GAME STORYLINES

- BYU is looking to increase its two game win-streak after beating Kansas 3-2 and Utah Valley 3-0 at South Field last week.
- Senior forward Nadia Gomes was named this weeks WCC Player of the Week after scoring three key goals against Kansas and UVU. Her first goal against Kansas tied the game at 1-all and her second goal gave the Cougars a 2-1 lead going into halftime. Against UVU, she scored the first goal to give BYU an early lead.
- Gomes is leading the Cougar offense with 4 goals and 2 assists for a total of 10 points. Gomes is climbing her way up in the program's record book. She has claimed the 15th spot with 22 career goals and is tied for 12th place with 21 career assists.
- The BYU offense is picking up after a slow start. In the last five games they have scored a total of 11 goals for a 3-1-1 record.
- Six different Cougars have found the back of the net this season. Senior forwards Avery Walker and Madie Lyons Mathews, sophomore forward Elise Flake and freshman forward Cameron Tucker each have two goals on the season.
- Senior midfielder Bizzy Bowen scored her first goal of the season against Utah Valley.
- The shutout against Utah Valley was the third of the season.
- The game against San Diego is the opener for West Coast Conference play.

South Field



BYU fans flocked to South Field in big numbers in 2016. There were an average of 2,957 spectators per game at the Cougars' home field, which led the nation for the second-straight year.

Work on the field began immediately after the season ended. The field was dug out and leveling and drainage work were done. Concrete was added to the press area. The grass was replaced and ready for camps in the summer.

BYU has played at South Field since the program existed. The record was set on September 1, 2017 when 5,735 fans gathered to watch the Cougars take on No. 1 UCLA.

2016 Success

The Cougars were a national powerhouse in 2016. They were ranked in the top 5 nationally in six of 11 weeks of rankings. Two weeks saw them at No. 3 in the nation.

BYU won a fifth-straight West Coast Conference title and advanced to the third round of the NCAA tournament, where they lost 1-0 to host and top-seed South Carolina.

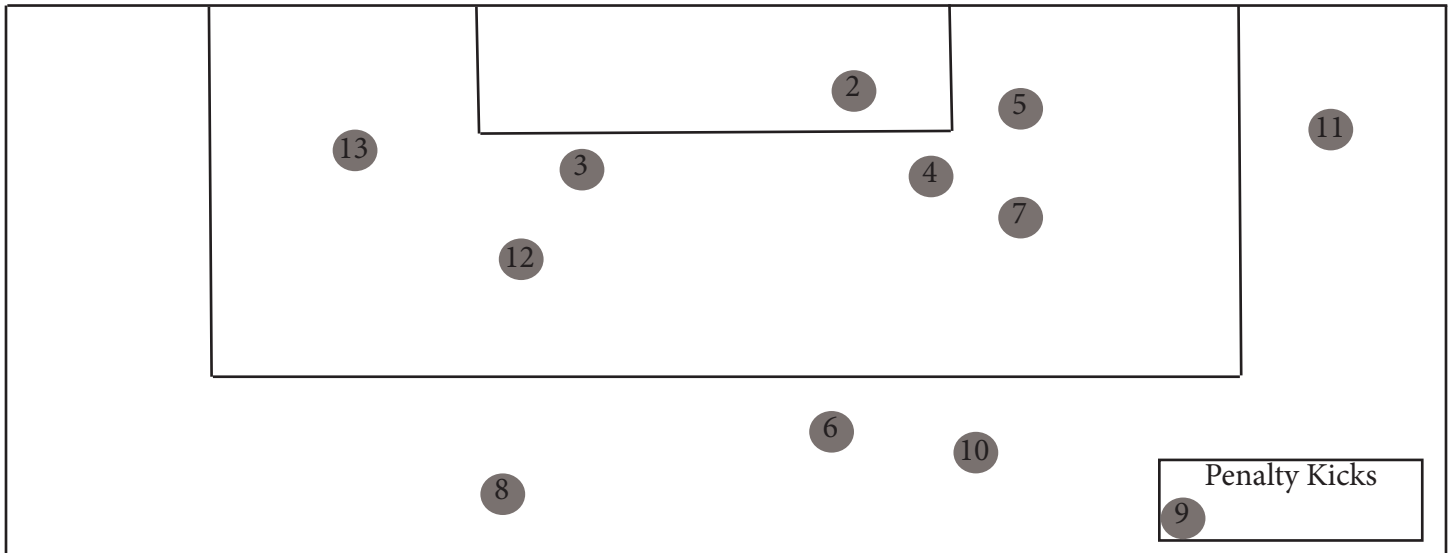

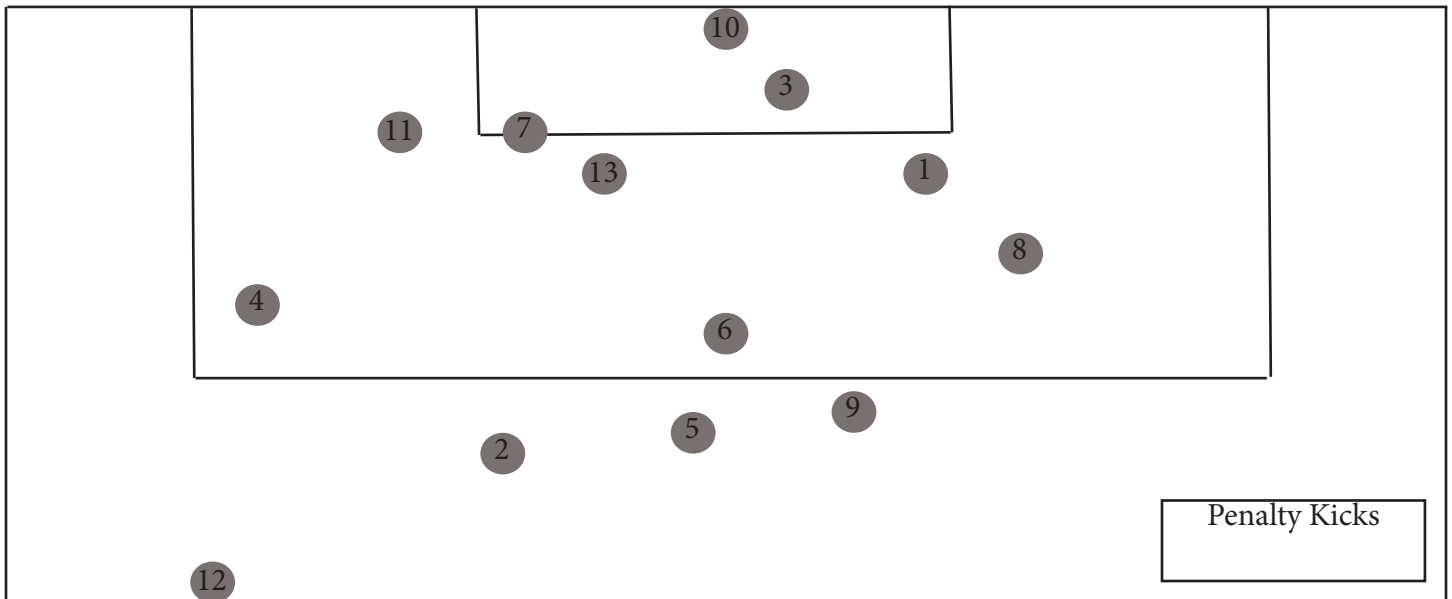
