

# A Look at 1992-93

BYU finished at the top of the Western Athletic Conference for the third time in four years, won 25 games for the second straight year and appeared in its fourth straight NCAA Tournament during a 1992-93 season which saw the Cougars place in the top four in attendance.

An average of 20,471 fans saw the Cougars finish 25-9 with upsets over nationally ranked Oklahoma and Memphis State and go 15-3 in the WAC against ranked teams like New Mexico, Texas-El Paso and Utah.

BYU defeated Southwest Conference champ Southern Methodist in the NCAA Midwest first round before losing to Final Four participant Kansas.

With his three league titles, Coach Reid has won more WAC crowns than any coach except Don Haskins (7), Stan Watts (5) and Ned Wulk (4).

Gary Trost was the All-WAC center for the second straight season and was all-district and honorable mention All-America. He was on the all-tournament team at the Far West Classic.

Russell Larson set a school record for field goal percentage at .631 and Nick Sanderson set school records for three-point attempts in a season (209) and career (350). Both were honorable mention All-WAC along with Jared Miller.

Trost finished with the second-best field goal percentage in school history (.566) and Miller is now third (.556). Sanderson has the fourth-best free throw shooting at .826. He also was the MVP of the Cougar Classic. Randy Reid was on the all-tournament team.



Kurt Christensen became a steady reserve on the guard line.

BYU set a school record for scoring and a Marriott Center mark for scoring margin with a 128-78 win over Sacramento State. The Cougars' 13-game winning streak was the nation's second longest.
