GAME 06: Things You Should Know

- The Purdue men's basketball team hopes to end its trip to paradise on a high note when it faces BYU in Wednesday's fifth-place game, tipping off at noon (HT) / 5 PM (ET) at the Lahaina Civic Center in Lahaina, Hawai'i.
- Purdue is coming off a dominating performance against Missouri in yesterday's consolation bracket. The Boilermakers surged to a 45-20 halftime lead and cruised in for a 21-point victory, the largest non-conference regular-season win away from Mackey Arena in the Painter era and since Dec. 13, 2003, an 80-39 win over Central Michigan in Indianapolis.
- **Rapheal Davis** scored a career-high 22 points and the Boilermakers made 33-of-43 free throws, including 21-of-26, in the second half to ease to the victory.
- **Kendall Stephens** continues to lead the Boilermakers in scoring (14.0 PPG) while making 18-of-34 (.529) three-point attempts.
- Freshmen **Isaac Haas** and **Vince Edwards** combine to score 22.0 points per game and grab 12.0 rebounds per game between them. The duo is shooting 40-of-62 (.645) from the field.
- During EASports Maui Invitational tournament play, four players are averaging double figures and Purdue is shooting 74.6 percent from the free throw line (47-of-63). However, Purdue has just 31 assists against 29 turnovers.
- As a team, Purdue is shooting 51.2 percent from the field and 40.4 percent from three-point range. Purdue is holding foes to just 35.8 percent shooting from the field and are outrebounding foes by 7.0 boards per game.

About BYU

- High-flying BYU enters the contest averaging 99.0 points per game, good for second in the country. The Cougars have scored at least 87 points in all five games, including a whopping 121 points against Chaminade on Tuesday, just 12 hours after playing a hard-fought double-overtime game vs. San Diego State. The Cougars made 17 three-pointers in the contest.
- One of the nation's top-returning scorers, **Tyler Haws**, leads BYU in scoring at 19.4 points per game. **Chase Fischer** averages 17.4 points per outing and **Anson Winder** comes off the bench to average 12.6 points.
- As a team, BYU is shooting 50.4 percent from the field and 42.7 percent from three-point range. The Cougars are allowing 75.4 points per game and foes have made 40.7 percent of their field goal attempts against BYU.

#BoilerNotes Entering Tuesday's Consolation Game With Missouri

- Purdue improved to 4-1 with its impressive 82-61 win over Missouri on Tuesday morning. The Boilermakers will attempt to go 2-1 in their third appearance at the EASports Maui Invitational. The Boilermakers went 2-1 in each of their previous two trips.
- Purdue improved to 9-3 all-time against Missouri with the victory. The winning percentage of .750 is the highest against a Power-Five conference school, with a minimum of 10 meetings.
- Purdue's 25-point halftime lead against Missouri was the largest over a Power-Five school since Feb. 19, 2000 against Minnesota (58-27).
- The 21-point victory was the largest over a Power-Five conference school away from Mackey Arena since Dec. 28, 2010 against Michigan (80-57).
- Entering tomorrow's tilt with BYU, head coach **Matt Painter** has never faced a West Coast Conference school in the regular season.
- Purdue's 61 points allowed against Missouri matched the fewest allowed against a Power-Five non-conference school since Alabama scored just 47 points on Dec. 4, 2010.
- Purdue started the same lineup for the fifth straight game against Missouri. Last year, head coach **Matt Painter** started 13 different lineups. Just three times did one of those lineups start four games in a row.
- Purdue's 46.8 field goal percentage against Missouri was a season low. Last year, Purdue shot 46.8 percent or better just seven times. Have done it all five times this year.
- Purdue fell to 79-10 during the **Matt Painter** era when Purdue shoots over 48.0 percent from the field.
- In the first half against Kansas State, Purdue had 11 turnovers that turned into 17 Wildcat points. In the contest with Missouri, Purdue forced 9 turnovers that it turned into 16 points.
- Purdue's 16 turnovers matched a season high, also set against Samford in the season opener. Purdue has had at least 13 turnovers in all five games this year.
- Purdue made a season-low five three-pointers in the win over Missouri. It is still shooting 40.4 percent from long distance.
- Purdue is also shooting 92-of-159 (.579) from inside the three-point line, a percentage that ranks 22nd in the country.
- Purdue's overall field goal percentage of 51.2 percent is 30th nationally.
- Seven of Purdue's 11 regulars have an assist-to-turnover ratio of greater than 1.00.
- Purdue has blocked 33 shots this year, a block rate of 18.4 percent to rank 15th nationally in that category. On the flipside, Purdue's opponents have blocked seven shots for a block rate of 4.4 percent to rank 18th nationally in terms of getting shots blocked.
- Purdue is outscoring opponents in the paint, 172-98, an average of 34.4 to 19.6 points per game.
- Purdue's bench has accounted for 47.0 percent of the minutes played this year, the second-highest percentage in America. Kentucky is first (48.4).
- Purdue has no scored 75 or more points in the first five games of the season for the second straight year (6 in 2013-14) and third time in the **Matt Painter** era (5 in 2010-11). The most in school history is 12 (1986-87).
- Purdue's 33 free throws made and 43 free throw attempts against Missouri were the most since going 35-of-46 against [9] Illinois on Jan. 9, 2002.
- Purdue has not trailed in three of its five games this year (IUPUI, Grambling, Missouri). It trailed by one point for 19 seconds against Samford.
- Over the last three halves, Purdue has outscored the opposition, 137-110, and all four of Purdue's victories have come by 20 or more points.
- Purdue's freshmen class is averaging 33.2 points per game and shooting 58-of-102 (.569) from the field and have 34 assists to just 23 turnovers.
- Purdue is now 5-3 in three EASports Maui Invitational appearances. The Boilermakers have never lost two games in the tournament. Purdue is also 15-7 all-time in games played in Hawai'i.

Individual Player Updates

#0 - Jon Octeus

- Sensational game against Missouri, with eight points, six rebounds, four assists and one steal in 21 minutes ... shooting 80.0 percent from the free throw line and 60.0 percent from the field ... in the last three games, is averaging 9.0 ppg, 3.3 rpg and 4.0 apg while shooting 9-of-13 (.692) from the field.

#1 - Bryson Scott

- Tallied twp points with an assist and steal in 11 minutes vs. Missouri ... named Big Ten Freshman of the Week twice last year ... continues to struggle with turnovers, now with seven in 64 minutes played ... one of the top perimeter defenders in the country.

#3 - P.J. Thompson

- Scored a career-high seven points against Missouri, adding two assists against zero turnovers in 22 minutes ... owns an assist:turnover ratio of 3.33 (10:3) ... tied for second on the team in assists ... started season 2-of-10 (first three games) from the field; is 2-of-2 in last two games.

#5 - Basil Smotherman

- Strong game against Missouri, with four points, three rebounds, two blocks, one steal and one assist in 17 minutes ... both of his field goals were thunderous dunks ... struggling shooting the ball this year (5-of-17; .294) after shooting 58.0 percent from the field a year ago.

#12 - Vince Edwards

- Big Ten Freshman of the Week on Nov. 17 ... started season 16-of-23 from the field in the first two games for 39 points and 16 rebounds in 48 minutes ... just 4-of-12 for 12 points and 15 rebounds in 65 minutes in the last three outings ... leads team in rebounding (6.2 RPG).

#20 - A.J. Hammons

- Moved into third-place tie on Purdue's career blocked shots list with 176 after swatting away three shots against Missouri ... scored season-high 12 points against the Tigers ... in two tournament games, Hammons has 18 points and eight rebounds in 28 minutes of action (eight fouls).

#21 - Kendall Stephens

- Has scored at least 20 points in two of his last four games (24 vs. IUPUI; 21 vs. Kansas State) ... made a three-pointer in 15 straight games, dating to last year (39-of-89; .438) ... his 18 three-pointers are tied for third nationally and shares the Big Ten lead ... has 82 career three-pointers and has 14 career games (37 contests) of three or more three-pointers.

#31 - Dakota Mathias

- Committed first turnover of the season against Kansas State ... Coach Painter calls him best passer he has ever seen and has a 5.00 assist-to-turnover ratio (10:2) early this year ... 18 of his 19 field goal attempts are three-pointers ... has at least two 3-pointers in three games this year.

#35 - Rapheal Davis




- Team captain ... his 18 free throw attempts against Missouri were the most for a Purdue player since Brad Miller had 21 against Rhode Island (March 13, 1997) ... scored a career-high 22 points against Missouri ... his 14 made free throws were most since Carl Landry had 15 on Nov. 22, 2005) ... can guard four positions on the floor.

#44 - Isaac Haas

- Averaging 14.0 points, 6.7 rebounds and 1.0 blocks in 21.3 minutes per game over the last three outings ... shooting 18-of-23 (.783) from the field in the last four games ... ranks fifth in the country in fouls drawn / 40 minutes (10.2) ... is just 12-of-26 (.462) from the free throw line in the last five games ... his 35 free throw attempts are 22nd in the country and second among the nation's freshmen (Duke's **Justise Winslow** - 36).

Head Coach Matt Painter

- ▶ **Record at Purdue:** 195-113 (.633) / 10th year
- ▶ **Career Record:** 220-118 (.651) / 11th year

- With a pair of Sweet 16 appearances, six NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 10th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season.
- Painter has averaged over 21 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 20 victories in six of those seasons.
- Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last eight years have seen six 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament berths, two Sweet 16 appearances, a regular-season Big Ten title and a Big Ten Tournament crown.
- The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.
- Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.
- The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.
- Painter has also resurrected Mackey Arena as one of the country's best home-court advantages, piling up a 123-28 (.815) record at home over the last nine seasons, including a remarkable 67-5 (.931) record against non-conference opponents.
- Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times in the last six seasons, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.
- Painter has seen a total of 21 players earn a combined 38 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored an Academic All-American, as Moore earned second-team honors during the 2009-10 season.
- In addition, the program has received the NCAA Public Recognition Award for posting a multi-year academic progress rate among the top 10 percent. Purdue has had an APR of at least 985 in each of the last three years, one of two schools in the Big Ten that can stake that claim (Michigan).
