BYU STORYLINES

- **SERIES HISTORY.** BYU and Toledo are meeting for the first time in the history of the two programs.
- **MAC.** BYU is facing an opponent from the Mid-American Conference for the first time this year. A MAC opponent makes for the third different conference the Cougars have had opponents from in 2016. BYU has faced the Pac-12 and Big 12 to start the year. BYU is 5-4 against the MAC.
- **COMBINED RECORD.** The combined record for BYU's first five opponents including Toledo is 14-4 with Arizona (2-2), Utah (4-0), UCLA (2-2), West Virginia (3-0), Toledo (3-0).
- **OPPONENT BYE WEEKS.** For the second consecutive week, BYU is facing a team coming off of a bye week with Toledo. This is the second of three 2016 opponents the Cougars will face that are coming off of a bye.
- **JAMAAL WILLIAMS.** Jamaal Williams has been named the College Sports Madness Independent Player of the Week. Williams rushed for 169 yards and two touchdowns on 24 carries against the Mountaineers.
- **STADIUM RECORD.** With a .767 winning percentage, BYU ranks No. 12 in stadium winning percentage among teams playing in their current stadium.

POSTGAME MEDIA AVAILABILITY

After home games, postgame press conference will be conducted in the LaVell Edwards Stadium press room, located on the southeast end of the stadium next to the BYU locker room. At the discretion of the visiting team, opponent interviews will be conducted in the Blue Zone, near the opponent's locker room located on northwest end of the stadium. Coach Sitake and select players will be available following the NCAA mandatory cooling off period. Members of the media are invited to move from the press box down to the field and to the press room four minutes prior to the ending of the game. A direct video feed will also be sent to the press box from the BYU postgame press conference. A basic transcript of Sitake's comments from the postgame press conference will be provided with additional player quotes upon availability. For road games, BYU will conduct interviews outside the locker room or in a location designated by the host school.

ROCKETS ROLL OVER FRESNO STATE, 52-17

Toledo, OH - Junior quarterback Logan Woodside threw for 239 yards and four touchdowns while senior running back Kareem Hunt rushed for 123 yards and one score to lead Toledo to a 52-17 victory over Fresno State at the Glass Bowl Saturday afternoon.

The victory moves Toledo to 3-0, while Fresno State falls to 1-2.

For the third time in three games, Toledo's defense dominated the game. Toledo held the Bulldogs to just 254 of total offense and 0-of-13 on third-down conversions. UT did not yield a first down until the 10-minute mark of the second quarter. Fresno State quarterback Chason Virgil completed just 12-of-23 passes, while Bulldog running backs averaged just 1.9 yards per carry. Senior defensive tackle Treyvon Hester led the way with two sacks and 2.5 tackles for loss, while senior defensive end John Stepec had two TFLs and two QB hurries.

The Rockets have now surrendered an average of just 10.0 points and 251.7 yards of total offense in their three wins.

"It was a soft box and we need to be able to do a better job than that," he said. "Give them credit for holding their own. We challenged the O-line at halftime and that was something we talked about all week. We were able to rotate some guys and play some different guys and were hoping we would be able to wear them out in the second half. And we did."

Davis completed 11-of-26 passes for 189 yards and a touchdown for YSU, and he also led the team with 62 yards on 13 attempts. Bailey caught three passes for 92 yards.

Woodside completed 15-of-26 passes, with two scoring throws to senior tight end Michael Roberts and one each to junior Cody Thompson and sophomore Jon'Vea Johnson. His four TD passes give him 11 in three contests this season. Thompson (game-high 102 yards receiving) and senior Corey Jones each had a game-high four receptions, while Roberts had three. Hunt cracked the 100-yard mark for the first time this season and the 21st time in his four-year career. Redshirt freshman Art Thompkins also gained 103 yards on 15 carries, his first 100-yard effort.

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR SIX

The 12-game independent schedule features teams from eight different conferences and an independent team. Six games come against Power Five opponents, including teams from the Pac-12, Big 12, Big Ten and SEC. The schedule ranks No. 7 in Phil Steele's preseason schedule rankings. The opponents on the 2016 schedule posted a 97-57 record in 2015, with 10 bowl teams and an FCS playoff team.

The Cougars host six home games and have four true road contests with two neutral site games, both at NFL stadiums, in 2016. The home schedule consists of UCLA, Toledo, Mississippi State, Southern Utah, UMass and Utah State. Teams on the home schedule put together a 44-31 record in 2015, with four reaching bowl games and Southern Utah earned an FCS playoff berth. Road contests include Utah, Michigan State, Boise State and Cincinnati with neutral site games against Arizona (University of Phoenix Stadium - home of the Arizona Cardinals) and West Virginia (FedEx Field - home of the Washington Redskins). All six games away from home are against 2015 bowl teams with a combined record of 53-16 last year.

TEAM CAPTAINS

BYU will have four captains for the 2016 season in senior quarterback Taysom Hill, senior running back Jamaal Williams, senior defensive back Kai Nacua and senior defensive lineman Harvey Langi. Hill is serving as a captain for the third time. BYU offensive coordinator Ty Detmer was also a three-time team captain (89, 90, 91).

FLAG BEARERS

BYU's tradition of carrying team flags out of the tunnel adds some new looks for 2016. A United States serviceman will carry an American flag for every game, with team flags carried by selected players and alumni flags carried by former BYU players for each game.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU is No. 12 in winning percentage among teams in their current stadiums.

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates missions around the world in 150 nations speaking more than 160 languages. Over 74,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions in 418 missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours—seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples)—teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

The 2016 team has 84 players that served church missions and there are another 27 currently serving. Members of the team have served in over 25 countries and six of the seven continents around the globe.

ALUMNI FIRESIDES

Former members of the BYU football team will produce firesides, or devotionals at local LDS churches the night before select road games during the 2016 season. Firesides are open to the public. Additional firesides may be announced. These devotionals are referred to as "firesides" and are intended to help those who attend strengthen or gain a knowledge of our purpose here on earth. Firesides typically include a musical number and talks

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recruiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. More than 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now, several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff.

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA. Sitake was raised in Laie, Hawaii and later moved to the mainland. His staff includes Polynesians Ilaisa Tuiaki, Steve Kaufusi, Reno Mahe, Nu'u Tafisi, Russell Tialavea, Tevita Ofahengaue, Jack Damuni, Jasen Ah You, Sione Kinikini, Vince Feula and Harvey Unga.

BYU FALLS 35-32 TO WEST VIRGINIA

LANDOVER, Md. – In another close battle, BYU football lost to 35-32, to West Virginia at FedEx Field on Saturday despite having another chance at late-game rally.

With less than five minutes left in the game, the BYU offense had two different chances to drive down the field to take the lead. However, turnovers proved to be costly for the Cougars. An interception with over four minutes to go looked to doom any chances but West Virginia coughed it up at the goal line on a fumble to give BYU one more shot.

After driving to the Mountaineer 28-yard line, BYU went for it all with just over a minute on the clock on a long pass for the end zone and the ball was tipped up just in front of the goal line and intercepted. West Virginia was able to run out the clock to hold on to the win.

BYU (1-3) out-gained West Virginia (3-0) 521 to 481 yards, but struggled with turnovers. The Cougars had three interceptions and one lost fumble. The Mountaineers capitalized on those, scoring 14 points off of turnovers. For BYU, every game this season has been decided by three points or less, with three losses coming by a combined seven points.

Both Jamaal Williams and Taysom Hill rushed for over 100 yards. Williams totaled 169 on 24 attempts with two touchdowns. Hill completed 23 of 35 passes for 241 yards with two touchdowns and three interceptions to go with his 101 rushing yards. On the defense, Fred Warner totaled 14 tackles, nine solo. Butch Pau'u recorded his first career interception in addition to his five tackles.

THE BYU OFFENSE

• **TAG TEAM, BACK AGAIN.** In 2013 when both played a full season, Taysom Hill (1,344) and Jamaal Williams (1,233) combined for 2,577 rushing yards. Through four games, the pair has combined for 642 yards (417 for Williams and 225 for Hill). They both rushed for 100 yards in the same game (West Virginia-Williams 169, Hill 105) for the first time since Sept. 11, 2014 against Houston. Hill ran for 160 and Williams ran for 139 in a 33-25 win. BYU had been 4-0 when both run for 100 before the Mountaineers.

• **NEW GUYS.** BYU has had some new faces contribute in the early 2016 season. Wideout Jonah Trinnaman has 11 receptions for 88 yards. Tight ends Hunter Marshall and Tanner Balderree have both caught balls this season for the first time in their careers. Receivers Aleva Hifo and Garrett Juergens also recorded their first receptions and fullback Brayden El-Bakri scored his first touchdown on his first career carry.

• **SCORING BY QUARTER.** BYU has scored 13 points in the first quarter, 22 in the second, 13 in the third and 35 in the fourth quarter this season. Last year, BYU was one of the best 4th-quarter teams nationally, scoring an average of 10.8 points in the 4th quarter. The 4th quarter was the highest scoring quarter for the Cougars in 2015.

THE BYU DEFENSE

- SCORING DEFENSE.** BYU held its first three opponents to 20 points or less in each game (16, 20, 17). The last time a BYU team has accomplished this was in 1984 (14, 13, 15). The 1984 team held its first five opponents to 20 points or less. In 2015, the Cougars were able to hold teams to 20 or less five times.
- TFL.** The Cougars notched at least six tackles for a loss in 12 out of 13 games in 2015 and have 26 total so far in the 2016 season, including a season-high of eight against UCLA. BYU has not had less than four tackles for a loss in a game so far this season. Last season, the Cougars ranked No. 9 nationally with 7.5 tackles for loss per game.
- STAYING POSITIVE.** BYU is 56-9 since 2005 with a positive turnover margin. BYU was plus-2 with two picks against Arizona and plus-3 with three picks and three fumble recoveries against Utah. The Cougars recorded a positive turnover margin in seven games in 2015.
- NEW FACES, NEW PLACES.** A number of players have shuffled positions with the coaching change to Kalani Sitake. Notable changes include several linebackers transitioning to defensive line positions with more 4-3 elements in the defensive scheme including Harvey Langi moving from mostly playing middle linebacker to defensive end. Two offensive players of note jumped to defense, including Francis Bernard moving from running back to linebacker and Akile Davis moving from receiver to cornerback. Micah Hannemann, the starting field corner in 2015 also moved into the middle at one of the safety positions.

Kalani Sitake (pronounced kah-lah-nee see-tah-kay) was named head coach overseeing the BYU football program on December 19, 2015, by director of athletics Tom Holmoe.

Sitake is the 14th head coach in BYU history. He comes to BYU from Oregon State, where he served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator.

A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake returns to his alma mater with 15 years of coaching experience, including seven years as defensive coordinator and four seasons as an assistant head coach.

Prior to serving as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator at Oregon State in 2015, Sitake spent 10 seasons at the University of Utah. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012.

Sitake has coached several Pac-12 and Mountain West Conference honorees, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014). He also helped mentor 14 NFL Draft picks during his time at Utah, including 12 all-league players and three freshmen All-Americans. He helped the Utes win seven of eight bowl games during his tenure.

Sitake began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002. Sitake then joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.

Born in Nuku'alofa, Tonga, and raised in Laie, Hawai'i and Provo, Utah, Sitake becomes the first FBS head football coach of Tongan descent. He is the 14th head coach in BYU history, and just the fourth since 1972, when Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards took over the program.

Sitake began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards.

He was named BYU's Football Scholar Athlete of the Year in 1998, Impact Player of the Year in 1999, along with team captain and the most valuable running back in 2000. He signed a free agent contract with the Cincinnati Bengals in 2001, but was forced to retire due to an injury.

Sitake graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. He and his wife Timberly have three children, Skye, Sadie and Kelaokalani (KK).
