- SERIES NOTES. BYU and Boise State signed to play a home-and-home series every year through 2023 back in 2012. In the five games since 2012, the home team has won every season, with Boise State holding a 3-2 advantage in that timespan and a 5-2 edge in the overall series. Every game but one in the series (2015) has been played on a Thursday or Friday night.
- FRIDAY NIGHT LIGHTS. BYU is playing its second of three Friday night matchups this season. The first was last week against Utah State and the last is Nov. 10 at UNLV. Last season, BYU went 2-0 in Friday night games, defeating Toledo 55-53 and Mississippi State 28-21 in double overtime. The Cougars had won five consecutive Friday games until last week
- **HOMECOMING.** This week is BYU's Homecoming week. Last season, the Cougars defeated Mississippi State 28-21 in double overtime on Homecoming night. The week is packed full of festivities on campus, including Friday night's game against the Broncos. Visit www.homecoming.byu.edu for more information.
- TEAMS COMING OFF A BYE. Boise State is the first of two consecutive games, and one of three games this season, where BYU will face a team that is coming off of a bye week The Broncos had last week off and BYU's next opponent, Mississippi State has a bye this week. BYU also hosts San Jose State later this season after the Spartans are coming off of their bye. The Cougars were in a similar situation in 2016 and went 2-1 against teams coming off of bye weeks (West Virginia, Toledo, UMass).
- ALMA MATER COACHES. For the third time in as many games for the Cougars, both head coaches in the
 matchup are coaching at their respective alma mater. Bryan Harsin played quarterback for the Broncos from 199599 while Kalani Sitake was a fullback at BYU in 1994, 97-2000. Harsin and Sitake are among 22 FBS head coaches
 coaching at their alma mater.
- HONORING LAVELL. Legendary hall of famer and beloved head coach at BYU for 29 seasons, LaVell Edwards, passed away on Dec. 29, 2016. The always steady and humble coach will be honored in several ways throughout the season, including the team wearing a uniform patch featuring his classic stoic profile he displayed for decades on the Cougar sidelines.

BRONCOS FALL TO VIRGINIA, 42-23

BOISE, Idaho (AP)- After losing 20 of its last 21 road games coming in, Virginia had a festive vibe in its locker room following a 42-23 dismantling of Boise State on Friday night with plenty of players excited about the 2,400-mile flight home.

"It's going to be a fun trip back," Virginia quarterback Kurt Benkert said, whose team was a 14-point underdog. "We see what people say, and it's expected after what kind of season we had last year. But we know what we're capable of and how much better we are.

"Now, people have to take us seriously. We're building momentum now, and we're excited to see how it plays out."

Benkert threw for 273 yards and three touchdowns as the Cavaliers handed Boise State its worst home loss since 2001.

Virginia (3-1) notched its first win west of the Mississippi River since 1991 when it beat BYU 45-40. In avenging an embarrassing 56-14 loss to Boise State in 2015, the Cavaliers also surpassed their win total from last season.

Boise State (2-2) hasn't suffered a double-digit loss at home since the 2001 season.

"There's gonna be some changes," said Boise State coach Bryan Harsin, whose team is 5-5 in its last 10 games. "What they are, I don't know yet. But we need to fix the consistency of our entire team in all three phases. It can't just be about one side.

"Good football teams play together, play off each other, and help all sides of the ball in one way or another. And that just didn't happen tonight."

While this was Virginia's first trip to Boise, second-year coach Bronco Mendenhall faced the Broncos on the road twice while coaching BYU, losing both times.

This time, it was different.

After surrendering an 80-yard scoring drive to open the game, Virginia took control by ripping off 21 straight points.

The momentum shifted on a botched play by Boise State's special teams, a long-time signature strength of the Broncos. Trailing 14-7 late in the first half, Boise State attempted a fake punt from its own 40, but Alec Dhaenens fumbled the direct snap and fell on it at the 33. Two plays later, Benkert hit Doni Dowling on a 27-yard scoring strike to push the Virginia lead to 14 points.

Boise State rallied with a quick touchdown before halftime, but Virginia took the opening drive of the second half 75 yards, on three plays, capped by a 64-yard touchdown pass from Benkert to Andre Levrone.

And the Cavaliers never looked back.

Brett Rypien, who returned to action after suffering a concussion against Washington State, threw for 353 yards and one interception for Boise State.

Virginia's defense held Boise State to just 30 yards rushing, while the Cavaliers' offense rolled up 167 yards on the ground.

With a trio of scoring strikes, Benkert moved into fifth among Virginia career touchdown passing leaders with 31.

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR SEVEN

The 13-game independent schedule features teams from six different conferences and an independent team. Four games are against Power Five opponents, including teams from the Pac-12, Big Ten and SEC. The opponents on the 2017 features six bowl teams from 2016

The Cougars will host six home games and have six true road contests with one neutral site game at a NFL stadium. The home schedule consists of Portland State, Utah, Wisconsin, Boise State, San Jose State and UMass. The season's single neutral site game against LSU will be played at NRG Stadium, home of the Houston Texans.



BOWLING OPPONENTS

Of BYU's 13 opponents in 2016, six played in a bowl game last year: LSU, Utah, Wisconsin, Boise State, Mississippi State and Hawai'i.

RVII VS. POWFR 5 TFAMS

BYU is tied for the most wins (23) over Power 5 opponents by a non-Power 5 school since 2003. The Cougars also have the longest streak among non-Power 5 teams with 11 consecutive seasons with at least one win over a Power 5 opponent.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's record at LaVell Edwards Stadium is ranked No. 12 among teams playing in their current stadium.

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates missions around the world in 150 nations speaking more than 160 languages. More than 70,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions in 422 missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours - seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples) — teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

About 64 percent of the current team has served an LDS mission. Members of the team have served in 28 different countries and six of the seven continents around the globe. BYU currently has about 30 members of the team (previous signees or on roster) that are currently serving in the mission field.

HONOR CODE

BYU's Honor Code helps maintain this learning environment. Initiated by students in 1949, the Honor Code emphasizes being honest, living a chaste and virtuous life, abstaining from alcohol and tobacco, using clean language, and following other values in line with the doctrines of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints.

POLYNESIAN PIPELINE

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recuiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. More than 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now, several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff.

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA. His staff includes Polynesians Ilaisa Tuiaki, Steve Kaufusi, Reno Mahe, Nu'u Tafisi, Russell Tialavea, Tevita Ofahengaue, Jack Damuni, Jasen Ah You, Sione Kinikini, Vince Feula and Harvey Unga.

FORMER PLAYERS ON STAFF

There are 20 former BYU football players on the football and athletic admnistration staff. Members of the staff were part of Cougar teams that won the 1980 "Miracle Bowl," the 1984 National Championship, Heisman Trophy, 1996 Cotton Bowl along with many other accolades. BYU OVERPOWERED IN 40-6 LOSS TO WISCONSIN

LOGAN, Utah — Plagued by turnovers, BYU fell to Utah State 40-24 Friday night at Maverik Stadium. The Cougars had a season-high 210 rushing yards but couldn't overcome seven turnovers. Running back Ula Tolutau recorded his first career 100-yard rushing game with 102 yards on 21 carries.

Beau Hoge completed 5 of 9 for 95 yards and two touchdowns. Koy Detmer Jr. came in midway through the second quarter and was 7 of 20 for 91 yards. Beau Tanner and Jonah Trinnaman led BYU receivers with 40 and 39 yards, respectively. The team had a season-high four sacks. Zayne Anderson and Sione Takitaki led the Cougars with nine tackles apiece, and Takitaki had 1.5 tackles for loss. Dayan Ghanwoloku and Fred Warner both added eight tackles. Warner also had a career-high three tackles for loss.

The Aggies scored on their opening drive, marching 75 yards down the field on nine plays. Dax Raymond caught a 32-yard touchdown pass from quarterback Kent Myers. Dominik Eberle connected on the PAT to put Utah State up 7-0 four minutes into the game.

Micah Hannemann recorded the Cougars' first pick-six of the season and the first of his career, returning it 46 yards with 9:08 left in the quarter. It was his fourth career interception and a career-long interception as well. Rhett Almond's PAT evened the score 7-7.

BYU started off the second quarter with a trick play. Austin Kafentzis took a direct snap and tossed it to Micah Simon, who handed it to Hoge. Hoge then completed a pass to Brayden El-Bakri at the 10-yard line and he took it into the end zone for the 26-yard touchdown. It marked El-Bakri's first career receiving touchdown and the second score of his career. The play put the Cougars up 14-7 nine seconds into the quarter.

After the Cougar defense forced the Aggies to punt, Hoge capped a three-play, 55-yard, 53-second drive by connecting with Beau Tanner on a 40-yard touchdown pass. The scoring play was initially ruled incomplete but a reviewed showed that Tanner got one foot down in the end zone before going out of bounds. Following the PAT, BYU took a 21-7 lead.

Utah State had a pick-six of its own as Jalen Davis grabbed the ball after it bounced off the shoulder pad of a teammate. The score came with 11:02 left in the quarter and closed the gap to 21-14.

The Aggies found the end zone a third time as Myers threw a 26-yard pass to Ron'quavion Tarver, tying the game 21-21 just before halftime. Utah State intercepted the ball less than a minute later, resulting in a 32-yard field goal to give the Aggies their first lead of the night, 24-21.

Utah State recovered a BYU fumble early in the third quarter en route to a 40-yard field goal to extend its advantage, 27-21. Moments into the fourth quarter, Myers ran 19 yards into the end zone, putting the Aggies up 33-21. They attempted a two-point conversion but the Cougars held firm.

Detmer connected with Jonah Trinnaman on a 39-yard pass to set up a 37-yard field goal from Almond with 12:28 on the clock for a score of 33-24.

Utah State had its second pick-six of the night at the 50-yard line with three minutes left for a final score of 40-24.

THE BYU OFFENSE

- YOUNG GUNS. After graduating several playmakers in 2016, a new crop of youngsters will look to make an impact in 2017. As many as 17 underclassmen are part of the two-deep on the offensive side of the ball, including six true freshman. BYU's first touchdown of the year was scored by freshman Neil Pau'u while freshman tight end Matt Bushman leads BYU in yards with 16 receptions and 181 yards and freshman Ula Toluta'u leads in rushing with 40 carries for 188 yards.
- **BEAU TO BEAU.** In one of the offensive highlight plays this season, quarterback Beau Hoge tossed a 40-yard touchdown to Beau Tanner against Utah State. Tanner leaped into the end zone and managed to touch his leg down just inbounds for the score. It led off the top plays on ESPN's SportsCenter that evening.
- REDSHIRTS COMING OFF. Several talented players redshirted the 2016 season, including some that saw time in 2015 as true freshmen. Receivers Akile Davis and Micah Simon return after seeing time in 2015, as does running back Trey Dye. A talented group of offensive linemen who spent the 2016 season returning to shape after LDS missions include Kieffer Longson, Austin Chambers and Chandon Herring. All of them are expected to contribute in 2017 and most of them saw their first game action against Portland State in game one.

BYU kept Utah to just one touchdown and four field goals on seven Blue Zone scoring opportunities.

The Cougars has a season-best four sacks against Utah State. It was the first time BYU has had at least four sacks since UMass last year.

BYU's defensive leader, Fred Warner, is averaging 8.2 tackles per game. The senior captain upped his average from last year at 6.6 tackles per game.

The Cougars have allowed teams to convert fourth downs just 40 percent of the time, ranking No. 34 nationally.

Defensive back Micah Hannemann recorded his first career pick-six against Utah State on a 46-yard return. It was his fourth career interception and first this season.

THE BYU DEFENSE

- STARTING EXPERIENCE. Most of the projected defensive starters saw action last year and return for the 2017 season. Additionally, three freshman have earned second- or third-string spots.
- WARNER BROS. Fred and Troy Warner combined for 17 total tackles against LSU, with a career-high nine for Troy and eight for Fred. The older brother, Fred, led the team with 86 total tackles in 2016 and currently leads this year as well after totaling 41 tackles with 23 solo stops. Fred also recorded both a forced fumble and fumble recovery against Utah. Both brothers are also tied for No. 20 nationally in fumbles recovered with one apiece.
- TAKITAKI TIME. In his first game since October 16, 2016 (Cincinnati), Sione Takitaki had seven tackles, three tackles for loss and two sacks against Portland State. He set a new career high in tackles for loss and tied his career record in sacks. Takitaki added eight more tackles in the following two games.
- CHANGE OF NAME. Known as Dayan Lake his freshman year, Dayan now goes by the last name of "Ghanwoloku" to honor his uncle and father's family from Liberia.

Kalani Sitake (pronounced kah-lah-nee see-tah-kay) was named head coach overseeing the BYU football program on December 19, 2015, by director of athletics Tom Holmoe.


Sitake is the 14th head coach in BYU history. He comes to BYU from Oregon State, where he served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator.

A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake returns to his alma mater with 15 years of coaching experience, including seven years a defensive coordinator and four seasons as an assistant head coach.

Prior to serving as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator at Oregon State in 2015, Sitake spent 10 seasons at the University of Utah. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012.

Sitake has coached several Pac-12 and Mountain West Conference honorees, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014). He also helped mentor 14 NFL Draft picks during his time at Utah, including 12 all-league players and three freshmen All-Americans. He helped the Utes win seven of eight bowl games during his tenure.

Sitake began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002. Sitake then joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.



Sitake began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards.

He was named BYU's Football Scholar Athlete of the Year in 1998, Impact Player of the Year in 1999, along with team captain and the most valuable running back in 2000. He signed a free agent contract with the Cincinnati Bengals in 2001, but was forced to retire due to an injury.

Sitake graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. He and his wife Timberly have three children, Skye, Sadie and Kelaokalani (KK).
