## BYU STORYLINES

- Hot start from the circle. So far, junior McKenna Bull threw a solo no-hitter against San Jose State, tied her career high 14 strikeouts against Wisconsin and broke the record for career saves at BYU in a 3-0 win against Bethune-Cookman. She has totaled 94 strikeouts and 33 walks so far, earning two-consecutive WCC Pitcher of the Week honors this season and a No. 2 rank in the nation.
- Freshman sensation. Freshman catcher Libby Sugg has come up big for BYU so far this season. She leads the team with 22 RBI and eight home runs overall. She had a . 353 overall batting average. Additionally, she is ranked in the top 25 in four categories: home runs per game, home runs, RBI and RBI per game.
Consistency is key. Leading the team, junior infielder Lauren Bell has .429 batting average this season, including seven games hitting . 500 or better. Bell has gone 3 for 4 in two games.
- Preseason hype. BYU was picked to win the West Coast Conference championship in the 2016 preseason poll. Four players, Gordy Bravo, Ashley Thompson, Coco Tauali'i Bond and McKenna Bull, were also voted to the preseason All-WCC team.
- Win total. With the 40-14 mark achieved in 2015, BYU now has nine seasons of 40 or more wins in its softball history.
- 11-straight NCAA Regionals. BYU went to its 11th-straight NCAA appearance in 2015, with 12 total. The Cougars advanced to the Eugene Regionals where they faced Oregon, San Jose State and Fresno State, with their sole win

BYU has shutout five teams so far this season: San Jose State, Creighton, Grand Canyon, Boise State and Bethune-Cookman.

Junior pitcher McKenna Bull is ranked second in the nation in strikeouts. She is also ranked second in the BYU record books with 556. This season so far she has 94, including three games with double-digit strikeouts.

Freshman catcher Libby Sugg has eight home runs so far this season, which is ranked No. 2 in the NCAA. She also leads the team in RBI with 16, which is ranked No. 20 in the nation.

Bull's shutout win over Utah Valley on May 5, 2015 broke the record for most victories in a single season, surpassing former pitcher Paige Affleck 32-win mark in 2010. Her 34th win came in the regular season finale against LMU.

BYU reached 40 wins in 2015, the ninth time the Cougars have had 40-plus wins in a season. The last time they reached that total was in 2012 when they finished with a 45-15 record.

## Top-20 teams await BYU in the Wildcat Invitational this weekend

PROVO, Utah - Following a 2-3 weekend at the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic II, BYU softball looks to bounce back in the Wildcat Invitational against four teams, including two top-20 teams, this weekend in Tucson, Arizona.

The Cougars won two games at the Mary Nutter Classic last weekend, beating Bethune-Cookman and Cal State Fullerton. Two of the losses came against top-15 teams UCLA and Missouri.

Junior pitcher McKenna Bull broke the all-time saves record at BYU with her ninth save over the weekend, earning her West Coast Conference Pitcher of the Week for the second-straight week.

## Mount St. Mary's | Thursday, March 3, 4 p.m. MST

The Mountaineers (0-5) are on a five-game losing streak to start the season, falling to then-No. 17 Arizona State in all five. Three of the games were in five innings. The Northeast Conference school currently has a . 226 batting average and finished with an 11-33 record in 2015.

## No. 15 Arizona | Thursday, March 3, 6 p.m. MST and Friday, March 4, 6 p.m. MST

Hosting this tournament, the Wildcats (11-3) will have home-field advantage this weekend. In 2015, Arizona advanced to the NCAA Super Regionals with a 41-20 record, falling to LSU. BYU will have two shots to play Arizona, hoping to improve its 0-5 record all-time against the Wildcats.

## UTEP | Friday, March 4, 8 p.m. MST

The Miners are currently 6-9 in 2016 with multiple wins against Texas A\&M-Corpus Christi. UTEP finished with a 14-39 overall record in 2015, including a 9-15 Conference USA mark. The Cougars have faced the Miners just twice, winning both contests.

## 2016 WCC PRESEASON POLL

PROVO, Utah - BYU softball was voted to finish first and four players were recognized in the West Coast Conference preseason poll released on Wednesday.

After winning two-consecutive WCC championships, the Cougars were picked in the preseason to repeat for a third time. BYU received five first-place votes to put them at the top, while Pacific and Loyola Marymount were voted to finish in second and third, respectively.

In the 2016 All-WCC Preseason Softball Team, BYU had four players recognized: Gordy Bravo, Ashley Thompson, Coco Tauali'i Bond and McKenna Bull. These four players also received WCC postseason honors in the 2015 season.

Senior midfielder Bravo is the reigning WCC Player of the Year after hitting .444 with four home runs, two triples, nine doubles, 76 hits and 30 RBI , notching the second best sin-gle-season average in school history. She started all 54 games of the 2015 season.

Junior Bull was last season's WCC Pitcher of the Year. She was also on the NFCA All-Pacific Region Third Team and named College Sports Madness' Pitcher of the Year as well. In 2015, Bull set the BYU single-season record for wins (34), strikeouts (256), innings pitched (257.1) and complete games (29). She led the WCC in strikeouts (64), ERA (1.55) and wins with an 11-0 record in WCC play.

Junior first baseman Thompson was named to the 2015 All-WCC First Team and senior third baseman Bond was on the second team. Thompson ranked in the top five in WCC play in seven categories: OBP (.500), runs scored (15), runs batted in (19), home runs (4), total bases (31) and stolen bases (4). Bond was first in the WCC with six home runs, 15 runs batted in and a .763 slugging percentage in conference play.

BYU's season starts a week from Thursday in Tempe, Ariz., against San Jose State in the Kajikawa Classic.

## GORDON EAKIN BYU HEAD COACH 2003-PRESENT

Eakin is entering his 14th season as the Cougars' head coach and his 17th season at BYU overall.
Eakin was named head coach in July 2002 after working as an assistant coach since the softball program's inception in 2000. Since that time he has led the Cougars to five Mountain West Conference championships, one Western Athletic Conference tournament championship, two West Coast Conference championship and 12 NCAA tournament appearances.
The 2015 WCC Coach of the Year (second-consecutive year) has coached 12 All-Americans, nine conference players of the year, four conference freshmen of the year, and three conference pitchers of the year during his tenure.
In 2010, Eakin guided the Cougars to 46 wins, the most in school history, as BYU advanced to the NCAA Super Regionals for the first time ever with wins over East Carolina and host Texas before ending its season at national runner-up Arizona. The Cougars finished second in the country in batting average, seventh in scoring and ninth in slugging percentage as a team.


Known as one of the best hitting coaches in the country, Eakin has helped BYU finish in the top-ten nationally six times in slugging percentage, six times in home runs per game, four times in batting average and four times in scoring.
In addition to his duties at BYU, Eakin was also an assistant coach and hitting coach for the USA National Team in 2009. In the summer of 2010, Eakin helped guide the National Team to a 17-2 record as USA won the World Championship in Venezuela, the World Cup in Oklahoma and the Japan Cup championship in Sendai, Japan.
Before entering the coaching ranks, Eakin was a successful baseball and softball player. After playing collegiate baseball at the University of Utah, Eakin signed with the Oakland Athletics organization where he played for three years.
Eakin went on to join the United States All-Star team, playing in three U.S. Olympic sports festivals in 1986, 1993 and 1994, winning bronze, silver and gold, respectively. While on the team, Eakin was honored on the ISC All-World First Team and was an ASA All-American. He would later go on to play shortstop on the internationally ranked Larry H. Miller Toyota Fast Pitch team, eventually earning induction into the Utah Fast Pitch Hall of Fame in 1998.
Eakin is a native of Holladay, Utah, and graduated from Granite High. He currently resides in Sandy, Utah, and is married to Barbi. They are the parents of three children (Alicia, Ryan \& Parker) and have five grandsons.
