## BYU STORYLINES

- Senior guard TJ Haws hit 9 of 15 from the field for 23 points and added five assists in BYU's win over Saint Mary's. Haws came alive in the second half, hitting 7 of 8 from the field for 17 points. Trailing 79-78, the Cougars took possession of the ball with 20 seconds remaining. Haws came off a screen at the top of the key and hit a 3 with 8.6 seconds remaining to put his team ahead for good.
- BYU has shot 50.0 percent or better in seven-straight games, tied for the second-longest single-season streak in team history. The record of nine games was set at the end of the 1988-89 season.
- With BYU's win over Saint Mary's, the Cougars are now tied with the Gaels for second in the West Coast Conference standings at 6-3 behind Gonzaga (9-0). It is a tight race behind BYU and Saint Mary's with four teams tied at 5-4.

BY THE NUMBERS

**6** The number of consecutive games BYU made 10-plus 3-pointers (11/27 to 12/14), a school record for consecutive games with double-digit 3s. The previous record was three games.

**12** The number of games BYU has made double-digit 3-pointers this season. Only one Cougar team made double-digit 3s in more games. The record of 13 games was set in 2015-16, the 2010-11 and 2014-15 teams also reached the mark 12 times and the 2007-08 team made 10-plus 3s 11 times.

**14** BYU has posted a winning on-court record in 14-straight seasons (officially 12 – all but one win in 2015-16 and 2016-17 were vacated by the NCAA). The Cougars won 20-plus games in 13 of those seasons and 19 in the other.

**41** The number of career double-doubles for Yoeli Childs – tied for second all-time in BYU history. He had five as a freshman, 15 as a sophomore in 2017-18, 17 as a junior in 2018-19 and four this season.

**80.0** BYU's first half shooting percentage against Weber State (20 of 25), a school record for a first half. Yoeli Childs made 10 of 10 in the first half, a school record for field goals without a miss in the first half and tied for the most in either half.

**125** TJ Haws has started every game of his BYU career, giving him 125-consecutive starts – the longest streak in BYU history. He passed Jeff Chatman, who started 122-straight games.

**981** Yoeli Childs is second all-time in career rebounds at BYU. The record of 1,047 is held by Kyle Collinsworth.

**1,788** The number of career points for senior guard TJ Haws. Haws is currently 10th all-time in BYU history.

**1,840** The number of career points for senior forward Yoeli Childs. Childs is currently eighth all-time in BYU history.

HOOPS HALL AWARDS: KARL MALONE CANDIDATE

For the second-straight season, the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame has named BYU forward Yoeli Childs to its preseason watch list for the Karl Malone Power Forward of the Year Award. Named after Class of 2010 Hall of Famer and two-time NBA Most Valuable Player Karl Malone, the annual honor in its sixth year recognizes the top power forwards in Division I men's college basketball. A national committee of top college basketball personnel determined the watch list of 20 candidates.

CHILDS NAMED TO WOODEN AWARD PRESEASON TOP 50

BYU senior forward Yoeli Childs has been named to the Preseason Top 50 Watch for the The John R. Wooden Award®, presented by Wendy's®. Chosen by a preseason poll of national college basketball experts, the list is comprised of 50 student-athletes who are the early front-runners for the most prestigious honors in college basketball, the Wooden Award All American Team™ and Most Outstanding Player Award.

HAWS NAMED WCC PLAYER OF THE WEEK – 12/02/19

The West Coast Conference has named BYU senior guard TJ Haws its Men's Basketball Player of the Week for Dec. 2, 2019. Haws led the Cougars to a 3-1 record and a third-place finish at the Maui Jim Maui Invitational while averaging 16.5 points and 4.8 assists and shooting 54.8 percent from the field, 54.2 percent from 3-point range and 77.8 percent from the free-throw line.

CHILDS, HAWS AND TOOLSON NAMED CANDIDATES FOR SENIOR CLASS AWARD

BYU's Yoeli Childs, TJ Haws and Jake Toolson are among the 60 NCAA men's and women's basketball student-athletes who excel both on and off the court and were selected as candidates today for the 2019-20 Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School®, the Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities.

LAST TIME VS. PORTLAND – SELJAAS SHINES IN WIN OVER PILOTS

PROVO, Utah – An aggressive BYU offense led the Cougars to a 96-70 victory over West Coast Conference foe Portland Saturday night in the Marriott Center.

BYU shot 52.1 percent in field goals and 50.0 percent from beyond the arc. Zec Seljaas led all players with 21 points while hitting 5 of 5 from 3-point range. Dalton Nixon and TJ Haws both recorded their first career double-doubles. Nixon scored 14 points and grabbed 11 rebounds while Haws recorded 13 points while dishing out a career-best 14 assists – two off the BYU single-game record. Jake Toolson also scored in double figures, scoring 12 points while tying his season high with eight assists.

The Cougars quickly pulled away at the start of the first half with a 15-0 run going a perfect 6 for 6 from the field with seven points coming from Nixon. Portland scored its first basket five minutes in, bringing the score to 15-2. Seljaas hit 3-pointers on consecutive possessions, extending the BYU lead to 24-2 six minutes into the half.

**NOTES AND STORYLINES**

**First-year coaches**

Mark Pope is the 19th head coach in BYU history. He comes to Provo after four seasons at Utah Valley in Orem where he led the Wolverines to 77 wins, three-straight postseason bids and back-to-back 20-win seasons. Of the previous 18 head coaches, four opened their BYU coaching tenure with 20-plus wins in their first season, including G. Ott Romney (20-10 in 1928-29), Stan Watts (22-12 in 1949-50), Roger Reid (21-9 in 1989-90) and Dave Rose (20-9 in 2005-06). Floyd Millet had the best win percentage by a Cougar coach in his first season\* at .850 (17-3 in 1941-42). BYU opened the Pope era with a 76-58 win over Cal State Fullerton. Other coaches who won their first games at the helm include C.T. Teetzel in 1905, Henry Rose in 1910, E.L. Roberts in 1911, Edwin R. Kimball in 1935, Fred 'Buck' Dixon in 1936, Floyd Millet in 1941, Stan Watts in 1949, Glenn Potter in 1972, Roger Reid in 1989 and Steve Cleveland in 1997.

**Childs and Haws in the BYU record book**

Seniors Yoeli Childs and TJ Haws have etched their names throughout the BYU men's basketball record book. Childs is eighth all-time in scoring (1,840 points), seventh in field goals made (723), second in rebounds (981) and fifth in blocks (154). Haws is 10th all-time in scoring (1,788 points), fourth in 3-point field goals made (229), 10th in free-throw percentage (81.8%), third in assists (541) and eighth in steals (144).

**Jake Toolson 180 shooter**

The addition of senior Jake Toolson, the 2018-19 WAC Player of the Year, gives BYU one of the most efficient shooters in the country. Last season, he was one of only seven players in the country per Ken Pomeroy who was a 180 shooter (FG%+3PT%+FT%=180-plus) with a minimum 100 free-throw and 100 3-point field goal attempts. Toolson shot 53.7 percent from the field, 44.8 percent from 3-point range and 85.1 percent from the free-throw line. See below for a list of all seven 180 shooters from 2018-19.

BYU has three players on its roster with 1,000 career points, including two in the top 15 on the BYU career scoring list. Yoeli Childs is eighth all-time with 1,840 points and a career average of 16.6 points per game. TJ Haws is 10th on the list with 1,788 points and a 14.3 career scoring average. Utah Valley transfer and 2019 WAC Player of the Year Jake Toolson has scored 1,383 career points, including 905 in his two seasons with the Wolverines.
