

Tori Almond passed up Christina Gwyn Trice for third in career strickouts last week against Utah. 8

She is one win behind Summer Tobias (45) for third place in career wins. She has also picked up the first two saves of her career against No. 2/3 Tennessee and No. 2/3 Oregon.

The Cougars have played 28 games against top five teams in program history with a 4-24 28 record in those games. This season BYU has faced four top five teams with a 2-2 record in those games. The Cougars lost to then No. 2 Washington 8-0 and No. 2 Oregon 3-2 while getting wins against No. 2 Tennessee 6-3 and Oregon 6-5.

Idaho State travelled to Portland, Ore., last week and took two of three games from Portland State to begin the defense of their regular season Big Sky Conference Championship. They have split two close contests against UVU and the University of Utah so far in their Utah road trip.

Freshman Kacie Burnett leads the team hitting .469, while junior infielder Vicky Galasso and senior catcher Terah Blackwell provide the bulk of the run scoring for Idaho State combining for 85 RBIs (46 percent of the team total) and 20 of the teams 25 home runs. Senior Haley Douglas is the primary pitcher for the Bengals. She has an 11-7 record with 32 strikeouts and a 5.10 ERA.

SALT LAKE CITY – Tori Almond passed Christina Gwyn Trice for third place in career strikeouts, but Utah took a 1-0 victory over BYU softball in nine innings.

"It was a great game that was well pitched by both pitchers," BYU head coach Gordon Eakin said. "Tori threw an incredible game and as good as she has in a long time. Utah deserves credit; they pulled it out in the end."

Almond struck out seven to give her 428 total career strikeouts, but did not have the run support she needed to get the victory over the Utes (11-9). BYU (10-18) had singles from Coco Tauali'i, Katie Manuma and Ashlee Robinson. Ashley Thompson went 1-for-4 with a double.

"We hit the ball hard, it was just right at them (Utah)," Eakin said. "I'm proud of our kids, they played well."

Utah put runners on first and second to lead off the bottom of the first, but Almond stuck out one and Robinson caught a line drive and threw to second for the inning-ending double play.

Manuma singled to right and Carly Duckworth walked to put runners on first and second with two outs in the top of the second. Robinson hit a blooper to center, but a sliding catch by Utah center fielder Chalese Hadley stranded the runners.

Utah doubled down the left field line with one out in the bottom of the ninth to put the winning run in scoring position. Kate Dickman then hit the walk-off double to center field to end the game.

IN THE RECORD BOOKS

Pitcher Tori Almond is fourth in career wins (44), third in career strikeouts (428x) and fourth in career shutouts (10). With one more win she will tie Summer Tobias for third all-time. She is BYU's career leader in lowest opponent batting average allowed at .206 ahead of Paige Affleck (.211). Almond also pitched the first no-hitter of her career on May 4, 2013. This marked the 15th no-hitter in BYU history.

McKenna Bull is fourth in strikeouts for a freshman at BYU with 92. With five more strikeouts she will pass up Tori Almond for third all-time. She is on pace to break the freshman record held by Paige Affleck (134) by the end of the year.

LAST YEAR VS. THIS YEAR

After breaking the all-time steals record at BYU a few weeks ago, Lacey Millett Hofstedt had her first extra base hit of her career against No. 2/3 Oregon.

With the bases loaded Hofstedt sent a line drive to the right field wall, rounded the bases and knocked the ball loose on a sweeping tag at home to finish off an inside-the-park grand slam. The four RBIs were also a new career high.

Her run also proved to be the winning run after the Ducks scored four runs in the top of the seventh.

BYU has finished tournament play with a 10-17 record. Last year they were 9-16 after tournament play. The Cougars have 19 home runs surpassing last year's season total of 18 home runs.

BYU head coach Gordon Eakin

Eakin is entering his 12th season as the Cougars' head coach and his 14th season at BYU overall.

Eakin was named head coach in July 2002 after working as an assistant coach since the softball program's inception in 2000. Since that time he has led the Cougars to five Mountain West Conference championships, one Western Athletic Conference tournament championship and eight NCAA tournament appearances.

As MWC Coach of the Year three-straight years (2009, 2010, 2011) he has coached eleven All-Americans, seven MWC Players of the Year, one WAC Player of the Year, three MWC Freshmen of the Year and two MWC Pitchers of the Year during his tenure.

In 2010, Eaking guided the Cougars to 46 wins, the most in school history, as BYU advanced to the NCAA Super Regionals for the first time ever with wins over East Carolina and host Texas before ending its season at national runner-up Arizona. The Cougars finished second in the country in batting average, seventh in scoring and ninth in slugging percentage as a team last season.

Known as one of the best hitting coaches in the country, Eakin has helped BYU finish in the top-ten nationally six times in slugging percentage, six times in home runs per game, four times in batting average and four times in scoring.

In addition to his duties at BYU, Eakin has also been an assistant coach and the hitting coach for the USA National Team since 2009. In the summer of 2010, Eakin helped guide the National Team to a 17-2 record as USA won the World Championship in Venezuela, the World Cup in Oklahoma and the Japan Cup championship in Sendai, Japan.

Before entering the coaching ranks, Eakin was a successful baseball and softball player. After playing collegiate baseball at the University of Utah, Eakin signed with the Oakland Athletics organization where he played for three years.

Eakin went on to join the United States All-Star team, playing in three U.S. Olympic sports festivals in 1986, 1993 and 1994, winning bronze, silver and gold, respectively. While on the team, Eakin was honored on the ISC All-World First Team and was an ASA All-American. He would later go on to play shortstop on the internationally ranked Larry H. Miller Toyota Fast Pitch team, eventually earning induction into the Utah Fast Pitch Hall of Fame in 1998.

Eakin is a native of Holladay, Utah, and graduated from Granite High. He currently resides in Sandy, Utah, and is married to Barbi. They are the parents of three children (Alicia, Ryan & Parker) and have five grandsons.
