GAME STORYLINES

- **SERIES NOTES.** BYU and UMass are playing for the second time. Last year the Minutemen visited Provo and the Cougars won 51-9. KJ Hall ran for 101 yards and one touchdown and BYU forced four turnovers in the game.
- **INDEPENDENT TEAMS.** This game features two FBS independent teams. UMass joined the FBS in 2012 and has been playing as an independent since 2016, while BYU played its first independent season in 2011. The Minutemen have gone 4-16 as an independent team while the Cougars are 55-34. BYU has faced fellow independent teams UMass and Notre Dame but has not matched up with Army yet. The Cougars will visit UMass next season at Gillette Stadium on November 10, 2018, home of the New England Patriots.
- **NOVEMBER GAMES.** BYU is 32-7 since 2007 in the month of November, and a perfect 18-0 at home. BYU has not lost a home November game since a 41-34 overtime loss to Utah in 2005.
- **INJURY BUG.** BYU has had 37 different players miss significant time with an injury this season. Of those 37, 25 have been members of the two-deep and 13 have been projected starters.
- **HONORING LAVELL.** Legendary hall of famer and beloved head coach at BYU for 29 seasons, LaVell Edwards, passed away on Dec. 29, 2016. The always steady and humble coach will be honored in several ways throughout the season, including the team wearing a uniform patch featuring his classic stoic profile he displayed for decades on the Cougar sidelines.

MINUTEMEN CLAIM FENWAY GRIDIRON SERIES WIN OVER MAINE, 44-31

BOSTON – Three touchdown receptions from junior wide receiver Andy Isabella and an interception returned for a touchdown by Lee Moses propelled Massachusetts football to a 44-31 victory over Maine during the Fenway Gridiron Series, hosted at Fenway Park, on Saturday. The win was head coach Mark Whipple's 60th as the program leader – the most by a head coach in UMass football history.

Andrew Ford returned from a one-game absence due to injury and finished 21-of-39 with 355 yards passing and four touchdowns. Isabella had three of those over eight receptions covering 152 yards. Jessie Britt had the fourth among four catches for 52 yards.

On the ground, Marquis Young rushed for 123 yards over 19 carries (6.5 per attempt) and provided the game-sealing touchdown on a 33-yard fourth quarter scamper down the sideline. Young finished with 208 all-purpose yards as he added 61 kick return yards and added a 24-yard reception.

A pair of interceptions – one each by Moses and Jesse Monteiro – plus 12 pass pickups added up to a disruptive day from the secondary as the Minutemen limited Chris Ferguson to 16-of-41 passing (39.0 percent) with 232 yards and no touchdowns.

On the defensive front, Da'Sean Downey totaled 2.0 TFLs for 12 yards lost and increased his season total to 18.0 over nine appearances – tied for the second most in one season in program history.

Massachusetts began the scoring onslaught in the game's opening drive. The Minutemen were methodical in their movement down the field, capped off by Ford's 33-yard strike to Britt, who juiced a defender before he jogged into the endzone.

Maine immediately responded with a 95-yard kickoff return as Earnes Edwards cut through the middle of the UMass special teams and evened the game at 7-all.

Isabella caught back-to-back touchdown balls, including a career-high-tying 69-yard grab, as Massachusetts struck to a 21-7 lead before the end of the first quarter. Laurent bumped the lead to 24-7 with his 41-yard field goal at the 10-minute, 20-second mark of the second quarter.

The Black Bears fought back with three consecutive scores, eventually evening the game at 24-all exactly five minutes into the third quarter. A Ferguson nine-yard run started the streak, which also featured a safety on Ford by Connor Walsh. Josh Mack plunged in from one yard away for the game-tying touchdown.

However, Ford and Isabella connected again on a 14-yard, left-corner, toe-drag tally with 2:42 to play in the third. Ford rolled left and bought time for Isabella, who created enough separation from the Maine defense with his speed to nab the reception before he ran through the back of the endzone and into the Fenway Park padding and home plate netting.

Moses distanced the Minutemen only 94 seconds later when he picked off Ferguson at the UMass 30 and rolled with an

Massachusetts continues its season on the road at BYU with a Sat., Nov. 18 game. Kickoff is slated for 3 p.m. (ET) on ESPN3 and BYUtv.

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR SEVEN

The 13-game independent schedule features teams from six different conferences and an independent team. Four games are against Power Five opponents, including teams from the Pac-12, Big Ten and SEC. The opponents on the 2017 features six bowl teams from 2016.

The Cougars will host six home games and have six true road contests with one neutral site game at a NFL stadium. The home schedule consists of Portland State, Utah, Wisconsin, Boise State, San Jose State and UMass. The season's single neutral site game against LSU will be played at NRG Stadium, home of the Houston Texans.



BOWLING OPPONENTS

Of BYU's 13 opponents in 2016, six played in a bowl game last year: LSU, Utah, Wisconsin, Boise State, Mississippi State and Hawai'i.

BYU VS. POWER 5 TEAMS

BYU is tied for the most wins (23) over Power 5 opponents by a non-Power 5 school since 2003. The Cougars also have the longest streak among non-Power 5 teams with 11 consecutive seasons with at least one win over a Power 5 opponent.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's record at LaVell Edwards Stadium is ranked No. 12 among teams playing in their current stadium.

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates missions around the world in 150 nations speaking more than 160 languages. More than 70,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions in 422 missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours — seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples) — teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

About 64 percent of the current team has served an LDS mission. Members of the team have served in 28 different countries and six of the seven continents around the globe. BYU currently has about 30 members of the team (previous signees or on roster) that are currently serving in the mission field.

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recruiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. More than 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now, several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff.

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA. His staff includes Polynesians Ilaisa Tuiaki, Steve Kaufusi, Reno Mahe, Nu'u Tafisi, Russell Tialavea, Tevita Ofahengae, Jack Damuni, Jasen Ah You, Sione Kinikini, Vince Feula and Harvey Unga.

FORMER PLAYERS ON STAFF

There are 20 former BYU football players on the football and athletic administration staff. Members of the staff were part of Cougar teams that won the 1980 "Miracle Bowl," the 1984 National Championship, Heisman Trophy, 1996 Cotton Bowl along with many other accolades. CANADA'S CAREER NIGHT IGNITES BYU IN 31-21 WIN OVER UNLV

LAS VEGAS – Squally Canada's career highs of 213 rushing yards on 25 carries lifted the BYU football team to a 31-21 win over UNLV Friday night at Sam Boyd Stadium. Canada took the pressure off true freshman quarterback Joe Critchlow in his first career start. Critchlow completed 14 of 22 passes for 160 yards and one touchdown.

Canada's rushing numbers mark the ninth-most rushing yards by a BYU player in a single game. Aleva Hifo caught six passes for 58 yards and one touchdown while Matt Bushman had 52 yards on five receptions. The Cougar defense held the Rebels to 122 rushing yards, less than half of the Rebel average for the season. Micah Hannemann led BYU with nine tackles, including seven solo stops. Zayne Anderson and Fred Warner added one interception apiece.

On UNLV's opening drive, Corbin Kaufusi sacked quarterback Johnny Stanton for a loss of nine yards on a critical third down, forcing the Rebels to take a long field goal attempt. Kicker Evan Pantels missed a 47-yarder with 10:23 left in the first quarter.

Midway through the second quarter, Anderson recorded his second career interception in the end zone and shifted momentum BYU's way en route to a seven-play, 80-yard scoring drive for the road team.

A mix of personnel helped put the Cougars' first points on the board. Running back Austin Kafentzis saw time in the wildcat package and rushed for 20 yards. Critchlow sent a 30-yard pass to Micah Simon over the middle. Hifo caught a 19-yard pass just shy of a touchdown. Brayden El-Bakri rushed one yard into the end zone for his second career touchdown and kicker Rhett Almond hit the extra point to put BYU up 7-0 with 9:06 on the clock.

Lexington Thomas rushed one yard on the third down to even the score 7-7 with 4:25 in the half. BYU responded with an 11-play, 74-yard scoring drive for a 14-7 lead heading into halftime. Critchlow completed 5 of 7 on the drive for 50 yards, including a two-yard quarterback sneak on fourth down. Hifo caught an 11-yard pass with 27 seconds left and managed to keep one foot in bounds long enough to earn the touchdown.

Canada opened the second half with a career-long 54-yard run, sparking a four-play, 68-yard scoring drive in under two minutes. Canada also rushed two yards for his fourth rushing touchdown of the season, extending BYU's lead 21-7.

Midway through the third quarter, a holding penalty called Almond's 34-yard field goal back and Almond missed the second attempt wide right with five more yards tacked on. UNLV capitalized on its following possession with an 18-yard touchdown pass to close the gap, 21-14.

Canada rushed 33 yards on four carries and Critchlow threw a 16-yard pass to Talon Shumway, setting up Kafentzis' first career touchdown on an 11-yard rush from the wildcat. The score gave the Cougars a 28-14 advantage with 1:40 in the quarter. In the fourth quarter, the Rebels connected on a 13-yard touchdown pass with 10:46 on the clock, 28-21.

Almond hit a 28-yard field goal to make it a two-score game, 31-21, with 5:39 on the clock. After the BYU defense forced a three-and-out, BYU gave the ball back on downs with 1:45 to go. On the Rebels' first play, Warner intercepted a pass at the UNLV 29-yard line and returned it 26 yards to the three-yard line, sealing BYU's 31-21 victory.

BYU OFFENSE BY THE NUMBERS

3 Tight end Matt Bushman is No. 3 among FBS tight ends with 45 receptions on the year. His 453 yards rank No. 8 among FBS tight ends. He is the top freshman tight end in the FBS in receptions and yards.

4 BYU is No. 4 nationally in tackles for loss allowed per game at just 3.27. The Cougars have been stopped behind the line of scrimmage just 36 times in 11 games, including sacks. In 2016, BYU was ranked No. 24, allowing 4.92 tackles for loss per game.

135 BYU has a lot of experience on the offensive line, including three seniors in the middle with Tejan Koroma (49 starts), Tuni Kanuch (27 starts) and Keyan Norman (24 starts). As a unit, the Cougar offensive line has 135 combined starts. BYU has had the same starting five for every game this season.

200x3 The Cougar offense has rushed for over 200 yards in three games this season, including twice in the last three games. BYU ran for 210 earlier in the year against Utah State, 266 against San Jose State and 265 last week against UNLV.

213 Squally Canada ran for 213 yards against UNLV for a career best. The 213 yards rank as the ninth-most rushing yards by a BYU player in a single game. It was the biggest rushing output by one player since Jamaal Williams ran for 286 against Toledo in 2016.

THE BYU OFFENSE

- **IN GOOD COMPANY.** With 45 receptions and 453 yards, freshman tight end Matt Bushman has the most catches and yards of any BYU tight end in a single season since Dennis Pitta in 2009. The All-American Pitta finished his senior campaign with 62 receptions and 829 yards.
- **STAYING POSITIVE.** BYU's offense has not been caught behind the line of scrimmage often, allowing just 3.27 tackles for loss per game, good for No. 4 nationally. The Cougars have allowed only 36 tackles behind the line of scrimmage this season, including 17 sacks. Missouri, the No. 1 team nationally, has given up 27 TFL while No. 130, Kent State, has given up 91.
- **YOUNG GUNS.** As many as 15 underclassmen are part of the two-deep on the offensive side of the ball, including four true freshman. One of the Cougars' current top rushers is true freshman Ula Toluta'u with 72 carries for 303 yards and two touchdowns while the top receiver is tight end Matt Bushman with 45 receptions and 453 yards. BYU's first touchdown of the year was scored by freshman Neil Pau'u. Freshman quarterback Joe Critchlow just earned the start against UNLV.
- **QUARTERBACKS.** Due to various injuries, BYU has had five different players take snaps at quarterback this year. Tanner Mangum has started eight games while Beau Hoge has started the other two. The Cougars have also had Koy Detmer Jr. see time as well as true freshman Joe Critchlow getting the last start at UNLV. Sophomore Austin Kafentzis has also seen time as a wildcat option quarterback. BYU has had at least two different quarterbacks start games every year over the past four seasons and in seven of the last eight seasons.

THE BYU DEFENSE

- **NO CHUNK PLAYS.** The Cougar defense has done a solid job not allowing the big play. BYU's defense ranks No. 26 in plays of 20 yards or more allowed, giving up just 37 plays. The team ranks No. 37 in plays allowed of 30 yards or more from the line of scrimmage with just 17 allowed all year.
- **TAKITAKI TIME.** Sione Takitaki is leading the Cougar defense in tackles for loss and sacks with 9.5 and 3.5, respectively, this year. He notched his best game in his first back since missing the 2016 season in the 2017 season opener with seven tackles, 3.0 tackles for loss and two sacks.
- **CHANGE OF NAME.** Known as Dayan Lake his freshman year, Dayan now goes by the last name of "Ghanwoloku" to honor his uncle and father's family from Liberia.

Kalani Sitake (pronounced kah-lah-nee see-tah-kay) was named head coach overseeing the BYU football program on December 19, 2015, by director of athletics Tom Holmoe.

Sitake is the 14th head coach in BYU history. He comes to BYU from Oregon State, where he served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator.

A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake returns to his alma mater with 15 years of coaching experience, including seven years a defensive coordinator and four seasons as an assistant head coach.

Prior to serving as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator at Oregon State in 2015, Sitake spent 10 seasons at the University of Utah. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012.

Sitake has coached several Pac-12 and Mountain West Conference honorees, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014). He also helped mentor 14 NFL Draft picks during his time at Utah, including 12 all-league players and three freshmen All-Americans. He helped the Utes win seven of eight bowl games during his tenure.

Sitake began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002. Sitake then joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.

Born in Nuku'alofa, Tonga, and raised in Laie, Hawai'i and Provo, Utah, Sitake becomes the first FBS head football coach of Tongan descent. He is the 14th head coach in BYU history, and just the fourth since 1972, when Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards took over the program.

Sitake began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards.

He was named BYU's Football Scholar Athlete of the Year in 1998, Impact Player of the Year in 1999, along with team captain and the most valuable running back in 2000. He signed a free agent contract with the Cincinnati Bengals in 2001, but was forced to retire due to an injury.

Sitake graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. He and his wife Timberly have three children, Skye, Sadie and Kelaokalani (KK).
