Coach Mike Littlewood

Coach Mike Littlewood (BYU `93) is in his first season as head coach at BYU. The 46-year-old coach enters the season with a 181-111 (.620) record in six seasons at the four-year level at Dixie State College and had a 382-127 (.750) mark in 10 seasons when that school was a junior college. He is assisted by Trent Pratt (Dixie `08), Brent Haring (So. Virginia -07) and Jeremy Thomas (BYU `99), all in their first years at BYU.

Series Record vs. Utah, Pepperdine

BYU leads the series vs. Utah, 249-109-2, with a 109-57-1 advantage against the Utes on the road. Since leaving the Mountain West Conference, BYU has a 4-3 record vs. Utah. BYU has a 25-11-1 record in non-conference games against Utah. BYU's greatest and longest standing rivalry—with the University of Utah—did not start on t he football field. On May 18, 1895, the Brigham Young Academy played against the Utes on a baseball diamond. The game ended in a 0-0 tie and a bench-clearing brawl. The other tie was a 2-2 tie in 1970 at Salt Lake City. Pepperdine leads the series, 18-9-1 vs. BYU, dating back to 1954 (http://byucougars.com/node/4500/m-baseball). The 1-1 tie was in 1963 at Malibu, Calif.

Top 25 Teams

BYU upset then No. 2 LSU (NCBWA, also No. 3 Collegiate Baseball & No. 10 Baseball America/USA Today), 9-4. Then two weeks later BYU twice upset No. 21 UC Irvine (NCBWA, also No. 21 Baseball America/USA Today & No. 22 Collegiate Baseball), 6-3 and 3-1. In 1983 prior to the NCAA Regionals BYU was ranked No. 1 after upsetting then No. 1 San Diego State in the WAC Playoffs. In 2012 BYU lost at No. 4 Arkansas and No. 7 Stanford. In 2011 BYU split at No. 6 Arizona State and lost three times to No. 3 TCU. In 2010 BYU beat No. 4 TCU once in six games and lost twice at No. 2 Arizona State. In 2009 BYU lost at No. 6 Baylor and No. 10 Kansas State and No. 10 TCU.

Home Season

The Cougars entered the 2013 season with a 152-89 (.631) record at Larry H. Miller Field which seats 2,204 fans in its 13th season since it was built.

In the first nine years BYU drew 218,981 fans for an average of 1,177 and 142,248 at night for an average of 1,452. The crowd of 3,081 against Utah in 2010 was the fourth-largest in school history and the secondlargest at Miller Park. The largest crowd at home during 2011 was 1,474 vs. Seattle and the crowd of 2,820 fans at Arizona State was the largest on the road. BYU drew 12,754 fans (averaging 797) for an 11-6 home record. Weather caused the cancellation of two home games (AFA & TCU) and forced a doubleheader vs. SDSU in 2011.

The last time BYU played in St. George was 1999 when it hosted the Southern Utah Chiropractic with a 2-3 record against Washington, Southern Utah, Lewis Clark State and Mesa State.

Jacob Hannemann is No. 23 in triples after tying the school record with two in one game in the 6-3 upset over No. 21 UC Irvine. Bret Lopez is No. 22 in sacrifice flies, James Lengal is ranked No. 30 with five saves, and Jeff Barker, Adam Miller and Desmond Poulson are each tied for No. 19 in games started.

Here are a couple of interesting baseball facts on the WCC (BYU has a 50-61-1 record against that league). Pepperdine won the College World Series in 1992. Of the nine current WCC teams, only St. Mary's has not participated in the NCAA post-season tournament. BYU's 1-1 tie against Pepperdine came in the second game of a doubleheader in 1963. BYU's win-loss baseball records and last action against the current WCC teams is: 13-15 vs. Gonzaga, 2012, GU won 17-1 3-5 vs. LMU, 2012, BYU won 8-6 9-20-1 vs. Pepperdine, 2012, PU won 8-7 11-9 vs. Portland, 2012, BYU won 7-4
