## BYU STORYLINES

- For the second-straight game, senior guard Jake Toolson eclipsed his BYU career high, scoring 22 points in BYU's 68-63 win against Southern Utah. He totaled 13 points in the second half, including key 3-pointer with 34 seconds remaining that put the Cougars ahead by four to hold off the Thunderbirds.
- Senior forward Dalton Nixon had one of his best games as a Cougar, totaling 13 points, 7 rebounds, 3 assists, 1 block and 2 steals against Southern Utah. He also match his career high with a pair of 3-pointers in the first half. Nixon, who made one 3-pointer all of last season, has hit at least one 3 in all three games this season.
- Friday's contest at Houston is BYU's first of five-straight games away from Provo. Following the matchup with the Cougars, BYU plays at Boise State on Nov. 20 and then three games at the Maui Invitational.

BY THE NUMBERS

- 14** BYU has posted a winning on-court record in 14-straight seasons (officially 12 – all but one win in 2015-16 and 2016-17 were vacated by the NCAA). The Cougars won 20-plus games in 13 of those seasons and 19 in the other.
- 37** The number of career double-doubles for Yoeli Childs – tied for third all-time in BYU history. He had five as a freshman, 15 as a sophomore in 2017-18 and 17 as a junior in 2018-19.
- 104** TJ Haws has started every game of his BYU career, giving him 104-consecutive starts, the fifth-longest streak in BYU history. Jeff Chatman holds the school record at 122.
- 882** Yoeli Childs is fifth all-time in career rebounds at BYU. The record of 1,047 is held by Kyle Collinworth.
- 1,490** The number of career points for senior guard TJ Haws. Haws is currently 19th all-time in BYU history.
- 1,609** The number of career points for senior forward Yoeli Childs. Childs is currently 14th all-time in BYU history.

HOOPS HALL AWARDS: KARL MALONE CANDIDATE

For the second-straight season, the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame has named BYU forward Yoeli Childs to its preseason watch list for the Karl Malone Power Forward of the Year Award. Named after Class of 2010 Hall of Famer and two-time NBA Most Valuable Player Karl Malone, the annual honor in its sixth year recognizes the top power forwards in Division I men's college basketball. A national committee of top college basketball personnel determined the watch list of 20 candidates.

CHILDS NAMED TO WOODEN AWARD PRESEASON TOP 50

BYU senior forward Yoeli Childs has been named to the Preseason Top 50 Watch for the The John R. Wooden Award®, presented by Wendy's®. Chosen by a preseason poll of national college basketball experts, the list is comprised of 50 student-athletes who are the early front-runners for the most prestigious honors in college basketball, the Wooden Award All American Team™ and Most Outstanding Player Award.

LAST TIME VS. HOUSTON – BYU FALLS TO HOUSTON, 11/24/18

PROVO, Utah – TJ Haws scored a season-high 25 points as BYU fell to Houston 76-62 Saturday afternoon in the Marriott Center to close out the Men Against Breast Cancer Cougar Cup.

BYU called an early timeout after falling to a 9-4 deficit. Out of the timeout, Childs made a couple buckets to lead a run that put BYU up 13-12. Six-straight Houston points put the visitors up 18-13 with 11:10 left in the first half. A pair of Haws 3-pointers kept it close, but BYU trailed 26-21 with 8:00 on the clock.

A couple minutes later, Haws hit a 3 to bring BYU within two points. After a Houston turnover, Childs threw down a transition dunk to tie the game at 28-28.

BYU went cold for the remainder of the half, knocking down just one more shot and one free throw. At the half, Houston led 37-32. Haws and Childs had 14 and 11 points, respectively.

Early in the second half, Houston went on a 15-3 run to lead by a game-high 15 points at 52-37 with just under 13 minutes left. At the 10-minute mark, BYU trailed 61-42.

**NOTES AND STORYLINES**

**First-year coaches**

Mark Pope is the 19th head coach in BYU history. He comes to Provo after four seasons at Utah Valley in Orem where he led the Wolverines to 77 wins, three-straight postseason bids and back-to-back 20-win seasons. Of the previous 18 head coaches, four opened their BYU coaching tenure with 20-plus wins in their first season, including G. Ott Romney (20-10 in 1928-29), Stan Watts (22-12 in 1949-50), Roger Reid (21-9 in 1989-90) and Dave Rose (20-9 in 2005-06). Floyd Millet had the best win percentage by a Cougar coach in his first season\* at .850 (17-3 in 1941-42). BYU opened the Pope era with a 76-58 win over Cal State Fullerton. Other coaches who won their first games at the helm include C.T. Teetzel in 1905, Henry Rose in 1910, E.L. Roberts in 1911, Edwin R. Kimball in 1935, Fred 'Buck' Dixon in 1936, Floyd Millet in 1941, Stan Watts in 1949, Glenn Potter in 1972, Roger Reid in 1989 and Steve Cleveland in 1997.

**Childs and Haws in the BYU record book**

Seniors Yoeli Childs and TJ Haws have etched their names throughout the BYU men's basketball record book. Childs is 14th all-time in scoring (1,609 points), ninth in field goals made (626), fifth in rebounds (882) and fifth in blocks (142). Haws is 19th all-time in scoring (1,490 points), sixth in 3-point field goals made (186), 16th in made free throws (352), seventh in free-throw percentage (82.8%), ninth in assists (427) and 15th in steals (120).

**Jake Toolson 180 shooter**

The addition of senior Jake Toolson, the 2018-19 WAC Player of the Year, gives BYU one of the most efficient shooters in the country. Last season, he was one of only seven players in the country per Ken Pomeroy who was a 180 shooter (FG%+3PT%+FT%=180-plus) with a minimum 100 free-throw and 100 3-point field goal attempts. Toolson shot 53.7 percent from the field, 44.8 percent from 3-point range and 85.1 percent from the free-throw line. See below for a list of all seven 180 shooters from 2018-19.

BYU has three players on its roster with 1,000 career points, including two in the top 20 on the BYU career scoring list. Yoeli Childs is 14th all-time with 1,609 points and a career average of 16.1 points per game. TJ Haws is 19th on the list with 1,480 points and a 14.3 career scoring average. Utah Valley transfer and 2019 WAC Player of the Year Jake Toolson has scored 1,053 career points, including 905 in his two seasons with the Wolverines.
