POSTGAME MEDIA AVAILABILITY

After home games, postgame press conference will be conducted in the LaVell Edwards Stadium press room, located on the southeast end of the stadium next to the BYU locker room. At the discretion of the visiting team, opponent interviews will be conducted in the Blue Zone, near the opponent's locker room located on northwest end of the stadium. Coach Sitake and select players will be available following the NCAA mandatory cooling off period. Members of the media are invited to move from the press box down to the field and to the press room four minutes prior to the ending of the game. A direct video feed will also be sent to the press box from the BYU postgame press conference. A basic transcript of Sitake's comments from the postgame press conference will be provided with additional player quotes upon availability. For road games, BYU will conduct interviews outside the locker room or in a location designated by the host school.

Other than during the recognized interview time after practice sessions, press conferences and other organized media availability, interviews and information inquiries must be initiated and arranged through the Athletic Communications office prior to being conducted. Media members should not contact directly BYU players, coaches, support staff or other athletic department personnel for any reason. He ranks high in several statistical categories in 2016. Williams became the Cougars' all-time leading rusher this season and is on pace to make a run at the BYU single-season record held by Doak Walker Award winner, Luke Staley (2001). Williams (1,034) is just behind where Staley (1,092) was after eight games played during Staley's winning season.

Kai Nacua was recently named a semifinalist for the 2016 Jim Thorpe Award, honoring the best defensive back in college football. A ball-hawking safety, Nacua has more interceptions than 17 FBS teams in 2016. He has 13 career interceptions, the most at BYU since 2000 when defensive statistics were officially tracked by the NCAA and unofficially tied for the fifth-most at BYU. Nacua has three games with multiple picks, including a three-interception game vs. Boise State in 2015 and two pick-sixes under his belt. He is also BYU's active leader in total tackles with 154.

THUNDERBIRDS PICK UP SENIOR GAME VICTORY OVER BOBCATS

CEDAR CITY, Utah – The Southern Utah Thunderbirds picked up a win with a 38-21 victory over the Montana State Bobcats for SUU’s Senior Game.

Aside from a brief 7-7 tie a few minutes into the second quarter, the Bobcats led the entire first half. The Thunderbirds entered the second half fired up, outscoring the Bobcats 24-7 to secure the 38-21 victory.

“I’m really happy for our seniors. We had a tough game last time we were on this field, so I wanted to make sure we finished it off right for those guys,” head coach Demario Warren said. “We came out in the second half and took over one play at a time. We made some clutch plays to put the game away.”

Malik Brown led the Thunderbirds, rushing 16 times for a gain of 84 yards and one touchdown. Raysean Pringle followed, rushing five times for 43 yards and a touchdown.

“It was a hard moment thinking about this being my last game (here),” Brown said. “Knowing it was our last game, we had to go out with a bang.”

Patrick Tyler threw 25-41-0 for 231 yards. Tyler connected with Logan Parker, Steve Wroblewski, and Cameron Chambers for three Thunderbird touchdowns.

The Thunderbirds displayed a defensively dominant game, which was highlighted by four interceptions. Mitch Dalley led the game defensively with eight tackles and two interceptions, as Josh Thornton and Kyle Hannemann tacked on the third and fourth interceptions.

“It felt so good to get a win on senior game. Our offense clicked and it all felt great,” Thornton said. “It’s been a tough year. We pride ourselves on being resilient, and our guys came out today ready to play.”

The Thunderbirds are back in action next week as they take on the BYU Cougars on Saturday, Nov. 12, at 2:30 p.m. in LaVell Edwards Stadium.

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR SIX

The 12-game independent schedule features teams from eight different conferences and an independent team. Six games come against Power Five opponents, including teams from the Pac-12, Big 12, Big Ten and SEC. The schedule ranks No. 7 in Phil Steele's preseason schedule rankings. The opponents on the 2016 schedule posted a 97-57 record in 2015, with 10 bowl teams and an FCS playoff team.

The Cougars host six home games and have four true road contests with two neutral site games, both at NFL stadiums, in 2016. The home schedule consists of UCLA, Toledo, Mississippi State, Southern Utah, UMass and Utah State. Teams on the home schedule put together a 44-31 record in 2015, with four reaching bowl games and Southern Utah earned an FCS playoff berth. Road contests include Utah, Michigan State, Boise State and Cincinnati with neutral site games against Arizona (University of Phoenix Stadium - home of the Arizona Cardinals) and West Virginia (FedEx Field - home of the Washington Redskins). All six games away from home are against 2015 bowl teams with a combined record of 53-16 last year.

BOWLING OPPONENTS

Of BYU's 12 opponents in 2016, 10 played in a bowl game in 2015. Only USC has more bowl teams on its 2016 schedule with 11. BYU, along with just Ole Miss and Colorado are the only three teams with 10 bowl teams on the schedule this season.

TEAM CAPTAINS

BYU will have four captains for the 2016 season in senior quarterback Taysom Hill, senior running back Jamaal Williams, senior defensive back Kai Nacua and senior defensive lineman Harvey Langi. Hill is serving as a captain for the third time. BYU offensive coordinator Ty Detmer was also a three-time team captain (89, 90, 91).

FLAG BEARERS

BYU's tradition of carrying team flags out of the tunnel adds some new looks for 2016. A United States serviceman will carry an American flag for every game, with team flags carried by selected players and alumni flags carried by former BYU players for each game.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's record at LaVell Edwards Stadium is ranked No. 12 among teams playing in their current stadium.

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates missions around the world in 150 nations speaking more than 160 languages. Over 74,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions in 418 missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours—seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples)—teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

The 2016 team has 84 players that served church missions and there are another 27 currently serving. Members of the team have served in over 25 countries and six of the seven continents around the globe.

POLYNESIAN PIPELINE

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recruiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. More than 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now, several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff.

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA. Sitake was raised in Laie, Hawaii and later moved to the mainland. His staff includes Polynesians Ilaia Tuiaiki, Steve Kaufusi, Reno Mahe, Nu'u Tafisi, Russell Tialavea, Tevita Ofahengaue, Jack Damuni, Jasen Ah You, Sione Kinikini, Vince Feula and Harvey Unga.

FORMER PLAYERS ON STAFF

There are 21 former BYU football players on the football and athletic administration staff. Members of the staff were part of Cougar teams that won the 1980 "Miracle Bowl," the 1984 National Championship, Heisman Trophy, 1996 Cotton Bowl along with many other accolades.

LAST GAME RECAP: DEFENSE LEADS BYU TO 20-3 WIN AT CINCINNATI

CINCINNATI – BYU football took down Cincinnati 20-3 on the road on Saturday with a stout defensive effort and a strong run game.

BYU improves to 5-4 on the season after outgaining Cincinnati (4-5, 1-4 American Athletic Conference) 338 to 286. The Cougars were successful on third down in the game, converting 10 of 16 attempts and holding the Bearcats to just 4 of 13 on third down and 0 for 2 on fourth.

The Cougar defense held Cincinnati without a touchdown, marking the first time BYU has kept an opponent out of the end zone since 2014 against Savannah State and first FBS opponent since SDSU in the 2012 Poinsettia Bowl. It was the fewest points the Bearcats have scored since a 10-3 loss to Rutgers in 2012.

Taysom Hill led the offense, completing 15 of 25 passes for 130 yards and one interception along with rushing 75 yards for a touchdown. Jamaal Williams had 25 carries for 92 yards while Squally Canada spelled him with nine carries, 41 yards and one touchdown.

On defense, Francis Bernard led the team with nine total tackles along with one pass breakup. Corbin Kaufusi had notched three tackles and one sack while Troy Warner logged three pass breakups in the first half.

In the Bearcats' opening drive, they made it to the BYU 6-yard line. The Cougars stayed tough, however, holding the home team to a 23-yard field goal, which would be the only score of the game for Cincinnati.

After BYU turned the ball over on downs on its first possession, freshman Austin McChesney picked off Gunner Kiel for his first interception of his career. He returned it 37 yards with 7:12 remaining in the first quarter. However, the Cougar offense stalled, punting the ball back to the Bearcats.

The defense held Cincinnati to a three and out in the next possession. On third down for BYU, Hill rushed 9 yards for the first down. Rhett Almond kicked a 28-yard field goal to tie the game 3-3 with 38 seconds left in the first quarter.

BYU finally got the offense going late in the second quarter. Colby Pearson and Nick Kurtz each had key third down conversions to keep the drive alive. To spark the team, Hill threw 43-yard flea flicker to Jonah Trinnaman, setting up the score. Hill rushed 8 yards into the end zone for the first touchdown of the game, taking the 10-3 lead heading into the break. The Cougars outgained Cincinnati 115 to 9 in the second quarter.

To start the second half, Pearson and Canada were clutch on third down to get the first downs in the opening drive of the half. Williams rushed 13 yards to get just short of the end zone, setting up the score. Canada punched in that last yard for his second touchdown of the year, pushing BYU's lead to 17-3 with 8:26 left in the third quarter.

The Bearcats' next chance to score came on a 39-yard field goal attempt in the third quarter, but it went wide left to keep the Cougars up 17-3.

BYU defense came up big again when Cincinnati went for it on fourth and two. Fred Warner and Tevita Mo'Unga combined to keep Bearcats running back Tion Green short, forcing a turnover on downs.

Draining 9:41 off the clock in the fourth quarter, the Cougars took their time marching down the field on their final scoring drive Williams converted on fourth down with a 2-yard rush. But on the second fourth down BYU faced, the team settled for a 19-yard field goal, pushing the lead to 20-3 with just 1:39 left in the game.

THE BYU OFFENSE

- **TAG TEAM, BACK AGAIN.** In 2013 when both played a full season, Taysom Hill (1,344) and Jamaal Williams (1,233) combined for 2,577 rushing yards. Through nine games, the pair has combined for 1,481 yards (1,034 for Williams and 447 for Hill).
- **SCORING BY QUARTER.** BYU has scored 44 points in the first quarter, 49 in the second, 48 in the third, 89 in the fourth quarter and 14 in overtime this season. Averaging 9.9 points in the 4th quarter ranks 16th in the FBS. Last year, BYU was one of the best 4th-quarter teams nationally (4) scoring an average of 10.8 points in the 4th quarter.
- **BALANCED ATTACK.** The Cougars have run a nearly perfect balanced attack. Through nine games, BYU has 1,748 rushing yards and 1,746 passing yards. With 200 total first downs, 94 have come rushing and 90 have come via the pass. The Cougars average 194.2 per game on the ground and 194.0 in the air.
- **THIRD-DOWN THREAT.** Taysom Hill running the ball on third down has accounted for 18 of BYU's 65 third-down conversions this season. He has run for 162 yards on those conversions, gaining an average of 9.0 yards on each carry converted for a first down.

BYU DEFENSE BY THE NUMBERS

- 2** Kai Nacua is ranked second in the NCAA in total interceptions with five. Nacua has 13 career interceptions, the most by a BYU player since 2000. As a team, the Cougars have 15 interceptions this year, one off the FBS lead.
- 3** The Cougar defense held the Bearcats out of the end zone with just three points. It is the first time BYU has held a team without a touchdown since 2014 against Savannah State (W, 64-0). It was the first FBS opponent since SDSU in the 2012 Poinsettia Bowl (W, 23-6).
- 5** The Cougars had five turnovers at Boise State: two interceptions and three fumble recoveries. BYU has 22 total turnovers gained so far in 2016, tied for second in the nation.
- 206** BYU gave up just 206 total yards against Michigan State, which was the fewest the Spartans had totaled since tallying 187 against No. 13 Nebraska in 2011. The 206 given up by BYU are the fewest the Cougars have allowed in 2016.
- 50** The defense held UCLA to just 50 rushing yards, the fewest of the season for a BYU opponent. The last time BYU held the opponents to less than 50 was against Mizzou last season when the Tigers had just 46 rushing yards.

THE BYU DEFENSE

- SCORING DEFENSE.** The BYU defense has held five opponents to 20 points or less (16, 20, 17, 14, 3). The last time a BYU team kept its first three opponents under 20 was in 1984 (14, 13, 15). The 1984 team held its first five opponents to 20 points or less. In 2015, the Cougars were able to hold teams to 20 or less five times.
- TFL.** The Cougars notched at least six tackles for a loss in 12 out of 13 games in 2015 and have 53 total so far in the 2016 season, including a season-high of nine against Mississippi State. Last season, the Cougars ranked No. 9 nationally with 7.5 tackles for loss per game.
- STAYING POSITIVE.** BYU is 58-10 since 2005 with a positive turnover margin. BYU was plus-5 with two picks and three fumble recoveries at Boise State and plus-3 with three picks and three fumble recoveries against Utah. The Cougars recorded a positive turnover margin in seven games in 2015.
- NEW FACES, NEW PLACES.** A number of players have shuffled positions with the coaching change to Kalani Sitake. Notable changes include several linebackers transitioning to defensive line positions with more 4-3 elements in the defensive scheme including Harvey Langi moving from mostly playing middle linebacker to defensive end. Two offensive players of note jumped to defense, including Francis Bernard moving from running back to linebacker and Akile Davis moving from receiver to cornerback. Micah Hannemann, the starting field corner in 2015 also moved into the middle at one of the safety positions.

Kalani Sitake (pronounced kah-lah-nee see-tah-kay) was named head coach overseeing the BYU football program on December 19, 2015, by director of athletics Tom Holmoe.

Sitake is the 14th head coach in BYU history. He comes to BYU from Oregon State, where he served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator.

A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake returns to his alma mater with 15 years of coaching experience, including seven years as defensive coordinator and four seasons as an assistant head coach.

Prior to serving as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator at Oregon State in 2015, Sitake spent 10 seasons at the University of Utah. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012.

Sitake has coached several Pac-12 and Mountain West Conference honorees, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014). He also helped mentor 14 NFL Draft picks during his time at Utah, including 12 all-league players and three freshmen All-Americans. He helped the Utes win seven of eight bowl games during his tenure.

Sitake began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002. Sitake then joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.

Born in Nuku'alofa, Tonga, and raised in Laie, Hawai'i and Provo, Utah, Sitake becomes the first FBS head football coach of Tongan descent. He is the 14th head coach in BYU history, and just the fourth since 1972, when Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards took over the program.

Sitake began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards.

He was named BYU's Football Scholar Athlete of the Year in 1998, Impact Player of the Year in 1999, along with team captain and the most valuable running back in 2000. He signed a free agent contract with the Cincinnati Bengals in 2001, but was forced to retire due to an injury.

Sitake graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. He and his wife Timberly have three children, Skye, Sadie and Kelaokalani (KK).
