In 2017, BYU swept the Lions during opening weekend and last year the Cougars also swept Santa Clara. BYU was picked to win the WCC Conference title for a fifth year in a row with Cougars earning every vote from the conference head coaches except for two (head coaches can't vote for their own team) which went to LMU.

• HOME RUN HEAT. Nine different Cougars have hit homers this season to give BYU a total of 26. Junior Rylee Jensen leads the team with six followed by Libby Sugg, Emilee Erickson and Ashley Godfrey with four apiece

• CHASING THE CHARTS. A handful of BYU softball players are moving up in the BYU all-time record books. Senior Libby Sugg finished the 2018 season ranked No. 2 and No. 3 at BYU in career on-base percentage (.455) and slugging percentage (.700), respectively. She continues to move up in other categories including No. 4 in RBI (199) and No. 5 in homers (46). After this weekend, Arissa Paulson moved into the No. 9 spot for career shutouts (6) and No. 10 in career strikeouts with 210.

• SWEEP WEEKLY AWARDS. Senior catcher Libby Sugg and sophomore pitcher Arissa Paulson swept the West Coast Conference weekly awards. Sugg led BYU to two wins against Utah Valley early in the week, batting .691 between the two games with three runs, four RBI, a home run and a double in both games. Paulson recorded two wins during the week, including a 6-0 shutout against UTSA. This is both of their first honors this season and BYU's seventh award.



Strength of schedule

The 2019 BYU schedule features face 10 NCAA Regional teams, four Super Regional teams and three Women's College World Series teams from last season. The Cougars will play six teams that finished in the top 15 of the final 2018 rankings in the ESPN.com/USA Softball and USA Today/NFCA Coaches polls including top-five teams UCLA, Oklahoma and Washington. BYU is slated to face teams in all of the Power Five conferences including four from the Southeastern (SEC), three from both the Big 12 and Pac-12 and one from the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) and Big Ten.

WCC: Year six

BYU enters the sixth season in the West Coast Conference after jumping around following its departure from the Mountain West. The Cougars played in the Western Athletic Conference in 2012 and the Pacific Coast Softball Conference in 2013 before softball was added in the WCC beginning in the 2014 season. Spanning the four conferences, BYU has won 10 conference titles in a row.

Team captains

Seniors Libby Sugg and Allie Hancock were voted captains by their teammates for the 2019 season. The Cougars have played without captains for years, but the coaching staff believes the captains' presence will help the team play decisively and freely, as well as create a more player-driven team.

Sisters in softball

Arissa and Aubrielle Paulson are the the third set of sisters to play together on a BYU softball team. In the inaugural softball season (2000), twins Jamie and Bryn Kreipl were on the roster. Sisters Anna and Alexandra Hudson played together from 2012-13. Arissa is a redshirt sophomore pitcher and Aubrielle is a freshman outfielder. Their older sister Arianna was a pitcher on the team last year before graduating.

Gail Miller Field

BYU's field is part of Miller Park, a unique, combined baseball-softball facility. Baseball plays on Larry H. Miller field, while softball calls Gail Miller Field, a back-to-back mirror image of the pre-existing baseball field, home. It was the first combined facility of its kind when it opened in April 2001. BYU has a home record of 206-51 (.802) at the field.

Gail Miller Field has 2,100 chair seats all in the lower bowl, making it the fourth-largest on-campus NCAA softball facility at the time of it's creation. The field dimensions are 2,010 feet down the left-and right-field lines and 220 in center field.

GORDON EAKIN BYU HEAD COACH 2003-PRESENT

Eakin is entering his 17th season as the Cougars' head coach and his 20th season at BYU overall.

He was named head coach in July 2002 after working as an assistant coach since the softball program's inception in 2000. Since that time he has led the Cougars to five Mountain West Conference championships, one Western Athletic Conference tournament championship, three West Coast Conference championship and 12 NCAA tournament appearances.

The 2017 WCC Coach of the Year (fourth-consecutive year) has coached 13 All-Americans, 12 conference players of the year, six conference freshmen of the year, and six conference pitchers of the year during his tenure.

In 2010, Eakin guided the Cougars to 46 wins, the most in school history, as BYU advanced to the NCAA Super Regionals for the first time ever with wins over East Carolina and host Texas before ending its season at national runner-up Arizona. The Cougars finished second in the country in batting average, seventh in scoring and ninth in slugging percentage as a team.

Known as one of the best hitting coaches in the country,

Eakin has helped BYU finish in the top-ten nationally seven times in slugging percentage, six times in home runs per game, four times in batting average and four times in scoring.

In addition to his duties at BYU, Eakin was also an assistant coach and hitting coach for the USA National Team in 2009. In the summer of 2010, Eakin helped guide the National Team to a 17-2 record as USA won the World Championship in Venezuela, the World Cup in Oklahoma and the Japan Cup championship in Sendai, Japan.

Before entering the coaching ranks, Eakin was a successful baseball and softball player. After playing collegiate baseball at the University of Utah, Eakin signed with the Oakland Athletics organization where he played for three years.

Eakin went on to join the United States All-Star team, playing in three U.S. Olympic sports festivals in 1986, 1993 and 1994, winning bronze, silver and gold, respectively. While on the team, Eakin was honored on the ISC All-World First Team and was an ASA All-American. He would later go on to play shortstop on the internationally ranked Larry H. Miller Toyota Fast Pitch team, eventually earning induction into the Utah Fast Pitch Hall of Fame in 1998.

Eakin is a native of Holladay, Utah, and graduated from Granite High. He currently resides in Sandy, Utah, and is married to Barbi. They are the parents of three children (Alicia, Ryan & Parker) and have five grandsons.
