- **THE SERIES.** BYU and UTSA are meeting for the first time. This will be the second consecutive Conference USA team the Cougars face in as many weeks.
- **RANKED TEAM.** BYU is currently ranked No. 15 in both the AP and Coaches Polls, the second-consecutive week the Cougars have been in the 2020 rankings. It is BYU's highest ranking since the 2009 season, when the Cougars reached as high as No. 7 in the AP poll. The 2009 team finished the year ranked No. 12.
- **HOMECOMING** The game against UTSA takes place during BYU's Homecoming Week on Campus. BYU is 3-1 under Kalani Sitake in Homecoming games. With many events virtual, visit homecoming.byu.edu for more info.
- **WILSON HONORS.** Following the Cougars' 45-14 victory over LA Tech, quarterback Zach Wilson was named the Walter Camp National Offensive Player of the Week and the CFPA Performer of the Week. He was also named to the Davey O'Brien Great 8 list for the second consecutive week and a Manning Award Star of the Week for the third week in a row. He went 24 of 26 for 325 yards, two touchdowns and ran for three more scores. His completion percentage of 92.3 set the school record for a single game (minimum 20, 25 attempts). He already owned the record for 15 attempts with his 18 of 18 game in 2018 vs. Western Michigan. On the year, Wilson has as many total touchdowns as he does incompletions (11).
- **NUMBER ONE.** BYU is ranked No. 1 in total offense and No. 1 in total defense. The Cougars are averaging 585.7 yards per game and only allowing 214.3 yards per game. BYU is dominating the statistics early in the season, ranking in the top 10 in more than 30 offensive categories and more than 20 defensive categories.

ROADRUNNERS DROP HEARTBREAKER AT UAB ON SATURDAY

BIRMINGHAM, Ala. — Sincere McCormick rushed for 150 yards and a touchdown and the UTSA defense forced four UAB turnovers, but it was not enough in a 21-13 loss to the Blazers in Conference USA action on Saturday at Legion Field.

Trailing by two scores in the fourth quarter, the Roadrunners (3-1, 1-1 C-USA) took advantage of their fourth takeaway of the day when Trevor Harmanson picked off a Bryson Lucero pass over the middle to set up UTSA on the UAB 34-yard line. McCormick dashed around left end for 25 yards on first down and, following a defensive pass interference penalty in the end zone, the sophomore from Converse Judson found paydirt from two yards. Hunter Duplessis' extra point made it 21-13 with 10:31 remaining.

UTSA then forced a three-and-out and drove into UAB territory, as Lowell Narcisse's 16-yard quarterback keeper put the ball on the 33. However, two straight tackles in the backfield followed by two incomplete passes turned the ball over on downs with 4:40 left to play.

The Roadrunners held on third down near midfield and forced a punt with a little more than one minute left, but a roughing the punter penalty gave the Blazers (3-1, 1-0) an automatic first down and they ran out the clock to secure the win, their 20th in a row at Legion Field.

McCormick paced the UTSA offense with his second 100-yard rushing game of the season and fifth of his career came on the strength of 22 carries. Narcisse added 42 yards on the ground, while Jordan Weeks, who came into the game after starting quarterback Josh Adkins was injured on the first play from scrimmage, completed seven passes for 57 yards.

Jamal Ligon, Antonio Parks and Rashad Wisdom led the defense with five tackles apiece, while Wisdom had one of three interceptions, joining Trevor Harmanson and Corey Mayfield Jr. Ligon, a freshman linebacker, came up with the fourth takeaway on a fumble that he forced and recovered. Lorenzo Dantzler pitched in with four stops, including two behind the line of scrimmage, and a pair of quarterback hurries.

Duplessis put UTSA on the board first after he drilled a career-long 48-yard field goal to cap an opening drive that took 5:20 off the clock.

UAB answered and took a 14-3 lead thanks to a pair of touchdown passes, one for 18 yards from Lucero to Myron Mitchell late in the opening frame and a second on a 15-yard strike to Gerrit Prince early in the second stanza. That second score was set up by a Michael Fairbanks interception that was returned five yards to the 30-yard line, giving the Blazers a short field.

Later in the second quarter, Duplessis extended his FBS-best streak of consecutive makes to 18 with a 35-yard field goal that pulled the visitors to within 14-6 with 6:39 left until halftime.

Both teams traded empty possessions to start the third quarter before UAB extended its lead to 21-6 following a 21-yard pass from Lucero to Prince with 1:32 on the clock.

Lucero completed 18 of 29 passes for 193 yards and three TDs and Spencer Brown rushed for 144 yards to lead UAB.

The Roadrunners will travel to Provo, Utah, to face No. 22 BYU (3-0)

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR TEN

As the only football team playing in the western part of the United States, the BYU football team looks to make its mark during an unprecedented 2020 football season. Entering its 10th year as an independent, BYU has pressed forward with its 2020 football season despite many conferences and teams canceling their season due to the COVID-19 pandemic. As one of only four independent teams moving forward, the Cougars currently have eight teams on the schedule from the American Athletic Conference, Sun Belt Conference, Conference USA and FCS's Big South Conference and with one game against a fellow independent team. The season features six home games against Troy, UTSA, Texas State, Western Kentucky and North Alabama with road matchups against Navy and Army.



BOWLING OPPONENTS

Both Navy and Western Kentucky played in bowl games following the 2019 season. After going 11-2 in, Navy participated in the 2019 Liberty Bowl coming away with a last-minute win taking down Kansas State 20-17. Western Kentucky also participated in the 2019 bowl, traveling to the First Responder Bowl taking the win against Western Michigan 23-20.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's winning percentage at LaVell Edwards Stadium is ranked No. 14 among teams playing in their current stadium.

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates more than 400 missions around the world in over 150 nations speaking more than 160 languages. More than 67,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours — seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples) — teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

About 65 percent of the current team has served a mission. Members of the team have served in 28 different countries and six of the seven continents around the globe. More than 30 members of the team (previous signees or on roster) are currently serving in the mission field.

POLYNESIAN PIPELINE

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recruiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. About 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now, several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff.

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA. His staff includes Polynesians Ilaisa Tuiaiki, Fesi Sitake Harvey Unga, Nu'u Tafisi, Jack Damuni, Jasen Ah You and Vince Feula.

NO. 22 BYU BEATS LOUISIANA TECH BEHIND WILSON'S FIVE TOUCHDOWNS

PROVO, Utah – Quarterback Zach Wilson's nearly perfect game gave No. 22 BYU a 45-14 edge against Louisiana Tech in a Friday night matchup at LaVell Edwards Stadium.

Wilson went 24 for 26 with 325 passing yards and two touchdowns while adding 43 rushing yards on eight attempts and three touchdowns. His 92.3 completion percentage was just shy of his perfect 18 of 18 game in 2018 and gives him the top two marks in school history (minimum 15 attempts). It marked the first time in his career with five total touchdowns. Wideouts Gunner Romney and Dax Milne split the charge both catching seven passes apiece while Romney totaled 101 yards and Milne had 89 yards. Tyler Allgeier led the team on the ground with 10 rushing attempts for 93 yards and one touchdown. Troy Warner and Max Tooley both recorded interceptions for the BYU defense and freshman Tyler Baty totaled three sacks on the night.

BYU racked up 513 total yards to LA Tech's 313. Through the air, BYU connected for 325 passing yards and two touchdowns averaging 13.5 yards per reception. On the ground, the Cougars scored four touchdowns at 188 yards while the BYU's defense held the Bulldogs to only 74 rushing yard and no touchdowns.

On its first drive of the game, a 16-yard pass to Gunner Romney followed immediately by a 39-yard pass to Dax Milne got the Cougars into the red zone. Wilson then ran the ball nine yards into the end zone to put BYU 7-0 with just over 10 minutes left in the quarter.

However, LA Tech quickly answered back with a 66-yard touchdown of their own to tie the game at 7-7 with just under six minutes left in the quarter. Warner gave the ball back to the Cougars, leaping over a Bulldogs wideout to grab his first career interception and gave the ball back to the BYU offense.

In the second quarter, BYU barreled through LA Tech's defense on short gains getting to the Bulldogs 22-yard line. In a crowded end zone, Wilson threw a ball downfield to Carter Wheat. Covered by two LA Tech defenders, Wheat jumped into the air and grabbed the ball over the two defenders to give the Cougars their second touchdown of the game. BYU took the lead 14-7 with 10:34 left in the half.

The Cougars followed it up with another touchdown as Gunner Romney grabbed a 22-yard pass moving BYU to the one-yard line. Allegier made his way into the end zone with a one-yard rush for his first touchdown of the game making the score 21-7 at the 5:07 mark.

A 37-second, 80-yard drive from the Cougars capped off the second quarter for BYU. The Cougars put another seven points on the board as Romney backstepped into the end zone after grabbing a 22-yard reception from Wilson. The Cougars went into the locker room with a 28-7 edge after the PAT from Jake Oldroyd.

To match their first-half momentum, the Cougars put another touchdown on the board to open up the second quarter. Five big yardage plays brought BYU down the field. An 18-yard pass to Masen Wake, followed by a 23-yard grab from Neil Pau'u and a 10-yard pass to Isaac Rex put BYU at the Bulldogs' 32-yard line. Running back Allgeier moved the ball 30 yards downfield before Wilson ran the ball one-yard into the end zone for another six points as the Cougars went up 35-7. Oldroyd then added a 45-yard field goal with just over seven minutes left in the quarter to make the score 38-7.

Wilson ran in his third rushing touchdown of the night to start the fourth quarter. A 21-yard catch from Romney, followed by an eight-yard reception from Milne set Wilson up for a 14-yard run into the end zone and the Cougars added to their score making it 45-7. The Bulldogs tacked on a touchdown with just under five minutes in the game with a four-yard bring the score to 45-14.

BYU OFFENSE BY THE NUMBERS

1 BYU is ranked No. 1 in total offense with 585.7 yards per game. The Cougars are also ranked No. 1 in yards per play (8.10), first downs per game (28.7), pass efficiency (214.86), passing yards per attempt (13.1), completion percentage (82.9) and passing plays of 20+ yards (19). The Cougars rank in the top 10 in more than 30 offensive categories.

11 On the year, quarterback Zach Wilson has the same amount of incompletions as he does total touchdowns with 11. He has completed 60 of 71 passes, and passed for six touchdowns and ran for five more.

130 The BYU offensive line is the most experienced unit on the team, having a combined 125 starts, including everyone from 2019 that started a game. Brady Christensen leads with (29), James Empey is next (28), followed by Keanu Saleapaga (19), Tristen Hoge (19), Chandon Herring (15), Blake Freeland (9), Clark Barrington (7), Kieffer Longson (3) and Joe Tukuafu.

200+ The Cougars began the year with 279 total passing yards against Navy, 472 vs. Troy and 325 vs. LA Tech. BYU passed for 200+ yards in every game in 2019. Including the final two games of 2018, the Cougars have gone for 200+ in 18 straight games. The last time BYU had 200+ in more consecutive games was a string of 26, spanning the 2007-09 seasons. 2008 was the last year BYU threw for at least 200 in every game prior to 2019.

3x100 Wideout Gunner Romney has had 100+ receiving yards in each of the first three games this season. The last BYU receiver to have three consecutive 100-yard games was Cody Hoffman in 2012 when he finished the year with four consecutive 100-yard games.

148 BYU's 148 points through the first three games is the third-most in the opening three games in BYU history. The 2001 team totaled 166 points while the 1977 squad had 158.

THE BYU OFFENSE

- **COACHING EXPERIENCE.** The BYU offensive staff has more than 90 years of coaching experience. Jeff Grimes has the most with more than 25 years. Tight ends coach Steve Clark has been coaching since 1994 and passing game coordinator Aaron Roderick has 21 years in the profession. Roderick, Clark and wide receivers coach Fesi Sitake have all been offensive coordinators at the college level.
- **BEING EFFICIENT.** BYU has completed 68 of 82 passes as a team for an 82.9 percent completion percentage, the best in the FBS to lead to an FBS-best 214.86 efficiency rating. Zach Wilson is the best in college football at 60 of 71 for 84.5 percent. He is also No. 2 in pass efficiency at 221.85.
- **SCORING MACHINE.** Running back Lopini Katoa continues to be a threat to find the end zone with another three total touchdowns against Navy. He has 102 career points, making him one of 36 offensive players (non-kickers) to score more than 100 points for the Cougars.
- **40+.** BYU has scored 40+ points in three consecutive games for the first time since the 2014 season when the Cougars finished the year with four in a row over the mark. The last time BYU started a season with three games of 40 or more points was in 2001, when the Cougars finished the year leading the nation in scoring at 46.8 points per game. BYU is currently at 49.3 points per game.

THE BYU DEFENSE

- **SENIOR STAFF.** While the BYU defense graduated many key contributors after the 2019 season, the Cougars bring back a number of veterans including four players coming off red-shirt seasons. Khyiris Tonga returns for his senior season after forgoing the 2019 NFL Draft. Seniors Zayne Anderson, Troy Warner and Chris Wilcox who all have significant playing time will make their comeback after injuries during both the 2018 and 2019 season.
- **TOP IN THE NATION.** The BYU defense currently ranks first in team defense allowing its opponents only 214.3 yard per game. It is the second week in a row the Cougars have held the ranking. BYU also ranks third in pass defense and third down conversions, fourth in scoring defense and fifth in rushing defense
- **DEFENSIVELY DENIED.** Against both Navy and Troy, the Cougars defense defended its end zone allowing only 24 points to be scored. Through two games, BYU holds a third down conversion rate of just 23.1 percent allowing only 9 of 38 attempts to be successful and are holding its opponents to only 3.9 yards per play.

Kalani Sitake (pronounced kah-lah-nee see-tah-kay) enters his fourth season overseeing the BYU football program in 2020.

A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake is the 14th head coach in BYU history and just the fourth since 1972, when Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards took over the program. Sitake is the first former player under Edwards to be named head coach at BYU.

Named BYU's head coach on December 19, 2015, Sitake returned to his alma mater with 15 years of coaching experience, including seven seasons a defensive coordinator and four years as an assistant head coach. He came to BYU from Oregon State, where he served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator in 2015 under head coach Gary Andersen. Sitake spent the prior 10 seasons at the University of Utah under head coach Kyle Whittingham. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012. He coached 12 all-conference honorees at Utah, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014).

During his career, Sitake has helped mentor 23 NFL Draft picks, including BYU linebackers Sione Takitaki and Fred Warner and running back Jamaal Williams. Takitaki was a third-round pick of the Cleveland Browns in this year's draft and Warner was one of the league's top rookies after being taken in the third round in 2018 by the San Francisco 49ers. Williams, who was selected in the fourth round by the Green Bay Packers in the 2017 NFL Draft, finished his BYU career as the school's all-time leading rusher after averaging the nation's fifth-best per-game totals at 137.5 yards per outing for Sitake's Cougars in 2016.

Sitake has coached in 11 bowl games during his career and has been on the winning side in nine of those 11 contests, including a 2-1 mark as a head coach. BYU is coming off an appearance in the 2019 Hawai'i Bowl vs. the Rainbow Warriors.

Sitake began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002 under Gary Crowton. Sitake then joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.

He began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards. A team captain as a senior, Sitake's last game as a player was also the last game coached by the legendary Edwards, who was a great mentor for Sitake.

Born in Nuku'alofa, Tonga, and raised in Laie, Hawai'i and Provo, Utah, Sitake is the nation's first FBS head football coach of Tongan descent. He graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. Sitake and his wife Timberly have three children, Skye, Sadie and Kelaokalani (KK).
