BYU STORYLINES

- With 29 points at Pacific and 25 vs. Pepperdine at home, Elijah Bryant has scored 20-plus points in back-to-back games for the second time this season. In the last two games, the junior from Gwinnett, Georgia, is averaging 27.0 points and 4.5 rebounds while shooting 66.7 percent (18-27) from the field, 50.0 percent (8-16) from 3-point range and 100.0 percent (10-10) from the free-throw line.
- Yoeli Childs had one of his best all-around games in BYU's win over Pepperdine, totaling 21 points, 12 rebounds, six assists, one block and three steals. The six assists tie a career high set in the season opener.
- In his fifth start of the season and first since game five, Zac Seljaas was a perfect 3 of 3 from the field for eight points while adding three rebounds, four assists, one block and one steal.

2 The number of preseason All-WCC honorees for BYU in TJ Haws and Yoeli Childs. Last season, Haws and Childs were both All-WCC Freshman Team honorees and Haws was named to the All-WCC First Team. Since joining the WCC in 2011, the Cougars have had two players on the All-WCC First Team each year.

7 The number of 20-point games for Elijah Bryant and Yoeli Childs the season. Bryant has netted 20-plus points against Mississippi Valley State (27), Princeton (22), Niagara (22), Utah (29), Portland (22), at Pacific (29) and Pepperdine (25). Childs has scored 20-plus against Niagara (21), Alabama (21), Utah Valley (24), Idaho State (20), Portland (26), Saint Mary's (29) and Pepperdine (21)

10 The number of steals BYU recorded against UMass, a season high and the most by the Cougars since Dec. 20, 2016 when BYU had 13 vs. Idaho State. Elijah Bryant had a team-best three while Yoeli Childs and Jahshire Hardnett had two apiece and TJ Haws, Rylan Bergersen and Payton Dastrup had one each.

12 The number of 3-point field goals made by BYU in the season opener vs. Mississippi State, tied for the most by a Cougar team in a season opener. BYU also made 12 in the 2003-04 season opener vs. Southern Utah. Twelve 3-point field goals is also a 2017-18 season high and it was matched at Utah Valley.

12 The number of consecutive seasons BYU has won at least 20 games. BYU has also reached the postseason in 12-straight seasons. Both streaks are program records.

13 The number of career double-doubles for sophomore forward Yoeli Childs. He had five as a freshman and has seven this season. His double-doubles this season have come against Mississippi Valley State (13 points, 10 rebounds), Alabama (21 and 11), UMass (19 and 11), Utah Valley (24 and 11), Utah State (10 and 10), Portland (26 and 13), Saint Mary's (29 and 10) and Pepperdine (21 and 12).

25 BYU posted a season-best 25 assists on 30 made field goals at Utah Valley. Four different players had four-plus assists, including McKay Cannon (6), Yoeli Childs (4), Elijah Bryant (4) and TJ Haws (4).

25 The number of consecutive free throws BYU made between the end of the Princeton game through the first half of the UT Arlington game. The Cougars made their final 17 attempts to finish at Princeton and all eight of their attempts in the first half of the UT Arlington game. Between the two games, BYU hit 44 of 49 (89.8 percent).

25 Dave Rose reached 300 wins in his 407th career game on Feb. 4, 2017. He is tied with Bob Knight and John Thompson for 25th fastest to 300 career wins in NCAA history.

319 Dave Rose (2005 to present) is second all-time in BYU basketball history with 319 career victories, behind only the great Stan Watts, who coached the Cougars to 371 wins from 1949 to 1972 and was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in 1986.

THE BASKETBALL HALL OF FAME: HOOPHALL AWARDS

BYU sophomore guard TJ Haws is a preseason candidate for the 2018 Jeff West Shooting Guard of the Year Award, presented by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Haws earned first-team All-WCC honors in 2016-17 while averaging 13.8 points, 2.9 rebounds, 3.2 assists and 1.0 steal. The Alpine, Utah, native also hit a team-high 76 3-pointers, second all-time among BYU freshmen.

LAST TIME OUT – BRYANT AND CHILDS LEAD BYU TO DOMINANT WIN OVER PEPPERDINE

PROVO, Utah – Elijah Bryant and Yoeli Childs led BYU to a dominant 83-63 win over Pepperdine Thursday night in the Marriott Center.

"This was a good bounce-back win for our guys," BYU head coach Dave Rose said. "The first half they had us spread out pretty well. I think we made some nice adjustments at halftime and were much more aggressive offensively in the second half."

Bryant led the Cougars with 25 points and was 5 from 8 in the 3-point range. Childs tied his career-high of six assists, contributed 21 points and grabbed 12 rebounds. TJ Haws added 10 points and McKay Cannon had eight off the bench.

A free-throw and layup from Childs gave BYU (13-4, 2-2 WCC) the edge over Pepperdine (3-13, 0-4 WCC) early in the game. Jahshire Hardnett contributed a 3-pointer, helping the Cougars maintain their early lead of 6-2.

With under sixteen minutes remaining, Bryant scored a

3-pointer and grabbed a steal that resulted in a layup to give BYU a 13-9 advantage.

Childs scored three consecutive dunks, giving the Cougars a 19-14 lead with 12:15 remaining in the half. The Waves continued to stay in the game, and with a tied score of 24-all with under seven minutes left in the half, a pair of Bryant free-throws pulled the Cougars ahead 26-24.

Buckets from Zac Seljaas, Bryant and Haws maintained the steady BYU lead the rest of the half, sending the Cougars into halftime on top 40-34.

At halftime, Bryant and Childs led the offense with 14 points apiece. BYU shot 60.9 percent from the field, while Pepperdine shot 56 percent.

Back-to-back Bryant 3-pointers and a Childs jumper gave BYU momentum early in the second half to extend the Cougar lead to 48-36. Buckets from Bryant and Seljaas gave BYU an 18-point lead with just over fifteen minutes remaining in the second half.

After the Waves went on a 5-0 run, the Cougars answered with a trey by Cannon and a jumper by Haws to keep BYU on top 71-47. A free throw from Luke Worthington gave BYU a 25-point lead, the largest of the night.

Free-throws from Haws and Evan Troy late in the second half solidified the Cougars' domination over the Waves 83-63.

The Cougars finished the game shooting 58.3 percent from the field, while Pepperdine shot 48 percent.

NOTES AND STORYLINES

All-Haws Team

TJ Haws earned first-team All-WCC honors as a freshman in 2016-17, becoming the third Haws in BYU history to earn all-league honors. His father Marty Haws earned first-team All-WAC honors as a senior in 1989-90 and his brother Tyler was a four-time all-league honoree. As a freshman in 2009-10, Tyler was named to the All-Mountain West Conference Third Team. Following a two-year mission for the LDS Church, Tyler earned first-team honors as a sophomore, junior and senior. In addition to joining his father and brother as an all-conference performer, TJ became the second Cougar in program history – the other being Danny Ainge – to earn first-team all-league honors as a freshman.

Dave Rose

BYU head coach Dave Rose has led the Cougars to one of the most successful eras in program history since taking over in 2005. His career record of 318-115 ranks him second in BYU history in total victories and first in winning percentage (.734). Rose has been named conference coach of the year three times, led the Cougars to four conference titles, eight NCAA tournament appearances, four NIT appearances, eight 25-win seasons and 12 20-win seasons.

BYU and the Postseason

Under Dave Rose, BYU has reached the postseason in 12-straight seasons, a school record. The previous record was six-straight seasons (1989-90 to 1994-95). During that time the Cougars have earned eight bids to the NCAA tournament and four to the NIT. The Cougars' eight NCAA tournament bids in the last 12 years are more than 200-plus NCAA Division I schools have since beginning their programs.
