GAME STORYLINES

- **THE SERIES.** BYU and Boise State are playing for the ninth time. The Cougars trail in the series 2-6 and have never won on the blue turf in Boise (0-4). The last time the two teams met, the Broncos won 24-7 in Provo in 2017. The last time BYU played in Boise, the Boise State edged the Cougars 28-27 in 2016.
- **MOUNTAIN WEST.** This is the third team from the Mountain West Conference BYU is facing this season. The Cougars have already played Utah State and Hawai'i, splitting the two games against MW foes. BYU competed in the Mountain West as a member from the inaugural season in 1999 until 2010. The Cougars won the title four times and finished third or better in 10 of 12 seasons as a member of the league.
- **ALMA MATER COACHES.** Both head coaches in the matchup are coaching at their respective alma mater. Bryan Harsin played quarterback at Boise State from 1995-99, while Kalani Sitake was a fullback at BYU in 1994, 97-2000. BYU is 3-1 this season against teams with head coaches at their alma maters with wins over Wisconsin (Paul Chryst), McNeese (Lance Guidry), Hawai'i (Nick Rolovich) and a loss to Utah State (Matt Wells).
- **100 GAMES IN INDEPENDENCE.** BYU's game against Boise State marks the 100th game as an independent program. The Cougars played their first season as an independent in 2011 after leaving the Mountain West. Since going it alone, BYU has compiled a 60-39 record and has played teams from more than two dozen states. The Cougars have also defeated at least one team from each of the Power 5 conferences. Of the 100 games, 38 have been against Power 5 opponents.
- **YOUNG GUNS.** BYU has played 25 freshmen this season, including 15 true freshmen. There have been 11 freshmen that have started games for the Cougars, including five true freshmen. Against Hawai'i, BYU started seven freshmen, including six on offense. Only Minnesota has started more freshmen on offense in a game (7). Freshmen have accounted for just over half of BYU's total scoring this year (95 of 182 total points – 52.2 percent).

Coach Sitake and select players will be available following the NCAA mandatory cooling off period. Members of the media are invited to move from the press box down to the field and to the press room four minutes prior to the ending of the game. A basic transcript of Sitake's comments from the postgame press conference will be provided with additional player quotes upon availability. For road games, BYU will conduct interviews outside the locker room or in a location designated by the host school.

RYPIEN'S FIVE TOUCHDOWN PASSES LEADS BRONCOS TO VICTORY AT AIR FORCE

AIR FORCE ACADEMY, Colo. — Brett Rypien threw for five touchdowns — three of them to John Hightower — and Boise State pulled away late to beat Air Force 48-38 on Saturday night.

Rypien completed 20 of 34 passes for 399 yards with touchdowns of 61, 44 and 18 yards to Hightower, 21 yards to A.J. Richardson and 35 yards to C.T. Thomas. It was his fifth 300-yard passing game of the season and 20th of his career, most in school history.

Hightower finished with eight catches for 182 yards and Sean Modster had 6 receptions for 101 yards for Boise State (6-2, 4-1 Mountain West), which won for the first time in three trips to Air Force (3-5, 1-4). Boise State's Alexander Mattison ran 22 times for 136 yards and a touchdown.

Haden Hoggarth's second field goal, a 47-yarder with 12:14 remaining, restored a 10-point lead for the Broncos. But Air Force again came back, driving nearly the length of the field before Sanders shoveled a 5-yard pass to Kadin Remsberg for a touchdown, pulling the Falcons to within three points with 5:24 remaining.

It didn't take long for Boise State to answer. Hightower shot past cornerback Zane Lewis' press coverage near the line of scrimmage and sprinted into the clear along the right sideline. Rypien spotted him, threw downfield and Hightower caught it on the run to complete the 61-yard score with 3:21 to go.

Air Force failed to convert a fourth down near midfield and Boise State ran out the clock to secure the victory.

The Broncos took a 38-31 lead into the fourth quarter, getting a 30-yard field goal from Hoggarth and a 1-yard touchdown run by Mattison that was set up by Avery Williams' 67-yard punt return to the Falcons' 5-yard line. Air Force squeezed in a 30-yard field goal by Jake Koehnke.

Rypien threw his fourth touchdown pass of the game to Thomas with five seconds left in the second quarter, allowing the Broncos to pull into a 28-all tie in a wild first half that saw the teams taking turns zipping down the field.

The Broncos broke on top with two quick first quarter scoring strikes from Rypien to Hightower around Air Force's first touchdown, a 17-yard burst up the middle by fullback Cole Fagan.

The Falcons finished off a 21-point second quarter with Sanders' 5-yard touchdown run and halfback Joseph Saucier's 32-yard touchdown pass to wide receiver Andrew Smith that pushed Air Force briefly in front 28-21.

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR EIGHT

The 12-game independent schedule for 2018 features eight teams that played in a bowl game in 2017. Four games are against Pac-12 opponents. BYU also takes on likely top-10 opponent Wisconsin on the road and features games against Mountain West foes Utah State, Boise State and Hawai'i. Independents UMass and New Mexico State also appear on the schedule along with Mid-American favorite Northern Illinois and FCS power McNeese State.

The Cougars will host six home games including Cal, McNeese State, Utah State, Hawai'i, Northern Illinois and New Mexico State. BYU is on the road against Arizona, Wisconsin, Washington, Boise State, UMass (Gillette Stadium) and Utah in Salt Lake City.



BOWLING OPPONENTS

Of BYU's 12 opponents in 2018, eight played in a bowl game last year: Utah State, Northern Illinois, New Mexico State, Arizona, Wisconsin, Washington, Boise State and Utah.

BYU VS. POWER 5 TEAMS

BYU has the most wins (25) over Power 5 teams by a non-Power 5 opponent school since 2003. BYU had a streak of 11 consecutive seasons with at least one win over a Power 5 team snapped last season. Navy is No. 2 at 24.

TEAM CAPTAINS

BYU will have eight captains for the 2018 season, with four on offense and four on defense. The captains will rotate for the coin toss.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's winning percentage at LaVell Edwards Stadium is ranked No. 14 among teams playing in their current stadium.

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates more than 400 missions around the world in over 150 nations speaking more than 160 languages. More than 67,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours — seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples) — teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

About 65 percent of the current team has served a mission. Members of the team have served in 28 different countries and six of the seven continents around the globe. More than 30 members of the team (previous signees or on roster) are currently serving in the mission field.

POLYNESIAN PIPELINE

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recruiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. About 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now, several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff.

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA. His staff includes Polynesians Ilaisa Tuiaki, Fesi Sitake, Nu'u Tafisi, Jack Damuni, Jasen Ah You, Alema Fitiseanu, Vince Feula, Matt Ah You and Harvey Unga.

BYU LOSES DEFENSIVE BATTLE 7-6 TO NIU

PROVO, Utah – BYU held Northern Illinois to just 204 total yards but it wasn't enough as the Cougars fell to the Huskies, 7-6, at LaVell Edwards Stadium Saturday.

BYU possessed the ball for nearly 35 of the 60 total minutes in the game, and put in 301 total yards, but were unable to score a touchdown for the first time since last year's game against Wisconsin. Freshman kicker Skyler Southam converted two of his three field goal attempts as BYU's only scorer on the day.

Quarterback Zach Wilson accounted for 215 of the Cougars 301 yards, with 208 in the air and seven on the ground, including a highlight hurdle over a Huskie defender. Sophomore tight end Matt Bushman led all receivers with 63 yards, averaging 21 yards per catch on three catches. Talon Shumway was the only other Cougar to go for over 50 receiving yards with 52, including a game-long 42-yard catch.

On the defensive side, Sione Takitaki led the way with 11 total tackles, eight of which were solo, with one sack. Isaiah Kaufusi and Dayan Ghankwoloku each had two tackles for loss, and Corbin Kaufusi and Khyiris Tonga shared the Cougars' other sack in the game.

BYU started the game with a 36-yard kickoff return by Tyler Allgeier, but then went three-and-out on the opening drive. The Cougar defense forced the Huskies to punt on their first drive, putting the ball back in BYU's hands with 9:36 remaining in the quarter. Two penalties on NIU brought BYU across the 50-yard line, but an incompletion to Gunner Romney brought up fourth down for the Cougars. BYU went for it and Wilson completed a pass to Micah Simon for a first down. Skyler Southam then converted a 35-yard field goal attempt to open the scoring and put the Cougars up 3-0 late in the first quarter.

Wilson threw a 28-yard pass to Bushman to start the BYU drive. The Cougars then went for it on fourth down and were unable to convert. NIU went for its own fourth down on its following drive as well, but were flagged for a false start and forced to punt with 9:26 left in the half. The teams were a combined 0 for 9 on third down conversions to that point.

BYU opened the following drive with two passes to Bushman and Holker for 16 and 12 yards, respectively. Wilson was sacked on the following play and the Cougars once again punted after failing to convert on a third-down pass to Gunner Romney. The Huskies had a chance to score on their following drive, but missed a 41-yard field goal attempt that would have tied the game.

NIU marched the ball 65 yards down the field in the opening minutes of the second half to score the first touchdown of the game and go up 7-3 on the Cougars. Wilson got sacked for the second time in the Cougars' opening drive of the half, but a 54-yard punt by Rhett Almond put NIU's offense in a tough position on its own one-yard line. BYU's defense held NIU to a three-and-out, putting the ball back in the offense's hands.

Wilson completed his longest pass of the game to Talon Shumway for a 42-yard gain, putting the Cougars on the 17-yard line, the closest they had been to the end-zone all game. Wilson then got the highlight play of the game with a hurdle over a Huskie defender for a first down on the five-yard line. Southam hit his second field goal of the game to pull BYU within one, 7-6, with 3:31 left in the third quarter.

Wilson opened the fourth quarter with back-to-back passes to Micah Simon and Akile Davis, for 14 and 13 yards. Matt Hadley broke away for 13 yards to convert the third down and put the Cougars on the NIU 29-yard line. Southam's longest field goal attempt of the year from 51 yards out went just right of the uprights, keeping the score at 7-6 in favor of the Huskies.

The Cougars began the following drive on their own one-yard line, with Squally Canada running for 14 quick yards to give them some breathing room. A 19-yard pass to Bushman gave the Cougars a first down and brought them up to their own 40-yard line. A couple of incomplete passes brought up a 4th down on the BYU 46-yard line, which BYU elected to punt on. The BYU defense held NIU to a three-and-out, but Wilson threw his first interception of the game on the first play of the next drive to give the Huskies the ball back. NIU ran the clock out, holding the Cougars to their lowest point total all season and bringing their record to 4-4.

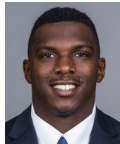

THE BYU OFFENSE

- **COACHING EXPERIENCE.** The BYU offensive staff has more than 80 years of coaching experience. Jeff Grimes has the most with about 25 years. Tight ends coach Steve Clark has been coaching since 1994 and passing game coordinator Aaron Roderick is approaching 20 years in the profession. Roderick, Clark and wide receivers coach Fesi Sitake have all been offensive coordinators at the college level.
- **FROSH SCORES.** With a dozen freshmen seeing playing time on offense, BYU has gotten touchdowns out of four different freshmen, including all four getting into the end zone against Hawaii. Lopini Katoa leads with five total touchdowns, Gunner Romney has two, Dallin Holker has one while Zach Wilson has one rushing touchdown to go along with his four passing touchdowns. Including freshman kicker Skyler Southam, three of BYU's top four scorers are freshmen. Including Southam, freshmen have accounted for just over half of the Cougars' total points this season (95 of 182 – 52.2 percent).
- **MID-RANGE GAME.** BYU is outscoring its opponents in both the second and third quarters this season. The Cougars have a 62-41 edge in the second quarter and 57-56 in the third frame.

Kalani Sitake (pronounced kah-lah-nee see-tah-kay) was named head coach overseeing the BYU football program on December 19, 2015, by director of athletics Tom Holmoe.

Sitake is the 14th head coach in BYU history. He came to BYU from Oregon State, where he served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator.

A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake returned to his alma mater with 15 years of coaching experience, including seven years a defensive coordinator and four seasons as an assistant head coach. He enters his 18th season overall in 2018.

Prior to serving as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator at Oregon State in 2015, Sitake spent 10 seasons at the University of Utah. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012.

Sitake coached several Pac-12 and Mountain West Conference honorees, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014). He also helped 14 players who became NFL Draft picks during his time at Utah, coaching 12 all-league players and three freshmen All-Americans. He helped the Utes win seven of eight bowl games during his tenure.

During his career, Sitake has helped mentor 16 NFL Draft picks, including BYU linebacker Fred Warner, drafted in the third round in 2018 by the San Francisco 49ers, and running back Jamaal Williams, who was selected in the fourth round by the Green Bay Packers in the 2017 NFL Draft. Williams finished his BYU career as the school's all-time leading rusher after averaging the nation's fifth-best per-game totals at 137.5 yards per outing for Sitake's Cougars in 2016.

Sitake began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002. Sitake then joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.

Born in Nuku'alofa, Tonga, and raised in Laie, Hawai'i and Provo, Utah, Sitake becomes the first FBS head football coach of Tongan descent. He is just the fourth BYU head coach to guide the program since 1972, when Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards took over the program. He is the first former player under Edwards to be named head coach at BYU.

Sitake began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards.

He was named BYU's Football Scholar Athlete of the Year in 1998, Impact Player of the Year in 1999, along with team captain and the most valuable running back in 2000. He signed a free agent contract with the Cincinnati Bengals in 2001, but was forced to retire due to an injury.

Sitake graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. He and his wife Timberly have three children, Skye, Sadie and Kelaokalani (KK).

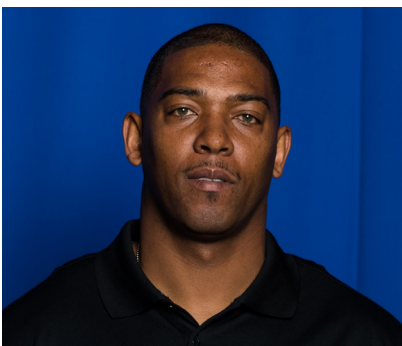
