SEASON REVIEW

BYU men's basketball finished the 2018-19 season with a record of 19-13 overall and tied for second in the West Coast Conference at 11-5. Following the season, Dave Rose retired as one of the most successful coaches in program history.

Over the past 14 years, Rose guided the Cougars to a record of 348-135, including eight trips to the NCAA Tournament and five bids to the National Invitational Tournament (NIT). Rose also won four conference titles, was named conference coach of the year three times and led BYU to 13 20-win seasons and eight 25-win seasons. He retired as BYU's all-time leader in winning percentage at 72.0 and second all-time in victories at 348.

In addition to the team success, Rose and the Cougars achieved, his players collected numerous accolades. Jimmer Fredette was the nation's scoring leader and the 2011 Consensus National Player of the Year and he and five other players received All-America recognition under Rose. Five players were named conference player of the year under Rose and 13 players collected 22 first-team all-conference honors.

Junior forward Yoeli Childs led the Cougars throughout the 2018-19 season, averaging team highs of 21.2 points and 9.7 rebounds while posting 17 double-doubles and 18 games with 20-plus points. He was named to the All-WCC First Team and the NABC and USBWA all-district first teams. Childs had a streak of three-straight games scoring 31 points against Weber State, Utah State and Utah, after which he was named the NCAA.com March Madness Player of the Week.

Junior guard TJ Haws started all 32 games in 2018-19, giving him a start in all 101 games played in his BYU career. Haws has also not missed a single game during his time as a Cougar. Haws averaged 17.8 points and 3.5 rebounds while leading the team in assists (5.1) and steals (1.2) per game. The 6-foot-4 guard was a team captain and earned All-WCC Second Team accolades and a spot on the NABC All-District 9 Second Team. Haws was also recognized for his success in the classroom as he earned Google Cloud Academic All-District 9 First Team and WCC All-Academic Team honors.

The 2018-19 roster featured a pair of seniors in Luke Worthington and McKay Cannon. Worthington was a four-year letterwinner for BYU and a team captain his junior and senior seasons. He appeared in 131 career games and started 63. As a senior, he averaged 2.8 points, 2.3 rebounds and shot 49.3 percent from the field. Worthington also earned a spot on the WCC All-Academic Team.

Cannon was a two-year letterwinner at BYU after transferring from Weber State. In 2018-19, he started 18 games, including the last 17 of the season. He averaged 3.4 points, 1.6 rebounds and 1.6 assists. In league play, he shot 47.4 percent from 3-point range.

Key contributions from upperclassmen also came from juniors Zac Seljaas and Nick Emery. Seljaas contributed 7.1 points and 3.5 rebounds while shooting 37.3 percent from 3-point range. He was second on the team with 44 makes from downtown. Emery returned after missing the 2017-18 season and pitched in 6.1 points, 1.7 rebounds and 1.8 assists per game.

The Cougars opened the season at No. 7/9 Nevada. BYU played even with the top 10 Wolfpack in the first half before falling behind in the second. The Cougars won their next five at home before suffering through a three-game losing streak. BYU bounced back with three-straight wins, including a home victory against Utah State before defeating Utah at Vivint Smart Home Arena in the Beehive Classic. BYU finished the nonconference season with an 8-7 record.

The Cougars won at Pacific to open WCC play and jumped out to a 4-1 record. After losing two of three, BYU won five-straight games, capped with comeback wins at San Diego and LMU. The Cougars trailed by as many as 14 at San Diego before coming back to win 88-82 in overtime. BYU trailed by 12 at LMU before rallying to win 70-62. The Cougars won at home against San Diego in the final game of the season to claim a tie for second in the WCC standings.

As the No. 3 seed, BYU fell to San Diego in the quarterfinals of the WCC Championships.

BY THE NUMBERS

- 1** This season marks the first time BYU men's basketball has had two players score 30-plus points three times each in the same season. Yoeli Childs eclipsed 30-plus against Weber State, Utah State and Utah and TJ Haws has scored 30-plus against Portland State, Pepperdine and San Diego (stat courtesy of Greg Wrubell, BYU Sports Network).
- 2** The number of teams in BYU history that have featured three players with 1,000-plus points each while playing together. Yoeli Childs, TJ Haws and Nick Emery played 23 games together in 2018-19 as 1,000-point scorers. The 1979-80 team played the final four games with Danny Ainge, Alan Taylor and Scott Runia as 1,000-point scorers.
- 18/22** The number of free throws made and attempted by TJ Haws at Pepperdine. The only player who has made and attempted more free throws in a single game in BYU history is Jimmer Fredette, who hit 23 of 24 vs. TCU in the 2010 Mountain West Championships.
- 37** The number of career double-doubles for Yoeli Childs – tied for third all-time in BYU history. He had five as a freshman, 15 as a sophomore in 2017-18 and 17 as a junior in 2018-19.
- 348** Dave Rose (2005 to present) finished his career second all-time in BYU basketball history with 348 career victories, behind only the great Stan Watts, who coached the Cougars to 371 wins from 1949 to 1972 and was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in 1986. Including his record at Dixie, Rose had 515 career wins as a head coach.
- 1,173** The number of career points for junior guard Nick Emery. He became the 50th player in BYU history to reach 1,000 career points and is currently 34th all-time in program history.
- 1,450** The number of career points for junior guard TJ Haws. He became the 52nd Cougar to reach 1,000 career points when he had 22 at Illinois State. Haws is currently 19th all-time.
- 1,609** The number of career points for junior forward Yoeli Childs. He became the 51st Cougar in program history to reach 1,000 career points when he totaled 24 vs. Oral Roberts. Childs finished the season 14th all-time in BYU history.

Cougars sign three to NLI's

During the November signing period, the Cougars signed three players to National Letters of Intent: Bernardo Da Silva, Nate Hansen and Shengzhe Li.

A 6-foot-9 forward from Brazil, Da Silva plays for Dave Evans at Wasatch Academy in Mount Pleasant, Utah. In 2017-18, he helped lead the Tigers to a 24-2 record, including a 12-game win streak to end the season. Da Silva also plays for the Utah Mountain Stars, coached by former Cougars Marty Haws and Kevin Nixon. During the summer of 2018, he averaged 14.8 points, 8.9 rebounds and 2.3 blocks.

Hansen hails from Provo, Utah, and plays for former Cougar Kevin Santiago at Timpview High School. In 2017-18, the 6-foot-3 guard helped lead the T-Birds to a record of 17-7 overall and 8-2 in region play while averaging 15.1 points and draining 53 3-pointers. He scored in double figures 18 times, had 20-plus points six times and registered season highs of 30 points, nine assists, eight steals and six 3-point field goals.

Originally from Shanghai, China, Li plays for former BYU assistant Jeff Reinert at Santa Margarita Catholic in Santa Margarita, California. A 6-foot-10 center, Li averaged 6.8 points and 5.6 rebounds while helping Santa Margarita to a record of 20-10 in 2017-18. Prior to playing for Santa Margarita, Li played two years in Spain for the Canarias Basketball Academy in Las Palmas. He also plays for the Pump N Run club during the AAU season.

NOTES AND STORYLINES

Dave Rose

BYU head coach Dave Rose led the Cougars to one of the most successful eras in program history from 2005-19. His career record of 348-135 ranks him second in BYU history in total victories and first in winning percentage (.720). Rose was named conference coach of the year three times, led the Cougars to four conference titles, eight NCAA tournament appearances, five NIT appearances, eight 25-win seasons and 13 20-win seasons.

Rose wins off the court

Rose won the 2018 ESPN INFINITI Coaches' Charity Challenge, raising more than \$100,000 for the BYU Simmons Center for Cancer Research. The Simmons Center in turn created the David and Cheryl Rose Family Student Cancer Research Endowment, a fellowship for BYU students conducting cancer research.

It's Academic

Team captains TJ Haws and Luke Worthington collected academic honors the week of Feb. 18. Both players were named to the WCC All-Academic Team – Haws a repeat honoree while Worthington was an honorable mention selection last season – and Haws was also named to the Google Cloud Academic All-District 8 Team.

Four star additions

Gavin Baxter (class of 2016), Connor Harding (2016) and Kolby Lee (2017) are all freshmen who were all ranked four-star recruits by ESPN.com. The Cougars also welcomed sophomore Jesse Wade, who was a four-star recruit in 2015 and a Gonzaga transfer.

Cougars with 1,000 points

In 2016-17, junior guard Nick Emery became the 50th player in Cougar history to score 1,000 career points and joined Tyler Haws, Danny Ainge and Eric Mika as the only BYU players to reach 1,000 career points as sophomores. Junior Yoeli Childs (Nov. 15) TJ Haws (Nov. 28) became the 51st and 52nd Cougars all-time and 15th and 16th under Rose to reach the milestone. The 16 players who have reached 1,000 points under Rose include the all-time leading scorer in Tyler Haws and the No. 2 scorer in Jimmer Fredette.

Tyler (2,720 points) and TJ Haws (1,440) are the third set of brothers to both reach 1,000 career points, joining Jackson (1,235) and Nick Emery (1,170) and Fred (1,841) and Ken Roberts (1,652). The Haws brothers are joined by their father Marty (1,337), who was also a 1,000-point scorer at BYU.

100 career 3-pointers

Junior guard TJ Haws reached 100 career 3-pointers in BYU's win at San Francisco last season, becoming the 23rd Cougar to reach the milestone. Junior guard Nick Emery was the 22nd Cougar to reach 100 3-pointers. Haws was fourth fastest to 100 career 3s in terms of games played while Emery is second. Junior Zac Seljaas hit a season-best five 3-pointers against Alabama A&M to reach 100 career 3s in 75 games, 12th fastest in BYU history.

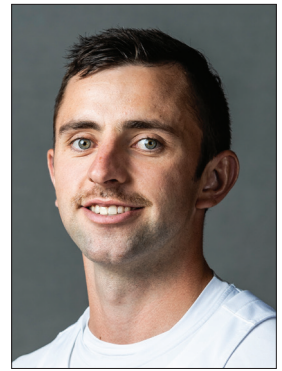

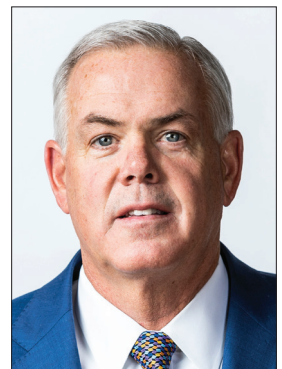
