## NOTES \& NEWS

LET'S DANCE: Honoring a tradition of excellence for Rutgers women's basketball, the Scarlet Knights are going dancing again at the NCAA Tournament. Rutgers earned its highest seed (6) since 2012 and will make its 26 th NCAA Tournament appearance with a compiled $36-25(.590)$ record in the Big Dance, including a run to the 2007 National Championship game, as well as a trip to the 2000 Final Four. Head coach C. Vivian Stringer will lead the Scarlet Knights to a 17 th NCAA Tournament appearance since taking over the program in the 1995-96 season.
RUTGERS RANKED: Rutgers women's basketball is ranked No. 21/23 by the AP and WBCA Coaches polls after tying for its highest finish in the Big Ten in third place with a 10-3 record in the conference (14-4 overall). Following a five-week hiatus, Rutgers won its final nine regular season games in the Big Ten by an average margin of 16.3 points, including ranked wins over Top 25 teams Northwestern and Ohio State.

CLOUD NINE: Rutgers is on its longest Big Ten winning streak since joining the conference. RU opened the 2018-19 Big Ten season with seven wins in a row. The Scarlet Knights have their first nine-game conference winning streak since the perfect $16-0$ Big East season of 2005-06, which was an actual 24 -game Big East streak going back to ${ }^{\circ} 04-05$.

NET WORKING: Rutgers is listed at No. 12 in the NCAA Evaluation Tool (NET) rankings, which replace RPI as a guide for selecting at-large bids for the NCAA Tournament. The NET rankings take into account Adjusted Net Efficiency (offensive vs. defensive points per possession weighted on quality of opponent) and Team Value Index (resultsoriented). Rutgers is ranked in the Top 10 of the NCAA in points per 100 offensive possessions and average point margin per 100 possessions.
ARELLA RISING: Redshirt senior guard Arella Guirantes is on six national watch lists: The Senior CLASS Award, the Wooden Award for Most Outstanding Player, the Naismith Trophy and Wade Trophy for National Player of the Year, a Top 5 finalist for the Meyers Shooting Guard Award, and the Naismith Defensive Player of the Year Award.

SHINE ON: True freshman Diamond Johnson matched her career high of 26 points in her first career postseason game against lowa in the Big Ten Tournament quarterfinals, and was one of 10 named to the Nancy Lieberman Award Watch List semifinalists for the country's top point guard. The Neumann Goretti product earned Rutgers' first ever Big Ten Freshman of the Week honor on Dec. 21. Johnson scored in double-figures in 16 of her first 18 games. Rutgers is $6-1$ when Diamond scores 20 or more points this season.

## Second Team All-Big Ten, Big Ten All-Freshman Team

THOU SHALL STEAL: Rutgers ranks fourth in the country with 12.6 steals per game and is eighth in the nation in turnover margin at 6.8. Four Scarlet Knights make up the Top 7 in the Big Ten in steals per game with Tekia Mack (9th in the nation - 3.1), Diamond Johnson (2.3), Arella Guirantes (2.1), and Mael Gilles (1.9).

THAT'S OFFENSIVE: Rutgers has scored 80 or more points in three Big Ten games this season. Before this year, Rutgers has had a total of three $80+$ games since joining the conference in 2014-15. RU had a five-game streak of scoring 70+ in conference games, the first time since 1997-98 in the Big East. RU earlier scored 80+ in five consecutive games for the first time since the 1990-91 season.

## WINNING AS A TEAM

Rutgers put together five consecutive games with four or more players scoring in double-figures from Dec. 11-23.

Rutgers has had four or more double-digit scorers in eight of its 18 games.

RU handed out 25 assists in the win against Hampton, the most in a game since 25 vs. FDU on Dec. 20, 2017.

All 10 players entering the Hampton victory scored at least one bucket.

## FREE RECORDS

Arella Guirantes is chasing more free throw history at Rutgers. At . 892 on the 2020-21 season, she is on pace to break the school record of .901 set by Tomora Young during the 1997-98 season.

Guirantes set a Rutgers record with 171 made free throws last season, surpassing the 155 by RU Hall of Famer Sue Wicks during her National Player of the Year season in 1987-88.

In the Big Ten Tournament, Guirantes set a single-game tournament record with 15 free throws made, topping the old mark of 14 by Ohio State's Jessica Davenport against Indiana on March 2, 2007.

Guirantes' 15-of-16 free throw mark in that game (94.8\%) ranks 10th all-time in the Big Ten Tournament record book for free throw percentage in a game, and is the best free throw performance since 2016 at the championship tournament. This came eight days after she set a Rutgers record with 14 makes without a miss on Feb. 27 in a win over Wisconsin at the RAC.
The 15 made free throws tie a Rutgers overall record for a single game (most since Monique Oliver's 15 in 2010, also tying Regina Howard from 1987).

## ROOKIE RECORDS

At 17.9 points per game, freshman guard Diamond Johnson is challenging Cappie Pondexter's freshman scoring record of 18.3ppg set during the 2002-03 season.

Johnson is also taking aim at the singleseason three-point shooting percentage record. Johnson has a . 450 mark (49-109), which would be behind the current record holder Pondexter's . 488 (62-127) from 2005-06.

## COACH OF THE WEEK

C. Vivian Stringer was named the NCAA

Women's Basketball Coach of the Week by ESPN on Feb. 17.

The Scarlet Knights won a pair of road games by an average of 17 points, including victory at No. 21/20 Northwestern, to stretch a winning streak to three since returning from a five-week hiatus. Rutgers reached 70 points or more in both victories at Northwestern and Purdue.

## STRINGER MILESTONE NUMBERS TO REMEMBER

Rutgers head coach Stringer has compiled a 1055-425 career record in her 50 seasons of coaching and joined the elite 1,000 career victory club on November 13, 2018 in the Scarlet Knight victory over Central Connecticut State.

Stringer is the sixth NCAA women's basketball coach and fifth NCAA Division I women's basketball coach to reach the milestone victory. In 2013, Stringer became just the seventh coach - men's or women's - to reach the 900-win mark.

With a 60-54 win over Minnesota on Feb. 28, 2019, Stringer was credited with her 36th 20win seasons to tie former Tennessee head coach Pat Summitt for women's basketball coaches with the most 20-win seasons.

A 63-48 victory over Wisconsin on Feb. 27, 2020 clinched Stringer's 37th 20-win season, breaking the tie with Pat Summitt and setting the new NCAA record.

The Naismith and Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Coach is the third winningest active coach in women's basketball and one of three current active coaches among all divisions with more than 1,000 career victories. She is fifth all-time in career wins among women's basketball coaches.

## C. VIVIAN STRINGER

## Head Coach • 26th Season at Rutgers, 50th Season Overall



One of the most recognizable names in all of college basketball, C. Vivian Stringer - mother, teacher, coach - has built an illustrious legacy highlighted by countless unforgettable moments through a tireless work ethic and desire for excellence. A pioneer, visionary and leader during her four decades of success on the hardwood, Stringer once again made history as she eclipsed the monumental 1,000 career victory milestone during the 2018-19 campaign, further adding to her legacy as one of the most influential faces in basketball. In 2019-20, she surpassed the late, great Pat Summitt and became the NCAA record holder with 37 seasons of 20 or more victories.

With 49 seasons on the sidelines, Stringer has been the primary architect in transforming three programs into national title contenders ever since her appearance in the first-ever NCAA National Championship game. She has guided teams to 27 of the 38 NCAA Tournaments, including 10 straight from 2003 to 2012 and not including the presumed inclusion in the cancelled 2020 tournament.

The first coach in men's or women's basketball history to take three different schools to the Final Four (Cheyney in 1982, lowa in 1993 and Rutgers, in 2000 and again in 2007), Stringer has been a pioneer, visionary and leader during her four decades of success on the hardwood.

Stringer has compiled an overall record of 1041-421, which ranks fifth alltime among NCAA women's basketball coaching victories, and was the fifth coach in NCAA Division I women's basketball history to surpass the 1,000 career win milestone.

While at Rutgers for the last 25 seasons, Stringer has registered 521-286 mark having led the Scarlet Knights to 17 NCAA Tournaments, including two Final Four appearances, as well as the WNIT Championship title in 2014.

Stringer was enshrined into the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame in arguably the best class ever in 2009. She joined fellow basketball greats Michael Jordan, David Robinson, John Stockton and Jerry Sloan to receive basketball's ultimate honor. She became just the 11th women's coach to earn the prestigious prize.

A 2001 inductee into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Stringer made her sixth appearance on a USA Basketball coaching staff in 2004, serving as an assistant coach for the gold-medal winning U.S. Olympic Team. Named one of the "101 Most Influential Minorities in Sports" by Sports Illustrated in 2003, Stringer continues to be one of the most recognized coaches in the game.

A coal miner's daughter, Stringer learned a valuable lesson from her parents growing up in the small tight-knit community of Edenborn in western Pennsylvania: "Work hard and don't look for excuses, and you can achieve anything."

That lesson has stuck with the legendary college basketball coach and has been one of the primary messages she has passed on to the hundreds of players who have stood before her. It's been her perseverance and strength in the eyes of adversity that has meant the most to the people around her. Stringer prides herself on not only teaching her players the game of basketball but more importantly providing them life lessons that stand the test of time.

Stringer has overcome many challenges in her life; the loss of her beloved father at the tender age of 19; in 1982, her only daughter being stricken with spinal meningitis just prior to her Cheyney team's appearance in the very first Final Four; the sudden death of her beloved husband, Bill, to a heart attack on Thanksgiving Day 1992 and a bout with breast cancer which she kept a secret from nearly everyone in her life. Through it all, Stringer has handled life with dignity and grace rising above the tragedies to make a difference in the lives of hundreds of young women.

Stringer was at a loss for words before she was to give her Naismith enshrinement speech on Sept. 11. After all, her career extended over four decades of work and involved countless players and coaches who touched her life. Overcome with emotion and fighting back tears, Stringer delivered one of
the most eloquent speeches, sharing with the crowd and a national audience on ESPN how her desire to coach was fueled early in her life.

In a moment where she was being heralded for her lifetime of accomplishments, Stringer saw it as an opportunity to say thank you to people who had given her as much as she had given them. "I celebrate, you my players. It is because of your hard work, passion, execution of the game plans and commitment to one another that I am here tonight," Stringer said during the ceremony.

In addition to Naismith, Stringer is also a member of the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame. Enshrined on June 9, 2001, in Knoxville, Tenn., the honor truly showed Stringer's mark on the game in regards to equality, innovation and growth.

Stringer has been named the National Coach of the Year three times (Wade Trophy -- 1982, Converse -- 1988 and Naismith -- 1993) by her peers. She also was named the 1993 Coach of the Year by Sports Illustrated, USA Today, Converse, the Los Angeles Times and the Black Coaches Association.

In addition, she was tabbed the 2000 Female Coach of the Year by the Rainbow/PUSH Organization, a group founded by Rev. Jesse Jackson; the District V Coach of the Year in 1985, 1988 and 1993; the District I Coach of the Year in 1998 and 2006; the Big Ten Coach of the Year in 1991 and 1993; the

BIG EAST Coach of the Year in 1998 and 2005; and a six-time Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association Coach of the Year (1998-00, 2005-06 and 2008).

One of her most personally-gratifying accolades was receiving the 1993 Carol Eckman Award, which acknowledges the coach demonstrating spirit, courage, integrity, commitment, leadership and service to the game of women's basketball.

A finalist for the Naismith National Coach of the Year Award seven times, Stringer was humbled when the U.S. Sports Academy decided to name its annual women's coaching award in her honor. The C. Vivian Stringer Medallion Award of Sport for Women's Coaching was handed out for the first time in July of 2002.

Stringer has also been inducted into numerous Halls of Fame, including the New Jersey Hall of Fame and the Sport in Society Hall of Fame in 2005, and in 2006 she entered the University of lowa Athletics Hall of Fame. Also in 2006, Stringer was inducted into the International Women's Sports Hall of Fame at the Women's Sports Foundation's Annual Salute to Women.

One of her most memorable events and honors in Stringer's life took place in September 2008 in Beaverton, Ore., when Nike named its second child development center after Stringer. The 35,000 square foot facility, houses 26 classrooms which provide care, learning and development for nearly 300 children between the ages of six months and five years old.

Additionally, in 2013, the Black Coaches Association named its annual Coach of the Year honor after Stringer.

Along with her well documented collegiate experience, Stringer has also successfully tested herself in the international arena. An assistant coach for the gold-medal 2004 U.S. Olympic Team, her first USA Basketball experience came as an assistant for the bronze-medal 1980 USA Jones Cup Team.
Stringer has had extensive head-coaching experience in the national program, leading the 1982 U.S. Olympic Festival East Team to a bronze medal and the 1984 U.S. World University Games Team (Kobe, Japan) to a silver.

Stringer also guided the 1989 U.S. World Championship Qualifying Team (Sao Paulo, Brazil) to a gold and a qualification for the following year's FIBA World Championship, as well as a bronze medal showing for the 1991 Pan American Games Team (Havana, Cuba).

A noted administrator, Stringer was one of the key players in the development of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association. Stringer serves on the Board of Directors of the Kay Yow/WBCA Cancer Fund, created in the fall of 2007. The Foundation, in partnership with the V Foundation for Cancer Research, is an initiative to fight breast cancer. She also serves on the U.S. Department of State's Council to Empower Women and Girls Through Sports.

A native of Edenborn, Pa., and a member of the Alumni Hall of Fame at her alma mater, Slippery Rock University, Stringer and the late William D. Stringer have three children -- David, Janine and Justin.

Stringer became a first-time grandmother in June 2009 with the addition of granddaughter, Dayton, and welcomed her first grandson, Ryker, in the summer of 2013.
