

- **THE SERIES**. BYU and Texas State are meeting for the first time. The Bobcats are one of six programs the Cougars will play for the first time in the 2020 season.
- BOBCAT CONNECTIONS. BYU's offensive line coach Eric Mateos spent two seasons (2017-18) at Texas State prior to his arrival in Provo. Texas State head coach Jake Spavital spent several years under the tutelage of Dana Holgorsen, coach of the Houston Cougars, BYU's most recent opponent. Spavital was Holgorsen's offensive coordinator for two seasons at West Virginia (2017-18) and also worked with him in a previous Houston (2009) stint and at Oklahoma State (2010).
- FIRST HOME GAME WITH FANS. For the first time this season, LaVell Edwards Stadium will allow a limited number of fans to attend the game. Approximately 6,000 spectators will be allowed in the venue.
- **RANKED TEAM.** BYU is currently ranked No. 11 in the Coaches Poll and No. 12 in the AP Poll, the sixth-consecutive week the Cougars have been in the 2020 rankings. It is BYU's highest ranking since the 2009 season, when the Cougars reached as high as No. 7 in the AP poll. The 2009 team finished the year ranked No. 12.
- **5-0 STARTS.** BYU is 5-0 for the first time since 2008. The Cougars have gone 5-0 now six times (2008, 2001, 1984, 1981, 1979). It is the best start through five games under head coach Kalani Sitake. BYU has gone 6-0 four times (2008, 2001, 1984, 1979).

TEXAS STATE FALLS 30-20 AT SOUTH ALABAMA

Mobile, Ala. — Despite a career-best performance from quarterback Brady McBride, South Alabama (2-2, 1-0 in Sun Belt) scored the final 10 points in the game as Texas State suffered a 30-20 loss Saturday afternoon in Hancock Whitney Stadium.

Texas State had tied the score at 20-20 with 10:30 left to play when Seth Keller kicked a 41-yard field goal.

But the Jaguars scored the final 10 points in the game when Desmond Trotter hit Kawaan Baker for an eight-yard touchdown pass and Diego Guajardo kicked the extra point to give the Jaguars a 27-20 advantage with 7:10 left to play. The Jaguars clinched the victory when Guajardo kicked a 44-yard field goal with 1:09 left to play.

McBride had career highs in completions and yards when he competed 28-of-40 passes for 260 yards and one touchdown. Jackson Lanam added a career-best five receptions for 48 yards and caught the first touchdown reception of his career.

Brock Sturges also added a one-yard touchdown run and Seth Keller scored eight points with two field goals and two extra points.

Carlos Davis led South Alabama's ground attack as the Jaguars outgained the Bobcats 132-88 in rushing yards. Davis ran for 113 yards and a touchdown on 32 attempts, and Desmond Trotter completed 18-of-22-passes for 187 yards and a touchdown. Chance Lovertich also completed 7-12 passes for 66 yards and another TD.

After Texas State (1-5, 1-2 in Sun Belt) turned the ball over on downs at South Alabama's 35-yard line on the game's first drive, the Jaguars drove down the field for a 33-yard field goal by Diego Guajardo to take a 3-0 lead.

Texas State answered with a 9-play, 65-yard drive for a touchdown. Brady McBride completed five of his six passes for 51 yards, including a nine-yard TD to Jackson Lanam. It was the first touchdown catch of Lanam's career.

South Alabama scored their first touchdown with 13:19 left to play in the first half when Carlos Davis scored on a one-yard run. Guajardo kicked the extra-point to give the Jaguars a 10-7 lead.

Texas State tied the score with 4:48 left in the first half when Seth Keller kicked a 30-yard field goal.

The Jaguars took a 17-10 advantage into halftime when Chance Lovertich hit Jalen Tolbert for a one-yard touchdown pass, and Guajardo kicked the extra point with six seconds left in the first half.

Texas State made the score 17-17 midway into the third quarter when the Bobcats took possession at midfield. McBride completed two straight passes to Jah'Marae Sheread for 47 yards to South Alabama's three-yard line. Brock Sturges scored his fourth touchdown of the season with a one-yard touchdown run, and Keller added the extra point.

The fourth quarter began with both teams exchanging field goals in the first five minutes. Guajardo kicked a 24-yard field goal at the 14:01 mark. Then, Keller evened the score at 20-20 before South Alabama scored the game's final 10 points.

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR TEN

As the only football team playing in the western part of the United States, the BYU football team looks to make its mark during an unprecedented 2020 football season. Entering its 10th year as an independent, BYU has pressed forward with its 2020 football season despite many conferences and teams canceling their season due to the COVID-19 pandemic. As one of only four independent teams moving forward, the Cougars currently have eight teams on the schedule from the American Athletic Conference, Sun Belt Conference, Conference USA and FCS's Big South Conference and with one game against a fellow independent team. The season features six home games against Troy. UTSA. Texas State, Western Kentucky and North Alabama with road matchups against Navy and Army.



BOWLING OPPONENTS

Both Navy and Western Kentucky played in bowl games following the 2019 season. After going 11-2 in, Navy participated in the 2019 Liberty Bowl coming away with a last-minute win taking down Kansas State 20-17. Western Kentucky also participated in the 2019 bowl, traveling to the First Responder Bowl taking the win against Western Michigan 23-20.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's winning percentage at LaVell Edwards Stadium is ranked No. 14 among teams playing in their current stadium. *Stadium recort: 243-80 (.752)*

MISSIONS

Missionaries work long hours — seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples) — teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

About 65 percent of the current team has served a mission. Members of the team have served in 28 different countries and six of the seven continents around the globe. More than 30 members of the team (previous signees or on roster) are currently serving in the mission field.

POLYNESIAN PIPELINE

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recuiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. About 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now, several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff.

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA. His staff includes Polynesians Ilaisa Tuiaki, Fesi Sitake Harvey Unga, Nu'u Tafisi, Jack Damuni, Jasen Ah You and Vince Feula.

2020 OPPONENTS

BYU PULLS OFF WIN AGAINST HOUSTON, 43-26

HOUSTON – Despite trailing at halftime and at the end of the third quarter after a fast start, No. 13/14 BYU finished strong putting up 29 unanswered points in the second half to defeat Houston 43-26 on Friday night at TDECU Stadium.

Quarterback Zach Wilson and wide receiver Dax Milne led the charge on the offense with both recording career high games. Milne boasted a career-best 184 receiving yards as well as career highs in receptions with nine and touchdowns with three. The wideout averaged 20.4 yards a catch with a career-long 78-yard touchdown reception on BYU's first offensive play and an 18-yard score that iced the win. Wilson went 25 for 35 on the night with his first career 400-yard passing game, finishing with exactly 400 yards and four touchdowns. The junior also led all rushers with nine attempts for 40 yards with a long rush of 32 yards. Isaiah Kaufusi and Keenan Pili led the Cougars on defense, both totaling eight tackles and one tackle for loss each. Zac Dawe added three tackles for loss, including one sack, while Tyler Batty recorded 1.5 tackles for loss.

Despite Houston getting an early 3-0 lead on the first drive, the BYU offense came out flying. With BYU's first play of the game, Wilson sent a ball 78 yards deep to Milne who took the ball all the way into the end zone for BYU's first score. The one-play, 19-second touchdown pass was a career-long for both Wilson and Milne as BYU went up 7-3 with 9:34 left in the first quarter.

On the next BYU drive, Wilson used his feet, scrambling down the field for a 32-yard gain followed immediately by a 35-yard pass to tight end Isaac Rex. Three plays later, Lopini Katoa punched in the ball for another BYU touchdown, increasing BYU's lead to 14-3.

Houston fought its way back, putting up a touchdown of its own followed by a field goal on its next drive. With the two scoring drives, Houston took the lead again at 17-14 with 4:42 left in the half. Houston capped the first half with a 49-yard field goal, pushing its lead to 20-14 going into halftime.

Houston continued with the momentum by eating up the majority of the clock on a 16-play, 99-yard drive that resulted in a touchdown with just over three minutes left in the quarter. Houston opted to go for two instead of a PAT, but Cougar defensive back George Udo intercepted the pass and Houston settled with six points for a 26-14 lead.

BYU got the final say of the quarter, getting in the end zone one last time before the time expired. An 18-yard pass to Pau'u followed by a 19-yard reception to Masen Wake set up Wilson to again connect with Milne, this time for 37-yards, to the Houston one-yard line. Two plays later Milne caught the ball for six points and Oldroyd connect on the PAT to decrease Houston's lead, 26-21.

After a 13-yard shanked punt by Houston, BYU's offense got the ball back on Houston's 23-yard line. Wilson made quick work with a 13-yard pass to Milne, followed by a quick underhand shovel pass to Wake for eight yards that put BYU in the end zone again. BYU elected to go for two and Wilson found Tyler Allgeier in the end zone as BYU pulled ahead 29-26 at the 10:35 mark.

The Cougars built on their momentum as Wilson made long yardage plays with a 24-yard rush and a 20-yard pass to Rex before finding again finding Milne with an 18-yard touchdown pass on 3rdand-15 from the Houston 18-yard line to extend the lead to 36-26.

BYU closed out the game with one last touchdown as Allgeier rushed 14 yards out to close the game and taking the win, 43-26.

BYU is the No. 1 in plays of 10 yards or more with 100, topping Clemson's 96 and Duke and SMU's 92. The Cougars are the most explosive in the passing game, ranking No. 1 with 72 passing plays of 10 yards or more. Zach Wilson is also tops in the FBS with 66 passing plays of 10 yards or more.

BYU is ranked No. 6 in total offense with 541.0 yards per game. The Cougars are ranked No. 1 in completion 6 percentage (78.2). BYU is No. 2 in yards per play (7.86) and yards per attempt (12.1), No. 3 in pass efficiency (204.84), total first downs (131) and total passing yards (1,768).

Quarterback Zach Wilson has six rushing touchdowns, the most by any FBS guarterback, ahead of five others tied 6 with five.



The BYU offensive line is the most experienced unit on the team, having a combined 140 starts, including everyone from 2019 that started a game. Brady Christensen leads with (31), James Empey is next (29), followed by Keanu Saleapaga (19), Tristen Hoge (19), Chandon Herring (17), Blake Freeland (11), Clark Barrington (9), Kieffer Longson (3) and Joe Tukuafu (2).

200+

The Cougars began the year with 279 total passing yards against Navy, 472 vs. Troy and 325 vs. LA Tech. BYU added 292 vs. UTSA and 400 at Houston. BYU passed for 200+ yards in every game in 2019. Including the final two games of 2018, the Cougars have gone for 200+ in 20 straight games. The last time BYU had 200+ in more consecutive games was a string of 26, spanning the 2007-09 seasons. 2008 was the last year BYU threw for at least 200 in every game prior to 2019.



BYU has a 100-yard rusher and a 100-yard receiver in the same game twice this season (Navy and UTSA). The Cougars also had two 100-yard receivers vs. Troy. BYU has also had a 100-yard receiver in every game this year. Gunner Romney has done it three times while Dax Milne added his third 100-yard game with 184 at Houston.

THE BYU OFFENSE

- **COACHING EXPERIENCE.** The BYU offensive staff has more than 90 years of coaching experience. Jeff Grimes has the most with more than 25 years. Tight ends coach Steve Clark has been coaching since 1994 and passing game coordinator Aaron Roderick has 21 years in the profession. Roderick, Clark and wide receivers coach Fesi Sitake have all been offensive coordinators at the college level.
- BEING EFFICIENT. BYU has completed 115 of 147 passes as a team for an 78.2 percent completion percentage, the best in the FBS to lead to a 204.84 efficiency rating, ranked second nationally. Zach Wilson is the best in college football at 107 of 136 for 78.7 percent. He is also No. 2 in pass efficiency at 207.68.

• WILSON AWARDS. Quarterback Zach Wilson has garnered several weekly awards during the 2020 season. The junior has earned a Manning Award Star of the Week four times, a Davey O'Brien Award Great 8 List selection three times and a CFPA National Player of the Week Award once, along with an honorable mention for the same honor.

• **THIRD DOWNS**. BYU is converting on third down 47.4 percent of the time, ranked No. 21 in the FBS. The Cougars have only had seven total 3-and-outs this year.

• DYNAMIC DUO. BYU's receiving tandem of Dax Milne and Gunner Romney rank No. 5 and 11 in receiving yards, respectively. Milne is also 11th in total receptions and Romney is 10th in yards per reception. Romney was recently added to the Biletnikoff Award Watch List. Milne is one of four players in the FBS with two 70-yard receptions.

• EXPLOSIVE PLAYS. BYU's offense has been one of the most explosive in college football, ranking No. 1 with 100 plays of 10 yards or more, topping Clemson's 96. The Cougars also rank No. 1 with 72 passing plays of 10+ and are in the top 10 for passing plays of 20+, 30+, 40+, 50+, 60+ and 70+.

KALANI SITAKE HEAD COACH YEARS AT BYU 5th year at BYU YEARS OVERALL 5th year as head coach, 20 years in coaching

Kalani Sitake (pronounced kah-lah-nee see-tah-kay) enters his fourth season overseeing the BYU football program in 2020.

A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake is the 14th head coach in BYU history and just the fourth since 1972. when Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards took over the program. Sitake is the first former player under Edwards to be named head coach at BYU.

Named BYU's head coach on December 19, 2015. Sitake returned to his alma mater with 15 years of coaching experience, including seven seasons a defensive coordinator and four years as an assistant head coach. He came to BYU from Oregon State, where he served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator in 2015 under head coach Gary Andersen. Sitake spent the prior 10 seasons at the University of Utah under head coach Kyle Whittingham. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012. He coached 12 all-conference honorees at Utah, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014).

During his career, Sitake has helped mentor 23 NFL Draft picks, including BYU linebackers Sione Takitaki and Fred Warner and running back Jamaal Williams. Takitaki was a third-round pick of the Cleveland Browns in this year's draft and Warner was one of the league's top rookies after being taken in the third round in 2018 by the San Francisco 49ers. Williams, who was selected in the fourth round by the Green Bay Packers in the 2017 NFL Draft, finished his BYU career as the school's all-time leading rusher

after averaging the nation's fifth-best per-game totals at 137.5 yards per outing for Sitake's Cougars in 2016.

Sitake has coached in 11 bowl games during his career and has been on the winning side in nine of those 11 contests, including a 2-1 mark as a head coach. BYU is coming off an appearance in the 2019 Hawai'i Bowl vs. the Rainbow Warriors.

Sitake began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002 under Gary Crowton. Sitake then joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.

He began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards. A team captain as a senior, Sitake's last game as a player was also the last game coached by the legendary Edwards, who was a great mentor for Sitake.

Born in Nuku'alofa, Tonga, and raised in Laie, Hawai'i and Provo, Utah, Sitake is the nation's first FBS head football coach of Tongan descent. He graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. Sitake and his wife Timberly have three children, Skye, Sadie and Kelaokalani (KK).
