## BYU STORYLINES

- Freshman forward Gavin Baxter made his first career start vs. LMU and posted career highs of 25 points and 10 rebounds. Baxter hit 10 of 14 from the field and hit 2 of 4 from 3-point range, his first career 3s. He is the fifth Cougar with at least 20 points and 10 rebounds in his first career start and only the second freshman - Shawn Bradley had 23 and 14 in his BYU debut on Nov. 14, 1990, vs. East Tennessee State.
- Junior guard Nick Emery had his best game of the season, hitting 5 of 5 from 3-point range for a season-high 17 points and a season-best four steals. His five makes without a miss is tied for the second-most 3s without a miss and one off the record of six set by Nathan Call and Brock Zylstra.
- BYU is 19-2 all-time against Portland and has won the last two meetings in Portland.

- 2** Since joining the WCC in 2011, the Cougars have had two players on the All-WCC First Team each year, including Yoeli Childs and Elijah Bryant in 2017-18.
- 2** The number of teams in BYU history that have featured three players with 1,000-plus points each while playing together. Yoeli Childs, TJ Haws and Nick Emery have played 14 games together as 1,000-point scorers. The 1979-80 team played the final four games with Danny Ainge, Alan Taylor and Scott Runia as 1,000-point scorers.
- 13** The number of consecutive seasons BYU has won at least 20 games and reached the postseason. Both streaks are program records.
- 18/22** The number of free throws made and attempted by TJ Haws at Pepperdine. The only player who has made and attempted more free throws in a single game in BYU history is Jimmer Fredette, who hit 23 of 24 vs. TCU in the 2010 Mountain West Championships.
- 30** The number of career 20-point games for Yoeli Childs, including 15 this season. He is tied for 11th-most 20-point games in BYU history.
- 32** The number of career double-doubles for junior forward Yoeli Childs – fifth all-time in BYU history. He had five as a freshman, 15 as a sophomore in 2017-18 and has 12 in 2018-19.
- 343** Dave Rose (2005 to present) is second all-time in BYU basketball history with 343 career victories, behind only the great Stan Watts, who coached the Cougars to 371 wins from 1949 to 1972 and was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in 1986. Including his record at Dixie, Rose has 505 career wins as a head coach.
- 1,119** The number of career points for junior guard Nick Emery. He became the 50th player in BYU history to reach 1,000 career points and is currently 42nd all-time in program history.
- 1,293** The number of career points for junior guard TJ Haws. He became the 52nd Cougar to reach 1,000 career points when he had 22 at Illinois State. Haws is currently 25th all-time.
- 1,439** The number of career points for junior forward Yoeli Childs. He became the 51st Cougar in program history to reach 1,000 career points when he totaled 24 vs. Oral Roberts. Childs is currently 18th all-time in BYU history.

YOELI MAKES THE LISTS

BYU junior forward Yoeli Childs is a preseason candidate for the 2019 Karl Malone Power Forward of the Year Award, presented by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. He has also been named to the Mid-Season Watch Lists for the Lute Olson Award – presented annually to the top Division I men's basketball player – and the Lou Henson Award – presented annually to the top Division I mid-major player. In 2018-19 he is averaging 21.2 points and 9.5 rebounds and has 12 double-doubles. Childs earned first-team All-WCC honors in 2017-18 while averaging 17.8 points, 8.6 rebounds and 1.8 blocks. The South Jordan, Utah, native also registered 15 double-doubles and shot 54.1 percent from the field.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS

BYU junior forward Yoeli Childs was named the Dec. 10 West Coast Conference Player of the Week and the NCAA March Madness Player of the Week. Childs led BYU to a pair of wins against in-state foes while averaging 31.0 points, 9.0 rebounds and 2.5 steals. For the week, Childs shot 70.6 percent from the field and 92.3 percent from the free-throw line.

Childs earned his second WCC Player of the Week honor on Jan. 14 after he led BYU to wins over Portland (79-56) and Santa Clara (80-74) while averaging 27.5 points, 9.0 rebounds, 1.5 assists and 1.0 steals. For the week, he shot 60.0 percent from the field, 55.6 percent from 3-point range and 82.4 percent from the free-throw line.

LAST TIME VS. LMU – CHILDS' DOUBLE-DOUBLE LEADS BYU TO 79-56 WIN VS. PORTLAND

PROVO, Utah – Yoeli Childs' double-double led BYU to a 79-56 win against Portland to open up the home West Coast Conference slate Thursday night in the Marriott Center.

"It's good to be home," BYU head coach Dave Rose said. "I think our guys came out with great focus and energy. I thought we played the first 10 minutes as well as we've played all year long."

Childs led all scorers posting 28 points to go with 12 rebounds. He added three assists while going 8 for 9 at the charity stripe. McKay Cannon tallied 11 points with four boards, three assists and four steals. Off the bench, BYU put up 24 points, including eight points from Zac Seljaas and seven from Rylan Bergersen.

The Cougars quickly took control of the game, going up 20-4 with an 18-0 run. A Childs dunk gave BYU its first points of the game, and Childs, Harding, Cannon and Emery all drained 3-pointers as part of the 18-0 run.

After Zac Seljaas nailed a 3-pointer of his own and Gavin Baxter make a layup, BYU took their biggest lead of the half with a 19-point margin at 25-6.

With just over six minutes to go in the game, the Cougars took their largest lead of the night, going up 24 points with the score at 69-45. BYU tallied a six-point run late in the game, making the final score 79-54.

During the November signing period, the Cougars signed three players to National Letters of Intent: Da Silva, Nate Hansen and Shengzhe Li.

A 6-foot-9 forward from Brazil, Da Silva plays for Dave Evans at Wasatch Academy in Mount Pleasant, Utah. In 2017-18, he helped lead the Tigers to a 24-2 record, including a 12-game win streak to end the season. Da Silva also plays for the Utah Mountain Stars, coached by former Cougars Marty Haws and Kevin Nixon. During the summer of 2018, he averaged 14.8 points, 8.9 rebounds and 2.3 blocks.

Hansen hails from Provo, Utah, and plays for former Cougar Kevin Santiago at Timpview High School. In 2017-18, the 6-foot-3 guard helped lead the T-Birds to a record of 17-7 overall and 8-2 in region play while averaging 15.1 points and draining 53 3-pointers. He scored in double figures 18 times, had 20-plus points six times and registered season highs of 30 points, nine assists, eight steals and six 3-point field goals. Hansen plays for the Utah Mountain Stars and plans to serve a mission following high school.

Originally from Shanghai, China, Li plays for former BYU assistant Jeff Reinert at Santa Margarita Catholic in Santa Margarita, California. A 6-foot-10 center, Li averaged 6.8 points and 5.6 rebounds while helping Santa Margarita to a record of 20-10 in 2017-18. Prior to playing for Santa Margarita, Li played two years in Spain for the Canarias Basketball Academy in Las Palmas. He also plays for the Pump N Run club during the AAU season.

**Dave Rose**

BYU head coach Dave Rose has led the Cougars to one of the most successful eras in program history since taking over in 2005. His career record of 343-132 ranks him second in BYU history in total victories and first in winning percentage (.722). Rose has been named conference coach of the year three times, led the Cougars to four conference titles, eight NCAA tournament appearances, five NIT appearances, eight 25-win seasons and 13 20-win seasons. On Nov. 6, 2018, BYU announced Rose signed a contract extension through the 2020-21 season.

**Rose wins off the court**

Rose won the 2018 ESPN INFINITI Coaches' Charity Challenge, raising more than \$100,000 for the BYU Simmons Center for Cancer Research. The Simmons Center in turn created the David and Cheryl Rose Family Student Cancer Research Endowment, a fellowship for BYU students conducting cancer research.

In two years with the Cougars, Yoeli Childs has made his mark on the BYU record book. He is currently climbing the rankings in points scored, blocks per game, total blocks, field goal percentage and rebounds per game. With another strong season, he is poised to climb the charts in career points and rebounds as well. See complete rankings on page 6.

**Four star additions**

BYU added four players to the roster that were four star recruits coming out of high school. Gavin Baxter (class of 2016), Connor Harding (2016) and Kolby Lee (2017) are all freshmen who were all ranked four-star recruits by ESPN.com. Baxter and Harding are coming off two-year missions while Lee was a redshirt in 2017-18. The Cougars also welcome sophomore Jesse Wade, who was a four-star recruit in the class of 2015. He served a mission before playing his freshman season at Gonzaga in 2017-18. Wade will sit out this season due to NCAA transfer rules.

**Cougars with 1,000 points**

In 2016-17, junior guard Nick Emery became the 50th player in Cougar history to score 1,000 career points. He also joined Tyler Haws, Danny Ainge and Eric Mika as the only BYU players to reach 1,000 career points as sophomores. Junior Yoeli Childs reached the milestone on Nov. 15 in BYU's win over Oral Roberts, becoming the 51st player in BYU history and 15th under Dave Rose to reach the milestone. TJ Haws became the 52nd Cougar and 16th under Rose to reach 1,000 career points at Illinois State on Nov. 28. The 16 players who have reached 1,000 points under Rose include the all-time leading scorer in Tyler Haws and the No. 2 scorer in Jimmer Fredette.

Tyler (2,720 points) and TJ Haws (1,293) are the third set of brothers to both reach 1,000 career points, joining Jackson (1,235) and Nick Emery (1,119) and Fred (1,841) and Ken Roberts (1,652). The Haws brothers are joined by their father Marty (1,337), who was also a 1,000-point scorer at BYU.

**100 career 3-pointers**

Junior guard TJ Haws reached 100 career 3-pointers in BYU's win at San Francisco last season, becoming the 23rd Cougar to reach the milestone. Junior guard Nick Emery was the 22nd Cougar to reach 100 3-pointers. Haws was fourth fastest to 100 career 3s in terms of games played while Emery is second. Junior Zac Seljaas hit a season-best five 3-pointers against Alabama A&M to reach 100 career 3s in 75 games, 12th fastest in BYU history.

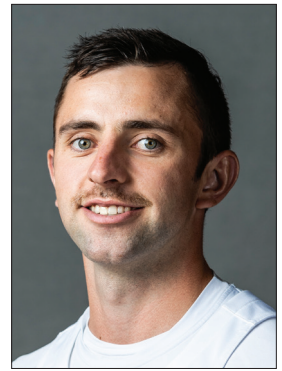

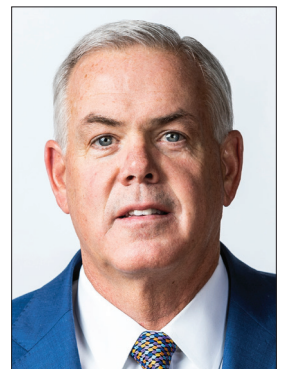
