

• WCC PITCHER OF THE WEEK. Sophomore pitcher Kerisa Viramontes has been named the West Coast Conference Pitcher of the Week, her first of the season and second of her career. She pitched three complete games for BYU en route to a 0.28 ERA over 25.1 innings pitched. Viramontes opened the week throwing 199 pitches in a 12-inning walk-off loss at No. 10/11 LSU, giving up no earned runs in the complete game. She also pitched in BYU's 3-1 win against No. 13/14 Baylor, going seven innings with just five hits and one earned run allowed. Viramontes had seven strikeouts on the week while lowering her season ERA to 1.83.

. HOME RUN HEAT. BYU ranks No. 14 nationally and No. 1 in the WCC in home runs per game with 1.13. Eleven Cougars have hit 35 homers in 29 games so far this season, led by Rylee Jensen's six. 

Strength of schedule

The 2018 schedule features 17 2017 NCAA Regional teams, seven Super Regional teams and four Women's College World Series teams. In the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic, BYU plays Oklahoma, the 2016 and 2017 National Champions. The Cougars will face teams from 15 different conferences: the SEC, Pac-12, MWC, Big West, Big 12, Big Ten, Big Sky, American Athletic Conference, Big South, Colonial Athletic Association, Conference USA, Mid-Atlantic Conference, Southland Conference and Summit League.

WCC: Year five

BYU enters the fifth season in the West Coast Conference after jumping around following its departure from the Mountain West. The Cougars played in the Western Athletic Conference in 2012 and the Pacific Coast Softball Conference in 2013 before softball was added in the WCC beginning in the 2014 season. Spanning the four conferences, BYU has won nine conference titles in a row.

Team captains

Seniors Caltlyn Alldredge, Briielle Breland, Alexa Strid and junior Libby Sugg were voted captains by their teammates for the 2018 season. The Cougars have played without captains for years, but the coaching staff believes the captains' presence will help the team play decisively and freely, as well as create a more player-driven team.

Student-athletes

On and off the field, BYU softball players are making their mark. Arianna Paulson, Briielle Breland and Brooke Vander Heide garnered NFCA All-America Scholar-Athlete honors for the 2016-17 academic year after earning at least a 3.5 GPA. Paulson also received WCC Commissioner's Honor Roll Gold Honors (4.00-3.75) while Breland and Vander Heide gathered Silver Honors (3.74-3.50). Six Cougars claimed Bronze Honors (3.49-3.00): Ashley Thompson, Lauren Bell, McKenzie St. Clair, Libby Sugg, Arissa Paulson and Rylee Jensen. Bell and Thompson also received WCC All-Academic honors for their pursuit of academic excellence in conjunction with contributions to the team.

Sisters in softball

Arianna and Arissa Paulson are the third set of sisters to play together on a BYU softball team. In the inaugural softball season (2000), twins Jamie and Bryn Kreipl were on the roster. Sisters Anna and Alexandra Hudson played together from 2012-13. Arianna is a senior, Arissa is a sophomore and both are pitchers. They are from Payson, Arizona.

Gail Miller Field

BYU's field is part of Miller Park, a unique, combined baseball-softball facility. Baseball plays on Larry H. Miller field, while softball calls Gail Miller Field, a back-to-back mirror image of the pre-existing baseball field, home. It was the first combined facility of its kind when it opened in April 2001. BYU has a home record of 206-51 (.802) at the field.

Gail Miller Field has 2,100 chair seats all in the lower bowl, making it the fourth-largest on-campus NCAA softball facility at the time of it's creation. The field dimensions are 2,010 feet down the left-and right-field lines and 220 in center field.

GORDON EAKIN BYU HEAD COACH 2003-PRESENT

Eakin is entering his 16th season as the Cougars' head coach and his 19th season at BYU overall.

He was named head coach in July 2002 after working as an assistant coach since the softball program's inception in 2000. Since that time he has led the Cougars to five Mountain West Conference championships, one Western Athletic Conference tournament championship. three West Coast Conference championship and 12 NCAA tournament appearances.

The 2017 WCC Coach of the Year (fourth-consecutive year) has coached 13 All-Americans, 11 conference players of the year, five conference freshmen of the year, and five conference pitchers of the year during his tenure.

In 2010, Eakin guided the Cougars to 46 wins, the most in school history, as BYU advanced to the NCAA Super Regionals for the first time ever with wins over East Carolina and host Texas before ending its season at national runner-up Arizona. The Cougars finished second in the country in batting average, seventh in scoring and ninth in slugging percentage as a team.

Known as one of the best hitting coaches in the country,

Eakin has helped BYU finish in the top-ten nationally seven times in slugging percentage, six times in home runs per game, four times in batting average and four times in scoring.

In addition to his duties at BYU, Eakin was also an assistant coach and hitting coach for the USA National Team in 2009. In the summer of 2010, Eakin helped guide the National Team to a 17-2 record as USA won the World Championship in Venezuela, the World Cup in Oklahoma and the Japan Cup championship in Sendai, Japan.

Before entering the coaching ranks, Eakin was a successful baseball and softball player. After playing collegiate baseball at the University of Utah, Eakin signed with the Oakland Athletics organization where he played for three years.

Eakin went on to join the United States All-Star team, playing in three U.S. Olympic sports festivals in 1986, 1993 and 1994, winning bronze, silver and gold, respectively. While on the team, Eakin was honored on the ISC All-World First Team and was an ASA All-American. He would later go on to play shortstop on the internationally ranked Larry H. Miller Toyota Fast Pitch team, eventually earning induction into the Utah Fast Pitch Hall of Fame in 1998

Eakin is a native of Holladay, Utah, and graduated from Granite High. He currently resides in Sandy, Utah, and is married to Barbi. They are the parents of three children (Alicia, Ryan & Parker) and have five grandsons.
