- PENN STATE ALL-TIME AT BYU: 5-3** - last matchup April 14, 2012 (L, 2-3); last win March 8, 2003 (3-2)
- COACHING MATCHUP:** Most wins by active coach (Pavlik, 573) vs. highest winning percentage (Olmstead, .759, 88-28)

## QUICK NOTES

- Penn State enters the 2020 season ranked 15th in the AVCA preseason poll, its first ranking in any AVCA poll since 2018 in the March 5th poll when PSU ranked 11th.
- Penn State was chosen second in the 2020 EIVA Preseason Coaches' poll after its runner-up finish in the EIVA Tournament in 2019.
- The Nittany Lions return nine players with starting experience to this year's lineup as well as all four of their All-EIVA award recipients from the 2019 roster.
- Penn State's 2020 schedule pits the Nittany Lions against 10 teams ranked in the AVCA's preseason top 15, including matches against ranked squads in the first six matches to begin the season.
- Coach Mark Pavlik is the winningest active coach in DI-II men's volleyball with 573 wins against just 199 losses.
- The Nittany Lions have won double-digit EIVA matches in the regular season for 20-consecutive seasons.
- Penn State compiled a 10-3 record in 2019 when hitting over .300 in its matches. It also finished the season 13-2 when out-hitting opponents and won all 10 matches when winning the first set.
- Penn State had two individuals gain offseason recognition from Off the Block. Jason Donorovich was a finalist in the 2019 National Player of the Year Fan Vote, while Brett Wildman was named 2019 Player of the Offseason after his international experience with USA Volleyball at the Pan Am Cup and the World University Games.
- Sophomore Brett Wildman had back-to-back 20+ kill performances in the 2019 EIVA Tournament April 18 & 20, becoming first Nittany Lion to have back-to-back 20-kill matches since Aaron Russell Jan. 16-17, 2015 (32 at Ball State, 20 at IPFW).

## HEAD COACH MARK PAVLIK

- » Mark Pavlik holds an overall record of 573-199, good for a .743 winning percentage since the 1995 season.
- » His 573 career wins entering the 2020 season is the most among all active DI-II men's volleyball coaches. Pavlik's record against EIVA opponents sits at an outstanding 247-20 (.925) and includes 14 undefeated seasons in conference.
- » The Nittany Lions have finished in first place in the EIVA standings 22 of the last 25 seasons since Mark Pavlik took over as head coach of the program.
- » Pavlik was named the 2008 AVCA Men's Volleyball Coach of the Year after leading the Nittany Lions to their second NCAA National Championship.
- » Before being named NCAA head coach in 1995, Pavlik was an assistant coach for Tom Peterson and was on the Nittany Lion staff during Penn State's first NCAA National Championship in 1994.
- » Under Pavlik's direction, the Nittany Lions have had at least three players earn All-EIVA honors every season.
- » Pavlik has been named EIVA Coach of the Year a record seven times, with the latest award coming in 2015.

- » The Nittany Lions received 53 points in the poll with Princeton compiling 62 points. George Mason trailed Penn State with 47 while NJIT was also close to the top of the pack with 44 points, including the other first place vote.
- » Princeton recorded seven of the eight first-place votes with NJIT picking up the lone other first-place vote.
- » Coaches were also asked to select two "Players to Watch" from their respective teams. Penn State's selections were redshirt senior Calvin Mende and sophomore Brett Wildman

### Award Winners

- » Penn State had five All-EIVA winners for 2019, four of which are back for 2020:
- » First team: Jason Donorovich
- » Second team: Will Bantle, Henrik Falck Lauten, Matt McLaren (graduated)
- » Honorable mention: Brett Wildman
- » In addition, Wildman was named to the EIVA All-Tournament team for his performance in last season's postseason tournament.
- » Wildman was also named Off the Block's Player of the Offseason for his performances with USA Volleyball at the World University Games and Pan Am Cup this summer.
- » Donorovich was one of four finalists for Off The Block's National Player of the Year Fan Vote.

### Run It Back

- » The Nittany Lions return with much more experience in 2020 with nine players having started at least two matches in 2019. All but one regular starter (Matt McLaren) is back for PSU this season.
- » Penn State has 79.2 percent of its point production back for 2020. All three of Penn State's primary middle blockers are back in the lineup as well as both of the team's primary setters.

### Henrik = Thor

- » Redshirt senior Henrik Falck Lauten led Penn State with 261 kills in 2019 as he emerged onto the DI-II volleyball season as the EIVA's Newcomer of the Year.
- » Falck Lauten had a solid EIVA Tournament with 25 kills and 16 digs in two matches, providing energy and flexibility for the Nittany Lions' lineup.
- » He set a career high with 18 kills while swinging .538 (18-4-26) against NJIT 3/2.
- » He had 14 matches of double-digit kills in 2019 and led the Nittany Lions in kills ten times, the most on the team.
- » Falck Lauten was named EIVA Defensive Player of the Week 3/25 after a team-best eight dig outing to pair with 10 kills 3/19 vs. Ohio State.

- » He hit .500 (9-2-14) in Penn State's 3-0 win over McKendree 1/25.
- » Falck Lauten recorded Penn State's first double-double of 2019 with 11 kills and a personal-best 10 digs 2/2 at Loyola Chicago.
- » He has shown that he is also a well-rounded defender with 147 digs (2nd on team) and 53.0 blocks (T-2nd on team).

### Big Man in the Middle

- » Redshirt senior Jason Donorovich emerged as one of the top middles in the country during the 2019 season.
- » Donorovich finished first in the EIVA with a .379 hitting percentage in 2019 while ranking 19th in the conference in kills (181).
- » He is also a game changer on the service line and on defense, leading the Nittany Lions in service aces (36) and total blocks (91).
- » Donorovich has 21-straight matches with a block, including 16 matches with multiple stuffs dating back to the beginning of 2019.
- » Donorovich had five or more kills in ten of the last 11 while hitting .300 or better in eight of the last nine outings in 2019.
- » Donorovich was named EIVA Offensive Player of the Week Feb. 18 after posting two single-game career highs with 13 kills 2/15/19 vs. Harvard and four aces 2/16/19 vs. Sacred Heart.
- » Donorovich was named EIVA Defensive player of the week 1/28/19 after picking up 15 blocks (5 solo) in three games between 1/21-1/26. He had a nine-block game 1/26/19 vs. Lindenwood.

### Wild Thing

- » Sophomore Brett Wildman erupted late in the 2019 season and looks to continue his surge into 2020.
- » Wildman had back-to-back 20+-kill performances in the 2019 EIVA Tournament April 18 & 20, becoming first Nittany Lion to have back-to-back 20-kill matches since Aaron Russell Jan. 16-17, 2015 (32 at Ball State, 20 at IPFW).
- » He has made 11-straight starts at opposite to end the 2019 season for the Nittany Lions. Over that span, he had 123 kills and 52 digs along with 20 service aces.
- » Wildman was named to the United States Volleyball World University Games roster last summer. He was the youngest player on the US roster, the team's only true freshman, and the lone representative of the EIVA on the team.
- » He ranked third on PSU with 195 kills and fourth with 237.5 points.
- » Wildman is also one of the Nittany Lions' top servers with 29 aces at a 0.32 aces/set rate, good for second on the team in 2019.

### Mende Back For More

- » Redshirt senior Calvin Mende is poised for a bounce-back year after an injury-riddled 2019.
- » Despite injury, Mende provided a big spark off the bench in several matches in 2019, notably 3/29 at Harvard (14 kills) and 3/26 vs. SFU (8 kills, .545 H%).
- » Mende led Penn State with 20 kills against both George Mason and Charleston 2/22-24. He also had 18 in last year's season opener at Ohio State 1/5/19.
- » Mende had at least five kills in 27-straight appearances from 4/8/17 to 1/12/19 which included 16 double-digit kill matches.





» Mende has been named First Team All-EIVA twice and a Volleyball Magazine Honorable Mention all American twice in his career (2017-18).

## Just Set 'Em

- » Both of Penn State's primary setters in 2019, sophomore Cole Bogner and redshirt senior Luke Braswell, have showcased the ability to run the Nittany Lion offense effectively.
- » Between the pair, the Nittany Lions had one player reach 30 assists in eight of the last 15 matches of 2019.
- » Braswell is the active leader in NCAA DI-II men's volleyball with 2,391 career assists.
- » As a true freshman in 2019 Bogner racked up 50 assists in back-to-back matches in the EIVA tournament with 57 against George Mason in the semis and 52 against Princeton in the final.
- » Bogner also had a individual season-best 11 digs against Princeton for his first career double-double.
- » Bogner had to learn on the fly early on in his freshman season, but did so marvelously with 25 assists when playing the 3rd-5th sets of the BYU game 1/18.
- » His 40 assists at SFU 1/21 was his best in the regular season. He set a season high in digs with eight 2/2 at Loyola Chicago.
- » Braswell set a 2019 season high with 47 assists against NJIT and added 45 more 3/8 at USC.
- » Braswell surpassed the 2,000 career assist mark 2/15 against Harvard, becoming just the 11th active player to reach the milestone.
- » Braswell has tallied at least 25 assists nine times in 2019, including reaching 30+ helpers seven times.

## Wait! There's More!

- » Sophomore Canyon Tuman started 26 matches for PSU in the middle and was tied second on the team with 53 blocks. He also had a season-best nine kills against George Mason in the EIVA semifinals.
- » Sophomore Cal Fisher had at least five kills in 10 of 20 matches played as an OH/OPP in 2019. He proved his versatility by started the last six matches at libero for the injured Will Bantle.
- » Redshirt freshman Will Bantle started 24 matches at libero led the team with 149 digs, good for third in the EIVA despite missing six games. He also was reliable on serve-receive at .937 (478-510).

## It's Their Time

- » Penn State will look to a few new faces to fill positions throughout the lineup and compete for playing time throughout the season.
- » Redshirt junior outside hitter Bobby Wilden aims to make his mark on the season after sitting out the 2019 year due to injury.
- » Senior setter and serving specialist Nathan Smith provides additional lineup flexibility for Penn State.
- » Sophomore Sam Marsh started five matches at middle for PSU in 2019.
- » Redshirt junior libero Declan Pierce and opposite hitter Kyle Mackiewicz each have the tools to effectively play in the Penn State lineup.
- » Freshman outside hitter Tim Herget could likely find playing time as a substitute early on thanks to his athletic ability. He spent the last two years on mission in Chile after graduating high school in 2017.
