#### **QUICK HITS**

VS.

- The 2011-12 season marks BYU's first as a member of the West Coast Conference and a new television partnership with BYUtv and ESPN that will give fans unprecedented access to BYU basketball. ESPN2 and ESPNU will broadcast a total of eight BYU games and BYUtv is currently scheduled to televise 18 games.
- Noah Hartsock and Brandon Davies both approached double-doubles and filled the stat sheet on Tuesday against BYU-Hawaii. Hartsock posted 14 points, nine boards, five assists, two blocks and two steals. Davies scored a career-high 25 points to go with nine boards, three assists, two blocks and one steal. Combined the shot 14 of 20 from the field.
- With the 73-52 win against BYU-Hawaii Dave Rose is 6-1 in home openers at BYU. Including the win over the Seasiders, the Cougars have won six-straight home openers. Last season, BYU defeated Fresno State 83-56 in the home opener.
- Dave Rose is one of the most successful coaches in the history of BYU basketball. He is second in program history in wins (160), first in winning percentage (.777) and has led the Cougars to five-straight NCAA Tournament berths and four conference titles. He also earned three Mountain West Conference Coach of the Year awards.
- BYU along with Butler, Kansas and Pittsburgh is one of only four NCAA Division I programs that has won at least 25 games in each of the last five seasons. Only eight teams have acheived the mark in each of the last four seasons, including BYU and WCC foes Gonzaga and Saint Mary's.

BYU will play its second of two home games in the Chicago Invitational on Tuesday, Nov. 22 against Prarie View A&M. The game is scheduled for 7 p.m. MST in the Marriott Center. Follow the game live via GameTracker on www.byucougars.com and listen live on the radio beginning with the pregame show at 6 p.m. MST on KSL Newsradio 102.7 FM and 1160 AM or via the Internet at KSL.com. The game will be televised live on BYUtv and BYUtv.org.

# LAST TIME OUT - BYU VS. BYU-HAWAII

PROVO, Utah – Junior Brandon Davies scored a career-high 25 points and the BYU men's basketball team cruised to a 73-52 victory in the season home-opener over visiting BYU-Hawaii, Tuesday night in the Marriott Center. With three minutes to play, Davies passed his previous career-high 24 points off a spin-move and basket to give him 25 points on the night. He led all players in points on 10-13 shooting from the field while also adding nine rebounds.

BYU shot 49.1 percent from the field and Noah Hartsock helped Davies out with 14 points, nine rebounds, five assists, two blocks and two steals. The Cougars held BYU-Hawaii to just 30.9 percent shooting and 25 percent from behind the arc. It took either team almost three minutes after the game started to get any points on the board but, with a bucket from Davies to kick off the scoring, BYU took control.

A Stephen Rogers block in the next possession kept momentum going and Davies finished on the other end with two more points. Another four from Davies, two from Charles Abouo and a 3-pointer from Brock Zylstra put the Cougars up 13-0 early.

BYU-Hawaii's Bracken Funk broke up the 13-point run from the Cougars with a three pointer, only to see BYU go on another 9-0 run before another Seasider would score.

The Cougars continued the onslaught and took their largest lead of the half, 26 points, with just 48 seconds before the break after a 3-pointer from Damarcus Harrison. Funk put BYU-Hawaii on the scoreboard first in the second half on a quick two points but Davies was quick to respond for the Cougars with a basket of his own.

Back-and-forth scoring highlighted the first 10 minutes of the second half but consecutive possessions for the Seasiders put five points on the board to cut the lead to 15. A 3-pointer from Rogers, however, silenced the Seasiders and BYU continued on a 4-0 run before the back-and-forth game continued. BYU-Hawaii's SeQuan Lawrence put the final two points on the board in the game with a minute to play. Lawrence's points finished the Seasiders' 21-point loss.

#### GOING GREEK

BYU men's basketball went on a 10-day, four-game tour of Greece in August. The Cougars won their first two games against the Athens All-Stars (88-56) and ASE Doukas (114-45) while also playing a friendly game against US Navy personnel on a base in Crete. While in Greece, BYU was invited to participate in the Acropolis of Athens Tournament against the Greek and Italian National Teams, both ranked among the top 10 in the world by FIBA. Against Greece, Stephen Rogers led BYU with 20 points in an 83-54 loss. Brock Zylstra exploded for 26 points and four 3-pointers in BYU's 102-63 loss to an Italian team that featured three NBA stars.

#### **NEW HOME**

In 2011-12, BYU men's basketball enters its first season as a member of the West Coast Conference. The Cougars have played each member of the league at least twice all time. Last season, BYU defeated St. Mary's 74-73 in the South Padre Island Invitational championship game and Gonzaga 89-67 in the third round of the NCAA Tournament to advance to the Sweet 16. #### NONCONFERENCE SCHEDULE

BYU's nonconference schedule features programs from 12 different conferences and includes nine teams that played in the postseason in 2011, including three that played in the NCAA Tournament.

#### **COACHING STAFF**

For the second-straight season there was a change to the coaching staff. Former associate head coach Dave Rice, who had been with the staff since Rose became the head coach in 2005, left to take the head job at his alma mater, UNLV. Rose hired Mark Pope as an assistant coach in May 2011. Pope comes to BYU after one season as an assistant at Wake Forest. Prior to Wake Forest, Pope was the director of basketball operations at Georgia. Pope played his college ball at Washington and Kentucky. In 1996, he was a team captain and helped Kentucky win the NCAA National Championship. Pope was selected by he Indiana Pacers in the second round of the NBA draft and played seven seasons in the NBA. He played in the Eastern Conference Finals with Indiana (1998) and Milwaukee (2001).

#### **ESPN AND BYUTV**

Eight of BYU's games this season will be broadcast on the ESPN family of networks, including: vs. Oregon at EnergySolutions Arena (Dec. 3 on ESPNU), at Saint Mary's (Dec. 29 on ESPN2), vs. Santa Clara (Jan. 14 on ESPNU) vs. Saint Mary's (Jan. 28 on ESPNU), vs. Gonzaga (Feb. 2 on ESPN2), at San Francisco (Feb. 16 on ESPNU), at Santa Clara (Feb. 18 on ESPNU) and at Gonzaga (Feb. 23 on ESPN2). BYUtv will broadcast all home games not televised by ESPN. Including the two exhibition games, BYUtv is currently scheduled to broadcast 18 home men's basketball games.

#### **YOUNG GUNS**

The 2011-12 roster includes eight freshmen who come from several different situations. Nate Austin and Ian Harward are true freshman and are coming off two-year missions for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. Josh Sharp is another return missionary and he redshirted one season at Utah prior to his mission. Matt Carlino and Anson Winder both redshirted for the Cougars last season. The other three freshmen — Damarcus Harrison, Austin Nelson and Jaren Sweeney — are all true freshmen.
