POINSETTIA BOWL

BYU has accepted an invitation to play in the San Diego County Credit Union Poinsettia Bowl scheduled for 6 p.m. at Qualcomm Stadium on Dec. 21. BYU is one of 10 teams that will go to a bowl game for a 12th consecutive season. Alabama, Boise State, Clemson, Florida State, Oklahoma, Virginia Tech, Wisconsin, Georgia and LSU are the other nine programs that extended their streak to 12 or more this season. The Cougars went to a program-record 17 bowl games in row from 1978 to 1994. BYU played in the Poinsettia Bowl in 2012, defeating SDSU 23-6 behind two defensive touchdowns by Kyle Van Noy. BYU STORYLINES

- **THE OLD WAGON WHEEL.** This will be the 86th meeting between the two schools. The series dates back to 1922. BYU won the last meeting with a 51-28 win up in Logan last year and took home the Old Wagon Wheel. Defensive lineman Tomasi Laulile picked up a fumble and ran it back 37 yards for a touchdown just prior to halftime. The play sparked the Cougars to outscore the Aggies 27-7 in the second half.
- **HEAD COACHES AT ALMA MATERS.** Kalani Sitake and Matt Wells have the opportunity to serve as the head coach at their respective alma maters. Sitake was a fullback at BYU (1994, 1997-00) while Matt Wells was a quarterback for the Aggies (1993-96). The two are among only 19 of 128 FBS head coaches currently at their alma maters.
- **NOVEMBER GAMES.** BYU is 34-6 in the month of November over the past 10 seasons, including a perfect 18-0 at home during that time. The Cougars have not lost at home in November since 2005 when they fell 41-34 to Utah.
- **BALL HAWKS.** BYU is the No. 1 team nationally in turnovers gained with 27 this year (18 interceptions, 9 fumbles).
- **BLACKOUT.** BYU will be wearing its black uniform combination with black jerseys, black pants and black helmets. Fans are encouraged to come to the game wearing black.
- **FIRST-YEAR FINISH.** There were 19 coaches hired prior to this season making their FBS head coaching debuts in 2016 (including coaches with interim tags in previous years). Kalani Sitake is just one of six that can finish the regular season with a winning record in the first year.

POSTGAME MEDIA AVAILABILITY

After home games, postgame press conference will be conducted in the LaVell Edwards Stadium press room, located on the southeast end of the stadium next to the BYU locker room. At the discretion of the visiting team, opponent interviews will be conducted in the Blue Zone, near the opponent's locker room located on northwest end of the stadium. Coach Sitake and select players will be available following the NCAA mandatory cooling off period. Members of the media are invited to move from the press box down to the field and to the press room four minutes prior to the ending of the game. A direct video feed will also be sent to the press box from the BYU postgame press conference. A basic transcript of Sitake's comments from the postgame press conference will be provided with additional player quotes upon availability. For road games, BYU will conduct interviews outside the locker room or in a location designated by the host school.

Other than during the recognized interview time after practice sessions, press conferences and other organized media availability, interviews and information inquiries must be initiated and arranged through the Athletic Communications office prior to being conducted. Media members should not contact directly BYU players, coaches, support staff or other athletic department personnel for any reason. UTAH STATE LOSES IN CLOSING SECONDS AT NEVADA, 38-37

RENO, Nev. - Nevada quarterback Ty Gangi scored on a 6-yard touchdown run with five seconds remaining in the game and Spencer Pettit tacked on the extra point as Nevada rallied for a 38-37 win over Utah State on Saturday afternoon at Mackay Stadium.

Redshirt freshman placekicker Dominik Eberle kicked the first three field goals of his career for the Aggies, including a 22-yarder that gave Utah State (3-8, 1-7 Mountain West) a 37-24 lead with 7:50 to go.

Tonny Lindsey, Jr. had a career day for the Aggies. The junior running back rushed for a career-best 168 yards on 21 carries. His career-long 68-yard touchdown run with 11:03 remaining in the game made it 34-24 for Utah State.

Junior quarterback Kent Myers was 10-of-18 passing for 127 yards and an interception. He also had 90 yards rushing and two scores on just 11 carries. The native of Rowlett, Texas, went over 1,000 yards rushing for his career on Saturday, becoming the third Aggie quarterback to do so.

Freshman wide receiver Rayshad Lewis added 83 yards rushing and a career-long 59-yard touchdown run on four carries, helping Utah State gain 396 yards on the ground.

However, the Wolf Pack (4-7, 2-5) rallied and scored the game's final 14 points. Elijah Mitchell began the comeback for Nevada when he recovered a muffed punt by the Aggies in the end zone with 7:19 to go.

Utah State went three-and-out on the ensuing possession and Nevada drove down to the Aggies' 5-yard line. Gangi threw an incomplete pass on third-and-4 and senior cornerback Marquan Ellison tackled James Butler short of the first down on the Wolf Pack's fourth-down play.

Senior linebacker Anthony Williams recorded 11 tackles for the Aggies, including 1.0 tackles for loss, while senior safety Devin Centers recorded 10 stops.

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR SIX

The 12-game independent schedule features teams from eight different conferences and an independent team. Six games come against Power Five opponents, including teams from the Pac-12, Big 12, Big Ten and SEC. The schedule ranks No. 7 in Phil Steele's preseason schedule rankings. The opponents on the 2016 schedule posted a 97-57 record in 2015, with 10 bowl teams and an FCS playoff team.

The Cougars host six home games and have four true road contests with two neutral site games, both at NFL stadiums, in 2016. The home schedule consists of UCLA, Toledo, Mississippi State, Southern Utah, UMass and Utah State. Teams on the home schedule put together a 44-31 record in 2015, with four reaching bowl games and Southern Utah earned an FCS playoff berth. Road contests include Utah, Michigan State, Boise State and Cincinnati with neutral site games against Arizona (University of Phoenix Stadium - home of the Arizona Cardinals) and West Virginia (FedEx Field - home of the Washington Redskins). All six games away from home are against 2015 bowl teams with a combined record of 53-16 last year.

BOWLING OPPONENTS

Of BYU's 12 opponents in 2016, 10 played in a bowl game in 2015. Only USC has more bowl teams on its 2016 schedule with 11. BYU, along with just Ole Miss and Colorado are the only three teams with 10 bowl teams on the schedule this season.

TEAM CAPTAINS

BYU will have four captains for the 2016 season in senior quarterback Taysom Hill, senior running back Jamaal Williams, senior defensive back Kai Nacua and senior defensive lineman Harvey Langi. Hill is serving as a captain for the third time. BYU offensive coordinator Ty Detmer was also a three-time team captain (89, 90, 91).

FLAG BEARERS

BYU's tradition of carrying team flags out of the tunnel adds some new looks for 2016. A United States serviceman will carry an American flag for every game, with team flags carried by selected players and alumni flags carried by former BYU players for each game.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's record at LaVell Edwards Stadium is ranked No. 12 among teams playing in their current stadium.

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates missions around the world in 150 nations speaking more than 160 languages. Over 74,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions in 418 missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours—seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples)—teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

The 2016 team has 84 players that served church missions and there are another 27 currently serving. Members of the team have served in over 25 countries and six of the seven continents around the globe.

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recruiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. More than 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now, several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff.

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA. Sitake was raised in Laie, Hawaii and later moved to the mainland. His staff includes Polynesians Ilaia Tuiaki, Steve Kaufusi, Reno Mahe, Nu'u Tafisi, Russell Tialavea, Tevita Ofahengaue, Jack Damuni, Jasen Ah You, Sione Kinikini, Vince Feula and Harvey Unga.

LAST GAME RECAP: SECOND-HALF SURGE HELPS BYU DEFEAT UMASS

PROVO, Utah – Behind a strong rushing attack and second half takeaways on defense and special teams, BYU defeated Massachusetts 51-9 on Saturday at LaVell Edwards Stadium.

The Cougars (7-4) were dominant on the ground, rushing for 247 yards and amassing 437 yards of total offense, while holding the Minutemen (2-9) to just 40 rushing yards on 20 attempts.

KJ Hall rushed for 101 yards on 18 carries and senior Harvey Langi gained 56 yards on 14 carries on his first game on offense this season. Senior quarterback Taysom Hill passed for 165 yards and rushed for 81 yards and a touchdown on 13 carries.

Despite falling behind early in the first half, the Cougars scored 44 unanswered points and dominated in the second half thanks to four turnovers and a blocked punt.

UMass quarterback Andrew Ford connected with Bernard Davis for a 70-yard touchdown pass and the Minutemen took a 6-0 lead after a missed PAT attempt with at the 3:27 mark in the first quarter.

The Cougars began the next drive on the 25-yard line and drove 75 yards in 10 plays for their first score of the game. Hill scored on an 11-yard run and the Cougars took a 7-6 lead.

The Minutemen answered quickly with a 50-yard kickoff return that resulted in a 44-yard field goal and UMass took a 9-7 lead with 12:58 remaining in the first half.

To cap off an 86-yard drive for the Cougars, Langi scampered into the endzone from five yards out with 5:22 remaining in the half to help BYU retake the lead with the score 14-9.

The Minuteman threatened to score again driving to the Cougars' 35-yard line, but a third down sack by Logan Taelle pushed UMass out of field goal range, forcing a punt.

To open the second half, BYU drove 53 yards in 11 plays and finished the drive with a 33-yard field goal from Rhett Almond.

On the next Minutemen possession, linebacker Morgan Unga reached the UMass punter in time to block the punt and BYU took over on the UMass 19-yard line. Almond tacked on another field goal, this time from 34 yards, and BYU led 20-9 with 9:13 left in the third.

On the ensuing kickoff, BYU's Eric Takenaka forced and recovered a fumble to give BYU possession on the UMass 17-yard line. Facing a long third down, Hill bulldozed several UMass defenders for an 11-yard rush that moved the ball to the two yard line and Langi scored his second touchdown of the afternoon on a 2-yard rush to make the score 27-9 in favor of BYU.

Three plays into the next UMass drive, Bernard picked off Ford and returned the interception 39 yards for the score to put the Cougars ahead, 34-9. Hill added a rushing touchdown later for a 41-9 edge.

With 7:56 remaining in the fourth quarter, BYU forced another turnover by Isaiah Armstrong getting an interception on the UMass 36-yard line. Tanner Mangum found Garrett Juergens in the end zone for a 7-yard touchdown pass to make the score 48-9. It was the first career touchdown for Juergens.

The following kickoff bounced off the hands of the UMass returner and Hiva Lee recovered the ball on the UMass 8-yard line. Almond added a 21-yard field goal with 3:05 remaining in the game and BYU held on to win by a final score of 51-9.

- 74** Taysom Hill tied Steve Young's mark of 74 career touchdowns responsible for (passing and rushing) with a score on the ground against UMass. He has 42 career passing touchdowns and 32 career rushing scores.
- 95.8** BYU is converting in the red zone (referred to as the blue zone at BYU) at a rate of 95.8 percent - ranked No. 2 in the FBS at getting points inside the 20s. The Cougars have scored on 46 of 48 attempts. BYU was 8 of 8 against the Minutemen.

THE BYU OFFENSE

• **IN GOOD COMPANY.** Taysom Hill tied Steve Young with 74 combined touchdowns (42 passing, 32 rushing) for 5th all-time at BYU. With 9,597 yards of total offense he is 126 yards away from tying Jim McMahon (9,723) for 4th in career total offense.

• **TAG TEAM, BACK AGAIN.** In 2013 when both played a full season, Taysom Hill (1,344) and Jamaal Williams (1,233) combined for 2,577 rushing yards. With one regular-season game remaining, the pair has combined for 1,591 yards (1,034 for Williams and 557 for Hill). The two combined for 17 rushing touchdowns in 2013 (10 Hill, 7 Williams) and have topped that with 18 this year (Williams 10, Hill 8).

• **SCORING BY QUARTER.** BYU has scored 58 points in the first quarter, 80 in the second, 68 in the third, 112 in the fourth quarter and 14 in overtime this season. Averaging 10.2 points in the 4th quarter ranks 13th in the FBS. Last year, BYU was one of the best 4th-quarter teams nationally (4) scoring an average of 10.8 points in the 4th quarter.

• **BALANCED ATTACK.** The Cougars have been very balanced this season. Through 11 games, BYU has 2,150 rushing yards and 2,305 passing yards. With 260 total first downs, 120 have come rushing and 120 have come via the pass (20 via penalties). The Cougars average 195.5 per game on the ground and 215.5 in the air.

• **THIRD-DOWN THREAT.** Taysom Hill running the ball on third down has accounted for 23 of BYU's 83 third-down conversions this season. He has run for 188 yards on those conversions, gaining an average of 8.2 yards on each carry converted for a first down.

BYU DEFENSE BY THE NUMBERS

- 1** BYU is the No. 1 team in the nation in turnovers gained with 27 this season (18 interceptions and nine fumbles). The Cougars are tied for second nationally in interceptions and tied for 34th in fumbles recovered.
- 5** Kai Nacua is ranked sixth in the NCAA in total interceptions with five. Nacua has 13 career interceptions, the most by a BYU player since 2000. As a team, the Cougars have 18 interceptions this year, two off the nation's lead (SDSU, 20).
- 20.3** Opponents are scoring just 20.3 points against BYU this season. The Cougar defense is ranked No. 18 in scoring defense in 2016.
- 109.5** BYU's run defense is allowing just 109.5 rushing yards per game, good for No. 12 nationally. The Cougars held SUU to just 21 rushing yards, the fewest for any opponent this season and fifth game under 100 yards.
- 206** BYU gave up just 206 total yards against Michigan State, which was the fewest the Spartans had totaled since tallying 187 against No. 13 Nebraska in 2011. The 206 given up by BYU are the fewest the Cougars have allowed in 2016.

THE BYU DEFENSE

- SCORING DEFENSE.** The BYU defense has held seven opponents to 20 points or less (16, 20, 17, 14, 3, 7, 9). In 2015, the Cougars were able to hold teams to 20 or less five times.
- TFL.** The Cougars notched at least six tackles for a loss in 12 out of 13 games in 2015 and have 69 total so far in the 2016 season, including a season-high of nine against Mississippi State. Last season, the Cougars ranked No. 9 nationally with 7.5 tackles for loss per game.
- STAYING POSITIVE.** BYU is 59-10 since 2005 with a positive turnover margin. BYU was plus-5 with two picks and three fumble recoveries at Boise State and plus-3 with three picks and three fumble recoveries against Utah. The Cougars recorded a positive turnover margin in seven games in 2015.
- NEW FACES, NEW PLACES.** A number of players have shuffled positions with the coaching change to Kalani Sitake. Notable changes include several linebackers transitioning to defensive line positions with more 4-3 elements in the defensive scheme including Harvey Langi moving from mostly playing middle linebacker to defensive end. Two offensive players of note jumped to defense, including Francis Bernard moving from running back to linebacker and Akile Davis moving from receiver to cornerback. Micah Hannemann, the starting field corner in 2015 also moved into the middle at one of the safety positions.

Kalani Sitake (pronounced kah-lah-nee see-tah-kay) was named head coach overseeing the BYU football program on December 19, 2015, by director of athletics Tom Holmoe.

Sitake is the 14th head coach in BYU history. He comes to BYU from Oregon State, where he served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator.

A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake returns to his alma mater with 15 years of coaching experience, including seven years as defensive coordinator and four seasons as an assistant head coach.

Prior to serving as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator at Oregon State in 2015, Sitake spent 10 seasons at the University of Utah. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012.

Sitake has coached several Pac-12 and Mountain West Conference honorees, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014). He also helped mentor 14 NFL Draft picks during his time at Utah, including 12 all-league players and three freshmen All-Americans. He helped the Utes win seven of eight bowl games during his tenure.

Sitake began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002. Sitake then joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.

Born in Nuku'alofa, Tonga, and raised in Laie, Hawai'i and Provo, Utah, Sitake becomes the first FBS head football coach of Tongan descent. He is the 14th head coach in BYU history, and just the fourth since 1972, when Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards took over the program.

Sitake began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards.

He was named BYU's Football Scholar Athlete of the Year in 1998, Impact Player of the Year in 1999, along with team captain and the most valuable running back in 2000. He signed a free agent contract with the Cincinnati Bengals in 2001, but was forced to retire due to an injury.

Sitake graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. He and his wife Timberly have three children, Skye, Sadie and Kelaokalani (KK).
