**BYU FALLS 20-16 TO MISSOURI**

KANSAS CITY, Mo. – The fourth-quarter comeback fell short for BYU football, falling 20-16 to Missouri at Arrowhead Stadium on Saturday night.

Francis Bernard scored a touchdown with 7:19 left in the game to put the Cougars within striking distance. Despite one more chance on offense, BYU could not find the end zone again. The Cougar defense was unable to get a stop on the other end and time ran out on the Cougars.

The loss snaps a five-game win streak for BYU (7-3) and ends a four-game losing streak for Mizzou (5-5, 1-5 SEC). The Tigers outgained the Cougars in yards 434 to 290. Penalties played a major role in this game as BYU had six for 42 yards while Mizzou had eight for 91 yards, with both sides benefitting from extended drives due to penalties.

**BYU PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS**

- **Tanner Mangum QB (Fr.)**  
Completed 23 of 41 passes with 244 yards and one touchdown. His first completion of the second half went for 11 yards, surpassing the BYU freshman passing yard record (2,316) set by Jake Heaps. With the 6-yard TD pass in the fourth quarter, Mangum surpassed another school freshman QB record for pass TDs in a season with 16.
- **Bronson Kaufusi DL (Sr.)**  
Recorded 10 total tackles for a career high and to go along with three tackles for loss and two forced fumbles. He is the first BYU player with two forced fumbles in one game since Brandon Ogletree in 2011 against Oregon State.
- **Francis Bernard RB (Fr.)**  
Had four catches for 56 yards and a touchdown. Going into the game he had five receptions for 40 yards.
- **Jonny Linehan P (Jr.)**  
Notched his 16th punt inside the 20 and had two punts of 50+ yards upping his total to nine on the season. He averaged 46.5 yards per punt, topping his 43.4 average.
- **Algernon Brown RB (Jr.)**  
Scored his ninth rushing TD of the season on an 11-yard run in the third quarter. He has 10 total to lead the team this season (9 rush, 1 rec.).
- **Harvey Langi LB (Jr.)**  
Recorded a career-high 10 total tackles with eight solo stops. He also had his first kickoff returns as a Cougar with two for 45 yards.

**BULLDOGS WIN 42-14 AT HAWAII'**

HONOLULU - Quarterback Zack Greenlee set new career-highs with 285 yards passing and six TDs in leading Fresno State to a 42-14 win over Hawai'i at Aloha Stadium.

The win was Fresno State's first on the road of the season and it came in a game where the 'Dogs (3-7, 2-5 MWC) forced four turnovers on a night full of penalties and scattered showers.

Greenlee was 20-of-35 passing on the night. His big night led Fresno State to a season-high in points, passing yards (285) and total yards (455).

Fresno State was aided in the first half by 10 Hawai'i penalties that went for 117 yards. Six of those were personal foul penalties, including four roughing the passer calls that helped the Bulldog offense get into a rhythm after a tough first quarter when the 'Dogs had just 71 yards of offense.

**FRESNO PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS**

- **Zack Greenlee QB (So.)**  
Set career-highs in completions (20), attempts (35) and passing yards (285). Threw for 182 yards and four touchdowns in the first half, setting new career-highs in both passing yards and TDs in only 30 minutes of play. His six TD passes are the most from any MWC quarterback this season.
- **Ejiro Ederaine LB (Sr.)**  
This was his fourth game this season and 12th of his career where he has had multiple tackles for loss. He also had his 20th-career sack and one interception (his second of the season).
- **Da'Mari Scott WR (Jr.)**  
Had two first-half touchdown receptions. In 32 career games prior to tonight, he only had two career TD catches.
- **Tyquan Glass DB (Jr.)**  
Intercepted a pass for the second-straight game. His three interceptions are the most by a Bulldog since 2013.
- **Chad Olsen TE (So.)**  
Caught his first TD pass of the season in the second quarter. Finished the game with four catches for a career-high 76 yards and one TD, all of which came in the first half.
- **Josiah Blandin WR (Jr.)**  
Caught his fifth touchdown pass of the season, which leads the team.

**INDEPENDENCE: YEAR FIVE**

The 12-game independent schedule features teams from 10 states and six conferences, including the American Athletic, Big Ten, Pac-12, Mountain West and SEC. BYU has four games scheduled against current Power 5 teams and seven against teams from the Group of 5 conferences. The 12 teams on the schedule had a record of 92-53 in 2014, with eight teams coming off bowl games in 2014.

The Cougars will play six home games, five road contests and one neutral site game in 2015. The home schedule consists of Boise State, UConn, East Carolina, Cincinnati, Wagner and Fresno State. The teams on the home schedule put together a record of 44-23, with four teams reaching bowl games in 2014. The road swing includes a big September with Nebraska, UCLA and Michigan. The Cougars visit San Jose State and Utah State with a game against Missouri at the Kansas City Chief's stadium in Kansas City, Mo. The road and neutral opponents combined for a 48-30 record in 2014, with four bowl games.

**FLAG BEARERS**

BYU has a tradition of selecting a player before each game to run the team flag and alumni flag. The team selects a former Cougar to carry out the alumni flag, along with the chosen current player who runs out with the current team flag. The team flag has been signed by each member of the team, while the alumni flag has been signed by former BYU payers. In 2011, the team added a special teams flag, donned by a vintage BYU logo adopted by the special teams, following the same protocol as the team flag with an exemplary special teams player being chosen to carry it each week.

**LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM**

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,275-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,275 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands.

**MISSIONS**

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates missions around the world in 145 nations speaking 164 languages. More than 85,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions in 417 missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours—seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples)—teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

81 members of the 2015 team have served church missions. Members of the team have served in over 25 countries and six of the seven continents around the globe.

**FIRESIDES**

The BYU football team will participate in hour-long devotionals prior or team service activities the night before each game this season. The team will conduct devotionals before six games. These devotionals are referred to as "firesides" and are intended to help players, coaches and those who attend strengthen or gain a knowledge of our purpose here on earth. Firesides typically include a musical number from members of the team and talks from selected players, along with coach Bronco Mendenhall.

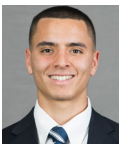

**THE BYU OFFENSE**

• **FOURTH QUARTER SCORING.** BYU has outscored its opponents 100-54 in the fourth quarter this year. The Cougars scored 102 points in the fourth quarter for all of the 2014 season. BYU scored 20 or more points three times in the fourth quarter this year (Boise State, UConn and Cincinnati). The Cougars had never had 20-plus points in the fourth quarter in two games in any season under Mendenhall, let alone three. BYU has hit the 20-point mark in the fourth quarter in seven total games under Mendenhall. It marks the first time BYU has scored 20 or more fourth-quarter points in three games since the 1988 season, Ty Detmer's redshirt freshman year.

• **BIG AND TALL.** BYU's tall receiving combination of Mitch Mathews, Nick Kurtz and Terenn Houk stands at 6-foot-6, 6-foot-5 and 6-foot-4. The three big receivers have accounted for 100 receptions, 1,365 yards and 12 touchdowns.

• **FRESHMAN QB RECORD WATCH.** Tanner Mangum broke the freshman quarterback records for passing yards in a season and touchdowns in a season against Missouri. He now totals 2,442 passing yards and 16 touchdowns. Earlier this year he set the single game freshman records for completions (35) and passing yards (365) against UConn. Mangum has completed 202 of 323 passes, closing in on Jake Heaps freshman record of 219 completions and 383 attempts. After 10 games (nine starts), Mangum is also tied with Heaps with six wins as a starter.

• **SPREADING THE BALL.** BYU has had 19 players catch a pass this season. Five players have over 300 yards receiving and four have over 400 receiving yards with two 500-yard receivers (Mitch Mathews and Devon Blackmon).

**THE BYU DEFENSE**

- STAYING POSITIVE.** BYU is 53-8 under Bronco Mendenhall with a positive turnover margin. The Cougars have recorded a positive turnover margin in five games this season.
- FBS ACTIVE CAREER LEADERS.** Bronson Kaufusi is No. 6 in career sacks (22.5) and No. 13 in TFLs (36) among active career leaders in FBS football.
- PASS DEFENSE.** BYU has held opponents to under 200 yards passing in five games this season. In 2014, Cougar opponents threw for under 200 yards on three occasions. The defense has given up 2,126 pass yards this season, which is the fewest through nine games since 2012 when the team had allowed 1,722.
- 3 AND OUT.** The BYU defense has held opponents to three and out in 45 out of 123 drives this season, averaging 4.5 times per game holding opponents to four downs or less per possession which is tied with Arizona State for No. 19.
- BRONSON.** The senior defensive end is in the top 5 in BYU history in four categories: 22.5 sacks (3rd), 36 tackles for loss (5th), 16 quarterback hurries (3rd) and five forced fumbles (3rd).

**BRONCO MENDENHALL****HEAD COACH****YEARS AT BYU**

11th year as head coach, 13th at BYU

Entering his eleventh season as head coach at Brigham Young University, Bronco Mendenhall has restored the Cougars' reputation as one of the nation's top college football programs. Taking over a BYU team that in 2005 was coming off three consecutive losing seasons, Mendenhall has guided his teams to 10 straight bowl appearances, two outright conference championships before football independence in 2011, and regular national top-25 rankings.

Under Mendenhall's leadership, BYU has earned a 90-39 record to rank 13th in total wins among all FBS teams since 2005 prior to the start of 2015. Mendenhall also ranks 13th in winning percentage at .698 among active coaches with at least five years of FBS experience in the same time period.

The Cougars finished the 2014 season with an 8-5 record that included a 3-0 mark against Power 5 conference schools. Fueled by Heisman hopeful Taysom Hill, BYU won its first four games including a 41-7 win over then-No. 25 Texas. BYU then overcame a rash of midseason injuries to key players to finish the season with a 10th consecutive bowl game. In doing so, the Cougars became one of 12 programs to earn a bowl invitation in each of the last 10 years. Only Florida State (7) has achieved more than BYU's six bowl victories over that timeframe.

The Cougars set a program record with four consecutive bowl wins from 2009-12, helping Mendenhall become the first BYU head coach to win six bowls in a seven-year span. The Cougars received nine straight bowl invitations for the first time since a string of 17 consecutive bowl bids under Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards from 1978 through 1994. Mendenhall is the only coach in BYU football history to take his first 10 teams to a bowl game, and is winning at the same pace as the legendary Edwards. Through his 129 games as BYU head coach, Mendenhall has a record of 90-39—similar to Edwards' 129-game mark of 93-35-1.

In 2006, Mendenhall was named the American Football Coaches Association Region IV Coach of the Year following an 11-2 season. In addition, the Football Writers Association of America named Mendenhall one of nine finalists for the prestigious Eddie Robinson Coach of the Year Award.

He has also served as the defensive coordinator for much of his tenure as the head coach. BYU has consistently fielded one of the nation's strongest defenses under Mendenhall's direction. Mendenhall's defense excels at keeping opponents out of the end zone, averaging a No. 20 national ranking in scoring defense over the past eight of nine seasons, including three top-10 ratings. In 2012, the Cougars featured one of the greatest defenses in school history, allowing just 266.1 yards, including 86.9 rushing yards, and 14.0 points per game. Ranked No. 3 in total defense, No. 3 in scoring defense and No. 2 in rushing defense, the Mendenhall-coached unit held its first six opponents under 300 total yards (part of a streak of 12 consecutive such games dating back to 2011) and kept opposing offenses without a touchdown six times during the year. Adjusting to the team's up-tempo offense in 2013, BYU's defense ranked No. 12 in yards per play allowed despite defending more plays than all but four teams nationally. Only two teams that defended as many plays ranked better than the Cougars at defending their turf.

Another hallmark of Mendenhall's program has been the emphasis on balance and priorities in the many other facets of life outside of football. Reflecting that emphasis, BYU consistently received the most academic all-conference honorees each season as a conference member, while six Cougar student-athletes have earned seven Academic All-America citations under Mendenhall. Only four programs have had more Academic All-America citations during Mendenhall's tenure. In addition, BYU tops all FBS programs for the most selections to the NFF Hampshire Honor Society (3.2 GPA over college career) since the program began in 2007.

Mendenhall was elected in 2013 to the American Football Coaches Association Board of Trustees as the District 8 Representative and also serves on the Ethics Committee. He began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at his alma mater, Oregon State. He later coached at Snow College, Northern Arizona, became the youngest defensive coordinator in the Pac-10 at Oregon State, then went to Louisiana Tech and New Mexico before coming to BYU as a defensive coordinator in 2003.
