- BYU and Weber State are playing in Vivint Smart Home Arena for the second time in the history of the series. This season's meeting is part of the inaugural Beehive Classic.
- Elijah Bryant had one of his best games as a Cougar Wednesday night against Illinois State. He hit 6 of 11 from the field for 17 points and added nine rebounds, nine assists, one block and three steals. The nine assists are a career high and the nine rebounds and three steals tied career highs.
- BYU has held its last two opponents to sub 30-percent shooting in the first half. Utah State shot 27.6 percent in the first half and Illinois State hit just 23.3 percent.

BY THE NUMBERS

- 2** The number of preseason All-WCC honorees for BYU in TJ Haws and Yoeli Childs. Last season, Haws and Childs were both All-WCC Freshman Team honorees and Haws was named to the All-WCC First Team. Since joining the WCC in 2011, the Cougars have had two players on the All-WCC First Team each year.
- 3** The number of 20-point games for Elijah Bryant and Yoeli Childs so far this season. Bryant has netted 20-plus points against Mississippi Valley State (27), Princeton (22) and Niagara (22) while Childs has scored 20-plus against Niagara (21), Alabama (21) and Utah Valley (24).
- 4:44** The amount of time remaining against UMass when BYU trailed by double figures for the final time, 61-51. It was the latest in a game the Cougars have trailed by double figures and comeback to win in the Rose era. BYU won by a final score of 68-66.
- 9** The number of career double-doubles for sophomore forward Yoeli Childs. He had five as a freshman and has four already this season. He opened the 2017-18 season with 13 points and 10 rebounds vs. Mississippi Valley State. Against Alabama, Childs had 21 points and 11 rebounds and he followed that with 19 and 11 vs. UMass and 24 and 11 rebounds at Utah Valley.
- 10** The number of steals BYU recorded against UMass, a season high and the most by the Cougars since Dec. 20, 2016 when BYU had 13 vs. Idaho State. Elijah Bryant had a team-best three while Yoeli Childs and Jahshire Hardnett had two apiece and TJ Haws, Rylan Bergersen and Payton Dastrup had one each.
- 12** The number of 3-point field goals made by BYU in the season opener vs. Mississippi State, tied for the most by a Cougar team in a season opener. BYU also made 12 in the 2003-04 season opener vs. Southern Utah. Twelve 3-point field goals is also a 2017-18 season high and it was matched at Utah Valley.
- 12** The number of consecutive seasons BYU has won at least 20 games. BYU has also reached the postseason in 12-straight seasons. Both streaks are program records.
- 25** BYU posted a season-best 25 assists on 30 made field goals at Utah Valley. Four different players had four-plus assists, including McKay Cannon (6), Yoeli Childs (4), Elijah Bryant (4) and TJ Haws (4).
- 25** The number of consecutive free throws BYU made between the end of the Princeton game through the first half of the UT Arlington game. The Cougars made their final 17 attempts to finish at Princeton and all eight of their attempts in the first half of the UT Arlington game. Between the two games, BYU hit 44 of 49 (89.8 percent).
- 25** Dave Rose reached 300 wins in his 407th career game on Feb. 4, 2017. He is tied with Bob Knight and John Thompson for 25th fastest to 300 career wins in NCAA history.
- 312** Dave Rose (2005 to present) is second all-time in BYU basketball history with 312 career victories, behind only the great Stan Watts, who coached the Cougars to 371 wins from 1949 to 1972 and was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in 1986.

THE BASKETBALL HALL OF FAME: HOOPHALL AWARDS

BYU sophomore guard TJ Haws is a preseason candidate for the 2018 Jeff West Shooting Guard of the Year Award, presented by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Haws earned first-team All-WCC honors in 2016-17 while averaging 13.8 points, 2.9 rebounds, 3.2 assists and 1.0 steal. The Alpine, Utah, native also hit a team-high 76 3-pointers, second all-time among BYU freshmen.

LAST TIME OUT – BRYANT AND HAWS LEAD BYU TO 80-68 WIN VS. ILLINOIS STATE

PROVO, Utah – Elijah Bryant led BYU to a commanding 80-68 win over Illinois State Wednesday night in the Marriott Center. Bryant finished the game just shy of a triple-double with 17 points, nine rebounds, nine assists and three steals.

TJ Haws had a season high 20 points and led the Cougars in scoring. Yoeli Childs added 17 points and seven boards.

Bryant scored the first points of the game on a 3-pointers off a pass from Haws and started the Cougars on a 7-0 run through the first three minutes of play. The Redbirds later answered with four straight points of their own to cut the deficit to 7-4 with 16:45 left in the half.

After a few minutes of limited scoring, Haws hit a 3 to extend BYU's lead to 14-6 at the 11:15 mark and sparked an 11-0 run. The next possession, Dalton Nixon followed up with a three-point conversion and after a defensive stop, ignited the arena with an offensive board and dish out to Haws who hit behind the arc to make

it 20-6, forcing Illinois to take a timeout with 9:26 left in the first half. A few minutes later Bryant maintained BYU's command of the game and hit two consecutive treys to make it 28-7.

Illinois State's Phil Fayne hit a nice jay after a well-delivered pass from Milik Yarbrough to cut it to 28-13, but McKay Cannon responded with a beautiful drive through a traffic-filled lane to lay it in and extend the lead to 17 with three minutes to go in the first half.

With 1:30 left in the first half Bryant got a quick defensive board and sent the ball sailing to a wide-open Haws who finished the nice dish with a one-handed slam, putting the Cougars up, 37-17. Childs started the second half with an offensive rebound and lay in to keep BYU's momentum coming out of halftime and a 41-17 advantage.

Moments later, Jahshire Hardnett had a nice drive past the Redbird defenders to give BYU its largest lead of the night, 28 points, at the 17:07 mark. In response, Illinois State hit a 3 to try and gain momentum in the game,

but a deep trey from Haws a few minutes later put the Cougar's lead up again to 27, 55-28.

The Redbirds however answered with a 5-0 run and forced BYU to call a timeout, leading 55-38, with 13:39 left in the second half.

As Illinois State fought to gain ground in the game, Hardnett sent a perfectly delivered alley-oop to Childs to increase a commanding lead to 61-36 with 11:32 remaining in the game.

Illinois State's Keyshawn Evans sent a great pass over BYU defenders to an open Fayne under the hoop for the rim-rocking, alley-oop dunk. Childs responded right back on the other end with a two-handed slam of his own, making it 72-55 for BYU with 7:08 left on the clock.

BYU finished the game shooting 53 percent from the field and 29 percent from behind the arc. Illinois State matched the Cougar's percentage from the 3-point line, but only shot 44 percent on field goals.

NOTES AND STORYLINES

Super Sophomores

BYU's 2017-18 roster includes three players who etched their names in the BYU record book during their freshman seasons. Yoeli Childs and TJ Haws were freshmen in 2016-17 while Zac Seljaas was a rookie in 2015-16. All three are back this season, looking to build on their record-setting freshman campaigns. Childs finished his freshman year first all-time among BYU freshmen in rebounds and second in rebounds per game, blocks, blocks per game and field goal percentage.

Haws concluded his first year second all-time among BYU freshmen in 3-point field goals, fourth in points scored, fifth in assists, tied for first in games started and third in double figure scoring games. Seljaas finished the 2015-16 season first all-time among BYU freshmen in 3-point field goal percentage, second in 3-point field goals, second in 3-point field goals per game, second in games with 3-plus 3-point field goals and tied for second most games with 5-plus 3-pointers.

All-Haws Team

TJ Haws earned first-team All-WCC honors as a freshman in 2016-17, becoming the third Haws in BYU history to earn all-league honors. His father Marty Haws earned first-team All-WAC honors as a senior in 1989-90 and his brother Tyler was a four-time all-league honoree. As a freshman in 2009-10, Tyler was named to the All-Mountain West Conference Third Team. Following a two-year mission for the LDS Church, Tyler earned first-team honors as a sophomore, junior and senior. In addition to joining his father and brother as an all-conference performer, TJ became the second Cougar in program history – the other being Danny Ainge – to earn first-team all-league honors as a freshman.

Dave Rose

BYU head coach Dave Rose has led the Cougars to one of the most successful eras in program history since taking over in 2005. His career record of 312-113 ranks him second in BYU history in total victories and first in winning percentage (.734). Rose has been named conference coach of the year three times, led the Cougars to four conference titles, eight NCAA tournament appearances, four NIT appearances, eight 25-win seasons and 12 20-win seasons.

BYU and the Postseason

Under Dave Rose, BYU has reached the postseason in 12-straight seasons, a school record. The previous record was six-straight seasons (1989-90 to 1994-95). During that time the Cougars have earned eight bids to the NCAA tournament and four to the NIT. The Cougars' eight NCAA tournament bids in the last 12 years are more than 200-plus NCAA Division I schools have since beginning their programs.
