BYU STORYLINES

- **SERIES HISTORY.** BYU and the Minutemen have never met in football. The two teams are scheduled to meet three more times as part of a four-game series with one more game in Provo and two at Gillette Stadium.
- **INDEPENDENCE.** UMass, like BYU, is currently playing as an FBS Independent. Since going independent, BYU has only matched up with one other independent school, Notre Dame.
- **GOING BOWLING.** After the 37-7 win over Southern Utah, BYU accepted a bowl invitation to the San Diego County Credit Union Poinsettia Bowl. BYU is one of 10 teams that will go to a bowl game for a 12th consecutive season. Alabama, Boise State, Clemson, Florida State, Oklahoma, Virginia Tech, Wisconsin, Georgia and LSU are the other nine programs that extended their streak to 12 or more this season. The Cougars went to a program-record 17 bowl games in row from 1978 to 1994.
- **NOVEMBER GAMES.** BYU is 33-6 in the month of November over the past 10 seasons, including a perfect 17-0 at home during that time. The Cougars have not lost at home in November since 2005 when they fell 41-34 to Utah.
- **ACADEMICS.** Tayson Hill was named a finalist for the William V. Campbell Trophy in addition to being named one of 12 National Football Foundation National Scholar-Athletes. With a 3.45 GPA, Hill graduated in the spring and will receive an \$18,000 post-graduate scholarship. The winner of the Campbell Trophy will be announced Dec. 6. Wide receiver Nick Kurtz and defensive lineman Logan Taele were also both named to the CoSIDA Academic All-District Team.

POSTGAME MEDIA AVAILABILITY

After home games, postgame press conference will be conducted in the LaVell Edwards Stadium press room, located on the southeast end of the stadium next to the BYU locker room. At the discretion of the visiting team, opponent interviews will be conducted in the Blue Zone, near the opponent's locker room located on northwest end of the stadium. Coach Sitake and select players will be available following the NCAA mandatory cooling off period. Members of the media are invited to move from the press box down to the field and to the press room four minutes prior to the ending of the game. A direct video feed will also be sent to the press box from the BYU postgame press conference. A basic transcript of Sitake's comments from the postgame press conference will be provided with additional player quotes upon availability. For road games, BYU will conduct interviews outside the locker room or in a location designated by the host school.

Other than during the recognized interview time after practice sessions, press conferences and other organized media availability, interviews and information inquiries must be initiated and arranged through the Athletic Communications office prior to being conducted. Media members should not contact directly BYU players, coaches, support staff or other athletic department personnel for any reason. LATE SURGE GUIDES TROY BY UMASS FOOTBALL

TROY, Ala. - Jalen Williams posted 108 receiving yards and one score in 52-31 defeat.

Massachusetts raced out to a 14-0 lead in the opening two minutes, 21 seconds with back-to-back Andrew Ford touchdown passes, one each to Dan Jonah and Adam Breneman.

Ford hit Jonah for a six-yard scoring strike only 84 seconds into play at Veterans Memorial Stadium after Troy won the toss and elected to defer possession to the second half, which gave the Minutemen the ball to start the game.

Troy quarterback Brandon Silvers was intercepted on his first pass attempt of the night as Isaiah Rodgers picked off his throw and returned it 36 yards to the Troy 11 yard line. Breneman's endzone touchdown grab followed two plays later.

Troy answered with the next three scoring drives. Silvers made up for his miscue with a five yard completion to Emanuel Thompson before Jordan Chunn and Silvers powered in for back-to-back rushing scores.

Logan Laurent cut into the 21-14 deficit at the 10:38 mark of the second quarter when he converted on a 28-yard field goal; however, the Trojans netted their fourth TD drive of the half with only 56 seconds to go for a 28-17 lead at the break. John Johnson hauled in a seven yard grab for the touchdown.

UMass answered back during its opening drive of the third quarter to cut the deficit to 28-24 with 10:13 to go. The Minutemen marched 70 yards over seven plays, capped by Williams' 31-yard TD reception.

Troy posted the next 24 points and put the game out of reach as the Trojans turned a four-point advantage into a 52-24 margin with 10 minutes to play.

Sadiq Palmer added the final UMass points of the contest with his first rushing touchdown, a four-yard scamper that closed out a 16-play, 75-yard series.

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR SIX

The 12-game independent schedule features teams from eight different conferences and an independent team. Six games come against Power Five opponents, including teams from the Pac-12, Big 12, Big Ten and SEC. The schedule ranks No. 7 in Phil Steele's preseason schedule rankings. The opponents on the 2016 schedule posted a 97-57 record in 2015, with 10 bowl teams and an FCS playoff team.

The Cougars host six home games and have four true road contests with two neutral site games, both at NFL stadiums, in 2016. The home schedule consists of UCLA, Toledo, Mississippi State, Southern Utah, UMass and Utah State. Teams on the home schedule put together a 44-31 record in 2015, with four reaching bowl games and Southern Utah earned an FCS playoff berth. Road contests include Utah, Michigan State, Boise State and Cincinnati with neutral site games against Arizona (University of Phoenix Stadium - home of the Arizona Cardinals) and West Virginia (FedEx Field - home of the Washington Redskins). All six games away from home are against 2015 bowl teams with a combined record of 53-16 last year.

BOWLING OPPONENTS

Of BYU's 12 opponents in 2016, 10 played in a bowl game in 2015. Only USC has more bowl teams on its 2016 schedule with 11. BYU, along with just Ole Miss and Colorado are the only three teams with 10 bowl teams on the schedule this season.

TEAM CAPTAINS

BYU will have four captains for the 2016 season in senior quarterback Taysom Hill, senior running back Jamaal Williams, senior defensive back Kai Nacua and senior defensive lineman Harvey Langi. Hill is serving as a captain for the third time. BYU offensive coordinator Ty Detmer was also a three-time team captain (89, 90, 91).

FLAG BEARERS

BYU's tradition of carrying team flags out of the tunnel adds some new looks for 2016. A United States service-man will carry an American flag for every game, with team flags carried by selected players and alumni flags carried by former BYU players for each game.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's record at LaVell Edwards Stadium is ranked No. 12 among teams playing in their current stadium.

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates missions around the world in 150 nations speaking more than 160 languages. Over 74,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions in 418 missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours—seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples)—teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

The 2016 team has 84 players that served church missions and there are another 27 currently serving. Members of the team have served in over 25 countries and six of the seven continents around the globe.

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recruiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. More than 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now, several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff.

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA. Sitake was raised in Laie, Hawaii and later moved to the mainland. His staff includes Polynesians Ilaia Tuiaki, Steve Kaufusi, Reno Mahe, Nu'u Tafisi, Russell Tialavea, Tevita Ofahengaue, Jack Damuni, Jasen Ah You, Sione Kinikini, Vince Feula and Harvey Unga.

LAST GAME RECAP: BYU BECOMES BOWL ELIGIBLE WITH 37-7 WIN OVER SOUTHERN UTAH

PROVO, Utah – BYU beat Southern Utah 37-7 on Saturday at LaVell Edwards Stadium to become bowl eligible for a 12th-consecutive season.

"It's good to be bowl eligible and get it done early," BYU head coach Kalani Sitake said. "Overall I'm happy about the win and proud of the way the guys played. I think they were excited to play this game and it showed from the get-go."

The Cougars (6-4) recorded several offensive season highs in the win. They tallied 596 total yards, 441 of which were through the air.

Taysom Hill played for most of the first three quarters, and passed for 320 yards and two touchdowns while rushing for 59 yards and another trip to the end zone.

Tanner Mangum played several series behind center, and threw for 121 yards with 42 rushing yards.

Freshman running back KJ Hall contributed significantly to BYU's offensive attack, rushing for 59 yards and a touchdown, with 68 receiving yards.

BYU used just two plays on its first drive to find the end zone. After forcing a turnover on downs on the Southern Utah 47 yardline, Hill connected with Mitchell Juergens for a 31-yard pass and followed it up with a 16-yard touchdown run for a 7-0 lead.

As the first quarter neared its end, Hill hooked up with Nick Kurtz for a 31-yard touchdown pass. The Cougars held a 14-0 lead as the first quarter ended.

About five minutes into the second quarter, BYU drove 29 yards before Rhett Almond made a 28-yard field goal to put the Cougars up 17-0.

With 3:56 left in the first half, Hill connected with Colby Pearson on a 21-yard touchdown pass. That punctuated a seven-play, 62-yard drive to put BYU up 24-0 after Almond's PAT.

The Thunderbirds got on the board with 2:02 left in the first half, via a 17-yard touchdown pass from Patrick Tyler to Logan Parker. The ensuing PAT cut the Cougars' lead to 24-7.

Hill scored his first BYU touchdown 46 seconds before halftime, finishing a six-play, 82 yard drive with a two-yard run. BYU increased its advantage to 31-7 going into halftime.

Neither team scored in the third quarter, as the Cougars maintained their 31-7 lead.

Almond hit a 30-yard field goal with 10:31 left in the game to put BYU up 34-17.

With 51 seconds left, Almond hit another field goal, this time a 20-yarder, to put the Cougars up 37-7.

THE BYU OFFENSE

- **TAG TEAM, BACK AGAIN.** In 2013 when both played a full season, Taysom Hill (1,344) and Jamaal Williams (1,233) combined for 2,577 rushing yards. Through 10 games, the pair has combined for 1,510 yards (1,034 for Williams and 476 for Hill). The two combined for 17 rushing touchdowns in 2013 (10 Hill, 7 Williams) and have matched that with 17 this year (Williams 10, Hill 7).
- **SCORING BY QUARTER.** BYU has scored 58 points in the first quarter, 66 in the second, 48 in the third, 95 in the fourth quarter and 14 in overtime this season. Averaging 9.5 points in the 4th quarter ranks 18th in the FBS. Last year, BYU was one of the best 4th-quarter teams nationally (4) scoring an average of 10.8 points in the 4th quarter.
- **BALANCED ATTACK.** The Cougars have been very balanced this season. Through 10 games, BYU has 1,903 rushing yards and 2,121 passing yards. With 233 total first downs, 108 have come rushing and 109 have come via the pass. The Cougars average 190.3 per game on the ground and 218.7 in the air.
- **THIRD-DOWN THREAT.** Taysom Hill running the ball on third down has accounted for 20 of BYU's 73 third-down conversions this season. He has run for 170 yards on those conversions, gaining an average of 8.5 yards on each carry converted for a first down.
- **PASSING YARDS.** BYU threw for 441 passing yards against the T-Birds. It was the most passing yards in a game since 486 against Northern Iowa in 2008.

BYU DEFENSE BY THE NUMBERS

3 The Cougar defense held the Bearcats out of the end zone with just three points. It is the first time BYU has held a team without a touchdown since 2014 against Savannah State (W, 64-0). It was the first FBS opponent since SDSU in the 2012 Poinsettia Bowl (W, 23-6).

5 Kai Nacua is ranked fifth in the NCAA in total interceptions with five. Nacua has 13 career interceptions, the most by a BYU player since 2000. As a team, the Cougars have 16 interceptions this year, three off the nation's lead (SDSU, 19).

21.4 Opponents are scoring just 21.4 points against BYU this season. The Cougar defense is ranked No. 26 in scoring defense in 2016.

116.4 BYU's run defense is allowing just 116.4 rushing yards per game, good for No. 18 nationally. The Cougars held SUU to just 21 rushing yards, the fewest for any opponent this season and fourth game under 100 yards.

206 BYU gave up just 206 total yards against Michigan State, which was the fewest the Spartans had totaled since tallying 187 against No. 13 Nebraska in 2011. The 206 given up by BYU are the fewest the Cougars have allowed in 2016.

THE BYU DEFENSE

- SCORING DEFENSE.** The BYU defense has held six opponents to 20 points or less (16, 20, 17, 14, 3, 7). In 2015, the Cougars were able to hold teams to 20 or less five times.
- TFL.** The Cougars notched at least six tackles for a loss in 12 out of 13 games in 2015 and have 61 total so far in the 2016 season, including a season-high of nine against Mississippi State. Last season, the Cougars ranked No. 9 nationally with 7.5 tackles for loss per game.
- STAYING POSITIVE.** BYU is 58-10 since 2005 with a positive turnover margin. BYU was plus-5 with two picks and three fumble recoveries at Boise State and plus-3 with three picks and three fumble recoveries against Utah. The Cougars recorded a positive turnover margin in seven games in 2015.
- NEW FACES, NEW PLACES.** A number of players have shuffled positions with the coaching change to Kalani Sitake. Notable changes include several linebackers transitioning to defensive line positions with more 4-3 elements in the defensive scheme including Harvey Langi moving from mostly playing middle linebacker to defensive end. Two offensive players of note jumped to defense, including Francis Bernard moving from running back to linebacker and Akile Davis moving from receiver to cornerback. Micah Hannemann, the starting field corner in 2015 also moved into the middle at one of the safety positions.

Kalani Sitake (pronounced kah-lah-nee see-tah-kay) was named head coach overseeing the BYU football program on December 19, 2015, by director of athletics Tom Holmoe.

Sitake is the 14th head coach in BYU history. He comes to BYU from Oregon State, where he served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator.

A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake returns to his alma mater with 15 years of coaching experience, including seven years as defensive coordinator and four seasons as an assistant head coach.

Prior to serving as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator at Oregon State in 2015, Sitake spent 10 seasons at the University of Utah. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012.

Sitake has coached several Pac-12 and Mountain West Conference honorees, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014). He also helped mentor 14 NFL Draft picks during his time at Utah, including 12 all-league players and three freshmen All-Americans. He helped the Utes win seven of eight bowl games during his tenure.

Sitake began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002. Sitake then joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.

Born in Nuku'alofa, Tonga, and raised in Laie, Hawai'i and Provo, Utah, Sitake becomes the first FBS head football coach of Tongan descent. He is the 14th head coach in BYU history, and just the fourth since 1972, when Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards took over the program.

Sitake began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards.

He was named BYU's Football Scholar Athlete of the Year in 1998, Impact Player of the Year in 1999, along with team captain and the most valuable running back in 2000. He signed a free agent contract with the Cincinnati Bengals in 2001, but was forced to retire due to an injury.

Sitake graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. He and his wife Timberly have three children, Skye, Sadie and Kelaokalani (KK).
