BYU QUICK HITS

- BYU went 4-0 in its home and conference opener last season, defeating Idaho State 5-2 and New Mexico State, 3-2, 9-1 (5) and 6-3. The team will play Marist in its home opener before traveling to San Diego for a double header on Friday and Saturday to begin conference play.
- This will be just the second time that BYU will face Marist in its history and this will also be the Red Foxes first visit to Gail Miller Field.
- BYU started last home season with an 8-0 record. Overall they were 17-1 at home, with the lone loss coming against No. 20 Hawai'i.
- BYU has an overall record of 5-3 against San Diego and is 3-2 against San Diego at their home field. San Diego was picked to finish third in the Pacific Coast Softball Conference pre-season poll.

BY THE NUMBERS

6 Gordon Eakin has led BYU to six conference championships. The team won it's first conference championship in 2005, by winning both the regular season championship with a record of 16-2 and then winning three-straight games in the MWC Championship for the tournament title as well. Last year, BYU grabbed its sixth conference tournament championship in the Western Athletic Conference after beating out Fresno State in the final.

8 BYU has secured eight-straight 40-win seasons. Last year, the team ended it's season with a record of 45-15 to keep the run going. The team also has eight-straight postseason appearances. In 2012 the team went 2-2 in the Oregon Regional. BYU has only advanced to a Super Regional once in 2010 against the University of Arizona.

48 BYU currently has a total of 48 wins against PCSC opponents. They have the best record against Utah Valley at 25-1 and have yet to score a win against Cal State Bakersfield with a record of 0-1. The Cougars have been most competitive with San Diego, holding a record of 5-3 against the Toreros.

416 Gordon Eakin reached the 400-win mark last season with a 5-0 win against Louisiana Tech. He ended the season with a record of 416-175. In the MWC, Eakin held the highest winning percentage in MWC history in MWC games (.750) and overall. He is also a three-time MWC Coach of the Year (2009, 2010, 2011)

RED DESERT CLASSIC OPPONENT NOTES**MARIST COLLEGE**

The Red Foxes were 6-2 heading into last weekend's San Diego Classic II. Their four-game winning streak was cut short after going 0-5 at the Classic to fall to 6-7 on the season. In only its second matchup against BYU, Marist will travel to Provo for the first time on Tuesday and will complete its trip to Utah with a game against PCSC-rival UVU on Wednesday.

The Red Foxes are led by newcomer Nicole Cheek who is hitting a .395 clip alongside a team-leading 17 hits, 29 total bases and three home runs. Danielle Koltz provides power in the lineup, hitting .333 with 10 runs scored and a team-high 14 RBI. With nine less games under its belt than BYU, Marist has garnered 10 home runs on the season to BYU's eight. Marist has four pitchers who have all earned a win this season, but are led by senior Emily Osterhaus who has an ERA of 1.28 with a record of 2-3 on the season. The pitching staff as a whole has held its opponents to just 19 (1.46 per game) extra-base hits to BYU's staff who has given up 65 (2.71 per game) extra-base hits so far this season. Defensively, the team has turned eight double plays and were ranked 1st in the NCAA with double plays per game as of March 11.

SAN DIEGO

San Diego took a record of 10-12 into the San Diego Classic II last weekend and extended its winning streak to six games in the tournament to improve to 15-12. The Toreros faced Marist in their second game of the tournament and beat them 3-2 in eight innings before ending the weekend with two walk-off wins to close out the Classic. Senior outfielder Lauren Tomey leads the way offensively for the Toreros. The 2012 First Team All-PCSC member is hitting a .415 clip alongside 34 hits and 42 total bases. The team only has three home runs on the season, but make up for it in doubles with 24. USD has also out-hit its opponents 198-158 this season and outscored its opponents 81-75. Junior's Cassidy Coleman and Jenny Lahitte have seen a majority of the time on the mound this year. Lahitte has a record of 6-7 with an ERA of 1.69, while Coleman takes an 8-5 record and an ERA of 2.28 into the team's conference opener against BYU on Friday. The two pitchers combine for 203 strikeouts and have only given up a total of seven home runs. BYU hasn't played USD since 2010, when the Cougars defeated the Toreros 11-3 in the Louisville Slugger Desert Classic. The Cougars have an overall record of 5-3 against the Toreros and are 3-2 at their home stadium.

LAST TIME OUT

PROVO, Utah --An explosive sixth inning helped the BYU softball team ensure an 11-6 victory in its home opener against the Marist Red Foxes Tuesday night at Gail Miller Field.

"It's good to win and to be home," head coach Gordon Eakin said. "We've had our challenges with a lot of different things and its just good to get a win. I thought our offense did a great job. We had several kids with timely hits and we moved the ball well."

BYU (10-15) outhit Marist (6-8) 11-10 and had five extra-base hits on the evening. Marissa Bravo and Coryn Taualii each had three RBI on the night, with two hits apiece. Katie Manuma also drove home a couple of runs with a deep shot to left field, extending her hitting streak to tie her career-high of seven games.

Tori Almond earned the win, her fifth of the season. Almond had two strikeouts to close out the first inning and sat down three straight in the second. Another Marist batter struck out swinging to open the third inning, making it six consecutive strikeouts for Almond.

The Cougars broke the scoreboard in the bottom of the third after Carly Duckworth grounded a single up the middle and advanced to second on a wild pitch. Bravo followed with a single up the middle, advancing to second as Duckworth charged home. Duckworth slipped around the tag to put the home team on the board.

A three-run fifth pulled Marist within one run at 4-3. Red Fox freshman Maureen Duddy singled to right field in the three spot. Duddy advanced to second after Danielle Koltz reached on a BYU error, setting up Nicole Cheek for a three-run homer.

BYU pushed its lead to 11-4 in the bottom of the sixth with Bravo and Manuma picking up two RBI each. With Lacey Millett, JC Clayton and Duckworth on base, Bravo drove home two runs with a double to left center. Manuma hit a deep ball into left field to bring home the two runners and put herself in scoring position at second base. Madisen Robb came up big and hit a pinch hit double to bring in Manuma for the Cougars' final run. Marist picked up a couple of runs in the top of the seventh inning, but it wasn't enough to overcome the Cougars who took the 11-6 victory in their home opener.

TRADING CONFERENCES

The BYU softball team will be joining its third conference in three years this season. From 2000-2011, the team was part of the Mountain West Conference. In 2012, the Cougars switched to the Western Athletic Conference for a season. This year, the team will spend the 2013 season in the Pacific Coast Softball Conference before making its final switch to the West Coast Conference in 2014. Softball will be the WCC's 14th sport.

HITTING STREAKS

Three players for BYU have season-hitting streaks of seven games or more including freshman outfielder Gordy Bravo, junior infielder Katie Manuma and senior shortstop JC Clayton.

Bravo hales from Upland, Calif. and is currently hitting .413 for the Cougars with 17 RBI, six doubles and 12 runs scored. Her career and season high is eight games with a hit.

Manuma has had hits in all but five games this season. She had a seven-game hitting streak from Feb.9-Feb. 21 and is currently on another seven-game hitting streak to tie her career high. Manuma also hit a home run in every preseason tournament, including a grand slam against UC Santa Barbara in the Mary Nutter Classic.

Clayton leads the team with a 19-game hitting streak from Feb. 8-Mar 2. She is currently hitting a .422 clip with a team-high 38 hits and 17 runs scored. Her streak was cut short in the USF Showcase against Maine, but she has had a hit in every game of the season but two.

STREAKING CLAYTON

JC Clayton's career-high 19-game hitting streak ties her for the third longest hitting-streak in BYU history. The record is held by former BYU player and current assistant coach, laneta Le'i. Clayton also tied for the second longest hitting-streak in the Pacific Coast Conference.

GRAND OLE' SLAM

Junior infielder Katie Manuma hit her first career grand slam against UC Santa Barbara at the Mary Nut-ter Classic. Down 10-3 in the bottom of the seventh inning, the Cougars rallied to score three runs and bring up Manuma with the bases loaded. Manuma took advantage with a bomb that tied up the game at 10-10 and sent the game into extra-innings. BYU wasn't able to keep the momentum in the eighth and surrendered two runs to the Gauchos for the 12-10 loss. This was BYU's first grand slam of the season and Manuma's third home run.

Manuma is currently hitting .333 with 17 runs scored, 24 RBI and 44 total bases. Manuma has hit a home run in every tournament of the season so far, leading the team and conference with five.

IN THE RECORD BOOKS

There are a number of BYU softball players who are currently setting all-time season and career records at BYU.

Senior shortstop JC Clayton is only two hits away from tying the all-time record in career hits set by Angie Quiocho with 265 hits. She has 38 hits so far on the season. Clayton is also fourth all-time in career runs with 146 and second in career batting average at .406. She is currently ranked 48th out of 150 in the NCAA for season batting average at .430.

Sophomore Lacey Millett is ranked fifth for the season record in stolen bases with 14. She currently has 10 steals on the season and ranks 63rd out of 150 in the NCAA.

Pitchers Tori Almond and Hannah Howell are tied for fifth in season wins, each with 20 in 2012. They have also both moved up in the area of career strikeouts at BYU. Almond is fourth with 312 and Howell is not far behind in fifth with 305.

RETURN TO THE MOUND

Due to injuries within the BYU pitching staff, former high school pitchers Katie Manuma and Carly Duckworth will each see some time on the mound this season. Both pitchers made their first appearances of the season in the San Diego Classic. Manuma pitched 3.2 innings, giving up two earned runs on six hits. Duckworth pitched one inning and held opponents to zero earned runs on two hits.

Both pitchers also saw a lot of time in the USF Under Armour Showcase. Manuma relieved Hannah Howell in the first game against Maine and earned the save after holding the Black Bears to no runs on three hits. She started the second game of the doubleheader and held Maine to two runs on four hits.

After relieving Manuma in the bottom of the sixth against Maine, Duckworth held the lead for her first win as a Cougar pitcher. Duckworth also pitched a full seven innings against Providence College. She gave up five runs on 11 hits to fall to 1-1 on the season.

Howell was 1-1 as well in the tournament. Both Almond and Umphlett took the rest to prepare for conference play.

PCSC PLAYER/PITCHER OF THE WEEK

PORTLAND—BYU's Tori Almond was named Pacific Coast Softball Conference Pitcher of the Week for her play in the San Diego Classic, while Cougar shortstop JC Clayton was named PCSC Player of the Week for the second-straight week.

Almond earned both wins in the San Diego Classic as the team defeated Boise State 8-1 and New Mexico 6-1, bringing her record to 4-3 on the season. The honor was her first of the season. In her three appearances over the weekend, she garnered a 1.52 ERA and allowed just two earned runs on five hits. She held opponents to a .152 batting average while also striking out 10.

Clayton earns her second-straight Player of the Week honor after extending her season hitting-streak to 19 games with a hit in all five games of the San Diego Classic. Her streak ties for the second-highest streak in PCSC history and third-highest in BYU history. She is only two games away from tying both records.

In the San Diego Classic, Clayton hit .500 (9 for 18) alongside three runs scored, three RBI and one triple. Defensively, she contributed 11 putouts and 10 assists and she currently leads the team with 41 assists. She also leads the conference and BYU with 32 hits and 13 runs scored on the season.

PRESEASON POLLS

PORTLAND, Ore.-BYU softball grabbed the top spot in the Pacific Coast Softball Conference preseason poll for 2013.

All seven head coaches participated in the poll and six of the seven gave BYU a first-place vote, each worth seven points. BYU received 48 votes overall followed by Loyola Marymount with 39 and San Diego with 32.

Saint Mary's received the other first place vote as the defending conference champions and were picked to finish just behind San Diego with 31 votes. Utah Valley finished with 18, CSU Bakersfield with 15 and Santa Clara with 13 votes.

In their first season in the PCSC, the Cougars will look to improve upon their record of 45-15 and 15-4 in conference play last year. BYU finished the 2012 season after winning the Western Athletic Conference tournament championship and traveling to the NCAA Oregon Regional for its eight-straight postseason appearance. The Cougars ended their season against Oregon in a 4-1 loss.

**BYU head coach Gordon Eakin**

Eakin is entering his 11th season as the Cougars' head coach and his 14th season at BYU overall.

Eakin was named head coach in July 2002 after working as an assistant coach since the softball program's inception in 2000. Since that time he has led the Cougars to five Mountain West Conference championships, one Western Athletic Conference tournament championship and eight NCAA tournament appearances.

As MWC Coach of the Year three-straight years (2009, 2010, 2011) he has coached eleven All-Americans, seven MWC Players of the Year, one WAC Player of the Year, three MWC Freshmen of the Year and two MWC Pitchers of the Year during his tenure.

In 2010, Eakin guided the Cougars to 46 wins, the most in school history, as BYU advanced to the NCAA Super Regionals for the first time ever with wins over East Carolina and host Texas before ending its season at national runner-up Arizona. The Cougars finished second in the country in batting average, seventh in scoring and ninth in slugging percentage as a team last season.

Known as one of the best hitting coaches in the country, Eakin has helped BYU finish in the top-ten nationally six times in slugging percentage, six times in home runs per game, four times in batting average and four times in scoring.

In addition to his duties at BYU, Eakin has also been an assistant coach and the hitting coach for the USA National Team since 2009. In the summer of 2010, Eakin helped guide the National Team to a 17-2 record as USA won the World Championship in Venezuela, the World Cup in Oklahoma and the Japan Cup championship in Sendai, Japan.

Before entering the coaching ranks, Eakin was a successful baseball and softball player. After playing collegiate baseball at the University of Utah, Eakin signed with the Oakland Athletics organization where he played for three years.

Eakin went on to join the United States All-Star team, playing in three U.S. Olympic sports festivals in 1986, 1993 and 1994, winning bronze, silver and gold, respectively. While on the team, Eakin was honored on the ISC All-World First Team and was an ASA All-American. He would later go on to play shortstop on the internationally ranked Larry H. Miller Toyota Fast Pitch team, eventually earning induction into the Utah Fast Pitch Hall of Fame in 1998.

Eakin is a native of Holladay, Utah, and graduated from Granite High. He currently resides in Sandy, Utah, and is married to Barbi. They are the parents of three children (Alicia, Ryan & Parker) and have four grandsons.
