COUGARS HIT THE ROAD TO FACE BYU ON SATURDAY

- For the first time during the 2018-19 season, the Cougars hit the road to meet BYU at 4 p.m. (MST) Saturday inside the Marriott Center.
- Cougars have opened the year with three straight home games, winning by an average of 28.3 points per game during the Men Against Breast Cancer Cougar Cup.
- Saturday's game will be the first time the Cougars have faced BYU since a win in the NIT First Round in Hofheinz Pavilion on March 15, 2006... Will be the first encounter in Provo, Utah, since an 89-69 victory on Dec. 14, 1996.
- Winner of Saturday's game will clinch the Men Against Breast Cancer Cougar Cup championship.
- Cougars enter Saturday's game following an 82-55 win over Northwestern State in H&PE Arena on Wednesday... For the third straight game, junior guard **Armoni Brooks** led Houston in scoring with 16 points as one of five Cougars to reach double-digit points... Junior center **Chris Harris Jr.**, senior guard **Landon Goesling** and senior guard **Corey Davis Jr.** posted 13 rebounds apiece.



HEADLINES and STORYLINES

- Houston will open the \$60-million Fertitta Center on Saturday, Dec. 1, against No. 21/20 Oregon.
- Cougars have won 18 straight home games in H&PE Arena dating back to final game of 2016-17 season... Streak is tied with Montana and Charleston for the nation's second-longest active streak... Last Houston home loss was a 78-75 setback to Akron in the NIT First Round in H&PE Arena on March 15, 2017.
- In the Nov. 10 season opener vs. Alabama A&M, senior point guard **Galen Robinson Jr.** dished out the 400th assist of his career while competing in his 100th consecutive game.
- Cougars signed forward **J'Wan Roberts** (Shoemaker High School); guard **Marcus Sasser** (Red Oak High School) and guard **Caleb Mills** (TC Roberson High School) – all freshmen – to National Letters of Intent in November signing period... Mills will join Cougars at semester break in January 2019 but not compete in any games.
- Houston was picked to finish third in the American Athletic Conference Coaches Preseason Poll, earning 103 points and a pair of first-place votes... Senior guard **Corey Davis Jr.** was named to the league's Preseason Second Team, while guard **Nate Hinton** was recognized as the league's Preseason Freshman of the Year.
- 2018-19 American Athletic Conference Coach of the Year **Kelvin Sampson** is in his 30th season as a collegiate head coach and his fifth at Houston.

• BYU brings a 5-1 record into Saturday's game following Wednesday's 105-78 win over Rice inside the Marriott Center.

• Cougars are 5-0 at home this season.

• Against Rice, forward Yoeli Childs led BYU with 28 points on 13-of-18 shooting and seven rebounds and added five assists.

• Guard Jahshire Hardnett added 20 points on 6-of-7 shooting with three rebounds, while guard TJ Haws finished with 18 points, four rebounds and a game-high eight assists.

• This season, Childs leads BYU with 20.7 points and 12.5 rebounds per game... Haws stands second with 14.2 points per contest and leads the Cougars with 5.5 assists per game, while Hardnett ranks third with 12.7 points per game.

SERIES HISTORY vs. BYU

- Houston owns a 4-2 lead in the series, which began with a 111-82 loss on Dec. 4, 1965, in Provo, Utah.
- Saturday's game will be the first meeting between the two teams since Houston claimed a 77-67 win in the NIT First Round in Hofheinz Pavilion on March 15, 2006.
- Houston has won the last two games and four of the last five... Only an 84-77 loss at the Pillsbury Classic in Minneapolis on Dec. 30, 1978, prevents a longer winning streak
- In last road meeting, Houston enjoyed an 89-69 win during the BYU Cougar Classic in Provo on Dec. 14, 1996.

KELVIN SAMPSON vs. BYU

- **Houston Head Coach Kelvin Sampson** has posted an 0-1 record against BYU during his career.
- Saturday's game will be the first time Sampson has faced BYU as Houston's head coach.
- In his only previous meeting, Sampson's 1987-88 Washington State team dropped a 60-54 decision to BYU in Pullman, Wash., on Dec. 3, 1987.

KELVIN SAMPSON vs. DAVID ROSE

Saturday's game will be the first time that **Houston Head Coach Kelvin Sampson** has faced **BYU Head Coach David Rose** during their careers.

THE AMERICAN PRESEASON HONORS

- The Cougars were picked to finish third in the American Athletic Conferences Preseason Coaches Poll in mid-October. Houston received 103 points and a pair of first-place votes to stand behind only UCF (114 pts., 6 votes) and Cincinnati (107 pts, 3 votes).
- Memphis (85 pts, 1 vote), UConn (75), Temple (74), SMU (63), Wichita State (60), Tulsa (48), Tulane (23), ECU (22) and USF (18) rounded out the field.
- Senior guard **Corey Davis Jr.** was named to the Preseason All-Conference Second Team, while guard **Nate Hinton** was recognized as the league's Preseason Freshman of the Year.

LAST TIME OUT

- Junior center **Chris Harris Jr.** posted a career-high 13 points as one of five players to reach double digits in leading the Cougars to an 82-55 win over Northwestern State inside H&PE Arena on Monday.
- Competing in Houston's third game in the Men Against Breast Cancer Cougar Cup, Harris connected on 6-of-8 shots from the field and added five rebounds – including four offensive – with two blocks as the Cougars won their third straight game to open the 2018-19 season and their 18th straight home game dating back to last year.
- For the third straight game, junior guard **Armoni Brooks** led the Cougars in scoring, posting 16 points with four 3-pointers, and added five rebounds and three assists. Senior guard and Preseason All-American Athletic Conference selection **Corey Davis Jr.**, and senior guard Landon Goesling added 13 points apiece, while senior point guard **Galen Robinson Jr.** finished with 11 points, six rebounds and a game-high seven assists without a turnover.

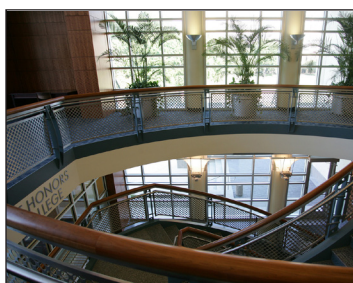

The University of Houston Men's and Women's Basketball programs will compete in a new game arena during the 2018-19 season when the Fertitta Center officially opens on Dec. 1 against No. 14/16 Oregon.

With the completion of the 2016-17 season, Hofheinz Pavilion underwent a \$60 million renovation. The renovation was made possible through a generous \$20 million donation from University of System Board of Regents Chairman Tilman J. Fertitta and his family in late August 2016.

The facility will feature a premium club area and a court-side club. The reconfigured bowl will move mid-court seating locations closer to game action with floor-level seating opposite the team benches for UH students. Renovations include a new audio system, sports lighting and video boards as well as new concession stands and expanded restrooms. The facility's exterior also will be refreshed.

Prominent to the center's exterior, the renovation will preserve the legacy of the

Hofheinz family and its contributions to both UH and the city of Houston. UH will transform an area adjacent to the new facility into Hofheinz Plaza, where fans will be greeted by a bronze statue of former Harris County Judge Roy Hofheinz.

The University of Houston will request that city officials rename a portion of Holman Street in front of the arena after the Hofheinz family. In addition, Roy Hofheinz's records will be permanently archived and publicly accessible as a special collection in the UH library and the Alumni Center will house an area describing the lives and public service of Roy and Irene Hofheinz.

"This gift is personal. It represents a commitment from my family and me to support the University of Houston in its quest to strengthen our nationally competitive institution both in academics and athletics," Fertitta said. "Upgrading our athletics facilities shows we are serious about competing at the highest levels of collegiate sports for many years to come. The University of Houston Men's Basketball program moved into its new home during the 2015-16 season following completion of construction of the Guy V. Lewis Development Facility.

The near-53,000-square-foot facility provides the environment that University of Houston Men's and Women's Basketball student-athletes need to excel throughout the season in all areas.

Named after 592-game winner and Hall of Fame Head Coach Guy V. Lewis, the Development Facility is located adjacent to Hofheinz Pavilion at the corner of Cullen Boulevard and Holman Street on the UH campus.

Construction on the \$25-million facility began in September 2014. Austin Commercial served as the construction manager for the project, which was designed by DLR Group and Page.
