BYU STORYLINES

- BYU has held 13 of its last 15 opponents under 70 points and is 13-2 during that period. The Cougars had a streak of six-straight games holding opponents below 70 to begin that stretch of 15 games and have held their last five opponents to fewer than 70 points. Last season BYU held opponents below 70 points 11 times.
- Over the last four games, Elijah Bryant has made all 23 of his free-throw attempts, a career-best streak for free throws made without a miss. Bryant also had a streak of 18-straight makes from Dec. 19-23 and a streak of 13-straight from Nov. 15-18.
- After hitting 79.2 percent from the field in the first half at Santa Clara, BYU hit 66.7 percent in the first half vs. LMU. The Cougars have shot better than 58.0 from the field in each of the last three games (58.3, 61.5, 59.5).

THE BASKETBALL HALL OF FAME: HOOPHALL AWARDS

BYU sophomore guard TJ Haws is a preseason candidate for the 2018 Jeff West Shooting Guard of the Year Award, presented by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Haws earned first-team All-WCC honors in 2016-17 while averaging 13.8 points, 2.9 rebounds, 3.2 assists and 1.0 steal. The Alpine, Utah, native also hit a team-high 76 3-pointers, second all-time among BYU freshmen.

BRYANT TIES SEASON HIGH AS BYU GETS PAST LMU

PROVO, Utah – Elijah Bryant tied a season-high with 29 points to help BYU to an 82-67 win over LMU Thursday night in the Marriott Center.

"It was a good win for our guys," BYU head coach Dave Rose said. "I thought we executed well in the first half and handled their pressure well. We turned the ball over a lot in the second half, but we were able to make big plays down the stretch and win the game."

The Cougars improved to 16-4, 5-2 (West Coast Conference) as the Lions went to 6-12, 1-6. Bryant was 8 of 12 from the field, 5 of 8 from 3-point range and a perfect 8 of 8 from the line. Yoeli Childs had 15 points, 10 rebounds and five blocks.

BYU hit 3-pointers for its first three buckets of the game, as Jahshire Hardnett, Bryant and TJ Haws all cashed in from beyond the arc. Bryant hit his second triple to give the Cougars a 14-5 lead four minutes in.

Bryant scored on back-to-back possessions to put BYU up

31-14 halfway through the first half.

With five minutes left in the first half, Payton Dastrup gave the Cougars a 20-point lead when he cut through the lane and threw down a dunk. LMU battled back to trail 43-29 with just two minutes until halftime.

Bryant buried a 3-pointer with less than a minute left to reach 20 points. BYU led 46-29 going into the locker room.

BYU started slowly in the second half but Zac Seljaas knocked down a 3-pointer and made a layup on consecutive possessions for a 51-34 lead with 16:09 on the clock.

The Lions once again chipped away and trailed 62-50 halfway through the second half. They cut the Cougar lead to single digits before Bryant and Hardnett made four-straight free throws to put BYU up 74-61.

Two more Bryant free throws gave the junior 29 points and made it an 80-64 lead. Childs' putback dunk on the next possession put the Cougars up 18 with two minutes left.

BYU cruised to the 82-67 win.

NOTES AND STORYLINES

All-Haws Team

TJ Haws earned first-team All-WCC honors as a freshman in 2016-17, becoming the third Haws in BYU history to earn all-league honors. His father Marty Haws earned first-team All-WAC honors as a senior in 1989-90 and his brother Tyler was a four-time all-league honoree. As a freshman in 2009-10, Tyler was named to the All-Mountain West Conference Third Team. Following a two-year mission for the LDS Church, Tyler earned first-team honors as a sophomore, junior and senior. In addition to joining his father and brother as an all-conference performer, TJ became the second Cougar in program history – the other being Danny Ainge – to earn first-team all-league honors as a freshman.

Dave Rose

BYU head coach Dave Rose has led the Cougars to one of the most successful eras in program history since taking over in 2005. His career record of 321-115 ranks him second in BYU history in total victories and first in winning percentage (.736). Rose has been named conference coach of the year three times, led the Cougars to four conference titles, eight NCAA tournament appearances, four NIT appearances, eight 25-win seasons and 12 20-win seasons.

BYU and the Postseason

Under Dave Rose, BYU has reached the postseason in 12-straight seasons, a school record. The previous record was six-straight seasons (1989-90 to 1994-95). During that time the Cougars have earned eight bids to the NCAA tournament and four to the NIT. The Cougars' eight NCAA tournament bids in the last 12 years are more than 200-plus NCAA Division I schools have since beginning their programs.
