BYU-NOTRE DAME STORYLINES

- This is the 7th meeting between BYU and Notre Dame.** The Cougars trail in the series 2-4 with the last matchup in South Bend going to Notre Dame with a 49-23 win. BYU has a 1-3 record at Notre Dame with the lone victory coming on a 21-14 win in 1994. This is the first time they meet together as independents.
- BYU is facing its second top-10 opponent in as many weeks.** Last week the Cougars fell to 42-24 to No. 10 Oregon State and face a tough task in traveling to South Bend to take on No. 5 Notre Dame.
- The Cougars have won four games against top-5 opponents in school history.** The last time BYU defeated a top-5 team was a 14-13 win over No. 3 Oklahoma in 2009. With a 4-8 record against the top-5, the Cougars offer wins include No. 3 Pittsburgh (1984), No. 4 Air Force (1985) and No. 1 Miami (1990).
- BYU wide receiver Cody Hoffman has caught a pass in 26 straight games,** tied for the 10th longest streak in the nation. He has caught a pass in 32 of 33 career games. Notre Dame's TJ Jones has caught a pass in 20 consecutive games for the Fighting Irish.
- Notre Dame and BYU are two of the top defensive teams in the nation.** Both teams are ranked in the top 25 in the following defensive categories: scoring defense, No. 2 Notre Dame (8.7), No. 7 BYU (13.6), total defense, No. 5 BYU (260.9), No. 11 Notre Dame (287.0), rushing defense, No. 3 BYU (67.8), No. 25 Notre Dame (113.5), pass defense, No. 14 Notre Dame (173.5), No. 24 BYU (193.0), red zone conversions allowed, No. 1 Notre Dame (50.0%) and No. 3 BYU (53.3%).
- Inside linebackers Brandon Ogletree and Manti Te'o lead their team as captains and defensive leaders.** Both Lott Trophy watch list honorees, Ogletree leads BYU on the year with 57 total tackles, No. 52 nationally and Te'o leads the Fighting Irish with 59 tackles, No. 40 in the country. Ogletree also adds 6.0 tackles for loss, four pass breakups and one quarterback hurry. Te'o brings 2.0 tackles for loss, three interceptions, three pass breakups, three quarterback hurries and two fumble recoveries.

POSTGAME MEDIA AVAILABILITY

A postgame press conference will be conducted in the LaVell Edwards Stadium press room, located on the southeast end of the stadium next to the BYU locker room. At the discretion of the visiting team, opponent interviews will be conducted in the Blue Zone, near the opponent's locker room located on northwest end of the stadium. Coach Mendenhall and select players will be available following the NCAA mandatory cooling off period. Members of the media are invited to move from the press box down to the field and to the press room four minutes prior to the ending of the game. A direct video feed will also be sent to the press box from the BYU postgame press conference. A basic transcript of Mendenhall's comments from the postgame press conference will be provided. For road games, BYU will conduct interviews outside the locker room or in a location designated by the host school.

BYU FADES IN FOURTH QUARTER, FALLS 42-24 TO NO. 10 OREGON STATE

PROVO, Utah - BYU matched No. 10 Oregon State with three touchdowns into the third quarter but was unable to hold on in the fourth to drop the contest, 42-24, in front of a sellout crowd at LaVell Edwards Stadium Saturday.

Oregon State (5-0) rolled up 450 yards to snap BYU's (4-3) 12-game streak of holding opponents under 300 yards. The Beavers were the last team to gain over 300 yards against the Cougars, a streak spanning 12 games since last year.

BYU collected 386 total yards with 305 coming through the air.

Freshman Jamaal Williams ran in two touchdowns as part of his 15 carries for 36 yards and did damage on short shovel passes with four receptions for 76 yards. Junior Cody Hoffman was a steady target for the Cougars with 10 completions for 102 yards. The game marks his fourth 100-yard receiving game this season and puts him at 2,004 career receiving yards, the 15th player in school history to do so.

The score was tied 21-all at the start of the fourth quarter before the Beavers were able to put the game away.

Senior quarterback Riley Nelson completed 28 of 51 for 305 yards, one touchdown and three interceptions.

In the opening drive of the game Oregon State marched down field 75 yards to quickly go up 7-0 with an 11-yard touchdown. The score ended the Cougars' 13-quarter streak of holding opposing offenses without a touchdown.

BYU engineered its own scoring drive on its first possession with Williams trotting into the end zone to tie the contest 7-7 with 9:27 left in the first quarter. A 16-yard pickup by Nelson on the first play and an 18-yard completion by Ross Apo highlighted the drive. The touchdown was the first allowed by Oregon State in a first quarter this season.

NOTES FROM BYU'S LAST GAME

BYU was tied with Oregon State 21-21 heading into the fourth quarter before the Beavers got the best of the Cougars, outscoring the team 21-3 in the final frame.

- **The last time the BYU defense allowed over 300 total yards was 2011's 38-28 victory over Oregon State** when the Cougars surrendered 365 total yards to the Beavers. This year it was too much for BYU however, giving up a season-high 450 yards.
- **The BYU defense got big and tall, batting down three Oregon State passes** for incompletions. Defensive linemen Romney Fuga, Bronson Kaufusi and Ezekiel Ansah all batted balls down.
- **Wide receiver Cody Hoffman kept his streak alive, now catching at least one pass in 26 straight games** and 32 of 33 career games. Hoffman had a career-best 10 receptions. He finished with 102 yards, his fourth 100-yard game of the season and 10th of his career.
- **Twin brothers, BYU's Uani 'Unga and Oregon State's Feti 'Unga** faced off against each other's team. Both players honored their mother by wearing her maiden name, Taumoepeau, on their jerseys. Uani finished with four tackles, including 0.5 tackle for loss. Feti finished with seven tackles and an identical 0.5 tackle for loss.
- **Quarterback Riley Nelson set a new career high in passing completions (28) and attempts (51).** He finished with 305 yards, one touchdown and three interceptions. Oregon State's Cody Vaz completed 20 of 32 passes for 332 yards and three touchdowns, all in his first career start.
- **With his 102 yards, Hoffman now has 2,004 career receiving yards,** the 13th player in school history to have at least 2,000 career receiving yards.

OPPONENT OUTLOOK

NOTRE DAME'S LAST GAME

SOUTH BEND, Ind. (AP) - Notre Dame knew what was coming. Stanford doesn't get cute inches from the goal line.

And after three years of getting pushed around by the Cardinal, the Fighting Irish pushed back, winning the most important shoving match they've had all season.

A wall of Notre Dame defenders stopped Stepfan Taylor inches from the goal line on fourth down in overtime and the seventh-ranked Irish remained unbeaten with a 20-13 victory against the No. 17 Cardinal on a soggy Saturday in South Bend.

Taylor kept reaching and turning with bodies underneath him, and his knee never did hit the ground before reaching the ball across the goal line. But the officials ruled it was too late. The whistle had blown, and that meant the play was stopped. Taylor finished with 102 yards on 28 carries. He needed 103.

The celebration had to wait for a replay review. The call stood. Irish fans who weren't already on the field spilled out of the stands, and Notre Dame's national title hopes remained alive. The Irish are 6-0 for the first time since 2002.

TJ Jones made a reaching 7-yard touchdown catch from Tommy Rees on the first overtime possession to



give the Fighting Irish (6-0) a seven-point lead.

Stanford (4-2) responded by driving to a first-and-goal at the 4.

Behind its big strong offensive line, Taylor ran for 1 on first, 2 on second and inches on third down. That left one play from inside the 1 and the Notre Dame defense, led by Carlo Calabrese, held up Taylor and moved him backward.

In the overtime, Rees lofted a 16-yard pass to Theo Riddick to convert a third-and-8 to the 7. On the next play, he threw behind Jones on a slant and the receiver reached back for a sliding two-handed catch and a 20-13 lead.

Then the Fighting Irish defense, which has now not given up a touchdown in four straight games, made it stand. Almost half the field was covered with Notre Dame fans, as rain poured down during the post-game celebration. They didn't seem to mind.

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR TWO

2011 was the Cougars inaugural year as an independent. BYU went 10-3 and won its fifth bowl game in six years. The Cougars had all 13 games televised, including 12 to a national audience, 11 of which were featured on the ESPN family of networks. BYU had five on ESPN, four on ESPN2 and two on ESPNU. In 2012, BYU ups the ante with a more difficult schedule, featuring a road game at fellow independent Notre Dame along with three teams from the Pac-12 and matchups against the ACC, WAC and MW. To date BYU has five games scheduled to air on the ESPN family of networks along with games on ABC, NBC and another on BYUtv, all nationally televised games. The Cougars have future games scheduled with Wisconsin, West Virginia, Nebraska, Notre Dame, East Carolina, Georgia Tech, Texas, UCF, Houston, Washington State, Boise State, Middle Tennessee State, Utah and Hawai'i.

FLAG BEARERS

BYU has a tradition of selecting a player before each game to run the team flag onto the field. In 2008, the team implemented a new tradition - the alumni flag. The team selects a former Cougar to carry out the alumni flag, along with the chosen current player who runs out with the current team flag. Both flags are white with a blue "Y" logo. The team flag has been signed by each member of the team, while the alumni flag has been signed by former BYU players. In 2011, the team added a special teams flag, donned by a vintage BYU logo adopted by the special teams, following the same protocol as the team flag with an exemplary special teams player being chosen to carry it each week.

TEAM CAPTAINS

Selected by their peers, quarterback Riley Nelson, linebacker Brandon Ogletree and running back David Foote have been named as team captains for the 2012 season. The three seniors are all new captains for the 2012 season. Nelson will serve as the offense's captain, Ogletree for the defense and Foote for special teams. Nelson has 1,172 total yards of offense and passed for 6 touchdowns this year. Ogletree has 57 total tackles to lead the team. Foote has 24 rushes for 97 yards and also has 4 tackles on special teams and blocked a punt.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 45,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 64,045 after refurbishing the middle of the east section. The capacity now sits at 63,470 due to accommodations for wheelchair access. For the 2012 season the stadium will feature new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands.

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates 347 missions around the world in 145 nations speaking 164 languages. More than 53,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions in 330 missions around the world. Seventy-five percent of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 25. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours—seven days a week for two years or 18 months for women and couples—teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

There are currently 38 missionaries from the football team serving in 17 different countries. Members of the current team cover six of the seven continents around the globe and speak six different languages.

FIRESIDES

The BYU football team participates in hour-long devotionals prior to eight games this season. These devotionals are referred to as "firesides" and are intended to help players, coaches and those who attend strengthen or gain a knowledge of our purpose here on earth. Firesides typically include a musical number from members of the team and talks from selected players, along with Holly and Bronco Mendenhall.

THE BYU OFFENSE

- **True freshman and 17-year old Jamaal Williams has shined in his first seven games as a Cougar.** Williams leads BYU in total touchdowns with five rushing scores on the year. Against Hawai'i, Williams seized the day, picking up 155 yards and two scores on just 15 carries. Just nine BYU freshmen running backs have rushed for over 100 yards with Jamaal Williams being the ninth vs. Hawai'i. The others include Fahu Tahī, Mike Hague, Ronnie Jenkins, Mark Atuaia, Josh Quezada, Curtis Brown, Jamal Willis and Harvey Unga. He did damage in the passing game vs. Oregon State, taking quick shovel passes for big gains, catching just for passes and turning them into 76 yards. Williams leads the team with 345 rushing yards and five touchdowns. He also has 10 receptions for 130 yards out of the backfield.
- **The tight end position has made a strong comeback with Kaneakua Friel.** Friel leads the tight ends with 23 receptions for 266 yards and a team-leading four touchdowns. He is second on the team in receiving yards and total receptions. Friel opened the season with a bang, grabbing six receptions for 101 yards and two scores. BYU's other tight ends have 13 catches for 174 yards and two touchdowns this season. He has caught a team-high four touchdown passes, good for No. 45 nationally.
- **Wideout Cody Hoffman leads BYU in receiving so far in 2012,** just as he did in 2011. Hoffman currently has 41 receptions, 534 yards and two scores. The junior picked up his fourth 100-yard receiving game of the season vs. Oregon State with a career-best 10 receptions and 102 yards. He had eight receptions for 114 yards vs. Utah State, including three of the four receptions on the Cougars only touchdown drive. His 534 receiving yards are No. 33 nationally. He is averaging 76.3 yards per game and 13.0 yards per reception.
- **The Cougars are winning all four quarters.** BYU has outscored opponents 28-24 in the first quarter and dominated the second quarter 64-6. The Cougars have a slight edge in the third quarter 43-37 and have outscored opponents 44-28 in the final frame. BYU is outscoring opponents in a game by an average of 25.6 to 13.6
- **Eleven different players have scored touchdowns this year** as BYU has been able to spread the ball around in 2012. Williams leads with five and Taysom Hill and Friel have four apiece while the rest go Hoffman (2), Lasike (2), Mahina (2) and then Lark, Alisa, Apo, Ridley, and Falslev all with 1 each. No one on the team has a rushing touchdown and a receiving touchdown.

- 3** BYU batted down three passes against Oregon State. Romney Fuga and Bronson Kaufusi got their hands on the ball in back-to-back plays to force the Beavers to punt on 4th and 8. Ezekiel Ansah used his height to bat down a third pass attempt.
- 4** Junior linebacker Kyle Van Noy recorded a sack against Oregon State to bump up his season total to 7.5, the fourth highest ranking in the nation. Named to multiple watch lists, Van Noy has rallied for 11.5 tackles for loss (T-11).

THE BYU DEFENSE

- **BYU is No. 5 nationally in total defense.** With seven returning starters from the No. 13 defensive unit in 2011, the Cougars have continued to climb the defensive rankings in 2012. BYU has help opponents to an average of 260.9 yards, good for the 5th-best mark nationally. The powerhouse defense holds eight top-10 defensive rankings, including No. 3 red zone defense and No. 3 rushing defense.
- **Spreading the wealth.** Team defense has been a big part of BYU's success so far this season as only two players have recorded double digit tackles in any game. Brandon Ogeltree did against Utah with a career-high 12 tackles and Spencer Hadley finished with 10 the same night. Eleven Cougars have 20 or more tackles on the season, with Ogeltree leading the way with 57 total tackles.
- **Three-and-outs.** BYU's defense is averaging 5.4 three-and-outs per game, good for the No. 6 spot in the category. The Cougars have forced their opponents off the field with a three-and-out 38 times in seven games. Of the 93 drives opponents have had against BYU, 40.8% of them have been cut short with a three-and-out. The defense had five three-and-outs vs. Oregon State.
- **Breaking up is hard to do.** The secondary that Bronco Mendenhall deemed the most athlete he's seen since at BYU has rallied for the 11th best mark in pass breakups with 41. Jordan Johnson leads the group in his first season starting at field corner with eight pass breakups and one interception, tied for 17th in the nation. The Cougars hussled for six pass breakups against the Beavers.
- **Ezekiel Ansah has come a long way since 2010** when he had to be taught how to put football pads on. The defensive lineman/linebacker hybrid had a break out game against Boise State, finishing with a career-high eight tackles and 2.5 tackles for loss, while picking up his first career sack. The sack was the first allowed by the Broncos this season. With a 6-foot-6, 270-pound frame, "Ziggy" also batted down a pass and snuffed out a 4th down attempt from Boise State. The former 200-meter track athlete improved on those numbers against Utah State, wreaking havoc in the backfield for the Aggies defense. Ansah finished with career highs in tackles for loss (3) and sacks (2), and tacked on two quarterback hurries.
- **The Kyle Van Noy Show is back.** After being the only Division I player to record a statistic in each of the major defensive categories in 2011, the 6-foot-3, 235 pounder is back at it again in 2012. The Bednarik Award, Nagurski Trophy and Lombardi Award watchlist candidate has top defensive marks for the Cougars in four categories, including tackles for loss (11.5), sacks (7.5), quarterback hurries (8) and forced fumbles (3). The junior playmaker is T-4th nationally in forced fumbles, T-4 in sacks and T-11 in tackles for loss. Van Noy's defensive presence is a solid asset to the No. 5 defense.
- **Stopping the run is often a theme and BYU is pretty good at it.** The Cougars finished the 2011 season ranked No. 19 in rushing defense and their run-stopping effort continues to be a trend in 2012. BYU held WSU's offense to -5 total yards rushing, the second time in three years allowing a team to negative rushing yards. The Cougars have held four opponents under 50 yards rushing to help lift them to the No. 3 spot in rushing defense. BYU is holding its opponents to just 67.86 yards.

During his seven seasons as the head coach at Brigham Young University, Bronco Mendenhall has returned the Cougars to the ranks of the nation's top teams. Taking over a BYU program in 2005 that was coming off three losing seasons, Mendenhall has guided his teams to seven straight bowl invitations, two outright conference championships and regular national top-25 rankings. The Cougars finished their first season as a football independent in 2011 with a 10-3 record and No. 25 final ranking to finish nationally ranked for the fifth time in the last six seasons.

Under his leadership, BYU has earned a 70-27 (.722) record to date to rank No. 15 in total wins among all teams in the nation during that span. The Cougars have received seven straight bowl invitations for the first time since a string of 17 consecutive bowls invitations from 1978 through 1994. Mendenhall is the only coach in BYU football history to take his first seven teams to a bowl game.

Mendenhall has led BYU to bowl wins in five of the last six seasons to become the first Cougar teams to ever win five bowls in a six-year span. Nationally, BYU is one of only seven programs to win five bowl games in the last six seasons. The Cougars have also won 10 or more games in five of the past six seasons and five of Mendenhall's seven seasons overall. In fact, only four programs have had more 10-win seasons over the past seven years.

BYU's success under Mendenhall is also evident in the national rankings and NCAA statistics. BYU has finished ranked in the top 25 in the various national statistical categories 88 times in the past seven seasons (46 offense, 32 defense, 9 special teams, 1 misc.). The Cougars have achieved 55 top-15 statistical rankings, 37 top-10 rankings and 19 top-5 rankings in that span. The Cougars have also been ranked in the top-25 polls during each of the past six seasons and finished ranked No. 12 following the 2009 season -- the program's highest final ranking since finishing No. 5 in 1996.

Another hallmark of Mendenhall's program has been the emphasis on balance and priorities in the many other facets of life outside of football. Reflecting that emphasis, BYU consistently received the most academic all-conference honorees each season as a conference member is tied for third nationally for Academic All-America recipients over Mendenhall's seven seasons at the helm. Seven Cougar student-athletes have been named ESPN Academic All-Americans in that span. Among all FBS schools only Penn State and Nebraska have had more during that period.

Mendenhall also serves as the team's defensive coordinator. The Cougars had the nation's No. 13 defense in 2011 to help BYU become one of only 11 programs to receive a final Top 25 overall team ranking in at least one of the two major polls during five of the past six seasons. BYU is one of only nine teams to do so in the USA Today Coaches Poll.
