## BYU STORYLINES

- **First meeting.** BYU and Middle Tennessee will meet for the first time in Friday night's game.
- **BYU is 42-13-1 against Conference USA opponents**, with the last victory coming vs. Tulsa in the 2011 Armed Forces Bowl. BYU won 24-21.
- **Quarterback Taysom Hill had a career-high 260 passing yards** vs. Utah and had 99 rushing yards. His previous high was 235 vs. Utah State in 2012.
- **Hoffman needs three touchdowns, 367 yds and nine receptions** to become the BYU all-time record holder in each of those categories. He needs three more 100-yard receiving games to become the BYU leader in that category and 771 yards to become the BYU all-time all-purpose yards leader. Hoffman missed the Uva game due to a hamstring injury, but returned for the victory vs. Texas.
- **BYU averages 306.7 rushing yards**, while Middle Tennessee' averages 152.5 defensive rushing yards.
- **The defense has allowed only eight rushing touchdowns** over the last 15 games to tie for No. 3 nationally with Rutgers among all teams over that time period.
- **BYU's defense has 12 players with double-digit tackles in 2013**, led by Uani 'Unga's 25. Kyle Van Noy has 22 tackles and Alani Fua has 20. Seven players have 15 or more tackles.
- **During the game, the BYU coaches will wear Coach to Cure MD shoulder patches** on the sidelines to help raise awareness of the program.

**POSTGAME MEDIA AVAILABILITY**

**BYU RALLY FALLS SHORTS VS. UTAH**

PROVO, Utah – BYU football's second-half rally came up short as the Cougars fell 20-13 to the University of Utah Saturday in the Deseret First Duel at LaVell Edwards Stadium.

"I'm looking forward to working with my team again on Monday," head coach Bronco Mendenhall said. "Certainly they're disappointed, and we're disappointed. I'm anxious to see the resiliency and the resolve and to get back to work."

Utah (3-1) scored with 12:44 left in the fourth quarter to go up 20-6 before the BYU (1-2) defense held the Utes to a three-and-out on their final four drives of the game to set up the rally.

Senior Michael Alisa scored a touchdown to bring the Cougars within seven points at 20-13 with just over five minutes left in the final quarter. An incomplete pass on third down looked to end the drive, but Utah was called for unsportsmanlike conduct to keep the drive alive. Two straight completions to JD Falslev and Cody Hoffman put the ball on the 1-yard line to set up the scoring run by Alisa.

The BYU offense had two drives in the final three minutes of the game but was unable to score to tie the game.

Utah got on the board first, hitting a 36-yard field goal to go up 3-0 with 1:30 left in the first quarter. A 65-yard run helped put the Utes on the 25-yard line before the Cougar defense held tough to limit the scoring to a field goal.

Utah added a second field goal and a touchdown in the second quarter to go up 13-0 at halftime. The last time BYU was shut out in the first half was last season when the score was 0-0 against Boise State at halftime.

BYU received the opening kick of the second half and drove 68 yards on nine plays to set up Justin Sorensen with a 32-yard field goal to bring the score to 13-3. On the drive, Hill hit Mitch Mathews for an 18-yard gain before busting off a 41-yard run to set up Sorensen's kick.

After holding Utah to a three-and-out on its first drive of the second half, the Cougars put together a 13-play, 61-yard drive that culminated with a 31-yard field goal by Sorensen to narrow the margin 13-6.

**NOTES FROM BYU'S LAST GAME**

- **Taysom Hill went 18-for-48** for a career-high 260 yards with one interception and 99 yards rushing on 20 carries.
- **Jamaal Williams rushed for 52 yards** on 13 carries before leaving the game in the third quarter with an injury. He became the No. 26 all-time rusher at BYU with 1,153 total yards.
- **Cody Hoffman had eight receptions** for 108 yards receiving for his 15th career 100-yard receiving game for his career. He now has 2,889 career receiving yards, passing Margin Hooks to earn the No. 4 spot at BYU for all-time receiving yards.
- **Hoffman has caught a pass in 34 consecutive games** played dating back to Oct. 23, 2010.
- **Mitch Mathews hauled in three passes for 54 yards**, both career highs. His 26-yard reception in the third quarter was also a career best.
- **With 10 tackles, Tyler Beck also set a career best**—his previous high was six against Hawai'i in 2011. The senior tallied 2.0 tackles for loss, the first time he has registered a tackle for loss.
- **Senior Mike Hague notched a personal-best** six tackles, with all six coming as solo tackles.

**OPPONENT OUTLOOK**

**MIDDLE TENNESSEE'S LAST GAME**

BOCA RATON, Fla. - Middle Tennessee prevailed in a thrilling down-to-the-wire contest, defeating Florida Atlantic 42-35 in overtime to win their first game as a member of Conference USA on Saturday at FAU Stadium.

The contest saw five ties with the Blue Raiders (3-1, 1-0 C-USA) never trailing in the contest. Florida Atlantic (1-3, 0-2 C-USA) answered multiple times including a flurry of action during the final minutes of regulation.

Reggie Whatley's 64-yard rushing touchdown put MT up 35-28 with under two minutes remaining in the fourth quarter. After earning good field position, the Owls marched down 54 yards where quarterback Jaquez Johnson found Lucky Whitehead for a 21-yard TD to tie the game with just three ticks left.

In only the sixth overtime since MT joined the FBS ranks, senior signal caller Logan Kilgore found Kyle Griswold for the 19-yard game-winning touchdown. With FAU on its last leg on fourth down, Kevin Byard pick pocketed FAU's Johnson to seal the victory.

The Blue Raiders moved to 3-1 for the second consecutive season and the first time in back-to-back years since 1991-92.



Middle Tennessee ran 296 yards on the ground and threw for 150 for 446 total yards of offense. Florida Atlantic put together 503 total yards with 321 coming from the air. However, FAU committed a hampering five turnovers.

Whatley and teammate Jordan Parker helped the Blue Raiders reach over 200 yards rushing for the second time this season. Whatley belted a personal-best 155 yards and three touchdowns on 10 carries. Meanwhile, Parker reached his seventh 100-yard game with 115 on 28 rushes.

The passing attack was led by Kilgore, who completed 13-of-23 for a touchdown and one interception. His one touchdown pass marked the 40th of his career, tying him for third all-time with Dwight Dasher.

Tavarres Jefferson became the go-to wide out, as he snagged a team-best five catches for 66 yards.

**INDEPENDENCE: YEAR THREE**

BYU's 2013 schedule may be the toughest in program history. The 12-game schedule with six road games and six home games includes fellow independent Notre Dame and teams from eight different conferences, including the Atlantic Coast, Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12, American Athletic, Conference USA, Mountain West and Big Sky.

**FLAG BEARERS**

BYU has a tradition of selecting a player before each game to run the team flag and alumni flag. The team selects a former Cougar to carry out the alumni flag, along with the chosen current player who runs out with the current team flag. The team flag has been signed by each member of the team, while the alumni flag has been signed by former BYU payers. In 2011, the team added a special teams flag, donned by a vintage BYU logo adopted by the special teams, following the same protocol as the team flag with an exemplary special teams player being chosen to carry it each week.

**TEAM CAPTAINS**

Selected by their peers, wide receiver Skyler Ridley, slot receiver JD Falslev, linebacker Uani 'Unga and safety Daniel Sorensen have been named team captains for the 2013 season. Three of the four captains started their BYU careers as walk-ons. In 2012, Ridley caught the first touchdown pass of the season and finished with 20 receptions for 206 yards and one touchdown. Falslev was second on the team with 37 receptions last season, while also returning punts and kickoffs. Sorensen is a three-year starter and led the team with three interceptions and was second on the team with 68 tackles. 'Unga recorded 28 tackles, three tackles for loss, one interception and one fumble recovery in his first year at BYU after transferring from Oregon State.

**LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM**

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 64,045 after refurbishing the middle of the east section. The capacity now sits at 63,470 due to accommodations for wheelchair access. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's 2012 average attendance of 61,161 ranked No. 3 in the West behind only USC (87,945) and UCLA (68,481).

**MISSIONS**

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates 405 missions around the world in 145 nations speaking 164 languages. More than 75,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions in 330 missions around the world. Seventy-five percent of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours—seven days a week for two years or 18 months for women and couples—teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

There are 73 returned missionaries on the 2013 team. There are 57 missionaries from the football team currently serving in 18 different countries. Members of the team cover five of the seven continents around the globe.

**FIRESIDES**

The BYU football team will participate in hour-long devotionals prior or team service activities the night before each game this season. The team will conduct devotionals before eight games. These devotionals are referred to as "firesides" and are intended to help players, coaches and those who attend strengthen or gain knowledge of our purpose here on earth. Firesides typically include a musical number from members of the team and talks from selected players, along with Bronco Mendenhall.

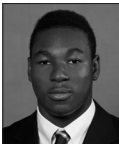

**THE BYU OFFENSE**

- **Sophomore Jamaal Williams rushed for a career-high** 182 rushing yards against Texas in Week 2. After a 52-yard output against Utah (the sophomore left the game after suffering a concussion), the sophomore ranks No. 26 at BYU for career rushing yards with 1,153 yards. He needs just eight yards to jump to the No. 24 ranking. A 114-yard effort will put him in the top-20 at BYU all-time.
- **Quarterback Taysom Hill ranks No. 8 in the country** in rushing yards per game with 133.33 per contest. His 259 yards against Texas are still the second-most rushing yards in one game this season. Williams ranks No. 10 nationally at 126 yards per game.
- **Keep an eye out for The Hoff Show.** Wideout Cody Hoffman has an opportunity to end his Cougar career as possibly the best receiver in BYU history. He enters this week needing just nine receptions, 367 yards and three touchdowns to take the top spot among the all-time leaders. As of now, Hoffman has amassed 213 receptions, 2,889 yards and 28 receiving touchdowns in his career, good for third, fourth and third, respectively, at BYU. Hoffman holds the record for receiving touchdowns in a game (5) and needs three 100-yard receiving games to have the most in program history.
- **Offensive staff rehaul.** BYU revamped the offensive coaching staff for the 2013 season. The new staff includes Robert Anae returning as the offensive coordinator for a second go-around with the Cougars after a two-year stint at Arizona. Joining Anae are offensive line coach Garrett Tujague, running backs coach Mark Atuaia, receivers coach Guy Holliday and quarterbacks coach Jason Beck. The new staff brings a variety of backgrounds and experience.
- **Go fast, go hard** has been the mantra of coach Anae. With coach Anae leading the offense again, he's brought the credo of "Go fast, go hard" to the team. Players conditioning has been ramped up with the expectation of nothing less than 100 percent on every drill, every rep and every workout.
- **BYU has not been shutout for 116 consecutive games.** The last time the Cougars failed to score was in 2003 in a 3-0 loss to Utah. That loss was the only other time BYU has not produced points since 1975. BYU has scored in the last 478 of 479 games since 1975.

**BYU DEFENSE BY THE NUMBERS**

- 1** In the game against Utah, the defense held Utah's offense to 1-for-14 on third down conversions. For the season, the unit has allowed opposing offenses to convert on 12-of-51 third downs to rank No. 7 nationally at 23.53 percent.
- 8** Over the last 15 games, the defense has allowed only eight rushing touchdowns to rank T-No. 3 with Rutgers nationally among all teams over that time period. Notre Dame has given up six touchdowns to rank No. 1 and Michigan State has given up 7 to rank No. 2.
- 12** BYU's defense has 12 players with double-digit tackles in 2013, led by Uani 'Unga's 25. and Kyle Van Noy who has 22. Seven players have 15 or more tackles including Eathyn Manumaleuna, Alani Fua, Remington Peck, Daniel Sorensen and Robertson Daniel.
- 20** The BYU defense has recorded 20 three-and-outs from opposing offenses this season. At this point of the season last year, the defense had forced 16 three-and-outs. BYU forces an average of 6.33 three-and-outs per game.

**THE BYU DEFENSE**

- **BYU finished the 2012 season ranked No. 3 in total defense.** The unit returns five starters to a defense that arguably was the best in team history. BYU finished the season No. 3 in the nation in total defense, ranking behind only Alabama and Florida State. The Cougars held opponents to an average of 266.1 yards per game, the lowest since 1974 when the Cougars held offenses to an average of 261 yards. The powerhouse held seven top-10 defensive rankings, including six top-5 rankings highlighted by the No. 1-ranked 3rd down defense and the No. 2 red zone defense.
- **One of everything, again.** After being the only Division I player to record a statistic in each of the major defensive categories in 2011, senior linebacker Kyle Van Noy repeated the same feat in 2012. The 6-foot-3, 245 pounder needed only a fumble recovery to duplicate his 2011 feat, which he did in the Poinsettia Bowl, stripping the San Diego State quarterback in the end zone and recovering that same fumble for a touchdown. The 2013 All-America candidate, who is also on the Bednarik Award, Nagurski Trophy, Butkus Award, Lombardi Award, Lott Impact Trophy, Maxwell Award and Walter Camp Award watch lists, was No. 3 in the nation in sacks (13) and No. 4 in tackles for loss (22). Van Noy led the No. 3 defensive unit in four categories, including tackles for loss (22), sacks (13), quarterback hurries (8) and forced fumbles (6) - a school record.
- **Making a name for themselves.** A strong fall camp earned Alani Fua a starting role at outside linebacker and other circumstances have pushed senior Tyler Beck into the starting role at inside linebacker. Currently Fua is fifth on team in tackles with 19, tied for third on the with two tackles for loss and tied for first with two sacks. In his first career start, Beck recorded a career-high 10 tackles and a career-high two tackles for loss against Utah last week.
- **A large defensive line will help anchor the defense.** Eathyn Manumaleuna returns to the field after suffering a season-ending knee injury last year and receiving a medical redshirt. The fifth-year senior and Outland Trophy candidate has started 38 games over his four-year career at both defensive end and defensive tackle. True sophomore and Ted Hendricks candidate Bronson Kaufusi and redshirt sophomore Remington Peck join Manumaleuna on the line, as defensive ends. In the mix for extensive playing time is junior Marques Johnson who redshirted last season. Combined, the four average a commanding 6-foot-4 and 283 pounds, and will look to wreck havoc in opposing backfield's all year long.
- **Behind enemy lines.** In three games this season, the defense has recorded at least six tackles for loss in each contest for an average of 7.0 TFL per game, ranked T-No. 35 nationally. Overall, the unit has recorded 21 TFL this season to rank T-62 nationally. Since last season, the defense has recorded 5.0 TFL in 15-16 games. Eathyn Manumaleuna, Uani 'Unga, Alani Fua, Daniel Sorensen, Tyler Beck, Remington Peck and Kyle Van Noy each have recorded 2.0 TFL or more with Van Noy tallying 4.5 to rank T-No. 53 nationally.
- **Injuries are part of the game.** The defensvie unit has been stung by the injury bug during the offseason and fall camp. JC transfer Trent Trammell, who was expected to fight for the starting job at boundary corner, tore his ACL during spring camp. Jordan Johnson, who started at all 13 games last season at field corner, tore his ACL during the first week of fall camp. Backup corner Adam Hogan tore three muscles in his quad during fall camp and will be out 3-4 weeks. The injuries have forced new players into the ever-important corner position, including true freshmen Michael Davis who began fall camp as a wideout and Dallin Leavitt.

In his first eight seasons as head coach at Brigham Young University, Bronco Mendenhall has restored tradition to the Cougars as one of the nation's top teams. Taking over a BYU program in 2005 that was coming off three losing seasons, Mendenhall has guided his teams to eight straight bowl invitations, two outright conference championships and regular national top-25 rankings. The Cougars finished the 2012 regular season 8-5, with a program-record fourth consecutive bowl victory, won four of their last five games and had the No. 3-ranked total defense in the nation.

Under his leadership, BYU has earned a 75-31 (.708) record to date to rank No. 12 in total wins among all teams in the nation since 2005. The Cougars have received eight straight bowl invitations for the first time since a string of 17 consecutive bowls invitations from 1978 through 1994. Mendenhall is the only coach in BYU football history that took his first eight teams to a bowl game and has the highest winning percentage of any coach in school history. He also has more wins in his first 100 contests at BYU than Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards.

Mendenhall has led BYU to bowl wins in six of the last seven seasons to become the first Cougar teams to ever win six bowls in a seven-year span and win four in a row. Nationally, no one has won more bowl games over the past eight years and BYU is one of only seven programs to win six bowl games in the last eight seasons. The Cougars have won 10 or more games in five of Mendenhall's eight seasons overall.

BYU's success under Mendenhall is also evident in the national rankings and NCAA statistics. BYU has finished ranked in the top 25 in the various national statistical categories 127 times in his eight seasons (47 offense, 58 defense, 20 special teams, 2 misc.). The Cougars have achieved 78 top-15 statistical rankings, 58 top-10 rankings and 27 top-5 rankings in that span. The Cougars have also been ranked in the top-25 polls during seven of the past eight seasons and finished ranked in five seasons, including No. 12 following the 2009 season -- the program's highest final ranking since finishing No. 5 in 1996.

Another hallmark of Mendenhall's program has been the emphasis on balance and priorities in the many other facets of life outside of football. Reflecting that emphasis, BYU consistently received the most academic all-conference honorees each season as a conference member, while six Cougar student-athletes have earned seven Academic All-America citations under Mendenhall. Only three teams have had more Academic All-America citations during Mendenhall's tenure. BYU has led all FBS programs three of the last four years for the most selections to the NFF Hampshire Honor Society (3.2 GPA over college career.)

He began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at his alma mater, Oregon State. He later coached at Snow College, Northern Arizona, became the youngest defensive coordinator in the Pac-10 at Oregon State and went to Louisiana Tech and New Mexico before coming to BYU as a defensive coordinator in 2003.

Hailing from Alpine, Utah, Mendenhall is married to Holly Johnston of Missoula, Mont. They have three sons, Cutter, Breaker and Raeder.

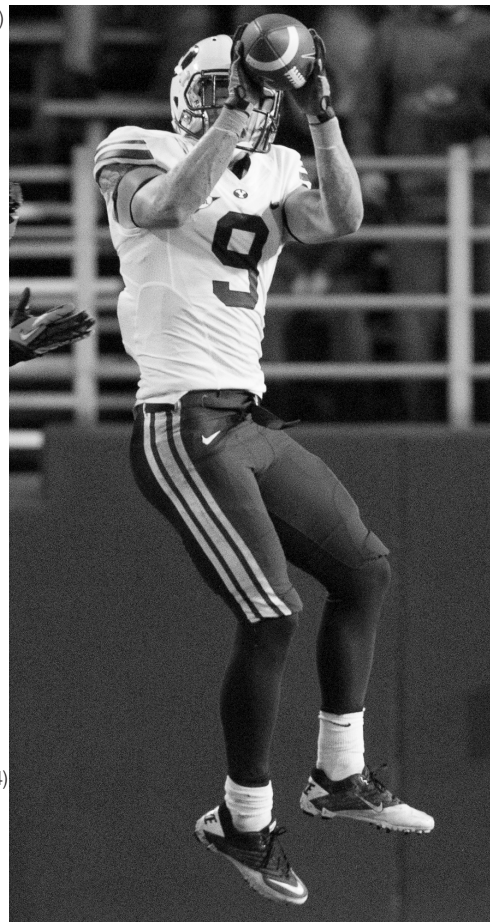
