- Elijah Bryant tied his season high with 29 points at Pacific. He hit 10 of 15 from the field, 3 of 8 from downtown and 6 of 6 from the free-throw line. Bryant previously set his season high against Utah and has scored 20-plus points six times this season.
- Through 50 career games, Yoeli Childs has recorded 79 blocks, good for 16th all-time in BYU history. He is one block from tying Corbin Kaufusi for 15th all-time in career blocks.
- Luke Worthington had one of his best weeks as a Cougar when BYU played at San Francisco and at Pacific. The junior forward averaged 9.0 points on 83.3 percent shooting from the field and 66.7 percent shooting from the free-throw line. He also averaged 3.0 rebounds and 2.0 blocks.

- 2** The number of preseason All-WCC honorees for BYU in TJ Haws and Yoeli Childs. Last season, Haws and Childs were both All-WCC Freshman Team honorees and Haws was named to the All-WCC First Team. Since joining the WCC in 2011, the Cougars have had two players on the All-WCC First Team each year.
- 6** The number of 20-point games for Elijah Bryant and Yoeli Childs the season. Bryant has netted 20-plus points against Mississippi Valley State (27), Princeton (22), Niagara (22), Utah (29), Portland (22) and at Pacific (29). Childs has scored 20-plus against Niagara (21), Alabama (21), Utah Valley (24), Idaho State (20), Portland (26) and Saint Mary's (29).
- 4:44** The amount of time remaining against UMass when BYU trailed by double figures for the final time, 61-51. It was the latest in a game the Cougars have trailed by double figures and comeback to win in the Rose era. BYU won by a final score of 68-66.
- 10** The number of steals BYU recorded against UMass, a season high and the most by the Cougars since Dec. 20, 2016 when BYU had 13 vs. Idaho State. Elijah Bryant had a team-best three while Yoeli Childs and Jahshire Hardnett had two apiece and TJ Haws, Rylan Bergersen and Payton Dastrup had one each.
- 12** The number of career double-doubles for sophomore forward Yoeli Childs. He had five as a freshman and has seven this season. His double-doubles this season have come against Mississippi Valley State (13 points, 10 rebounds), Alabama (21 and 11), UMass (19 and 11), Utah Valley (24 and 11), Utah State (10 and 10), Portland (26 and 13) and Saint Mary's (29 and 10).
- 12** The number of 3-point field goals made by BYU in the season opener vs. Mississippi State, tied for the most by a Cougar team in a season opener. BYU also made 12 in the 2003-04 season opener vs. Southern Utah. Twelve 3-point field goals is also a 2017-18 season high and it was matched at Utah Valley.
- 12** The number of consecutive seasons BYU has won at least 20 games. BYU has also reached the postseason in 12-straight seasons. Both streaks are program records.
- 25** BYU posted a season-best 25 assists on 30 made field goals at Utah Valley. Four different players had four-plus assists, including McKay Cannon (6), Yoeli Childs (4), Elijah Bryant (4) and TJ Haws (4).
- 25** The number of consecutive free throws BYU made between the end of the Princeton game through the first half of the UT Arlington game. The Cougars made their final 17 attempts to finish at Princeton and all eight of their attempts in the first half of the UT Arlington game. Between the two games, BYU hit 44 of 49 (89.8 percent).
- 25** Dave Rose reached 300 wins in his 407th career game on Feb. 4, 2017. He is tied with Bob Knight and John Thompson for 25th fastest to 300 career wins in NCAA history.
- 318** Dave Rose (2005 to present) is second all-time in BYU basketball history with 318 career victories, behind only the great Stan Watts, who coached the Cougars to 371 wins from 1949 to 1972 and was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in 1986.

THE BASKETBALL HALL OF FAME: HOOPHALL AWARDS

BYU sophomore guard TJ Haws is a preseason candidate for the 2018 Jeff West Shooting Guard of the Year Award, presented by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Haws earned first-team All-WCC honors in 2016-17 while averaging 13.8 points, 2.9 rebounds, 3.2 assists and 1.0 steal. The Alpine, Utah, native also hit a team-high 76 3-pointers, second all-time among BYU freshmen.

LAST TIME OUT – COUGARS COME UP SHORT AT PACIFIC

STOCKTON, Calif. — The BYU men's basketball team fell 67-66 in a heartbreaker against Pacific on Saturday night at the Alex G. Spanos Center.

"We were really stagnant and stale in the first half tonight and that surprises me because that's not something we've really seen from this team," BYU head coach Dave Rose said. "This is a team that's been successful when we play as a team. It's disappointing. We have got to find a way to be better at executing down the stretch and win the close ones."

Bryant tied his season-high 29 points while grabbing seven rebounds. Yoeli Childs contributed 13 points and six boards. Luke Worthington added nine points and a career-best three blocks while TJ Haws had seven points and Jahshire Hardnett had six.

Hardnett scored the first bucket of the contest, giving the Cougars their first lead of the night. The Tigers answered with five consecutive points before a Bryant basket tied the game at 5-all. With just under 14 minutes remaining in the

first half, Haws converted once at the line to give BYU a 15-9 advantage.

After BYU started the game 6 of 7 from the field, Pacific answered with a 4-0 run before Bryant grabbed a steal for a dunk, keeping the Cougar lead, 17-13. After the Tigers evened the game at 19, they continued on to take a 23-19 advantage with six minutes remaining before halftime.

As the clock dropped to under two minutes, Pacific gained control and took a 34-26 lead. A pair of free-throws by Bryant and another by Childs cut the deficit, but the Tigers went into the locker room on top, 36-29.

At halftime, Bryant led the Cougar offense with 15 points on 6 of 8 shooting. BYU shot 45.5 percent from the field compared to Pacific's 55.6 percent.

In the first four minutes of the second half, three different BYU players put points on the board, including a 3-pointer by Childs to even the score at 40-all.

A second trey by Childs gave BYU a 47-44 advantage with 13:32 remaining. Free-throws by Cannon and another 3-pointer by Bryant kept the Cougars on top by four points, 53-49. With 5:20 remaining and the score tied at 56, the Tigers converted on two points from the line, while on the other end Childs finished under the basket to keep the game even at 58-58.

The two teams continued to exchange the lead throughout the final minutes of the game and with 1:30 remaining, Pacific scored a pair of free-throws to take a three-point lead, 64-61. Haws cut the score down to one-point on a reverse layup with under a minute to go.

With the Cougars down by four and 23 seconds remaining, Bryant hit one from beyond the arc to make it a one possession game. After the Tigers missed two free-throws, a baseline shot by Zac Seljaas after a scramble for a loose ball came just after the clock expired and Pacific held on to win.

The Cougars finished the game shooting 46.8 percent from the field, while Pacific shot 52.0 percent.

NOTES AND STORYLINES

Super Sophomores

BYU's 2017-18 roster includes three players who etched their names in the BYU record book during their freshman seasons. Yoeli Childs and TJ Haws were freshmen in 2016-17 while Zac Seljaas was a rookie in 2015-16. All three are back this season, looking to build on their record-setting freshman campaigns. Childs finished his freshman year first all-time among BYU freshmen in rebounds and second in rebounds per game, blocks, blocks per game and field goal percentage.

Haws concluded his first year second all-time among BYU freshmen in 3-point field goals, fourth in points scored, fifth in assists, tied for first in games started and third in double figure scoring games. Seljaas finished the 2015-16 season first all-time among BYU freshmen in 3-point field goal percentage, second in 3-point field goals, second in 3-point field goals per game, second in games with 3-plus 3-point field goals and tied for second most games with 5-plus 3-pointers.

All-Haws Team

TJ Haws earned first-team All-WCC honors as a freshman in 2016-17, becoming the third Haws in BYU history to earn all-league honors. His father Marty Haws earned first-team All-WAC honors as a senior in 1989-90 and his brother Tyler was a four-time all-league honoree. As a freshman in 2009-10, Tyler was named to the All-Mountain West Conference Third Team. Following a two-year mission for the LDS Church, Tyler earned first-team honors as a sophomore, junior and senior. In addition to joining his father and brother as an all-conference performer, TJ became the second Cougar in program history – the other being Danny Ainge – to earn first-team all-league honors as a freshman.

Dave Rose

BYU head coach Dave Rose has led the Cougars to one of the most successful eras in program history since taking over in 2005. His career record of 318-115 ranks him second in BYU history in total victories and first in winning percentage (.734). Rose has been named conference coach of the year three times, led the Cougars to four conference titles, eight NCAA tournament appearances, four NIT appearances, eight 25-win seasons and 12 20-win seasons.

BYU and the Postseason

Under Dave Rose, BYU has reached the postseason in 12-straight seasons, a school record. The previous record was six-straight seasons (1989-90 to 1994-95). During that time the Cougars have earned eight bids to the NCAA tournament and four to the NIT. The Cougars' eight NCAA tournament bids in the last 12 years are more than 200-plus NCAA Division I schools have since beginning their programs.
