BYU STORYLINES

RETURNING FIREPOWER: The Cougars return 13 players from last year's roster, including AVCA Newcomer of the Year Gabi Garcia Fernandez and Freshman All-American Felipe Ferreira de Brito. Garcia, also a second-team 2018 AVCA All-American, had a team-best 387 kills as a freshman last year and returns to help the Cougars manage the void left by the departure of first-team All-American outside hitter Brenden Sander. Ferreira led the team in blocks averaging 1.14 per set. Junior outside hitter Storm Fa'agata-Tufuga returns as BYU's third-most productive hitter (194 kills) from last season. Fellow junior setter Wil Stanley, who played in 90 of BYU's 112 sets last year, also returns along with sophomore libero Zach Hendrickson, who USA Volleyball named to the Men's Junior National Team this summer.

CONFERENCE ELITE: BYU was picked to finish second behind UCLA in the MPSF preseason poll after winning the regular season title and MPSF championship last season.

NATIONAL PROMINENCE: The team was ranked No. 5 in the AVCA preseason coaches poll after reaching the Final Four last season and maintained the No. 5 ranking in the latest poll for Week 1. The Cougars reached the Final Four in three-straight seasons and won three national championships in 1999, 2001 and 2004.

INTERNATIONAL TALENT: BYU features four players from outside of the United States: Garcia Fernandez from Puerto Rico, de Brito Ferreira from Brazil, Miki Jauhainen from Finland and Davide Gardini from Italy. All four are projected to start for the Cougars. Gardini's father, Andrea, is a three-time Olympian in volleyball for Italy.

AWARDS WATCH LISTS: Garcia Fernandez racked up several preseason selections following his National Newcomer of the Year season last year, including Off the Block/Springbak Preseason First-Team All-American and the Bryan Ivie Award watch list for outside hitters. De Brito Ferreira and junior Mikki Jauhainen were both named to the Ryan Millar Award watch list for middle blockers.

BYU OPENS SEASON AGAINST TWO TOP 15 OPPONENTS
 PROVO, Utah – No. 5 BYU men's volleyball opens the 2019 season at home this week against two Top 15 foes in No. 7 Ohio State and No. 14 Ball State. The Cougars host the three-time national champion Buckeyes in the Smith Fieldhouse on Thursday before the Cardinals visit Provo on Saturday. Both matches start at 7 p.m. MST.

No. 5 BYU (0-0)

- The Cougars return 13 players from last year's roster, including AVCA Newcomer of the Year Gabi Garcia Fernandez and Freshman All-American Felipe Ferreira de Brito.

- BYU was picked to finish second behind UCLA in the MPSF preseason poll after winning the regular season title and MPSF championship last season.

- The team was ranked No. 5 in the AVCA preseason coaches poll after reaching the Final Four last season, where they lost to UCLA in the semifinal.

No. 7 Ohio State (2-0)

- BYU welcomes the Buckeyes to the Smith Fieldhouse Thursday, Jan. 10 at 7 p.m. MST.

- Ohio State is coming off of two wins at home against Charleston, who they swept, and Penn State. The trip to Provo will be the first road game for the Buckeyes.

- The series history favors BYU at 12-6 overall, including a win over a No. 1 ranked Buckeyes team in Columbus, Ohio, last season. The two teams faced each other in back-to-back national championship matches in 2016 and 2017. BYU and Ohio State have each won the NCAA title three times.

No. 14 Ball State (2-0)

- The Cardinals take on the Cougars Saturday, Jan. 12 at 7 p.m. MST in the Smith Fieldhouse.

- Ball State won its first two matches against Princeton and New Jersey Institute of Technology last week, and plays at UC Irvine and Stanford this week before traveling to Provo on Saturday.

- BYU is 11-4 against the Cardinals in the all-time series, including a win last season in Muncie, Indiana, when the Cardinals were also ranked No. 14.

HEAD COACH SHAWN OLMSTEAD: 2015-present

After becoming head coach of the men's team in the summer of 2015, Olmstead coached the squad to the national championship match of the 2016 NCAA Tournament. He helped coach his team to an outright Mountain Pacific Sports Federation regular-season and tournament title while being named the 2016 MPSF Coach of the Year. The Cougars finished with a 27-4 (19-3 MPSF) record in 2016.

Olmstead coached the 2017 squad to another MPSF regular-season title in addition to a second-straight national championship run in the NCAA tournament after going 26-5 (16-2 MPSF).

He was named the MPSF Coach of the Year for the second time in three seasons after guiding his team to a 22-7 (10-2 MPSF) overall record in 2018. He led the squad to the national semifinals of the NCAA tournament for a third-straight season - the first such stretch in program history. Olmstead coached four AVCA All-Americans in 2018: Brenden Sander, Gabi Garcia Fernandez, Leo Durkin and Price Jarman.

Olmstead saw his most successful season as head coach of the BYU women's squad in 2014. He coached BYU to the national championship match of the NCAA tournament for the first time in program history. The Cougars became the first unseeded team in tournament history to make it to the final match. To get there, BYU upset No. 11 Arizona, No. 6 Florida State, No. 14 Nebraska and No. 2 Texas. The Cougars also won an outright West Coast Conference title after Olmstead led his squad to a 16-2 league record.

In 2013, Olmstead coached his team to the round of 16 in the NCAA tournament for a second-consecutive year. The Cougars placed second in the West Coast Conference after narrowly losing a five-set battle at San Diego for the league title in the final regular-season match.

Named West Coast Conference and Pacific Region Coach of the Year for 2012, Olmstead led the Cougars to their first conference title since 2005 and best season record (28-4, 13-3 WCC) since 1998.

In 2011, Olmstead coached the BYU women's volleyball team to a 21-9 season, its first season with 20 or more wins since 2007. The 2011 season marked BYU's first time playing as a member of the WCC. Though picked to finish sixth in the preseason coaches' poll, Olmstead helped the Cougars to a No. 3 ranking, tied with Saint Mary's, to end 2011.

Olmstead came to BYU with four years of coaching experience, most recently as an assistant coach for two years at Utah State under former BYU men's volleyball assistant coach Grayson DuBose. While at Utah State, Olmstead served as the program's recruiting coordinator, putting together the second-best recruiting class in the Western Athletic Conference in 2007. He also was responsible for defensive game preparation, including breaking down opponent film and preparing scouting reports. His efforts helped the Aggies rank 25th nationally in blocks per game in 2007.

Prior to his stint at Utah State, Olmstead spent one year as an assistant coach at Cal Poly San Luis Obispo in San Luis Obispo, Calif., in 2005 where he also served as the recruiting coordinator and organized team travel. He helped the Mustangs achieve a 19-6 overall record, improving from 5-24 the year prior to Olmstead's arrival. Olmstead also served as a volunteer assistant coach at Utah Valley in 2004, right after graduating from BYU as a player from 2000-04.
