1,000 RUSHING YARDS CLUB

Jamaal Williams is already one of 10 BYU players to ever rush for 1,000 yards in a single season (2013, 1,233 yards). The 10 players have accomplished the feat 14 times, with Harvey Unga, Curtis Brown and Jamal Willis as the only players to do it multiple times (Unga 3, Brown and Willis 2). Williams can become the fourth player in BYU history with multiple 1,000-yard rushing seasons with another 58 yards.

CLOSE GAMES

Seven of BYU's eight games this season have been decided by seven points or fewer. The Cougars have had just two seasons with more than seven games decided by seven points or less - 1993 and 1994. In 1993, BYU was 4-4 in the close games and finished 6-6 overall. The 1994 team was 6-2 in close ones and 10-3 overall. The 1978 team also had seven games within seven points, going 4-3 in those games and went 9-4 on the year.

BYE WEEKS AND NOVEMBER GAMES

BYU is 11-2 when coming off of a bye week over the past 10 seasons. Both losses came in 2013 against Utah and Wisconsin. The Cougars are also 31-6 in the month of November over the past 10 seasons.

BYU STORYLINES

- **SERIES HISTORY.** Last year, BYU defeated the Bearcats 38-24 in the two schools' first meeting. Trailing 24-17, BYU scored 21 points in the fourth quarter at LaVell Edwards Stadium. Nick Kurtz had 119 receiving yards and two touchdowns and Algje Brown scored two rushing touchdowns and had 88 rushing yards.
- **THE AMERICAN.** BYU is facing an opponent from the American Athletic Conference, marking the seventh different conference BYU has faced in 2016. The team has already played games against the Pac-12, Big 12, MAC, Big Ten, SEC and Mountain West.
- **TOUGH SCHEDULE.** BYU's 2016 schedule ranks 17th in the Jeff Sagarin USA Today rankings. The Cougars have played six Power 5 teams, going 3-3 against them. Three of the four losses have come at the hands of teams currently ranked in the top 20 (No. 14/15 WVU, No. 16 Utah and No. 24 Boise State).
- **NFF NATIONAL SCHOLAR-ATHLETE.** Taysom Hill was named one of 12 finalists for the William V. Campbell Trophy and a National Scholar-Athlete by the National Football Foundation. With the honor he earns an \$18,000 postgraduate scholarship. Hill graduated in finance with a 3.45 GPA. The winner will have their scholarship increased to \$25,000 and will be announced Dec. 6 in New York.
- **JIM THORPE AWARD.** Defensive back Kai Nacua was named as one of 16 semifinalists for the Jim Thorpe Award, honoring the nation's top defensive back. Nacua is tied for No. 2 nationally in interceptions with five.

POSTGAME MEDIA AVAILABILITY

BYU's Jamaal Williams, a four-time Doak Walker Award watch-list honoree, is putting together a strong case for the award, as well as All-American consideration. He ranks high in several statistical categories in 2016. Williams became the Cougars' all-time leading rusher this season and is on pace to make a run at the BYU single-season record held by Doak Walker Award winner, Luke Staley (2001). Williams has more rushing yards after seven games played than Staley did (896) in his winning season, along with three of the last five winners, including Derrick Henry (901), Monte Ball (816) and Trent Richardson (912). Williams has also played against more Power 5 teams (6) in the first seven games than any of the previous five winners of the award.

Kai Nacua was recently named a semifinalist for the 2016 Jim Thorpe Award, honoring the best defensive back in college football. A ball-hawking safety, Nacua has more interceptions than 30 FBS teams in 2016. He has 13 career interceptions, the most at BYU since 2000 when defensive statistics were officially tracked by the NCAA and unofficially tied for the fifth-most at BYU. Nacua has three games with multiple picks, including a three-interception game vs. Boise State in 2015 and two pick-sixes under his belt. He is also BYU's active leader in total tackles with 151.

BEARCATS FALL AT TEMPLE

PHILADELPHIA - The University of Cincinnati coaching staff knew it would be difficult to slow Temple's offense, but after the way quarterback Gunner Kiel played last week, they had every reason to believe they could score enough points to keep up with the Owls.

They didn't come close.

Temple was every bit as formidable as it was expected to be, rolling up 474 yards of offense, 275 on the ground, but the UC offense was punchless in the second half when it failed to produce a first down or complete a pass. The Bearcats went three-and-out on all four of their second-half possessions.

The result was a disheartening 34-13 loss for the Bearcats on Saturday before 29,763 fans at Lincoln Financial Field, their third loss in the last four games, leaving them with a 4-4 record overall, 1-4 in the American Athletic Conference. Temple, which shares first place with South Florida in the AAC East with a 4-1 record, is 6-3 overall.

"I thought if we could keep them between 400 and 500 yards we'd have a chance," said UC coach Tommy Tuberville, "but I didn't think that they would be able to shut our offense down like that in the second half. You've got to give credit to their defense."

The Bearcats were so ineffective on offense that Tuberville said after the game it was time for a change, not just in personnel or technique, but with substantial alterations to their offensive approach.

"Sometimes we might go a little bit conservative trying to protect the quarterback and get it down the field," Tuberville said. "We've got to get away from that. We've got to be more aggressive on offense. We've got to take the reins off, let our receivers run routes.

"We very seldom get five out on a route. We keep a back in to help protect. We can't do that anymore. We've got to be more aggressive in play calling, formations, things that can give you more big plays. We've got to really come together as an offensive staff and really look at what we're doing in terms of trying to get the ball to our outside receivers."

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR SIX

The 12-game independent schedule features teams from eight different conferences and an independent team. Six games come against Power Five opponents, including teams from the Pac-12, Big 12, Big Ten and SEC. The schedule ranks No. 7 in Phil Steele's preseason schedule rankings. The opponents on the 2016 schedule posted a 97-57 record in 2015, with 10 bowl teams and an FCS playoff team.

The Cougars host six home games and have four true road contests with two neutral site games, both at NFL stadiums, in 2016. The home schedule consists of UCLA, Toledo, Mississippi State, Southern Utah, UMass and Utah State. Teams on the home schedule put together a 44-31 record in 2015, with four reaching bowl games and Southern Utah earned an FCS playoff berth. Road contests include Utah, Michigan State, Boise State and Cincinnati with neutral site games against Arizona (University of Phoenix Stadium - home of the Arizona Cardinals) and West Virginia (FedEx Field - home of the Washington Redskins). All six games away from home are against 2015 bowl teams with a combined record of 53-16 last year.

BOWLING OPPONENTS

Of BYU's 12 opponents in 2016, 10 played in a bowl game in 2015. Only USC has more bowl teams on its 2016 schedule with 11. BYU, along with just Ole Miss and Colorado are the only three teams with 10 bowl teams on the schedule this season.

TEAM CAPTAINS

BYU will have four captains for the 2016 season in senior quarterback Taysom Hill, senior running back Jamaal Williams, senior defensive back Kai Nacua and senior defensive lineman Harvey Langi. Hill is serving as a captain for the third time. BYU offensive coordinator Ty Detmer was also a three-time team captain (89, 90, 91).

FLAG BEARERS

BYU's tradition of carrying team flags out of the tunnel adds some new looks for 2016. A United States serviceman will carry an American flag for every game, with team flags carried by selected players and alumni flags carried by former BYU players for each game.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's record at LaVell Edwards Stadium is ranked No. 12 among teams playing in their current stadium.

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates missions around the world in 150 nations speaking more than 160 languages. Over 74,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions in 418 missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours—seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples)—teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

The 2016 team has 84 players that served church missions and there are another 27 currently serving. Members of the team have served in over 25 countries and six of the seven continents around the globe.

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recruiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. More than 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now, several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff.

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA. Sitake was raised in Laie, Hawaii and later moved to the mainland. His staff includes Polynesians Ilaia Tuiaiki, Steve Kaufusi, Reno Mahe, Nu'u Tafisi, Russell Tialavea, Tevita Ofahengauae, Jack Damuni, Jasen Ah You, Sione Kinikini, Vince Feula and Harvey Unga.

LAST GAME RECAP: TURNOVERS NOT ENOUGH FOR BYU TO OVERCOME NO. 14 BOISE STATE

BOISE, Idaho – Despite the defense forcing five turnovers, BYU football's comeback effort fell short 28-27 at No. 14 Boise State on Thursday night.

In the final drive of the game, BYU attempted a 44-yard field goal for the win but Rhett Almond's attempt on second down was blocked. The Cougars recovered the blocked kick to try to win the game. Taysom Hill threw the ball into the end zone on a final attempt but it went incomplete as time expired.

The Cougar defense forced five turnovers, including two pick-sixes in the contest, but the offense was able to score just three points when the possession was returned to them. Boise State had 571 total yards to BYU's 322.

On the defense, Sae Tautou led the team with nine total tackles, one sack, one tackle for loss and one forced fumble. Butch Pau'u also had nine tackles to go along with his 0.5 sacks and 0.5 tackles for loss. Fred Warner and Dayan Lake each recorded an interception for a touchdown. Warner filled out the stat sheet with seven total tackles and a forced fumble to go along with the interception. Freshman Lake had a well-rounded game as well, earning eight tackles, including five solo stops.

Hill completed 21 of 41 passes for 187 yards. He also rushed for 48 yards and a touchdown. Sophomore running back Squally Canada rushed a career-high 88 yards on 21 carries. Nine different BYU receivers caught a pass in the game, led by Mitchell Juergens' four catches for 57 yards.

The Broncos struck early in the game. They scored touchdowns on their first two drives to take the early 14-0 lead over the Cougars.

Boise State came out for a field goal attempt but Corbin Kaufusi blocked the kick, deflecting it right into Kai Nacua's arms. Nacua returned the ball 25 yards to set up the offense in good position. To start the second quarter, BYU finished off the drive started by the blocked field goal. The Cougars ended up settling for a 35-yard field goal from Almond, putting them on the board, 10-3.

In Boise State's ensuing drive, the defense turned the tide once again. Fred Warner picked off the Broncos' quarterback Brett Rypien, returning it 59 yards for a pick-six, the first of the season for the Cougars. With 14:22 to play until the half, BYU made it a four-point game, 14-10.

BYU's defense came up with another big play with less than five minutes to go in the half. Off a tipped pass, Lake snagged it and returned a second interception for a touchdown. The freshman took the pick 50 yards down the field into the end zone to give the Cougars their first lead of the game, 17-14. With 35 seconds until the break, the Broncos scored on a 36-yard pass to head into the locker room back on top, 21-17.

In the third, Hill found Juergens for a 33-yard diving catch just short of the end zone. The 1-yard rushing touchdown from Hill put the Cougars up 24-21 with 6:55 on the clock.

In the following series, the Broncos fumbled the ball again. Fred Warner forced the ball loose and Troy Warner recovered it, bringing the offense back out to start the fourth quarter. The Cougars were held to just a field goal, a 37-yarder from Almond that pushed the lead up to 27-21 with 13:33 left in the game.

After a 46-yard pass, Boise State responded, scoring on a 4-yard rush with 10:37 to play to take the 28-27 lead over BYU. When the Cougar offense could not convert on third down, they punted the ball back to the Broncos, who drained four minutes off the clock.

THE BYU OFFENSE

- **TAG TEAM, BACK AGAIN.** In 2013 when both played a full season, Taysom Hill (1,344) and Jamaal Williams (1,233) combined for 2,577 rushing yards. Through eight games, the pair has combined for 1,314 yards (942 for Williams and 372 for Hill). They both rushed for 100 yards in the same game (West Virginia-Williams 169, Hill 105) for the first time since Sept. 11, 2014 against Houston. Hill ran for 160 and Williams ran for 139 in a 33-25 win. BYU is 4-1 when the two go for at least 100 each.
- **SCORING BY QUARTER.** BYU has scored 41 points in the first quarter, 42 in the second, 41 in the third, 86 in the fourth quarter and 14 in overtime this season. Averaging 10.8 points in the 4th quarter ranks 14th in the FBS. Last year, BYU was one of the best 4th-quarter teams nationally (4) scoring an average of 10.8 points in the 4th quarter.
- **BALANCED ATTACK.** The Cougars have run a nearly perfect balanced attack. Through eight games, BYU has 1,541 rushing yards and 1,616 passing yards. With 177 total first downs, 82 have come rushing and 81 have come via the pass. The Cougars average 192.6 per game on the ground and 202.0 in the air.

BYU DEFENSE BY THE NUMBERS

- 2** Kai Nacua is ranked second in the NCAA in total interceptions with five. Nacua has 13 career interceptions, the most by a BYU player since 2000. As a team, the Cougars have 14 interceptions this year, ranked No. 4 nationally.
- 206** BYU gave up just 206 total yards against Michigan State, which was the fewest the Spartans had totaled since tallying 187 against No. 13 Nebraska in 2011. The 206 given up by BYU are the fewest the Cougars have allowed in 2016.
- 5** The Cougars had five turnovers at Boise State: two interceptions and three fumble recoveries. BYU has 21 total turnovers gained so far in 2016, ranked No. 2 nationally.
- 9** Against Mississippi State, the Cougars tallied a season-high nine tackles for loss in the winning effort, surpassing the eight recorded against UCLA. BYU has now had at least four tackles for loss in every game this season.
- 50** The defense held UCLA to just 50 rushing yards, the fewest of the season for a BYU opponent. The last time BYU held the opponents to less than 50 was against Mizzou last season when the Tigers had just 46 rushing yards.

THE BYU DEFENSE

- SCORING DEFENSE.** The BYU defense has held four opponents to 20 points or less (16, 20, 17, 14). The last time a BYU team kept its first three opponents under 20 was in 1984 (14, 13, 15). The 1984 team held its first five opponents to 20 points or less. In 2015, the Cougars were able to hold teams to 20 or less five times.
- TFL.** The Cougars notched at least six tackles for a loss in 12 out of 13 games in 2015 and have 50 total so far in the 2016 season, including a season-high of nine against Mississippi State. BYU has not had less than four tackles for a loss in a game so far this season. Last season, the Cougars ranked No. 9 nationally with 7.5 tackles for loss per game.
- STAYING POSITIVE.** BYU is 58-10 since 2005 with a positive turnover margin. BYU was plus-5 with two picks and three fumble recoveries at Boise State and plus-3 with three picks and three fumble recoveries against Utah. The Cougars recorded a positive turnover margin in seven games in 2015.
- NEW FACES, NEW PLACES.** A number of players have shuffled positions with the coaching change to Kalani Sitake. Notable changes include several linebackers transitioning to defensive line positions with more 4-3 elements in the defensive scheme including Harvey Langi moving from mostly playing middle linebacker to defensive end. Two offensive players of note jumped to defense, including Francis Bernard moving from running back to linebacker and Akile Davis moving from receiver to cornerback. Micah Hannemann, the starting field corner in 2015 also moved into the middle at one of the safety positions.

Kalani Sitake (pronounced kah-lah-nee see-tah-kay) was named head coach overseeing the BYU football program on December 19, 2015, by director of athletics Tom Holmoe.

Sitake is the 14th head coach in BYU history. He comes to BYU from Oregon State, where he served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator.

A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake returns to his alma mater with 15 years of coaching experience, including seven years as defensive coordinator and four seasons as an assistant head coach.

Prior to serving as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator at Oregon State in 2015, Sitake spent 10 seasons at the University of Utah. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012.

Sitake has coached several Pac-12 and Mountain West Conference honorees, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014). He also helped mentor 14 NFL Draft picks during his time at Utah, including 12 all-league players and three freshmen All-Americans. He helped the Utes win seven of eight bowl games during his tenure.

Sitake began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002. Sitake then joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.

Born in Nuku'alofa, Tonga, and raised in Laie, Hawai'i and Provo, Utah, Sitake becomes the first FBS head football coach of Tongan descent. He is the 14th head coach in BYU history, and just the fourth since 1972, when Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards took over the program.

Sitake began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards.

He was named BYU's Football Scholar Athlete of the Year in 1998, Impact Player of the Year in 1999, along with team captain and the most valuable running back in 2000. He signed a free agent contract with the Cincinnati Bengals in 2001, but was forced to retire due to an injury.

Sitake graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. He and his wife Timberly have three children, Skye, Sadie and Kelaokalani (KK).
