MOUNTAINEERS RALLY TO DEFEAT YOUNGSTOWN STATE

MORGANTOWN, W.Va. - Skyler Howard tied a career-high five with touchdown passes to lead West Virginia to a harder-than-expected 38-21 victory over Youngstown State at Milan Puskar Stadium this afternoon.

"I give them a lot of credit for keeping it close," said West Virginia coach Dana Holgorsen, who improved to 6-0 at WVU against FCS schools. "We were prepared for this and our guys didn't panic when it was close."

A sun-drenched crowd of 56,261 saw the Mountaineers fall behind 14-7 early in the second quarter after Ricky Davis hit Alvin Bailey on a 74-yard catch and run, following Martin Ruiz's one-yard score on Youngstown State's prior possession.

But Howard, who completed a 53-yard touchdown pass to Ka'Raun White in the first quarter, tied the game with 3:15 left in the second when he hit Shelton Gibson in stride down the near sideline for a 54-yard touchdown.

WVU (2-0) had an opportunity to take the lead right before the end of the first half, Howard orchestrating a drive from his own 35 to the Penguin 13, but kicker Mike Molina's 30-yard boot hooked left as the first half clock expired, leaving the score tied at 14.

Four straight runs, two by Shell, one by Howard, and another by Justin Crawford, moved the ball to the Penguin 11 where Howard located Daikiel Shorts Jr. in the back corner of the end zone for a touchdown pass, which the game's replay official upstairs confirmed.

WVU added more points late in the third period when Howard hooked up with Gibson on a second touch-down toss, this play going for 57 yards.

The game developed just as Holgorsen indicated he felt it might go earlier in the week, the Penguins sticking around early until depth and the heat took its toll in the second half. That happened in the third quarter when West Virginia reeled off 17 straight points.

Howard finished the afternoon completing 20 of his 33 pass attempts for 389 yards, five touchdowns and one interception, while Gibson caught six of those passes for 171 yards and two scores.

Last week's leading receiver, Daikiel Shorts Jr., finished the afternoon with six catches for 93 yards and a touchdown. White made five catches for 88 yards and McKoy had the other grab for 21 yards.

Shell led all ball carriers with 84 yards on 16 carries, while Howard added 50 yards on eight attempts. The Mountaineers finished the afternoon with 235 yards on the ground, but Holgorsen thought his team left some yards out there today.

2016 BYU FOOTBALL **TEAM NOTES-4**

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR SIX

The 12-game independent schedule features teams from eight different conferences and an independent team. Six games come against Power Five opponents, including teams from the Pac-12, Big 12, Big Ten and SEC. The schedule ranks No. 7 in Phil Steele's preseason schedule rankings. The opponents on the 2016 schedule posted a 97-57 record in 2015, with 10 bowl teams and an FCS playoff team.

The Cougars host six home games and have four true road contests with two neutral site games, both at NFL stadiums, in 2016. The home schedule consists of UCLA, Toledo, Mississippi State, Southern Utah, UMass and Utah State. Teams on the home schedule put together a 44-31 record in 2015, with four reaching bowl games and Southern Utah earned an FCS playoff berth. Road contests include Utah, Michigan State, Boise State and Cincinnati with neutral site games against Arizona (University of Phoenix Stadium - home of the Arizona Cardinals) and West Virginia (FedEx Field - home of the Washington Redskins). All six games away from home are against 2015 bowl teams with a combined record of 53-16 last year.

TEAM CAPTAINS

BYU will have four captains for the 2016 season in senior quarterback Taysom Hill, senior running back Jamaal Williams, senior defensive back Kai Nacua and senior defensive lineman Harvey Langi. Hill is serving as a captain for the third time. BYU offensive coordinator Ty Detmer was also a three-time team captain (89, 90, 91).

FLAG BEARERS

BYU's tradition of carrying team flags out of the tunnel adds some new looks for 2016. A United States serviceman will carry an American flag for every game, with team flags carried by selected players and alumni flags carried by former BYU players for each game.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands.

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates missions around the world in 150 nations speaking more than 160 languages. Over 74,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions in 418 missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours - seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples) - teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

The 2016 team has 84 players that served church missions and there are another 27 currently serving. Members of the team have served in over 25 countries and six of the seven continents around the globe.

ALUMNI FIRESIDES

Former members of the BYU football team will produce firesides, or devotionals at local LDS churches the night before select road games during the 2016 season. Firesides are open to the public. BOWLING OPPONENTS

Of BYU's 12 opponents in 2016, 10 played in a bowl game in 2015. Only USC has more bowl teams on its 2016 schedule with 11. BYU, along with just Ole Miss and Colorado are the only three teams with 10 bowl teams on the schedule this season.

POLYNESIAN PIPELINE

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recuiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. More than 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now, several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff.

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA. Sitake was raised in Laie, Hawaii and later moved to the mainland. His staff includes Polynesians Ilaisa Tuiaki, Steve Kaufusi, Reno Mahe, Nu'u Tafisi, Russell Tialavea, Tevita Ofahengaue, Jack Damuni, Jasen Ah You, Sione Kinikini, Vince Feula and Harvey Unga.

BYU DROPS HOME OPENER TO UCLA. 17-14.

PROVO, Utah – Despite rallying late, BYU came up short in its home opener against UCLA Saturday night at LaVell Edwards Stadium, falling 17-14.

The Cougars (1-2) scored all 14 points in the second half, but were still playing catch-up as time expired. The Bruins (2-1) nabbed BYU in a close game for the second year in a row.

Jamaal Williams and Nick Kurtz both scored their first touchdowns of the season for the Cougars. In addition to finding the end zone, Kurtz wound up with 83 receiving yards on eight receptions. Butch Pau'u tied the BYU record (since 2000) for tackles in a single game with 19.

BYU also picked up its longest pass player earlier in the first quarter with a 39-yard pass completion from Taysom Hill to Williams. Hill finished the game completing 26 of 48 passes for 250 yards, one touchdown and one interception.

Also of note was Fred Warner's first interception of the season. He picked off UCLA quarterback Josh Rosen at the UCLA 33-yard line, jumping a Bruin receiver's route.

BYU OFFENSE BY THE NUMBERS

After not having any passing plays of over 20 yards in the first two games, BYU had two against UCLA. A 39-yard catch and run from Jamaal Williams and a 23-yard toss to Nick Kurtz gave BYU its two longest passing plays of the season.

BYU has 13 different players with a reception to start the 2016 season. The Cougars had 19 players with a catch after the 2015 season.

Needing 681 yards to reach the career rushing record at BYU, Jamaal Williams needs to average 75.7 yards per game for the remaining 9 regular season games to hit the mark.

After BYU had a blue zone scoring percentage in 2015 of 94.34 percent, good for No. 4 nationally, the Cougars are 7 of 7 inside the 20s to start the year at 100 percent. BYU is one of 23 teams to still be perfect in that category.

BYU is averaging 30:50 in its time of possession through three games. The Cougars have not averaged above 30 minutes of possession time since 2012.

BYU DEFENSE BY THE NUMBERS

Kai Nacua is ranked first in the NCAA for interceptions per game and in total interceptions with three. Nacua has 11 career interceptions, the most by a BYU player since 2000.

Butch Pau'u is ranked third in the nation in total tackles with 37. He notched a career-high 19 tacles against UCLA.

The Cougars are ranked fifth in the nation in turnovers gained with nine total this season. Six of those turnovers have come from interceptions.

In each game this season, the BYU defense has held its opponents to 20 points or less (16, 20, 17). The last time a BYU team accomplished this was in 1984 (14, 13, 15). The 1984 team held its first five opponents to 20 points or less.

The defense held UCLA to just 50 rushing yards, the fewest of the season for a BYU opponent. The last time BYU held the opponents to less than 50 was against Mizzou last season when the Tigers had just 46 rushing yards.

THE BYU DEFENSE

- SCORING DEFENSE. BYU has held its first three opponents to 20 points or less in each game (16, 20, 17). The last time a BYU team has accomplished this was in 1984 (14, 13, 15). The 1984 team held its first five opponents to 20 points or less. In 2015, the Cougars were able to do this five times.
- TFL. The Cougars notched at least six tackles for a loss in 12 out of 13 games in 2015 and 22 so far in the 2016 season, eight against UCLA. BYU has not had less than six tackles for a loss in a game so far this season. Last season, the Cougars ranked No. 9 nationally with 7.5 tackles for loss per game.
- STAYING POSITIVE. BYU is 56-9 since 2005 with a positive turnover margin. BYU was plus-2 with two picks against Arizona and plus-3 with three picks and three fumble recoveries against Utah. The Cougars recorded a positive turnover margin in seven games in 2015.
- NEW FACES, NEW PLACES. A number of players have shuffled positions with the coaching change to Kalani Sitake. Notable changes include several linebackers transitioning to defensive line positions with more 4-3 elements in the defensive scheme including Harvey Langi moving from mostly playing middle linebacker to defensive end. Two offensive players of note jumped to defense, including Francis Bernard moving from running back to linebacker and Akile Davis moving from receiver to cornerback. Micah Hannemann, the starting field corner in 2015 also moved into the middle at one of the safety positions.

A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake returns to his alma mater with 15 years of coaching experience, including seven years a defensive coordinator and four seasons as an assistant head coach.

Prior to serving as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator at Oregon State in 2015, Sitake spent 10 seasons at the University of Utah. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012.

Sitake has coached several Pac-12 and Mountain West Conference honorees, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014). He also helped mentor 14 NFL Draft picks during his time at Utah, including 12 all-league players and three freshmen All-Americans. He helped the Utes win seven of eight bowl games during his tenure.

Sitake began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002. Sitake then joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.

Born in Nuku'alofa, Tonga, and raised in Laie, Hawai'i and Provo, Utah, Sitake becomes the first FBS head football coach of Tongan descent. He is the 14th head coach in BYU history, and just the fourth since 1972, when Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards took over the program.

Sitake began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards.

He was named BYU's Football Scholar Athlete of the Year in 1998, Impact Player of the Year in 1999, along with team captain and the most valuable running back in 2000. He signed a free agent contract with the Cincinnati Bengals in 2001, but was forced to retire due to an injury.

Sitake graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. He and his wife Timberly have three children, Skye, Sadie and Kelaokalani (KK).
