## USF Meets BYU on Thursday in Provo Dons Look to End Three-Game Slide

### San Francisco Dons (11-6, 1-3 WCC) vs. BYU Cougars (12-5, 3-1 WCC)

### USF at a Glance

- Now 11-6 overall and 1-3 in the WCC after dropping home games to Gonzaga (95-80) and Saint Mary's (63-52) last week...have lost three straight and four of last five.
- Are off to its best 17-game start since the 2004-05 team was 13-4 at the same point of the season...were 9-8 at the 17-game mark last year (9-9 after 18 games)...USF's 10 non-conference wins were the most since 2011-12 (10) and marked the fourth time since 1985-86 the Dons had won at least 10 non-conference games.
- Meet BYU for the first time this season on Thursday in Provo...Dons are 6-15 all-time vs. the Cougars and have dropped seven straight in the series dating back to last win on Feb. 9, 2013.
- BYU swept last year's season series with USF, winning 102-92 in Provo on Jan. 9 and 114-89 in San Francisco on Feb. 11...Cougars were a combined 32-for-57 (56.1) from three-point range in the two games and have averaged 12.5 three's a game vs. USF over last two seasons.
- Are 1-2 on the road this season...picked up a win at UC Santa Barbara on Nov. 16 and have dropped games at Eastern Washington and Santa Clara.
- Now rank third in the WCC in scoring at 75.9 points per game...averaging 67.5 ppg in four WCC games after averaging 78.5 in 13 non-conference games.
- Rank third in the WCC in field goal percentage at 47.3...shot 50 percent or better from the floor in six of the first eight games of the season and have eclipsed the 50 percent mark twice in last seven games...shot 50 percent or better in just six games last year...shooting 41.4 percent (140-for-338) over last six games.
- Lead the WCC and are tied for 14th nationally in three's made per game (9.6)...have made 10 or more three's in eight games this season, including a school-record 18 against Eastern Washington and 16 vs. Utah...have slipped to fifth in 3PT field goal percentage at 38.4 after shooting 27.6 (37-for-134) from distance over last six games.
- Four players - **Charles Minlend** (31), **Ronnie Boyce** (31), **Jordan Ratinho** (28) and **Chase Foster** (24) -- have made 20+ threes this season while a total of seven players have made 10 or more shots from distance.
- Rank 10th in the WCC in free throw percentage at 64.4 percent...shooting 61.0 (100-for-161) from the line over the last nine games.
- USF's reserves have combined to score 318 points over the last eight games and have outscored the opponent's bench 573-308 (+265) over the last 16 games.
- Started a lineup consisting of three sophomores (**Matt McCarthy**, **Nate Renfro**, **Mladen Djordjevic**) and two freshmen (**Charles Minlend**, **Jordan Ratinho**) Saturday against Saint Mary's...of USF's 15-man roster, 13 players are underclassmen.
- Senior **Ronnie Boyce** has scored 20 or more points five times this season and 11 times in his career...he leads the Dons in scoring with a 16.0 per game average.
- With an 10.6 ppg scoring average, **Charles Minlend** ranks as the second-highest scoring freshman in the WCC. behind BYU's **TJ Haws** (13.1).
- Return home to face the Pacific Tigers on Saturday...tip-off is scheduled for 8:00 p.m. on the Hilltop.

# USF Basketball Game Notes



## Head Coach Kyle Smith Hamilton College '92

Career Record ..... 112-88 (7th season)  
Overall Record at USF ..... 11-6 (1st season)

Kyle Smith, who served as the head coach at Columbia University for the previous six seasons, was named USF's head men's basketball coach on March 30.

Smith, 46, becomes the 19th head coach of one of college basketball's most storied programs that has won two NCAA championships (1955 and '56), one National Invitation Tournament title (1949) and 16 conference championships.

In six seasons at Columbia, Smith guided the Lions to a 101-82 overall record and two postseason appearances. The 101 victories were the most in a six-year span at Columbia since the program posted 107 victories from 1965-71. In 2015-16, Columbia finished with a 25-10 record, finished third in the Ivy League with a 10-4 mark, and captured the ColleagueInsider.com Tournament with a 73-67 victory over UC Irvine in the title game. The Lions became only the second Ivy League team to win a postseason tournament after Princeton's 1975 NIT Championship.

The 25 victories established a single-season school-record while the 10 Ivy League victories were the most by a Columbia team since the 1992-93 squad also went 10-4 in the Ivy. It was Columbia's second 20-win season in three years under Smith, who also guided the Lions to a 21-13 record during the 2013-14 season.

During his last three seasons at Columbia, the Lions compiled a 59-38 (.608) overall record. The 59 wins tied Princeton for the third-highest total in the Ivy League behind Yale (64) and Harvard (63).

During his six-year tenure, Smith also developed 10 players who earned All-Ivy League honors, including Maodo Lo, a two-time All-Ivy first-team recipient who is ranks as the Lions second all-time leading scorer and holds the school-record for three-pointers made.

The 2014-15 season saw an injury-riddled Lion team led top-ranked Kentucky for 27 minutes while holding the powerful Wildcats to a season-low 56 points. Lo emerged as one of the top point guards in the Ivy League and earned unanimous all-league honors, as well as NABC All-Region and All-Metropolitan second team accolades.

Smith guided the Lions to one of their best seasons in school history in 2013-14, as Columbia finished with a 21-13 overall record and earned a berth in the ColleagueInsider.com Tournament, which was the Lions first post-season appearance since 1968. The 21 wins were the most since the Lions won 23 games en route to the 1967-68 Ivy League championship. The Lions also drilled a school-record 278 three-pointers and finished fourth in the nation in free throw percentage with a .755 mark. Individually, Alex Rosenberg earned first team All-Ivy League honors while Lo was a second team choice.

In 2012-13, Columbia posted home wins over eventual NCAA Tournament teams Villanova and Harvard in Levien Gymnasium.

Smith led Columbia to its second straight 15-win season in 2011-12, marking the first time the Lions accomplished that feat since 1977-78 and 1978-79 under Tom Penders. Brian Barbour earned first team All-Ivy honors and was also an all-region NABC all-region selection.

In Smith's first season in 2010-11, the Lions finished with a 15-13 record, which was the first winning season for a new Columbia head coach in 33 years. The Lions increased their scoring output by more than 10 points a game and went over the 70 point mark on 15 occasions. Guards Noruwa Agho (first team) and Barbour (honorable mention) were All-Ivy League selections, while Agho was also honored on the regional level by the NABC and the Metropolitan Writers Association.

Prior to his appointment at Columbia in May of 2010, Smith spent 18 seasons as an assistant coach on the NCAA Division I level, including nine seasons (2001-10) at Saint Mary's College, one season at Air Force (2000-01) and eight years at the University of San Diego (1992-2000).

Born in El Paso, Texas, Smith graduated in 1992 from Hamilton College with a degree in English literature. He also played basketball and helped lead the Continentals to a 26-1 record the No. 1 ranking in the nation for NCAA Division III as a junior. He shot 51.3 percent from three-point range and helped Hamilton to an Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) championship. He also shot 51.3 percent from three-point range, which still stands as a Hamilton single-season record.

Smith also earned a master's degree in educational leadership from the University of San Diego, where he began his coaching career. Kyle and his wife, Katie, have three sons, Rocco, Bo and Luke.

### What's a Don

"Don" is an acronym for **De Origen Noble**, which translates to "of noble origin" and is a Spanish title given only to a noble person of political, social or official distinction. The name references the early history of California and San Francisco, which was marked by the exploits of the adventuresome and swashbuckling Spanish Dons. All USF students and alumni are of noble origin who share in the long passion for learning in order to better understand the past, clarify the present and anticipate the future. Thus, we are proud to call ourselves the Dons. USF's mascot is named **Don Francisco**, in honor of **Don Francisco de Haro**, the first mayor of San Francisco.



### Opening Tip

USF (11-6, 1-3 WCC) travels to Provo, Utah to meet the BYU Cougars (12-5, 3-1 WCC) on Thursday night at the Marriott Center. USF is coming off a pair of losses last week to No. 5 Gonzaga (95-80) and No. 19 Saint Mary's (63-52) while the Cougars earned a split in its two conference games, dropping an 81-68 decision at Saint Mary's before taking out Pacific, 91-62 in Provo. Thursday's game will be broadcast on BYUtv with Dave McCann and Blaine Fowler calling the action from the Marriott Center.

### USF-BYU Series History

BYU leads the all-time series with USF, 15-6. The Cougars have won seven consecutive games in the series dating back to the Dons last victory on Feb. 9, 2013, when USF nailed 14 three-pointers in a 99-87 victory in Provo. USF is 1-10 vs. BYU since the Cougars joined the WCC for the 2011-12 season. BYU won both meetings last season, claiming a 114-89 decision in San Francisco and 102-92 in Provo (see below). The teams have met once in NCAA Tournament play, with the Dons scoring a 86-63 victory in a second round game played in Tucson, Ariz. in 1979 and once in WCC Championship action, with BYU prevailing 79-77 in overtime in 2014.

### Last Year's Meetings With BYU

BYU made 15-of-30 of its three-point tries and defeated USF, 102-92 on Jan. 9 in Provo. The Dons had five players score in double figures, led by **Devin Watson's** 25 points, shot 48.5 percent from the field and outrebounded the Cougars, 40-38 but could not overcome a hot-shooting BYU team. Three Cougars - **Chase Fischer** (25), **Nick Emery** (21) and **Zac Seljaas** (20) - combined for 56 points and accounted for 14 of the team's 15 three-pointers. USF enjoyed a five point lead in the first half but trailed at the break, 51-45. **Tim Derksen** (20), **Ronnie Boyce** (13), **Matt McCarthy** (10) and **Nate Renfro** (10) also finished in double-figures for the Dons.

In the return game in San Francisco on Feb. 11, BYU made 17 three-pointers en route to a 114-89 victory over USF on the Hilltop. Six Cougars scored in double figures, led by **Nick Emery**, who made 10-of-12 three-point attempts and finished with a game-high 37 points. **Chase Fischer** added 22 while **Kyle Collinworth** chipped in with 17 to go along with eight assists. **Devin Watson** led all USF scorers with 29 points, **Tim Derksen** finished with 25 and **Ronnie Boyce** added 15. No other Don player managed to score more than five points on the night. The Cougars shot 57.6 percent from the field for the game, including a staggering 63.0 percent from long distance. USF trailed by just eight points at 29-21 with 9:16 left before intermission but a pair of three-pointers by Emery and one by Fischer keyed a 9-0 run which opened the Cougars lead to 17 at 38-21 with 7:48 left in the first. The Cougars enjoyed as much as a 26-point lead at 99-73 with 7:53 left before cruising to the 114-89 victory. The 114 points were the most allowed by a USF team since the Dons dropped a 117-73 decision at Duke on Jan. 26, 1993.

### Last Time Out: Saint Mary's 63, USF 52

USF gave the nation's 19th-ranked Saint Mary's all it could handle for 34 minutes before falling, 63-52 in War Memorial at the Sobrato Center. With Saint Mary's nursing a 52-49 lead with 6:56 remaining, Tanner Krebs and Dane Pineau hit back-to-back three-pointers in a span of 48 seconds to give the Gaels all the breathing room they needed to win for the 22nd time in 23 games against the Dons. Saint Mary's outscored USF, 11-3 run down the stretch as the Dons were able to connect on just one of their last 10 shots from the floor. Saint Mary's center **Jock Landale** led all scorers with 21 points while Pineau (14) and **Joe Rahon** (13) also reached double figure. The Gaels held a decisive edge on the boards, outrebounding USF, 43-27. **Ronnie Boyce** was the only USF (11-6, 1-3 WCC) player to reach double figures with 19 points on 8-of-17 shooting from the field.

### The Record

At 11-6, USF is off to its best 17-game start since the 2004-05 team was 13-4 at the same point of the season. USF is one of four WCC teams with 10 or more wins on the season, along with Gonzaga (14), Saint Mary's (14) and BYU (12). The Dons were 9-8 at the 17-game mark last season (9-9 after 18 games). USF's 10 non-conference wins were its most since the 2010-11 season (10).

### Lately

USF has dropped its last three games and four out of its last five contests dating back to Christmas. Two of the three losses came against top-25 teams in No. 5 Gonzaga and No. 19 Saint Mary's while another came at the hands of defending Mountain West Conference champion San Diego State in the championship game of the Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic.

### Home, Road and Somewhere in Between

USF is 6-3 at home, 1-2 on the road and 4-1 on neutral courts this season. USF's lone road win came at UC Santa Barbara on Nov. 16 and have suffered losses at Eastern Washington (Nov. 27) and Santa Clara (Dec. 31). USF is 18-14 in its last 32 WCC road games dating back to the 2012-13 season.

### The Scoreboard

USF has scored 80 or more points in nine games this season and ank third in the WCC in scoring at 75.9 points per game. The Dons are scoring at a 67.5 ppg clip over its first four WCC contests after averaging 78.5 ppg in 13 non-conference games.

### From the Floor

The Dons rank third in the WCC in field goal percentage at 47.3 and have shot 50 percent or better from the field in eight games this season. Last season, USF managed to shoot 50 percent or better from the floor just six times. USF is shooting 41.4 percent (140-for-338) from the floor over the last six contests and 43.6 percent in four conference games.

### Beyond the Arc

USF leads the WCC and ranks 28th nationally in three-pointers made per game (9.6). However, over the last six games, the Dons are 37-for-134 (27.6) from distance, dropping the season percentage from 43.3 to its present mark of 38.4, which ranks fifth in the WCC. USF has made 10 or more three-pointers in eight games this season, topped off by a school-record 18 three-pointers in a loss at Eastern Washington. The Dons also made more three-pointers (16) than two-point field goals (15) in their 89-86 win over Utah. Four players - **Charles Mindel** (31), **Ronnie Boyce** (31), **Jordan Ratinho** (28) and **Chase Foster** (24) -- have made 20+ threes this season while a total of seven players have made 10 or more shots from distance.

### Board Work

USF was outrebounded in both games last week vs. Gonzaga (39-23) and St. Mary's (43-27) and has been outrebounded four times in the last five contests. USF has outrebounded nine opponents this season, were even on the boards in two other games and have been outrebounded six times. USF ranks seventh in the WCC in rebound margin (+2.4)

### Toeing the Line

USF has slipped to 10th place in the WCC in free throw percentage at 64.4 percent, as the Dons are converting on just 61.0 (100-for-161) of their charity tries over the last eight games.

### The Dons Bench

The Dons bench has combined to score 318 points in the last eight games (39.7). USF's reserves have outscored the opponent 573-309 (+264) over the last 16 games after being outscored, 28-21 in the season-opener against Illinois-Chicago. The Dons' bench is averaging 35.3 ppg this season (594 total), compared to the opponents at

### Dons Defensively

After allowing its second-highest point total of the season to Gonzaga (95), USF limited Saint Mary's to just 63 points and 43.8 percent shooting last Saturday. The Dons are allowing 70.8 points a game this year while opponents are shooting 42.9 percent from the floor.

### Good Starts

The Dons have led at halftime in 12 of 17 games this season. USF was tied at the break at UC Santa Barbara (32-32) and trailed Illinois State (31-29), San Diego State (32-28), Santa Clara (38-28) and Gonzaga (46-36) at intermission. The Dons trailed at halftime in 19 of 30 games last season and were 6-13 in those contests.

### Lineups

USF employed its fifth starting lineup of the season against Saint Mary's, with freshman **Charles Minlend** drawing his first career start, giving the Dons a starting lineup consisting of two freshman (Minlend and Ratinho) and three sophomores (McCarthy, Renfro and Djordjevic) against the nation's 19th-ranked team. **Chase Foster** came off the bench for the first time this season after starting the first 16 contests. A total of nine players have drawn starts this season, with **Nate Renfro** being the one constant in all 17 games this season.

### USF Ushers In Kyle Smith Era

The season-opener against Illinois-Chicago marked **Kyle Smith's** USF head coaching debut. Smith was named the Dons' head coach on March 30 after six seasons at Columbia, where he guided the Lions to a 101-82 record, culminating in last year's CollegeInsider.com Tournament championship. Smith has deep ties in the West Coast Conference, having served as assistant coach at both San Diego (1992-2000) and Saint Mary's (2001-10).

### Staff Additions

Rounding out Kyle Smith's staff are associate head coaches **Derrick Phelps**, who was a point guard on North Carolina's 1993 NCAA Championship team, **Todd Golden**, a former standout at St. Mary's who served as an assistant coach at Auburn for the past two seasons and assistant coach **Kevin Hovde**, a former player at Richmond. Phelps and Hovde both followed Smith to San Francisco from Columbia, while Golden served as Smith's assistant coach on the Columbia staff during the 2013-14 season before moving onto Auburn. He also played for Smith at St. Mary's, where he captained the 2007-08 Gaels. Additionally, the efficient **John Andrzejek** takes over the USF's director of basketball operations after serving in the same capacity at Columbia.

### Dons Picked Ninth in WCC Preseason Poll

USF was picked to finish ninth in the WCC Preseason Coaches Poll. The Dons garnered 27 points, one less than Portland and two less than Pacific. Gonzaga was picked first with 79 total points, including seven first-place votes, followed closely by Saint Mary's, which garnered 75 points and three first place votes.

## Renfro Named Captain

Sophomore forward **Nate Renfro** (Tucson, AZ / Sahuaro HS) has been named USF's team captain for the 2016-17 season. The selection was made in an unanimous vote of the coaching staff and players.

## Bloodlines

**Charles Minlend's** father, **Charles Sr.**, was a standout at St. John's from 1992-97 and still ranks as the school's 23rd all-time leading scorer (1,349) and 10th all-time leading rebounds (784). **Chance Anderson** is the son of former Georgia standout **Willie Anderson**, a 10-year NBA veteran who was also member of the 1988 United States' Olympic Team and **Carla McGhee**, who played on Tennessee's 1987 and '89 NCAA Championship teams before embarking on a 13-year professional career that saw her win a gold medal at the 1996 Atlanta Olympic Games.

## European Tour

USF played four games during a 10-day European trip to Germany, Belgium and France in early August. The Dons won all four games on the trip, defeating the Artland Dragons, 87-74 in Dusseldorf, Germany; the Ghent Hawks, 77-63 and KBBC Oostkamp, 83-58 in Belgium and Cergy Pontoise, 72-70 in Paris.

## Dons Sign Souley Boum

**Souley Boum**, a two-time Oakland Athletic League Player of the Year from Oakland Technical High School, has signed a national letter of intent to play basketball at the University of San Francisco. Boum, a 6-3 combo guard, averaged 21.2 points, 5.5 rebounds and 3.1 assists per game last season for Oakland Tech. He also shot 53 percent from the floor and 49 percent from three-point range for the Bulldogs which finished with a 28-4 overall record last season and went undefeated in the OAL with a 10-0 mark. Boum earned OAL Player of the Year honors as a sophomore and junior. He also averaged 20.8 points, 5.0 rebounds and 1.6 steals a game last summer for AAU's Team Lillard. He was the fifth-leading scorer in the 64-team adidas Uprising Summer Circuit.

Hardy played three seasons (1975-78) at USF and left as the program's 10th all-time leading scorer (1,075) and its seventh leading rebounder (772). A native of Long Beach, Hardy was part of a heralded recruiting class which included fellow Hall of Famers **Bill Cartwright** and **Winford Boynes**. The trio led USF to the nation's No. 1 ranking in 1976-77 after the Dons reeled off 29 consecutive wins to open the season..

War Memorial at the Sobrato Center Renovations  
USF's home facility, **War Memorial at The Sobrato Center**, underwent significant renovations during the summer in the first phase of a multi-faceted renovation project to upgrade the venerable facility which was first opened in 1958. During the summer, the facility was seismically retrofitted, restrooms were remodeled and an elevator was installed in the southwest corner of the facility. New seats will be installed in the lower bowl in December. Phase II of the project, scheduled to begin next summer, includes the construction of a club level with preferred seating on the west side of the facility and relocating the main entrance to the southwest corner across from the University Center. The new club level will include a **Sport and Social Change Museum** designed to promote core Jesuit values through sports and highlight USF's athletic history. The project was made possible by the generous donation of Silicon Valley philanthropist and real estate developer **John A. Sobrato** and his wife **Susan**, whose historic gift of \$15 million to the University of San Francisco was the largest individual gift in the institution's history.

Russell Receives Muhammad Ali Legacy Award  
**Bill Russell**, who led the University of San Francisco to back-to-back NCAA Championships in 1955 and '56 and won 11 NBA Championships in his 13-year professional career with the Boston Celtics, was selected as one of three recipients for the **Sports Illustrated Muhammad Ali Legacy Award**, which is presented to individuals for their incomparable athletic career and decades as social activists. **Kareem Abdul-Jabbar** and **Jim Brown** join Russell as this year's recipients. Russell was a passionate spokesman for social and racial injustice throughout his playing career and following his retirement in 1968. One of the most influential figures in sports history, Russell challenged social injustices while becoming one of the greatest winners in sports history. He was a prominent voice among athletes during the Civil Rights Movement of the 1960's and took part in the March on Washington in 1963 and was in attendance when Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. delivered his "I Have a Dream" on the National Mall. He was a staunch supporter of Muhammad Ali's anti-Vietnam War stance.
