





BYU STORYLINES

- LAST MEETING. BYU is taking on Missouri for the second time in program history. The first matchup was in 1983 at the Holiday Bowl. Down 17-14 to the Tigers with just 23 seconds remaining, quarterback Steve Young handed off to running back Eddie Stinnett who then passed back to an open Young for the winning touchdown. Young passed for one touchdown, ran for one and caught another to earn Holiday Bowl MVP honors in the 21-17 win.
- SEC GAMES. BYU is 5-4 against the SEC as currently constituted. The Cougars have wins over Ole Miss, Mississippi State, Texas A&M and Missouri. Texas A&M and Missouri were not members of the SEC at the time of their previous matchups however.
- NEUTRAL SITE GAMES. Under Bronco Mendenhall, BYU is 7-5 in neutral site games, including 10 bowl games. BYU is 1-1 in regular-season neutral site games under Mendenhall. In 2009, BYU defeated No. 3 Oklahoma 14-13 at then Cowboys Stadium (AT&T Stadium) and fell 38-28 to TCU in the same venue in 2011.

• PLAYING FRESHMEN. BYU has played 28 freshmen this season (16 true, 12 redshirts), tied for the third-most in the country. Only Rice (31) and TCU (30) have played more freshmen than the Cougars.

POSTGAME MEDIA AVAILABILITY

After home games, postgame press conference will be conducted in the LaVell Edwards Stadium press room, located on the southeast end of the stadium next to the BYU locker room. At the descretion of the visiting team, opponent interviews will be conducted in the Blue Zone, near the opponent's locker room located on northwest end of the stadium. Coach Mendenhall and select players will be available following the NCAA mandatory cooling off period. Members of the media are invited to move from the press box down to the field and to the press room four minutes prior to the ending of the game. A direct video feed will also be sent to the press box from the BYU postgame press conference. A basic transcript of Mendenhall's comments from the postgame press conference will be provided. For road games, BYU will conduct interviews outside the locker room or in a location designated by the host school.

DEFENSE HOLDS ON TO WIN 17-16

SAN JOSE, Calif. – Defensive back Michael Wadsworth prevented a two-point conversion to shut down a San Jose State comeback and give BYU football a 17-16 win on Friday night at Spartan Stadium.

With 0:45 seconds left in the game, SJSU quarterback Kenny Potter rushed six yards to the pylon for six to make it a one-point game. San Jose State went for the win and attempted the two-point conversion with a halfback pass. Wadsworth read the play and was able to get a hand up to disrupt the pass and the ball fell to the turf to preserve the lead.

The Spartans tried for the onside kick and 6-foot-6 BYU wide receiver Mitch Mathews out-jumped San Jose State's hands team and knocked the ball out of bounds, giving possession to the Cougars to seal the win.

BYU PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS

Tanner Mangum QB (Fr.)

His 15th touchdown pass of the season tied the BYU freshman record for most in a season. He threw for 293 yards on 23-of-37 passing. He started off the game 6 of 7 on the first drive with 51 yards and a TD pass.

• Fred Warner LB (So.)

Had his second career multi-sack game with all four career sacks in the past two games. He recovered his third fumble this season on a 4th-down rushing attempt by the Spartans. It is also the most in a season since Shawn Doman had four recoveries in 2009

• Mitch Mathews WR (Sr.)

Matched his 2014 season TD total of 9 with first scoring reception of game, ending the game with 62 yards on four receptions. Has caught a pass in 33 consecutive games.

Michael Wadsworth DB (Sr.)

Notched 10 tackles for his fourth double-digit tackle game this season. He also stopped the potential game-winning two point conversion.

Algernon Brown RB (Jr.)

Scored his eighth rushing touchdown of the year-all in the last four games. He had 41 rushing yards in the win.

• Bronson Kaufusi DL (Sr.)

Upped his career sack total to 22 with a half sack and one tackle for loss to go along with six tackles in the win.

MIZZOU FALLS TO MISSISSIPPI STATE COLUMBIA, Mo. – Dak Prescott threw for 303 yards and four touchdowns to lead No. 24/25 Mississippi State to a 31-13 over Mizzou at Memorial Stadium on Thursday evening.

Senior LB Kentrell Brothers continued his all-America-caliber season, notching a game-high 14 tackles to pad his nation-leading total. He also forced a fumble, and registered his third block of the season on a second-quarter punt to tie for the national lead.

The Tigers kept the game close in the first half, posting a pair of Andrew Baggett field goals after Prescott's first TD pass of the game. After the Bulldogs (7-2, 3-2 SEC) scored on their ensuing drive, the Tigers scored on a 14-yard rush by Russell Hansbrough to end a four-game long end-zone drought.

MISSOURI PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS • Tyler Hunt TB (Sr.)

Hunt recorded 120 all-purpose yards (85 rushing, 35 receiving) to bring his season average-per-touch to 13.6 yards. The 85 rushing yards on six carries were a career high.

- Ish Witter TB (So.)
- Carried the ball 12 times for 81 yards, his most since running for 98 yards vs. South Carolina.
- Kentrell Brothers LB (Sr.)

Recorded 14 tackles on the evening, his fourth consecutive and eighth overall game with 10+ tackles. He also notched his first forced fumble of the season, the fourth of his career, and his second blocked punt of the season.

Charles Harris DE (So.)
 Notched his fourth consecutive game with a

tackle-for-loss with 1.5 on the night. Harris has 17.0 tackles-for-loss on the season.

Andrew Baggett PK (Sr.)

Scored seven points with two successful field goal tries (31, 35 yards) and an extra point to move to just 19 points shy of becoming Mizzou's all-time leading scorer.

Russell Hansbrough TB (Sr.)

Scored the only touchdown for the Tigers on a 14yard run. He had 62 yards in the loss.

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR FIVE

The 12-game independent schedule features teams from 10 states and six conferences, including the American Athletic, Big Ten, Pac-12, Mountain West and SEC. BYU has four games scheduled against current Power 5 teams and seven against teams from the Group of 5 conferences. The 12 teams on the schedule had a record of 92-53 in 2014, with eight teams coming off bowl games in 2014.

The Cougars will play six home games, five road contests and one neutral site game in 2015. The home schedule consists of Boise State, UConn, East Carolina, Cincinnati, Wagner and Fresno State. The teams on the home schedule put together a record of 44-23, with four teams reaching bowl games in 2014. The road swing includes a big September with Nebraska, UCLA and Michigan. The Cougars visit San Jose State and Utah State with a game against Missouri at the Kansas City Chief's stadium in Kansas City, Mo. The road and neutral opponents combined for a 48-30 record in 2014, with four bowl games.

FLAG BEARERS

BYU has a tradition of selecting a player before each game to run the team flag and alumni flag. The team selects a former Cougar to carry out the alumni flag, along with the chosen current player who runs out with the current team flag. The team flag has been signed by each member of the team, while the alumni flag has been signed by former BYU payers. In 2011, the team added a special teams flag, donned by a vintage BYU logo adopted by the special teams, following the same protocol as the team flag with an exemplary special na choson to carny it oach w

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 64,045 after refurbishing the middle of the east section. The capacity now sits at 63,470 due to accomodations for wheelchair access. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands.

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates missions around the world in 145 nations speaking 164 languages. More than 85,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions in 417 missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours-seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples)-teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

81 members of the 2015 team have served church missions. Members of the team have served in over 25 countries and six of the seven continents around the globe.

FIRESIDES

The BYU football team will participate in hour-long devotionals prior or team service activities the night before each game this season. The team will conduct devotionals before six games. These devotionals are referred to as "firesides" and are intended to help players, coaches and those who attend strengthen or gain a knowledge of our purpose here on earth. Firesides typically include a musical number from members of the team and talks from selected players, along with coach Bronco Mendenhall.

THE BYU OFFENSE

- FOURTH QUARTER SCORING. BYU has outscored its opponents 94-40 in the fourth quarter this year. BYU scored 20 or more points three times in the fourth quarter this year (Boise State, UConn and Cincinnati). The Cougars had never had 20-plus points in the fourth quarter in two games in any season under Mendenhall, let alone three. BYU has hit the 20-point mark in the fourth quarter in seven total games under Mendenhall. It marks the first time BYU has scored 20 or more fourth-quarter points in three games since the 1988 season, Ty Detmer's redshirt freshman year.
- BRUISING BACKS. The running back duo of bruisers Algernon Brown (6-1, 235) and Francis Bernard (6-0, 235) have accounted for 682 rushing yards and 12 total touchdowns in the last five games.
- **BIG AND TALL.** BYU's tall receiving combination of Mitch Mathews, Nick Kurtz and Terenn Houk stands at 6-foot-6, 6-foot-5 and 6-foot-4. The three big receivers have accounted for 93 receptions, 1,278 yards and 12 touchhdowns.
- **OFFENSIVE LINE EXPERIENCE.** BYU returns an experienced offensive line for 2015. The five projected starters for BYU have logged 100 starts between them and have played in 124 games. Offensive tackle Ryker Mathews has the most games under his belt with 29 starts in 40 games played.
- FRESHMAN QB RECORD WATCH. Tanner Mangum broke the freshman quarterback records for completions (35) and passing yards (365) against UConn and tied the freshman season record for touchdown passes with his 15th against San Jose State and wins with his sixth. Jake Heaps set the season records for freshman quarterbacks in 2010, going 219 of 383 for 2,316 yards, 15 touchdowns and had six wins as a starter. After nine games (eight starts), Mangum is 179 for 282 with 2,198 yards, 15 touchdowns and has six wins as a starter.
- **TRUE FRESHMAN SIGNAL CALLERS.** BYU played three true freshman quarterbacks in the game against Wagner. No other FBS team has played three true freshman quarterbacks during the 2015 season, let alone all three in the same game. Oregon State has played two redshirt freshman quarterbacks and one true freshman quarterback during the 2015 season but not in the same game. BYU's three true freshman tallied 411 passing yards, 741 yards of total offense and led 10 touchdown drives.
- SPREADING THE BALL. BYU has had 19 players catch a pass this season. Five players have over 300 yards receiving and three have over 400 receiving yards with one 500-yard receiver (Devon Blackmon) and Mitch Mathews knocking on the door with 499.

Cougar linebacker Fred Warner has recovered three fumbles this season, ranked in a tie for No. 3 in the nation. He is the first BYU player to total three recoveries in a season since linebacker Shawn Doman had four in 2009.

BYU is tied at No. 6 with Texas in average team sacks per game with 3.33. The Cougars have sacked the opponents 30 times this season for the most in a season since 2012.

The defense recorded six tackles for loss against the San Jose State Spartans. BYU ranks No. 25 in the nation with 7.3 per game-tied with Louisville, Kent St. & Duke and ahead of Michigan, Utah, Temple & Washington.



THE BYU DEFENSE

• GETTING BEHIND THE LINE. In 2014, the Cougars were 4-0 when notching at least three sacks in a game. In 2015, they are 7-0. Since 2005, BYU is 48-2 when notching three or more sacks in a single game. The Cougars have sacked the opposing QB 30 times this season, which is the most since the 2012 campaign when the team had 34.

- SACKS AND TFLS. Against San Jose State, BYU's defense recorded six tackles for loss and three sacks. The Cougars have notched at least six tackles for a loss in eight out of nine games this season.
- THIRD DOWN IS KEY. On the season, the defense is holding the opponent to 43 of 127 on third down conversions for 34 percent. It is the best third-down conversion defense through nine games since 2012 (25.6%).
- **STAYING POSITIVE.** BYU is 53-8 under Bronco Mendenhall with a positive turnover margin. The Cougars have recorded a positive turnover margin in five games this season.
- FBS ACTIVE CAREER LEADERS. Bronson Kaufusi is No. 7 in career sacks (22) and No. 21 in TFLs (33) among active career leaders in FBS football.
- Pass Defense. BYU has held opponents to under 200 yards passing in five games this season. In 2014, Cougar opponents threw for under 200 yards on three occasions. The defense has given up 1,882 pass yards this season, which is the fewest through nine games since 2012 when the team had allowed 1,510.
- 3 AND OUT. The BYU defense has held opponents to three and out in 43 out of 113 drives this season, averaging 4.78 times per game holding opponents to four downs or less per possession.

With an emphasis on special teams, the 2011 squad adopted an "old school" Cougar logo to represent the special teams. The Cougar head with the cap became the face of the team. donning special teamers practice gear along with the special teams flag carried out each game by a selected special teams player.

BRONCO MENDENHALL HEAD COACH

YEARS AT BYU

11th year as head coach, 13th at BYU YEARS OVERALL

27th year

Entering his eleventh season as head coach at Brigham Young University, Bronco Mendenhall has restored the Cougars' reputa tion as one of the nation's top college football programs. Taking over a BYU team that in 2005 was coming off three consecutive losing seasons, Mendenhall has guided his teams to 10 straight bowl appearances, two outright conference championships before football independence in 2011, and regular national top-25 rankings.

Under Mendenhall's leadership, BYU has earned a 90-39 record to rank 13th in total wins among all FBS teams since 2005 prior

to the start of 2015. Mendenhall also ranks 13th in winning percentage at .698 among active coaches with at least five years of FBS experience in the same time period.

The Cougars finished the 2014 season with an 8-5 record that included a 3-0 mark against Power 5 conference schools. Fueled by Heisman hopeful Taysom Hill, BYU won its first four games including a 41-7 win over then-No. 25 Texas. BYU then overcame a rash of midseason injuries to key players to finish the season with a 10th consecutive bowl game. In doing so, the Cougars became one of 12 programs to earn a bowl inviation in each of the last 10 years. Only Florida State

(7) has achieved more than BYU's six bowl victories over that timeframe.

The Cougars set a program record with four consecutive bowl wins from 2009-12, helping Mendenhall become the first BYU head coach to win six bowls in a seven-year span. The Cougars received nine straight bowl invitations for the first time since a string of 17 consecutive bowl bids under Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards from 1978 through 1994. Mendenhall is the only coach in BYU football history to take his first 10 teams to a bowl game, and is winning at the same pace as the legendary Edwards. Through his 129 games as BYU head coach, Mendenhall has a record of 90-39-similar to Edwards' 129-game mark of 93-35-1.

In 2006, Mendenhall was named the American Football Coaches Association Region IV Coach of the Year following an 11-2 season. In addition, the Football Writers Association of America named Mendenhall one of nine finalists for the prestigious Eddie Robinson Coach of the Year Award.

He has also served as the defensive coordinator for much of his tenure as the head coach. BYU has consistently fielded one of the nation's strongest defenses under Mendenhall's direction. Mendenhall's defense excels at keeping opponents out of the end zone, averaging a No. 20 national marking in scoring de-fense over the past eight of nine seasons, including three top-10 ratings. In 2012, the Cougars featured one of the greatest defenses in school history, allowing just 266.1 yards, including 86.9 rushing yards, and 14.0 points per game. Ranked No. 3 in total defense, No. 3 in scoring defense and No. 2 in rushing defense, the Mendenhall-coached unit held its first six opponents under 300 total yards (part of a streak of 12 consecutive such games dating back to 2011) and kept opposing offenses without a touchdown six times during the year. Adjusting to the team's up-tempo offense in 2013, BYU's defense ranked No. 12 in yards per play allowed despite defending more plays than all but four teams nationally. Only two teams that defended as many plays ranked better than the Cougars at defending their turf.

Another hallmark of Mendenhall's program has been the emphasis on balance and priorities in the many other facets of life outside of football. Reflecting that emphasis, BYU consistently received the most academic all-conference honorees each season as a conference member, while six Cougar student-athletes have earned seven Academic All-America citations un-der Mendenhall. Only four programs have had more Academic All-America citations during Mendenhall's tenure. In addition, BYU tops all FBS programs for the most selections to the NFF Hampshire Honor Society (3.2 GPA over college career) since the program began in 2007

Mendenhall was elected in 2013 to the American Football Coaches Association Board of Trustees as the District 8 Representative and also serves on the Ethics Committee. He began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at his alma mater, Oregon State. He later coached at Snow College, Northern Arizona, became the youngest defensive coordinator in the Pac-10 at Oregon State, then went to Louisiana Tech and New Mexico before coming to BYU as a defensive coordinator in 2003.
