## BYU STORYLINES

- Sophomore Dalton Nixon had his best game in a Cougar uniform against UT Arlington, post career highs of 15 points and eight rebounds while adding one assist and one steal. Nixon hit 5 of 6 from the field and 5 of 6 from the free-throw line.
- TJ Haws and Zac Seljaas are riding streaks of consecutive games with a 3-point field goal, both dating back to their freshman seasons. Haws has hit a 3 in 19-straight games, the 10th-longest streak in BYU history. Seljaas had drained a trey in 13-straight games.
- BYU has shot 89.8 percent from the free-throw line the last two games, including 92.6 percent (25-27) at Princeton and 86.4 percent vs. UT Arlington.

**THE BASKETBALL HALL OF FAME: HOOPHALL AWARDS**

BYU sophomore guard TJ Haws is a preseason candidate for the 2018 Jeff West Shooting Guard of the Year Award, presented by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Haws earned first-team All-WCC honors in 2016-17 while averaging 13.8 points, 2.9 rebounds, 3.2 assists and 1.0 steal. The Alpine, Utah, native also hit a team-high 76 3-pointers, second all-time among BYU freshmen.

**LAST TIME OUT – BYU FALLS TO UT ARLINGTON**

PROVO, Utah – Despite a career-night from Dalton Nixon, BYU men's basketball fell 89-75 to UT Arlington Saturday night at the Marriott Center.

"UT Arlington is a great team," BYU head coach Dave Rose said. "They were prepared for us. I thought we were in really good shape and ready to go, but they just out-executed us. We had a tough time making shots, especially in the first half. We will learn from it. This was a good test for us."

Nixon led the Cougars with a career-high 15 points to go with a career-high eight boards. Elijah Bryant added 15 points while Yoeli Childs and TJ Haws contributed 12 and 11 points, respectively. Haws also collected a career-high eight assists.

Back-to-back 3-pointers from Bryant and Haws propelled BYU to an early 8-2 lead in the first half. UT Arlington quickly rallied, however, to even the score at 10-all following a long-distance trey from the Mavericks' Erick Neal.

UT Arlington then went on a 9-2 run to take a 19-15 advantage with just under 10 minutes to play in the half.

The streak continued for the Mavericks as they went up 32-17 during more than a five-minute Cougar scoring drought.

A Childs put-back dunk brought BYU back within 12, trailing 37-25, and a three-point play from Bryant kept the Cougars within striking distance to end the half with BYU down 43-28.

Four different Maverick players scored to start the second half as they took a 54-34 advantage, forcing a Cougar timeout at the 15:31 mark.

Zac Seljaas hit a 3-pointer, set up by Haws, which was followed by a Childs dunk to help pace BYU, trailing 67-44.

The Cougars struggled with fouls, in addition to high-percentage shots by UT Arlington, as a dunk extended the

Mavericks' advantage to 25, 75-50.

BYU followed that up with a 6-0 run, with shots by Jahshire Hardnett, Childs and Nixon, to get back within 19, 75-56.

A pair of Peyton Dastrup 3-pointers in the closing minutes made it 86-75, but it wasn't enough as the Mavericks picked up the 89-75 win.

**NOTES AND STORYLINES**

**Super Sophomores**

BYU's 2017-18 roster includes three players who etched their names in the BYU record book during the freshman seasons. Yoeli Childs and TJ Haws were freshmen in 2016-17 while Zac Seljaas was a rookie in 2015-16. All three are back this season, looking to build on their record-setting freshman campaigns. Childs finished his freshman year first all-time among BYU freshmen in rebounds and second in rebounds per game, blocks, blocks per game and field goal percentage.

Haws concluded his first year second all-time among BYU freshmen in 3-point field goals, fourth in points scored, fifth in assists, tied for first in games started and third in double figure scoring games. Seljaas finished the 2015-16 season first all-time among BYU freshmen in 3-point field goal percentage, second in 3-point field goals, second in 3-point field goals per game, second in games with 3-plus 3-point field goals and tied for second most games with 5-plus 3-pointers.

**All-Haws Team**

TJ Haws earned first-team All-WCC honors as a freshman in 2016-17, becoming the third Haws in BYU history to earn all-league honors. His father Marty Haws earned first-team All-WAC honors as a senior in 1989-90 and his brother Tyler was a four-time all-league honoree. As a freshman in 2009-10, Tyler was named to the All-Mountain West Conference Third Team. Following a two-year mission for the LDS Church, Tyler earned first-team honors as a sophomore, junior and senior. In addition to joining his father and brother as an all-conference performer, TJ became the second Cougar in program history – the other being Danny Ainge – to earn first-team all-league honors as a freshman.

**Dave Rose**

BYU head coach Dave Rose has led the Cougars to one of the most successful eras in program history since taking over in 2005. His career record of 307-112 ranks him second in BYU history in total victories and first in winning percentage (.733). Rose has been named conference coach of the year three times, led the Cougars to four conference titles, eight NCAA tournament appearances, four NIT appearances, eight 25-win seasons and 12 20-win seasons.

**BYU and the Postseason**

Under Dave Rose, BYU has reached the postseason in 12-straight seasons, a school record. The previous record was six-straight seasons (1989-90 to 1994-95). During that time the Cougars have earned eight bids to the NCAA tournament and four to the NIT. The Cougars' eight NCAA tournament bids in the last 12 years are more than 200-plus NCAA Division I schools have since beginning their programs.
