

#### THE BASKETBALL HALL OF FAME: HOOPHALL AWARDS

BYU sophomore guard TJ Haws is a preseason candidate for the 2018 Jeff West Shooting Guard of the Year Award, presented by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Haws earned first-team All-WCC honors in 2016-17 while averaging 13.8 points, 2.9 rebounds, 3.2 assists and 1.0 steal. The Alpine, Utah, native also hit a team-high 76 3-pointers, second all-time among BYU freshmen.

#### LAST TIME OUT - BYU RALLIES LATE IN COMEBACK WIN VS. UMASS

BROOKLYN, N.Y. – BYU men's basketball came back from a 12-point deficit to edge past UMass 68-66 Saturday afternoon in the Cougars' final game of the Barclays Center Classic.

"The challenge at halftime was that your effort has to be sustained by your will and determination, not by how you're playing," BYU head coach Dave Rose said. "That is where we won the game. It was all effort and execution in the second half, sustained over a long period of time."

Yoeli Childs earned his third double-double of the season with 19 points and 11 rebounds. Elijah Bryant and Jashire Hardnett added 18 and 10 points, respectively.

After UMass shot 56.5 percent in the first half, BYU held the Minutemen to 34.5 percent in the second. The Cougars outrebounded UMass 43 to 31.

Down by 10 points with 4:44 left to play, the Cougars went on an 11-0 run with contributions from Hardnett, Payton Dastrup, Childs and Bryant. A 3-pointer from

Bryant brought BYU within one, 61-60, and his perfect trip to the charity stripe with 1:55 on the clock gave the Cougars their first lead 62-61 since midway through the first half.

The lead changed hands twice more before the Cougars jumped ahead 66-63 on a pair of free throws by Hardnett. Rashaan Holloway then completed a three-point play for UMass with 13 seconds to go, tying the score at 66-all.

After a timeout, Hardnett drove left and connected with an open Childs who dunked to solidify BYU's win 68-66 with four seconds left.

To open the game, Childs sparked the Cougar effort with nine unanswered points on a 3-pointer and back-to-back-to-back jumpers to go up 9-0 with 16:31 on the clock.

The Minutemen then went on a 10-2 run to trail by one, 11-10, midway through the first half.

UMass took its first lead of the game, 18-17, midway through the half. A 3-pointer from Zac Seljaas brought BYU within one, 21-20, but the Minutemen extended their lead to as many as 12 before taking a 10-point advantage at the half, 38-28.

BYU opened the second half on a 10-4 run to swing the momentum its way. Bryant hit a 3 and put a transition layup in to cut the deficit to four, 42-38 with 15:37 on the clock.

UMass steadily built its lead back up to 10 before the Cougars fought back with their late offensive push.

#### NOTES AND STORYLINES

#### Super Sophomores

BYU's 2017-18 roster includes three players who etched their names in the BYU record book during their freshman seasons. Yoeli Childs and TJ Haws were freshmen in 2016-17 while Zac Seljaas was a rookie in 2015-16. All three are back this season, looking to build on their record-setting freshman campaigns. Childs finished his freshman year first all-time among BYU freshmen in rebounds and second in rebounds per game, blocks, blocks per game and field goal percentage.

Haws concluded his first year second all-time among BYU freshmen in 3-point field goals, fourth in points scored, fifth in assists, tied for first in games started and third in double figure scoring games. Seljaas finished the 2015-16 season first all-time among BYU freshmen in 3-point field goal percentage, second in 3-point field goals, second in 3-point field goals per game, second in games with 3-plus 3-point field goals and tied for second most games with 5-plus 3-pointers.

#### All-Haws Team

TJ Haws earned first-team All-WCC honors as a freshman in 2016-17, becoming the third Haws in BYU history to earn all-league honors. His father Marty Haws earned first-team All-WAC honors as a senior in 1989-90 and his brother Tyler was a four-time all-league honoree. As a freshman in 2009-10, Tyler was named to the All-Mountain West Conference Third Team. Following a two-year mission for the LDS Church, Tyler earned first-team honors as a sophomore, junior and senior. In addition to joining his father and brother as an all-conference performer, TJ became the second Cougar in program history – the other being Danny Ainge – to earn first-team all-league honors as a freshman.

#### Dave Rose

BYU head coach Dave Rose has led the Cougars to one of the most successful eras in program history since taking over in 2005. His career record of 309-113 ranks him second in BYU history in total victories and first in winning percentage (.732). Rose has been named conference coach of the year three times, led the Cougars to four conference titles, eight NCAA tournament appearances, four NIT appearances, eight 25-win seasons and 12 20-win seasons.

#### BYU and the Postseason

Under Dave Rose, BYU has reached the postseason in 12-straight seasons, a school record. The previous record was six-straight seasons (1989-90 to 1994-95). During that time the Cougars have earned eight bids to the NCAA tournament and four to the NIT. The Cougars' eight NCAA tournament bids in the last 12 years are more than 200-plus NCAA Division I schools have since beginning their programs.




