2 The number of preseason All-WCC honorees for BYU in TJ Haws and Yoeli Childs. Last season, Haws and Childs were both All-WCC Freshman Team honorees and Haws was named to the All-WCC First Team. Since joining the WCC in 2011, the Cougars have had two players on the All-WCC First Team each year.

8 The number of 20-point games for Elijah Bryant and Yoeli Childs this season. Bryant has netted 20-plus points against Mississippi Valley State (27), Princeton (22), Niagara (22), Utah (29), Portland (22), at Pacific (29), Pepperdine (25) and Loyola Marymount (29). Childs has scored 20-plus against Niagara (21), Alabama (21), Utah Valley (24), Idaho State (20), Portland (26), Saint Mary's (29), Pepperdine (21) and Santa Clara (22).

4:44 The amount of time remaining against UMass when BYU trailed by double figures for the final time, 61-51. It was the latest in a game the Cougars have trailed by double figures and comeback to win in the Rose era. BYU won by a final score of 68-66.

12 The number of consecutive seasons BYU has won at least 20 games. BYU has also reached the postseason in 12-straight seasons. Both streaks are program records.

15 The number of career double-doubles for sophomore forward Yoeli Childs. He had five as a freshman and has 10 this season. His double-doubles this season have come against Mississippi Valley State (13 points, 10 rebounds), vs. Alabama (21 and 11), vs. UMass (19 and 11), at Utah Valley (24 and 11), vs. Utah State (10 and 10), Portland (26 and 13), Saint Mary's (29 and 10), Pepperdine (21 and 12), at Santa Clara (22 and 13) and Loyola Marymount (15 and 10).

25 The number of consecutive free throws BYU made between the end of the Princeton game through the first half of the UT Arlington game. The Cougars made their final 17 attempts to finish at Princeton and all eight of their attempts in the first half of the UT Arlington game. Between the two games, BYU hit 44 of 49 (89.8 percent).

25 Dave Rose reached 300 wins in his 407th career game on Feb. 4, 2017. He is tied with Bob Knight and John Thompson for 25th fastest to 300 career wins in NCAA history.

26 BYU posted a season-best 26 assists on 32 made field goals at Santa Clara. Yoeli Childs had a career-best eight assists and Jahshire Hardnett tied his career best with five assists. The previous season high in assists was 25 at Utah Valley.

27 The number of consecutive free throws Elijah Bryant has made over the last five games, tied for the eighth longest streak of consecutive free throws made in BYU history with Stephen Rogers. The longest streak is 50, set by Tyler Haws. Bryant also has streaks of 18-straight makes and 13-straight makes this season.

79.2 BYU's first half field goal percentage at Santa Clara, its best shooting half of the season. It is also the Cougars' best field goal percentage in a half since BYU hit 82.4 percent (14 of 17) in the second half vs. Air Force in Provo on Feb. 23, 2004.

322 Dave Rose (2005 to present) is second all-time in BYU basketball history with 322 career victories, behind only the great Stan Watts, who coached the Cougars to 371 wins from 1949 to 1972 and was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in 1986.

THE BASKETBALL HALL OF FAME: HOOPHALL AWARDS

BYU sophomore guard TJ Haws is a preseason candidate for the 2018 Jeff West Shooting Guard of the Year Award, presented by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Haws earned first-team All-WCC honors in 2016-17 while averaging 13.8 points, 2.9 rebounds, 3.2 assists and 1.0 steal. The Alpine, Utah, native also hit a team-high 76 3-pointers, second all-time among BYU freshmen.

LAST TIME OUT – HAWS AND HARDNETT GIVE BYU 74-58 WIN OVER SAN DIEGO

PROVO, Utah – TJ Haws and Jahshire Hardnett registered career nights to help BYU men's basketball beat San Diego 74-58 at the Marriott Center on Saturday night.

Haws tied his season-high 24 points, leading the Cougars in scoring and had a career-high of four steals. Hardnett scored a career-high 17 points and grabbed a career high eight rebounds.

San Diego (13-7, 4-4 WCC) won the tip and scored the first basket of the game on a jump shot. BYU (17-4, 6-2 WCC) missed three consecutive shots, but tied the game 2-2 with a pair of free-throws by Yoeli Childs with 18:09 left in the first half.

Both teams struggled shooting from the field early on and the Toreros took a 4-6 lead with 15 minutes left in the first period. The Cougars answered with baskets on back-to-back offensive possessions from Haws and Childs to give BYU an 8-6 lead.

The Cougars' shots started to fall when Haws hit his first 3-point shot of the game and Childs scored in the post off

an offensive rebound. This pushed the Cougars' lead to 15-9 with 11:28 left in the half.

San Diego's Olin Carter III scored seven consecutive points to help the Toreros complete a 10-4 run and even the game at 19-19 with 7:11 left in the first half.

Elijah Bryant scored five points off of two free-throws and a trey to help BYU answer with a 10-2 run to give BYU a 29-21 lead with 3:49 left in the period.

Harnett drew an offensive foul to give the Cougars the final shot of the half with 0:10 left on the clock. Haws' 3-point shot from the top of the arc rattled out as the buzzer sounded and sent BYU into the locker room with a 35-26 advantage.

San Diego opened up the half with seven straight points in the first few minutes to close the gap to 35-33. Haws scored the first basket for BYU with 16:15 left in the game after the Cougars missed scoring in their first five possessions. The Toreros took advantage of BYU's cold shooting to take a

38-37 lead. Haws answered with a 3-pointer on the ensuing possession to give the Cougars the lead once again.

Luke Worthington stole the ball from the Toreros and Childs capitalized off the turnover with a bucket from beyond the arc. A jumper by Worthington and another Haws trey extended BYU's lead to 51-43 with just under 10 minutes remaining in the game.

A jumper by Carter III cut the Cougar lead to five points, but Haws drove through the lane to score a layup to push BYU's lead back to seven with a score of 55-48 with 6:29 left in the second half.

BYU started to pull away from the Toreros in the final five minutes. Haws started a run with his fourth 3-point shot from deep. Hardnett grabbed his eighth rebound and was fouled scoring a fast break layup. His made free throw gave BYU a 67-54 lead with 3:26 left.

Hardnett closed the game off with a 3-pointer to extend BYU's lead to 16 points and a 74-58 victory.
