QUICK HITS

- The two top-ranked teams in the country will enter the first match as the only undefeated teams remaining in the NCAA DI-II. Winning 16-straight matches, No. 2 BYU is in the midst of its second-best start to a season in program history and second-best winning streak in the rally era. No. 2 Hawai'i is also off to its second-best start to a season having won its first 14 matches.
- The Cougars are 41-20 all-time against the Rainbow Warriors while only holding a 14-14 record in Honolulu. Under head coach Shawn Olmstead, BYU is 5-2 overall and 3-0 in the Stan Sheriff Center when facing Hawai'i. Currently on a 19-match home win streak against non-conference opponents, the last non-Big West team to beat the Rainbow Warriors in their own arena was the Cougars in 2018.
- The matches this week mark the third and fourth times in the rally era that BYU and Hawai'i have met as the two top-ranked teams in the regular season. In 2001, the second-ranked Cougars bested No. 1 Hawai'i in consecutive matches at the Smith Fieldhouse. Overall, BYU is 7-3 (4-1 at home; 3-2 on the road) in the rally era when ranked No. 2 and facing a top-ranked team.
- BYU is 19-10 (12-5 at home; 7-5 on the road) when playing a team ranked No. 1 in the country in the rally era. The Cougars are 4-1 in matches against opponents ranked No. 1 since Shawn Olmstead took over the program ahead of the 2016 season, including a 3-0 away record.
- The Cougars have played one of the toughest schedules in the country so far with 11 of their 16 matches being against ranked opponents. Their past opposition currently combines for a .632 winning percentage, the third-highest past opposition winning percentage in the NCAA.
- The Cougars had their highest-attended home match since 2005 when 5,817 fans showed up to watch BYU sweep No. 13 Stanford last week. Both the Cougars and the Rainbow Warriors lead the NCAA in average attendance with Hawai'i averaging 4,382 per match and BYU averaging 3,948.
- BYU is 4-0 against Big West teams so far this season as the Cougars won a pair of matches against No. 3 UC Santa Barbara and No. 5 UC Irvine.
- The Cougars remained at No. 2 behind Hawai'i in the most recent AVCA Coaches Poll (3/2) while receiving four first-place votes. BYU has been ranked for 477-consecutive weeks dating back to the final rankings of the 1991 season. Under Olmstead, the Cougars have now been ranked fifth or better 60 times, including 48 weeks rated inside the top-3.
- BYU averages 3.01 blocks per set to lead the nation while Hawai'i is second with an average of 2.886. The Cougars are second in hitting percentage (.351) behind the Warriors (.386) while also ranking sixth in the NCAA DI-II in assists per set (12.18) and seventh in kills per set (12.89).
- For the seventh week in a row, opposite hitter Gabi Garcia Fernandez leads the NCAA with an average of .840 aces per set while also leading the nation in points per set (5.38). Setter Wil Stanley is averaging 10.74 assists per set to rank third in the country while middle blocker Felipe de Brito Ferreira is seventh in blocks per set (1.282).
- Atop the MPSF standings, BYU is currently two matches ahead of second place halfway through its conference schedule. The Cougars were picked to win the MPSF in the league's preseason poll.
- After defeating Pepperdine at home (2/8/20), Olmstead became the second coach in program history to win 100 games at the helm of the men's volleyball team. The fifth-year coach joined his former coach and BYU legend, Carl McGown, as the only two head coaches to reach the milestone. Olmstead also reached the 100 win milestone when coaching the BYU women's volleyball team (2011-14).
- Olmstead entered the 2020 season with the highest winning percentage of any active men's volleyball coach in NCAA DI-II (.88-28, .759, 2016-19).

COACHING FAMILY TREE

Head coach Shawn Olmstead comes from a family of volleyball coaches. His father, Rick, is a well-known high school and club coach in California who coached U.S. star and current National Team head coach Karch Kiraly at Santa Barbara High.

Shawn's sisters, Laci and Heather, both played volleyball at the collegiate level. Laci was a setter for the Cougars (1994-95) and Heather played four seasons as a libero at Utah State (1998-01).

Heather has been the BYU women's volleyball head coach the last five seasons. She's led her team to four conference titles and NCAA Sweet 16 berths, including a Final Four appearance in 2018. Previously, Shawn and Heather worked together on the women's team for four seasons with Shawn as head coach, helping BYU to two conference titles and three trips to the NCAA Tournament, including a 2014 national runner-up finish. Both Shawn and Heather have been named the AVCA NCAA Women's Volleyball DI Coach of the Year.

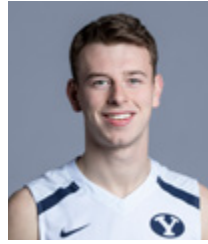

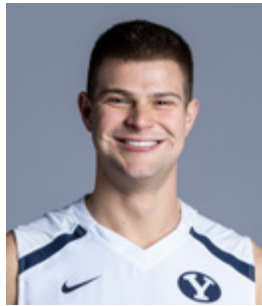
