BY THE NUMBERS

6 Gordon Eakin has led BYU to six conference championships. The team won it's first conference championship in 2005, by winning both the regular season championship with a record of 16-2 and then winning three-straight games in the MWC Championship for the tournament title as well. Last year, BYU grabbed its sixth conference tournament championship in the Western Athletic Conference after beating out Fresno State in the final.

8 BYU has secured eight-straight 40-win seasons. Last year, the team ended it's season with a record of 45-15 to keep the run going. The team also has eight-straight postseason appearances. In 2012 the team went 2-2 in the Oregon Regional. BYU has only advanced to a Super Regional once in 2010 against the University of Arizona.

48 BYU currently has a total of 48 wins against PCSC opponents. They have the best record against Utah Valley at 25-1 and have yet to score a win against Cal State Bakersfield with a record of 0-1. The Cougars have been most competitive with San Diego, holding a record of 5-3 against the Toreros.

416 Gordon Eakin reached the 400-win mark last season with a 5-0 win against Louisiana Tech. He ended the season with a record of 416-175. In the MWC, Eakin held the highest winning percentage in MWC history in MWC games (.750) and overall. He is also a three-time MWC Coach of the Year (2009, 2010, 2011)

OPPONENT NOTES**Loyola Marymount**

LMU is currently on a four-game win streak after sweeping Saint Mary's in its last conference series. The Lions are 25-18 on the season and are just behind BYU in the conference standings with an 8-4 record. The team was favored to finish second in the conference preseason poll and are currently leading the conference with a .403 slugging percentage, 27 home runs, 63 doubles and 278 strikeouts. The Lions have been led all season by freshman pitcher Sydney Gouveia. She has a 13-2 record alongside a 1.54 ERA in 24 total appearances. Gouveia ranks 3rd in the NCAA in strikeouts per seven innings with 11.5, 9th in total strikeouts with 195 and 12th in shutouts with six. With a record of 5-1 in conference play, she has given up just 10 earned runs on 26 hits for a 1.81 ERA. Newcomer Hannah Montalban has also been a welcome addition to the team, hitting a .367 clip alongside 10 doubles and 14 RBI. The Lions have three players with five or more home runs on the season including senior Olivia Alvarez (5), junior Meghan Harman (6) and freshman Stephanie Crist (7).

In conference play, LMU split series with CSU Bakersfield and Santa Clara before its sweep of Saint Mary's. BYU is currently on a six-game win streak against LMU and in that time outscored the Lions 49-4. LMU is averaging almost four runs and seven hits per game so far this season. LMU has a huge in advantage in power at the plate with 27 home runs to BYU's 10 and 63 doubles to BYU's 34. However, BYU has an advantage on the base paths with 50 stolen bases to LMU's 16 on the season. LMU also has six more games under its belt this season, alongside one more conference series.

LAST TIME OUT

OREM, Utah –The BYU women's softball team split games on Friday and Saturday against conference foe Utah Valley at Wolverine Field.

Ashlee Brawley Robinson went 3 for 4 in game one on Friday and singled in the winning run in the eighth inning to lead the Cougars to a 2-1 victory over UVU. Howell (6-12) scattered six hits over seven innings to earn the win.

A three-run rally in the top of the seventh fell short as the BYU softball team was defeated by UVU 6-4 in the second game of a twin bill. Debra Lovell hit a walk-off, two-run homerun in the bottom of the seventh after the Cougars had tied the game at 4-4 in the top of the inning. Gordy Bravo tied the game in the top of the seventh inning on a two-out three-run homerun to centerfield. The home run was the first of the season for Bravo and the first of her career.

A seventh-inning comeback attempt in Saturday's first game by BYU softball fell short, as the Cougars dropped a 3-2 matchup with Utah Valley. Katie Manuma and Bravo picked up one RBI apiece for the Cougars.

The BYU softball team outlasted UVU for the second time with an extra-inning 3-2 victory against the Wolverines in game two. BYU and UVU weren't able to get a single runner past second base in the eighth and ninth resulting in the tie-breaker rule to start the top of the tenth. The Cougars and Wolverines each placed a runner from the previous inning on second base to start the top and bottom of the inning. Carly Duckworth, who was placed on second for BYU, advanced to third on a sacrifice bunt from Bravo. Manuma then stepped to the plate and smacked a hard hit ball to the pitcher, which was deflected and scooped up by the UVU shortstop to save the out, but not before Duckworth was able to cross the plate for BYU. BYU held onto the lead in the bottom to earn the 3-2 victory.

On Wednesday night, a four-run fifth inning allowed the BYU softball team to shut out Utah State 5-0 and keep its 11-game win streak alive against the Aggies on Wednesday at Johnson Softball Field. The Cougars (17-20, 6-2 PCSC) had just five hits in the game, but a three-run blast from Madisen Robb helped BYU to the 5-0 victory. Utah State falls to 8-30 on the season (2-7 WAC).

TRADING CONFERENCES

The BYU softball team will be joining its third conference in three years this season. From 2000-2011, the team was part of the Mountain West Conference. In 2012, the Cougars switched to the Western Athletic Conference for a season. This year, the team will spend the 2013 season in the Pacific Coast Softball Conference before making its final switch to the West Coast Conference in 2014. Softball will be the WCC's 14th sport.

HITTING STREAKS

Three players for BYU have season-hitting streaks of seven games or more including freshman outfielder Gordy Bravo, junior infielder Katie Manuma and senior shortstop JC Clayton.

Bravo hales from Upland, Calif. and is currently hitting .382 for the Cougars with 25 RBI, eight doubles and 17 runs scored. Her career and season high is eight games with a hit.

Manuma had a seven-game hitting streak from Feb.9-Feb. 21 and beat that streak with a hit in nine games from Mar. 2-Mar. 22. Manuma also hit a home run in every preseason tournament, including a grand slam against UC Santa Barbara in the Mary Nutter Classic.

Clayton leads the team with a 19-game hitting streak from Feb. 8-Mar 2. She is currently hitting a .385 clip with a team-high 50 hits and 27 runs scored. Her streak was cut short in the USF Showcase against Maine.

STREAKING CLAYTON

JC Clayton's career-high 19-game hitting streak ties her for the third longest hitting-streak in BYU history. The record is held by former BYU player and current assistant coach, laneta Le'i. Clayton also tied for the second longest hitting-streak in the Pacific Coast Conference.

IN THE RECORD BOOKS

There are a number of BYU softball players who are currently setting all-time season and career records at BYU.

Senior shortstop JC Clayton broke the all-time hit record with six hits against San Diego to surpass Angie Quiocho. She now has 276 career hits and 51 hits so far on the season. Clayton is also fourth all-time in career runs with 173 and second in career batting average at .400.

Sophomore Lacey Millett is tied for fourth with 15 stolen bases this season after grabbing two stolen bases against UVU in the team's last game of the series. She is also tied for fifth in season stolen bases with 14 her freshman year.

Pitchers Tori Almond and Hannah Howell are tied for fifth in season wins, each with 20 in 2012. They have also both moved up in the area of career strikeouts at BYU. Almond is fourth with 330 and Howell is not far behind in fifth with 321.

CONSISTENT CLAYTON

Senior shortstop JC Clayton has been as consistent as they come for BYU softball. The California native made an impact right away for the Cougars, starting in 54 games her freshman year. She had a career-high 80 hits that season alongside a .430 batting average and a career-high 56 runs scored. Her consistency throughout the season helped lead BYU to its first ever NCAA Super Regional against Arizona.

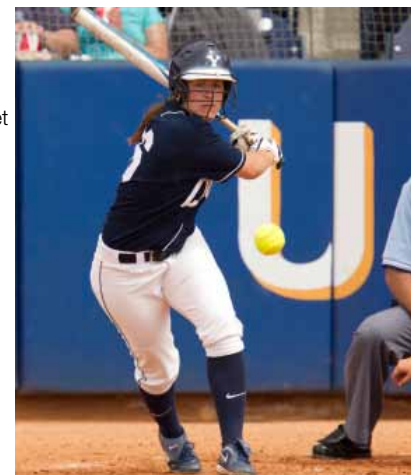
In her sophomore and junior seasons she started in every game and continued to add to her impressive freshman stats, leading the Cougars to two more NCAA Regional appearances and two conference championships.

In her first three years at BYU, Clayton garnered Mountain West Conference Freshman of the Year, Mountain West All-Conference First Team, Easton Second-Team All-American, NFCA All-Region First Team, All-WAC First Team and two BYU Offensive Player of the Year accolades.

At the beginning of this season, she was named to the Top 50 Watch List for the 2013 USA Collegiate Softball Player of the Year. With six hits against USD in the conference opener, she surpassed Angie Quiocho to hold the new all-time hit record at BYU with 275 career hits. Clayton also set a game record in game two against the Toreros for stolen bases in a game with four.

"JC has been a cornerstone on our team for four years now," Eakin said of her accomplishment. "She is a complete player. This record could stand for a very long time."

Clayton is also second in career batting average with .403, fourth in career runs scored with 169, second in career triples with 9 and third in career stolen bases with 38. She has also won three of the seven PCSC Player of the Week honor's so far this season. She currently has 274 career hits.

PCSC PLAYER/PITCHER OF THE WEEK

PROVO, Utah—Senior shortstop JC Clayton has been named the Pacific Coast Softball Conference Player of the Week for the third time in five weeks.

Clayton had a record-breaking week for the Cougars to lead the team to a 5-0 record and a 4-0 start in conference play. She hit .368 and scored a run in all five games, including three runs in the team's first matchup with San Diego. With her seven hits on the week she surpassed Angie Quioco as the all-time hit leader at BYU. She now has 269 career hits and leads the conference with a season batting average of .419, 44 hits and 23 runs scored. Clayton also had four stolen bases in the team's last game against San Diego to break the single-game record for stolen bases at BYU. Her record of four stolen bases in a game also ties the PCSC single-game record.

Freshman right-hander Lujane Mussadi from Saint Mary's earned her second Pitcher of the Week honor after going 2-0 last weekend. She pitched 21.2 innings and allowed just one earned run in the team's four game series against Utah Valley. Other top performers in the running for Player of the Week include CSU Bakersfield's Laura King who hit .214 with one RBI, two runs scored and three triples. Utah Valley's Debra Lovell was also noticed for her .533 clip, one home run and two doubles.

Cougar pitcher Hannah Howell was nominated as another top performer for PCSC Pitcher of the Week alongside Utah Valley's Josi Summers. Howell went 2-0 with a 0.93 ERA and 13 strikeouts, while Summers sported a 1.68 ERA and a 3-0 record.

PRESEASON POLLS

PORTLAND, Ore.-BYU softball grabbed the top spot in the Pacific Coast Softball Conference preseason poll for 2013.

All seven head coaches participated in the poll and six of the seven gave BYU a first-place vote, each worth seven points. BYU received 48 votes overall followed by Loyola Marymount with 39 and San Diego with 32.

Saint Mary's received the other first place vote as the defending conference champions and were picked to finish just behind San Diego with 31 votes. Utah Valley finished with 18, CSU Bakersfield with 15 and Santa Clara with 13 votes.

In their first season in the PCSC, the Cougars will look to improve upon their record of 45-15 and 15-4 in conference play last year. BYU finished the 2012 season after winning the Western Athletic Conference tournament championship and traveling to the NCAA Oregon Regional for its eight-straight postseason appearance. The Cougars ended their season against Oregon in a 4-1 loss.

Eakin at a Glance

**BYU head coach Gordon Eakin**

Eakin is entering his 11th season as the Cougars' head coach and his 14th season at BYU overall.

Eakin was named head coach in July 2002 after working as an assistant coach since the softball program's inception in 2000. Since that time he has led the Cougars to five Mountain West Conference championships, one Western Athletic Conference tournament championship and eight NCAA tournament appearances.

As MWC Coach of the Year three-straight years (2009, 2010, 2011) he has coached eleven All-Americans, seven MWC Players of the Year, one WAC Player of the Year, three MWC Freshmen of the Year and two MWC Pitchers of the Year during his tenure.

In 2010, Eakin guided the Cougars to 46 wins, the most in school history, as BYU advanced to the NCAA Super Regionals for the first time ever with wins over East Carolina and host Texas before ending its season at national runner-up Arizona. The Cougars finished second in the country in batting average, seventh in scoring and ninth in slugging percentage as a team last season.

Known as one of the best hitting coaches in the country, Eakin has helped BYU finish in the top-ten nationally six times in slugging percentage, six times in home runs per game, four times in batting average and four times in scoring.

In addition to his duties at BYU, Eakin has also been an assistant coach and the hitting coach for the USA National Team since 2009. In the summer of 2010, Eakin helped guide the National Team to a 17-2 record as USA won the World Championship in Venezuela, the World Cup in Oklahoma and the Japan Cup championship in Sendai, Japan.

Before entering the coaching ranks, Eakin was a successful baseball and softball player. After playing collegiate baseball at the University of Utah, Eakin signed with the Oakland Athletics organization where he played for three years.

Eakin went on to join the United States All-Star team, playing in three U.S. Olympic sports festivals in 1986, 1993 and 1994, winning bronze, silver and gold, respectively. While on the team, Eakin was honored on the ISC All-World First Team and was an ASA All-American. He would later go on to play shortstop on the internationally ranked Larry H. Miller Toyota Fast Pitch team, eventually earning induction into the Utah Fast Pitch Hall of Fame in 1998.

Eakin is a native of Holladay, Utah, and graduated from Granite High. He currently resides in Sandy, Utah, and is married to Barbi. They are the parents of three children (Alicia, Ryan & Parker) and have four grandsons.
