brien Award Great 8 quarterbacks for the week. His career-best 392 yards also earned him a spot on the Davey O'Brien Watch List. Wilson was also named one of eight quarterbacks as a Manning Award Star of the Week for the second time this season. Wilson was also an honorable mention for CFPA National Quarterback of the Week. In addition to Wilson, left tackle Brady Christensen was named to the Pro Football Focus Team of the Week after grading out as one of the top offensive lineman in the country. Both Wilson and Christensen are ranked No. 2 in PFF's rankings.
- 600 CLUB. BYU topped 600 yards against Troy, racking up 664 total yards. The Cougars had 472 in the air and 192 on the ground. It was the most yards since 741 against Wagner in 2015 and the most against an FBS opponent since 681 vs. Houston in 2013.
- OFFENSE, DEFENSE. Through two games, BYU is dominating the statistics on both fronts. The Cougars are No. 2 in scoring offense and No. 2 in scoring defense. BYU ranks No. 1 in total defense and No. 4 in total offense. The Cougars are ranked in the top 10 in several other offensive and defensive categories to start the year.

ANTHONY LEADS LA TECH FOOTBALL TO VICTORY

RUSTON, La. - Luke Anthony threw five touchdowns and ran for another to lead Louisiana Tech to a 66-38 win over Houston Baptist Saturday night before a "Covid19 sellout" of 7,140 fans at Joe Aillet Stadium.

Anthony, who faced the Huskies as the starting QB for Abilene Christian the past two seasons in Southland Conference play, found Wayne Toussant on a pair of long TD passes in the opening quarter before hitting Isaiah Graham to two more in the second guarter as the Bulldogs built a 38-17 halftime lead.

The Bulldogs (2-0, 1-0 C-USA) amassed 542 yards of total offense as Anthony hit 17-of-30 passes for 314 yards and the five scores. He found Jawaun Johnson for a 41-yard strike in the third quarter and also scored on a one-yard plunge in the third stanza.

Justin Henderson rushed 11 times for 77 yards and one score while Israel Tucker added 63 yards on nine carries to lead the Bulldogs ground game that totaled 182 yards in the game. Henderson scored on a three-yard run early in the second quarter to give Tech a 31-14 advantage.

Greg Garner added a two-yard run in the fourth quarter while Westin Elliott found Kyle Maxwell for a seven-yard score for the final TD of the game.

Freshman Jacob Barnes, who connected on all nine extra point attempts in the game, started the scoring for the Bulldogs with a 51-yard field goal just four minutes into the contest.

Smoke Harris led all Tech receivers with five catches for 30 yards while Adrian Hardy (4-69), Toussant (3-91-2 TDs), Graham (3-36-2 TDs), Maxwell (3-29-1 TD), Griffin Hebert (2-47) and Johnson (2-44-1 TD) were all involved heavily in the passing game.

Defensively, the Bulldogs got enough stops against a high-powered Huskies passing game that had scored 31 points against North Texas and 33 points against Texas Tech. HBU quarterback Bailey Zappe completed 37-of-58 passes for 406 yards and five touchdowns in the contest but did throw his first interception in more than 140 pass attempts on the season.

Bee Jay Williamson intercepted Zappe in the second quarter, upping the LA Tech streak to 19 straight games with at least one forced turnover. It also marked the seventh straight game with at least one interception by the Bulldogs.

True freshman Tyler Grubbs followed up his impressive debut against Southern Miss with another strong outing, totaling 12 tackles and one tackle for loss. Trey Baldwin added nine tackles before leaving the game due to a targeting foul in the third quarter while Williamson chipped in with seven stops.

Milton Williams, Levi Bell and Tristan Allen all recorded sacks in the

Tech returns to action Friday when it travels to Provo to face BYU. Kickoff is set for 8 p.m. CT in a game that will be televised on ESPN2.

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR TEN

As the only football team playing in the western part of the United States, the BYU football team looks to make its mark during an unprecedented 2020 football season. Entering its 10th year as an independent, BYU has pressed forward with its 2020 football season despite many conferences and teams canceling their season due to the COVID-19 pandemic. As one of only four independent teams moving forward, the Cougars currently have eight teams on the schedule from the American Athletic Conference, Sun Belt Conference, Conference USA and FCS's Big South Conference and with one game against a fellow independent team. The season features six home games against Troy, UTSA, Texas State. Western Kentucky and North Alabama with road matchups against Navy and Army.



BOWLING OPPONENTS

Both Navy and Western Kentucky played in bowl games following the 2019 season. After going 11-2 in, Navy participated in the 2019 Liberty Bowl coming away with a last-minute win taking down Kansas State 20-17. Western Kentucky also participated in the 2019 bowl, traveling to the First Responder Bowl taking the win against Western Michigan 23-20.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's winning percentage at LaVell Edwards Stadium is ranked No. 14 among teams playing in their current stadium. Stadium record: 246-79 (.757)

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates more than 400 missions around the world in over 150 nations speaking more than 160 languages. More than 67,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours — seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples) — teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

About 65 percent of the current team has served a mission. Members of the team have served in 28 different countries and six of the seven continents around the globe. More than 30 members of the team (previous signees or on roster) are currently serving in the mission field

POLYNESIAN PIPELINE

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recuiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. About 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now, several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff.

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA. His staff includes Polynesians Ilaisa Tuiaki, Fesi Sitake Harvey Unga, Nu'u Tafisi, Jack Damuni, Jasen Ah You and Vince Feula.

WILSON LEADS NO. 18 BYU TO 48-7 VICTORY OVER TROY

PROVO, Utah – Led by quarterback Zach Wilson's career-high 392 passing yards, the No. 18 BYU football team flew by Troy 48-7 Saturday night at LaVell Edwards Stadium.

The BYU offense racked up 664 yards in the game with 472 through the air and 192 on the ground. Wilson led the charge going 23-28 for 392 passing yards with two touchdowns and added two scores on the ground.

Wideouts Dax Milne and Gunner Romney were the Cougars' leading receiving targets but eleven different players caught a pass. Milne had a career-best seven catches for 140 yards and one touchdown with a 70-yard reception while Romney caught five passes for 138 yards and a long reception of 52-yards. It was the first time BYU had two 100-yard receivers since 2015.

On defense, Keenan Pili nabbed nine total tackles including six solo stops while Khyiris Tonga recorded a career-high two sacks. The defense held Troy to just 181 total yards, the Trojans worst output since 2014.

Despite two back-to-back Troy drives due to a BYU muffed punt return, the Cougars defense held the Trojans offense scoreless to open the game. The BYU offense gained momentum with two long passes to Lopini Katoa and Tyler Allegier to put BYU in the red zone for the first time. On fourth-and-one at the goal line, fullback Masen Wake pushed his way into the end zone to close out the first quarter as the Cougars went up 7-0.

Zach Wilson showed his arm strength to open the second quarter sending a pass 41-yards downfield to Gunner Romney to Troy's 1-yard line. It was quickly followed by a quarterback sneak from Wilson for a touchdown to put BYU ahead 14-0. A 52-yard pass to Gunner Romney, again put the BYU offense in the red zone and the Cougars capped the drive with a 10-yard pass to Isaac Rex for another six points and a PAT from Jake Oldroyd. With under two minutes left in the quarter the Cougars were up 21-0.

The Trojans responded with a two-yard rushing touchdown to bring the scoring margin to 21-7 with just over one minute remaining in the half. BYU had the final say of the quarter as Oldroyd boomed a kick through the uprights with a 54-yard field goal to make the score 24-7 going into halftime.

To open the second half, Wilson threw a 70-yard bomb downfield to an open Dax Milne on the second play of the half and Milne ran the ball into the end zone for a 31-7 lead. Wilson then tacked on his second rushing touchdown of the night on a two-yard play, pushing the Cougars lead to 38-7 with just under four minutes left in the half.

On the first play of the fourth quarter, Wake accounted for his second touchdown of the night running the ball 10-yards into the end zone for a 45-7 lead. Jake Oldroyd connected on his second field goal of the night, this time a 20-yarder, making the score 48-7. The Cougars finished out the game taking a knee to run out the clock and secure the win 48-7.

BYU OFFENSE BY THE NUMBERS

The BYU offensive line is the most expereienced unit on the team, returning a combined 125 starts, including everyone from 2019 that started a game. Brady Christensen and James Empey have started the most games, with 28 starts each, followed by Keanu Saleapaga (19), Tristen Hoge (19), Chandon Herring (14), Blake Freeland (8), Clark Barrington (6) and Kieffer Longson (3).

The Cougars began the year with 279 total passing yards against Navy and 472 vs. Troy. BYU passed for 200+ yards in every game in 2019. Including the final two games of 2018, the Cougars have gone for 200+ in 17 straight games. The last time BYU had 200+ in more consecutive games was a string of 26, spanning the 2007-09 seasons. 2008 was the last year BYU threw for at least 200 in every game.

BYU had a pair of 100-yard receivers for the first time since 2015. Dax Milne led all receivers with seven receptions for 140 yards while Gunner Romney posted five catches for 138 yards. In 2015, Mitchell Juergens had 172 yards and Devon Blackmon had 105 in a 35-24 win over Boise State.

BYU has scored 100+ points over the first two games of a season for the first time since 2001 when the Cougars hung 70 on Tulane and 52 against Nevada. BYU has outscored its first two opponents 103-10.

The 664 yards of total offense were the most against an FBS team for the Cougars since 681 against Houston in 2013. The Cougars had two 600-yard games in 2019 with 639 (Utah State) and 628 (UMass)

BYU DEFENSE BY THE NUMBERS

After another dominate performance from the BYU defense, the Cougars finished their second game ranking first in the nation in both total defense with 165 yards and pass defense at 96 yards. It is the second week in a row that BYU has been first in the nation in pass defense.

The Cougars currently rank second in the nation in scoring defense allowing only 10 points to be scored against them, seven against Troy and three against Navy, for 5.0 points per game. BYU also ranks second in the nation in first downs allowing its opponents to claim only 15 first downs in two games.

After holding Navy to only 1.3 yards per rush, the BYU defense again shutdown the rush against Troy, allowing only 1.1 yards per rush. BYU was holding Navy to only 1.3 yards per rush. The Trojans finished the game with only 19 total rushing

Five different players recorded tackles for loss in the game against Troy, including a career-high two sacks from senior 6 captain Khyiris Tonga. Zac Dawe also posted a career-high 1.5 tackles for loss including a sacks. Troy Warner grabbed his second career tackle for loss and newcomers Tyler Batty and Micah Harper posted one tackle for loss and 0.5 tackles for loss, respectively

In his BYU debut, freshman Micah Harper showed up for the BYU defense tallying seven total tackles, including three solo stops. The defensive back earned his first career start in his debut game while also tabbing his first career tackle for loss.

THE BYU DEFENSE

- SENIOR STAFF. While the BYU defense graduated many key contributors after the 2019 season, the Cougars bring back a number of veterans including four players coming off red-shirt seasons. Khyiris Tonga returns for his senior season after forgoing the 2019 NFL Draft. Seniors Zayne Anderson, Troy Warner and Chris Wilcox who all have significant playing time will make their comeback after injuries during both the 2018 and 2019 season.
- TOP NATIONAL RANKINGS. The BYU defense had a dominant game against both Navy and Troy ranking in the top 10 nationally in seven different categories including first in total defense and for the second week in a row, first in pass defense. The Cougars also rank second in the national in scoring defense and first downs.
- DEFENSIVELY DENIED. Against both Navy and Troy, the Cougars defense defended its end zone allowing only 10 points to be scored. Through two games, BYU holds a .160 third down conversion rate allowing only 4 of 25 attempts to be successful and are holding its opponents to only 3.3 yards per play.

5th year at BYU YEARS OVERALL

5th year as head coach, 20 years in coaching

Kalani Sitake (pronounced kah-lah-nee see-tah-kay) enters his fourth season overseeing the BYU football program in 2020.

A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake is the 14th head coach in BYU history and just the fourth since 1972. when Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards took over the program. Sitake is the first former player under Edwards to be named head coach at BYU.

Named BYU's head coach on December 19, 2015, Sitake returned to his alma mater with 15 years of coaching experience, including seven seasons a defensive coordinator and four years as an assistant head coach. He came to BYU from Oregon State, where he served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator in 2015 under head coach Gary Andersen. Sitake spent the prior 10 seasons at the University of Utah under head coach Kyle Whittingham. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012. He coached 12 all-conference honorees at Utah, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014).

During his career, Sitake has helped mentor 23 NFL Draft picks, including BYU linebackers Sione Takitaki and Fred Warner and running back Jamaal Williams. Takitaki was a third-round pick of the Cleveland Browns in this year's draft and Warner was one of the league's top rookies after being taken in the third round in 2018 by the San Francisco 49ers. Williams, who was selected in the fourth round by the Green Bay Packers in the 2017 NFL Draft, finished his BYU career as the school's all-time leading rusher

after averaging the nation's fifth-best per-game totals at 137.5 yards per outing for Sitake's Cougars in 2016.

Sitake has coached in 11 bowl games during his career and has been on the winning side in nine of those 11 contests, including a 2-1 mark as a head coach. BYU is coming off an appearance in the 2019 Hawai'i Bowl vs. the Rainbow Warriors.

Sitake began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002 under Gary Crowton. Sitake then joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.

He began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards. A team captain as a senior, Sitake's last game as a player was also the last game coached by the legendary Edwards, who was a great mentor for Sitake.

Born in Nuku'alofa, Tonga, and raised in Laie, Hawai'i and Provo, Utah, Sitake is the nation's first FBS head football coach of Tongan descent. He graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. Sitake and his wife Timberly have three children, Skye, Sadie and Kelaokalani (KK).
