BYU STORYLINES

- **FIRST MEETING.** BYU is facing East Carolina for the first time in program history. The Pirates will be the first team from either of the Carolinas to make a trip to Provo and represent the first squad from North or South Carolina to play BYU. BYU is scheduled to play a return game in Greenville in 2017, marking the first trip to the Carolinas for the Cougars.
- **SAGARIN'S TOUGHEST SCHEDULE.** BYU ranks No. 1 with the toughest schedule in all of college football according to the latest ratings by USA Today's Jeff Sagarin. The top five goes BYU, Texas, Virginia, Hawaii and Alabama.
- **ECU-BYU CONNECTION.** In 1947, the East Carolina Teacher's College started a football program under athletic director Dr. Nephi Moroni Jorgensen, the first son of Danish immigrants born in America after joining the LDS church. Eventually ECTC became ECU in the 1960's, with the football program and athletic department flourishing under eventual ECU Hall of Famer Jorgensen. Several of Jorgensen's descendants have attended either BYU, ECU or both.
- **VS. THE AAC.** BYU is 20-5 against the American Athletic Conference as currently constituted. The Cougars have played Tulsa the most, holding a 7-1 record against the Golden Hurricane.
- **GAME SIX.** Under Coach Mendenhall, the BYU is 9-1 in game six of the regular season, with the only loss coming last season to Central Florida in overtime.

POSTGAME MEDIA AVAILABILITY

After home games, postgame press conference will be conducted in the LaVell Edwards Stadium press room, located on the southeast end of the stadium next to the BYU locker room. At the discretion of the visiting team, opponent interviews will be conducted in the Blue Zone, near the opponent's locker room located on northwest end of the stadium. Coach Mendenhall and select players will be available following the NCAA mandatory cooling off period. Members of the media are invited to move from the press box down to the field and to the press room four minutes prior to the ending of the game. A direct video feed will also be sent to the press box from the BYU postgame press conference. A basic transcript of Mendenhall's comments from the postgame press conference will be provided. For road games, BYU will conduct interviews outside the locker room or in a location designated by the host school.

BYU WINS 30-13 OVER UCONN

PROVO, Utah - Led by Tanner Mangum's record-breaking night, BYU football defeated Connecticut 30-13 at home on Friday night.

BYU (3-2) had 539 total yards in the win compared with 230 from UConn (3-2, 0-1 AAC). The Cougar defense had four sacks in the game and allowed just one touchdown.

Mangum completed 35 of 53 passes for 365 yards, two touchdowns and two interceptions, breaking the record for passing yards in a single game by a freshman quarterback at BYU.

Terenn Houk led the receivers with career-high 129 yards and Mitchell Juergens led the team with a career-high 10 receptions. Mitch Mathews caught two touchdown passes in the fourth quarter, totaling 78 receiving yards in the game. Running backs Algernon Brown and Francis Bernard rushed for 95 and 69 yards, respectively. Bernard had one touchdown.

BYU PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS

- **Tanner Mangum QB (Fr.)**
Mangum threw for over 300 yards for the second time this season on 35 of 53 passing for 365 yards through the air to go along with two touchdowns and two interceptions. He set the record for BYU freshman quarterbacks in completions, attempts and yards in a single game.
- **Terenn Houk WR (Sr.)**
Houk recorded career highs with six receptions and 129 receiving yards. He had 64 yards in the first quarter, eclipsing his previous career high of 59 set in the Nebraska game.
- **Bronson Kaufusi DL (Sr.)**
Kaufusi finished the game with three tackles, one sack, two tackles for loss and his second-career interception.
- **Mitch Mathews WR (Sr.)**
Mathews caught eight passes for 78 yards and two touchdowns for his second multi-touchdown game this season and fifth of his career. He is now 10th on the BYU career list for receiving touchdowns with 18. He has caught a pass in 29 consecutive games.
- **Mitchell Juergens WR (Jr.)**
Juergens caught a career-high 10 passes for 74 yards. his previous career high was seven at California in 2014.
- **Francis Bernard RB (Fr.)**
Bernard scored the first touchdown of his career with a 1-yard carry for the first points of the game. He ended the game with 69 yards on 11 carries with a long run of 19.



ECU RALLIES PAST SMU FOR 49-23 WIN

DALLAS, Texas - When it's Summers' time, things really start to heat up.

For the second week in a row, James Summers came off the bench to replace Blake Kemp at quarterback and injected a giant jolt of energy into East Carolina's offense, leading the Pirates from a double-digit deficit with 42 unanswered points in a 49-23 victory over SMU at Gerald J. Ford Stadium.

Summers took the field with ECU staring at a 23-7 deficit and showing little life, using his right arm and legs to burn the Mustangs and help the Pirates even their American Athletic Conference record at 1-1.

The junior completed all but one of his 10 passes for 153 yards and two touchdowns and added 85 yards rushing on nine carries and two more TDs.

ECU PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS

- **James Summers QB (Jr.)**
Summers led the Pirates to 42-straight points, scoring a pair of rushing TDs and passing for two more. He completed 9 of 10 passes for 153 yards and rushed 85 yards on nine carries.
- **Blake Kemp QB (Jr.)**
Kemp completed 10 of 16 with one TD and a pair of interceptions. It was his eighth touchdown pass of the season. Five of the 10 completions went for 10 or more yards.
- **Montese Overton LB (Sr.)**
Overton tallied four sacks and six total tackles, including five tackles for a loss of 36 yards in the win over SMU.
- **Yiannis Bowden LB (Fr.)**
Against SMU, Bowden had four total tackles, including 2.5 tackles for a loss of 29 yards.
- **Chris Hairston RB (Sr.)**
Hairston rushed for 91 yards and one touchdown in the win over the Pirates. His longest play was 34 yards.
- **Trevon Brown WR (So.)**
Brown had 85 receiving yards, including one touchdown, in the win on Saturday. He caught a 47-yard heave in the game, the longest completed pass of the day for ECU.

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR FIVE

The 12-game independent schedule features teams from 10 states and six conferences, including the American Athletic, Big Ten, Pac-12, Mountain West and SEC. BYU has four games scheduled against current Power 5 teams and seven against teams from the Group of 5 conferences. The 12 teams on the schedule had a record of 92-53 in 2014, with eight teams coming off bowl games in 2014.

The Cougars will play six home games, five road contests and one neutral site game in 2015. The home schedule consists of Boise State, UConn, East Carolina, Cincinnati, Wagner and Fresno State. The teams on the home schedule put together a record of 44-23, with four teams reaching bowl games in 2014. The road swing includes a big September with Nebraska, UCLA and Michigan. The Cougars visit San Jose State and Utah State with a game against Missouri at the Kansas City Chief's stadium in Kansas City, Mo. The road and neutral opponents combined for a 48-30 record in 2014, with four bowl games.

FLAG BEARERS

BYU has a tradition of selecting a player before each game to run the team flag and alumni flag. The team selects a former Cougar to carry out the alumni flag, along with the chosen current player who runs out with the current team flag. The team flag has been signed by each member of the team, while the alumni flag has been signed by former BYU payers. In 2011, the team added a special teams flag, donned by a vintage BYU logo adopted by the special teams, following the same protocol as the team flag with an exemplary special teams player being chosen to carry it each week.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 64,045 after refurbishing the middle of the east section. The capacity now sits at 63,470 due to accommodations for wheelchair access. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands.

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates missions around the world in 145 nations speaking 164 languages. More than 85,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions in 417 missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours—seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples)—teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

81 members of the 2015 team have served church missions. Members of the team have served in over 25 countries and six of the seven continents around the globe.

FIRESIDES

The BYU football team will participate in hour-long devotionals prior or team service activities the night before each game this season. The team will conduct devotionals before six games. These devotionals are referred to as "firesides" and are intended to help players, coaches and those who attend strengthen or gain a knowledge of our purpose here on earth. Firesides typically include a musical number from members of the team and talks from selected players, along with coach Bronco Mendenhall.

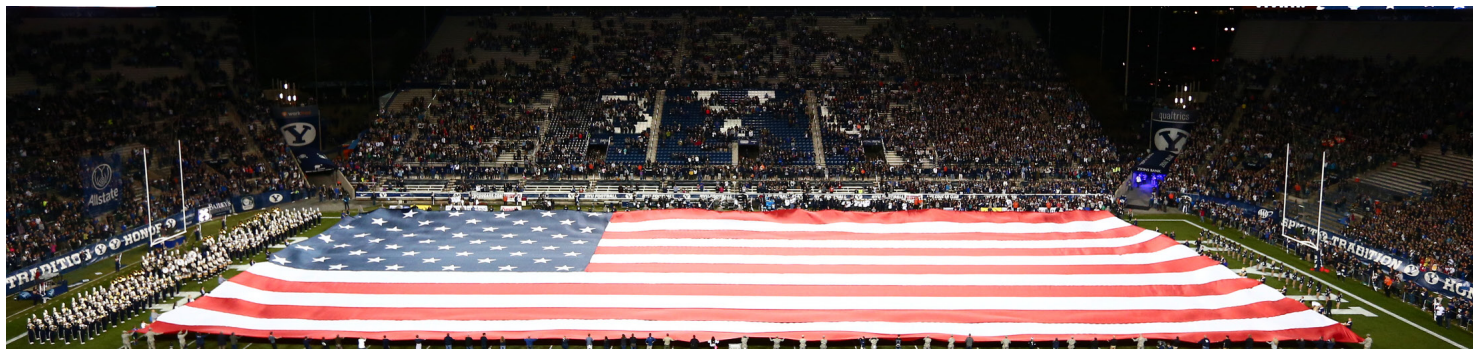

THE BYU OFFENSE

• **FOURTH QUARTER SCORING.** BYU has outscored its opponents 56-17 in the fourth quarter this year. BYU scored 20 or more points twice in the fourth quarter this year (Boise State and UConn). The Cougars have never had 20-plus points in the fourth quarter in two games in any season under Mendenhall. BYU has hit the 20-point mark in the fourth quarter in six games under Mendenhall. It marks the first time BYU has scored 20 or more fourth-quarter points twice in a season since 1995.

• **MITCH AND MITCHELL.** BYU's pair of receivers both named Mitch have been go-to targets in the first five games. In fact, both players named Mitch are the only players to catch touchdown passes this season. The combo of Mitch Mathews and Mitchell Juergens have combined for 51 receptions, 591 yards and five touchdowns. The 591 yards are 43.7 percent of the passing yards on the team.

• **THE BIG THREE.** BYU's receiving combination of Mitch Mathews, Nick Kurtz and Terenn Houk stands at 6-foot-6, 6-foot-5 and 6-foot-4. The three big receivers accounted for 57 receptions, 718 yards and five touchdowns.

• **OFFENSIVE LINE EXPERIENCE.** BYU returns an experienced offensive line for 2015. The five projected starters for BYU have logged 92 starts between them and have played in 111 games. Offensive tackle Ryker Mathews has the most games under his belt with 27 starts in 38 games played.

• **FRESHMAN WATCH.** The Cougars are starting a true freshman quarterback for just the fourth time. Tanner Mangum and Taysom Hill are the only two to win their first starts as true freshman. BYU has also had significant contributors as freshman this year with wide receiver Moroni Laulu-Pututau and running back Francis Bernard.

• **FRESHMAN QB RECORDS.** Tanner Mangum broke the freshman quarterback records for completions (35), attempts (53) and passing yards (365) against UConn. Jake Heaps set the season records for freshman quarterbacks in 2010, going 219 of 383 for 2,316 yards and 15 touchdowns. After five games, Mangum is 101 of 167 for 1,084 yards and six touchdowns.

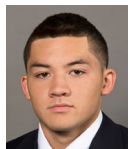

THE BYU DEFENSE

- **Third Down is key.** The Cougars have held opponents to a third-down conversion rate of under 25 percent in three games this season. BYU held opposing offenses to under 20 percent in only two games in 2014 (vs. Savannah St. & Texas).
- **3 and out.** The BYU defense has held opponents to three and out in 26 out of 65 drives this season, averaging 5.2 times per game holding opponents to four downs or less per possession. The Cougars are ranked No. 21 in the country just ahead of Florida, Florida State, Arizona State and Ole Miss.
- **Staying Positive.** BYU is 51-8 under Bronco Mendenhall with a positive turnover margin. The Cougars recorded a positive turnover margin in its first three games of the season.
- **Take Your Picks.** BYU's defense has recorded two or more interceptions in three of its five games this year while recording a pick in four of five games. The Cougars had 14 in all of 2014.

The last time BYU held its opponent to three straight games of sub-200-yard passing was a stretch spanning the last two games in 2012 and the first game of 2013 (New Mexico St., San Diego St. & Virginia).

Entering his eleventh season as head coach at Brigham Young University, Bronco Mendenhall has restored the Cougars' reputation as one of the nation's top college football programs. Taking over a BYU team that in 2005 was coming off three consecutive losing seasons, Mendenhall has guided his teams to 10 straight bowl appearances, two outright conference championships before football independence in 2011, and regular national top-25 rankings.

Under Mendenhall's leadership, BYU has earned a 90-39 record to rank 13th in total wins among all FBS teams since 2005 prior to the start of 2015. Mendenhall also ranks 13th in winning percentage at .698 among active coaches with at least five years of FBS experience in the same time period.

The Cougars finished the 2014 season with an 8-5 record that included a 3-0 mark against Power 5 conference schools. Fueled by Heisman hopeful Taysom Hill, BYU won its first four games including a 41-7 win over then-No. 25 Texas. BYU then overcame a rash of midseason injuries to key players to finish the season with a 10th consecutive bowl game. In doing so, the Cougars became one of 12 programs to earn a bowl invitation in each of the last 10 years. Only Florida State (7) has achieved more than BYU's six bowl victories over that timeframe.

The Cougars set a program record with four consecutive bowl wins from 2009-12, helping Mendenhall become the first BYU head coach to win six bowls in a seven-year span. The Cougars received nine straight bowl invitations for the first time since a string of 17 consecutive bowl bids under Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards from 1978 through 1994. Mendenhall is the only coach in BYU football history to take his first 10 teams to a bowl game, and is winning at the same pace as the legendary Edwards. Through his 129 games as BYU head coach, Mendenhall has a record of 90-39—similar to Edwards' 129-game mark of 93-35-1.

In 2006, Mendenhall was named the American Football Coaches Association Region IV Coach of the Year following an 11-2 season. In addition, the Football Writers Association of America named Mendenhall one of nine finalists for the prestigious Eddie Robinson Coach of the Year Award.

He has also served as the defensive coordinator for much of his tenure as the head coach. BYU has consistently fielded one of the nation's strongest defenses under Mendenhall's direction. Mendenhall's defense excels at keeping opponents out of the end zone, averaging a No. 20 national ranking in scoring defense over the past eight of nine seasons, including three top-10 ratings. In 2012, the Cougars featured one of the greatest defenses in school history, allowing just 266.1 yards, including 86.9 rushing yards, and 14.0 points per game. Ranked No. 3 in total defense, No. 3 in scoring defense and No. 2 in rushing defense, the Mendenhall-coached unit held its first six opponents under 300 total yards (part of a streak of 12 consecutive such games dating back to 2011) and kept opposing offenses without a touchdown six times during the year. Adjusting to the team's up-tempo offense in 2013, BYU's defense ranked No. 12 in yards per play allowed despite defending more plays than all but four teams nationally. Only two teams that defended as many plays ranked better than the Cougars at defending their turf.

Another hallmark of Mendenhall's program has been the emphasis on balance and priorities in the many other facets of life outside of football. Reflecting that emphasis, BYU consistently received the most academic all-conference honorees each season as a conference member, while six Cougar student-athletes have earned seven Academic All-America citations under Mendenhall. Only four programs have had more Academic All-America citations during Mendenhall's tenure. In addition, BYU tops all FBS programs for the most selections to the NFF Hampshire Honor Society (3.2 GPA over college career) since the program began in 2007.

Mendenhall was elected in 2013 to the American Football Coaches Association Board of Trustees as the District 8 Representative and also serves on the Ethics Committee. He began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at his alma mater, Oregon State. He later coached at Snow College, Northern Arizona, became the youngest defensive coordinator in the Pac-10 at Oregon State, then went to Louisiana Tech and New Mexico before coming to BYU as a defensive coordinator in 2003.
